Dear Sir:

I am interested in securing a position as a teacher, counselor, art therapist, museum technician, graphics artist, librarian, or related fields. I am a certified teacher in the field of art and have had experience in Museum, Graphics, Counseling, Library and Art Therapy work among other fields. In 1975, I graduated from Jacksonville State University, Jacksonville, Alabama, majoring in Fine Arts, and from Auburn University, Auburn, Alabama in Education (Art) where I received additional training in art and my certification.

Both the Art and Education Schools at Auburn are nationally accredited, as you probably know, and the Education School is a member of NCATE and the Interstate Certification Compact.

I am well versed in the areas of mechanical perspective, lettering, drawing, painting, ceramics, pottery, sculpture (model construction and clay), printmaking, design, and history of art. I have a firm foundation in drawing and painting, having studied oil painting under a professor who received her graduate study from the Boston Art Academy. I have worked for the Graphics Department at Auburn University where I made transparencies and rendered Old English Lettering on Graduate Documents for the School of Education.

I am also well schooled in ceramics and pottery, and have taught pottery lessons at two summer camps in the mountains of North Carolina, where I was a counselor and English riding instructor. I was promoted to Division leader with the second camp.

If necessary, I am able to completely construct a potter's wheel and am experienced in the full operation of an electric kiln.

I also received a minor in American History with my B.A. and have studied in other fields such as Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, and two years each in English, French, and Science (Biology, General Science).

My duties as Director of Education at the Carson County Square House Museum consisted in participation in planning, designing, and constructing museum exhibits. While I was there working closely with the Director and Curator of the exhibits, we produced nineteen in all. In addition to this, my duties consisted of the accession of artifacts, giving tours and teaching a series of six art classes to children and adults in a two-month period. The education program was considered highly successful by the Executive Board of the museum and by the community as it was the largest ever in that we had fifteen different subject headings. The Museum Day, which is the annual fund-raising day for the Museum, was considered the most successful to date in relation to attendance and contribution. Special exhibits included heirlooms from the Masterson family (founders of the King Ranch in Texas), in which I participated in planning and construction. Lieutenant Governor Bill Hobby of Texas attended the proceedings. The Museum is fully accredited by the American Association of Museums.

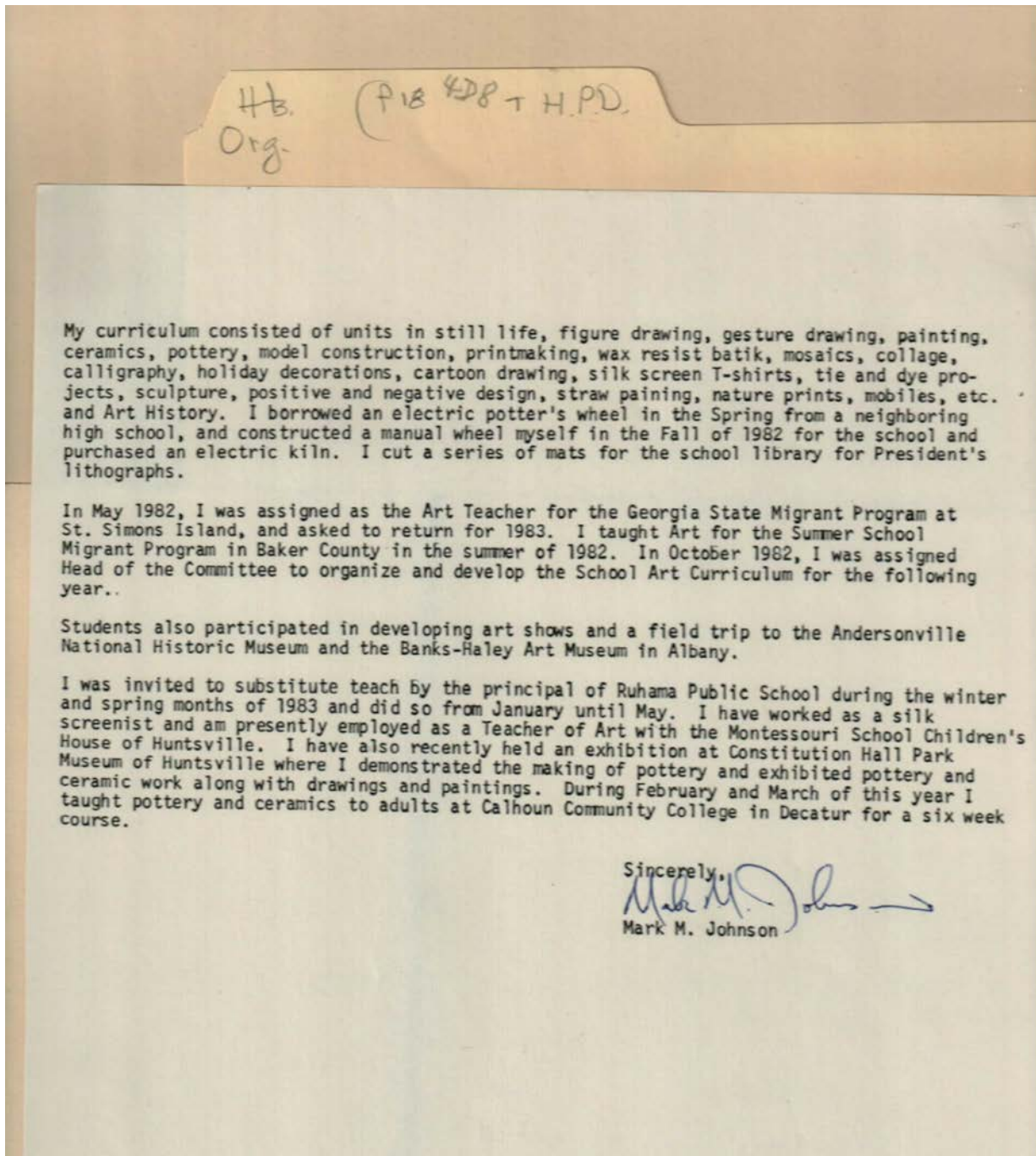
As of March 1, 1982 I was employed as an Art teacher with the Baker County School System, Baker County, Georgia, replacing the former Art teacher who had resigned in February 1982, due to a serious discipline problem in the school. I resigned in November 1982, after being struck in the face by a substantial sized student.
