THE HOWARD WEEDEN HOUSE HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

The date of construction — 1819 — alone makes the Weeden house significant. Built by H. C. Bradford, owned by John Brahan, lived in from 1824-27 by John McKinley (later associate justic of the U. S. Supreme Court), then bought by banker-planter Bartley M. Lowe, next Martha C. Betts, the house became the home of the Weeden family in 1845. Confiscation for use of Federal officers from 1862-65 was the only interruption in Weeden occupancy until the house was sold to Mrs. B. A. Stockton in 1956.

Alabama's history—from Constitutional Convention (held one block away in 1819) to the Space Age—is represented here in a single building. It can become part of the future. If enough people care enough.

ARTISTIC SIGNIFICANCE

The Weeden House is the birthplace (1847), lifelong home, and studio of one of the South's most outstanding nineteenth century women, poet-painter Maria Howard Weeden. From delicate water color sketches of wild flowers to deep toned oil portraits there is evidence of her versatility and skill. No other artist captured the brown skin tones and the spiritual dignity of the nineteenth century Negro. Miss Weeden was acclaimed from Berlin to Nashville. Scrapbooks of letters and clippings attest her popularity. Only her untimely death in 1905 prevented her ranking with the immortals in the world of art.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

The most significant historic buildings in the United States were included in the 1935 Historic American Building Survey. The Weeden House is one of these. Its plan is cataloged in the Library of Congress for reference of future generations.

1819 Federal detailing was "modernized" in 1845 to the then fashionable Greek Revival style. Fanlight and spiral starcase are among the rare architectural features. Much of the handmade window glass, floors, woodwork, and mantels are original.

Restoration as a house museum appear to be practical and not exorbitant. Fully restored and furnished the property will be forth about \$250,000, but much less money is needed immediately.

EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

Wordlessly proclaiming its wealth of cultural significance to every visitor, young and old, antiquer and engineer, black and white, native and foreign-born, the Weeden House can become an invaluable addition to the educational facilities of Huntsville. Restored and furnished, landscaped and maintained, and opened to the public on a regular schedule it will enrich the lives of countless people.

It will surely be the most important house museum in Alabama.

It will be the only such facility in this region.

Comparable only to houses in Charleston, Savannah, Natchez, and New Orleans, it will be an incomparable asset to Huntsville. The Weeden House Restoration Project is coordinated by the Twickenham Historic Preservation District Association, a non-profit Alabama corporation. Contributions are tax deductible.
