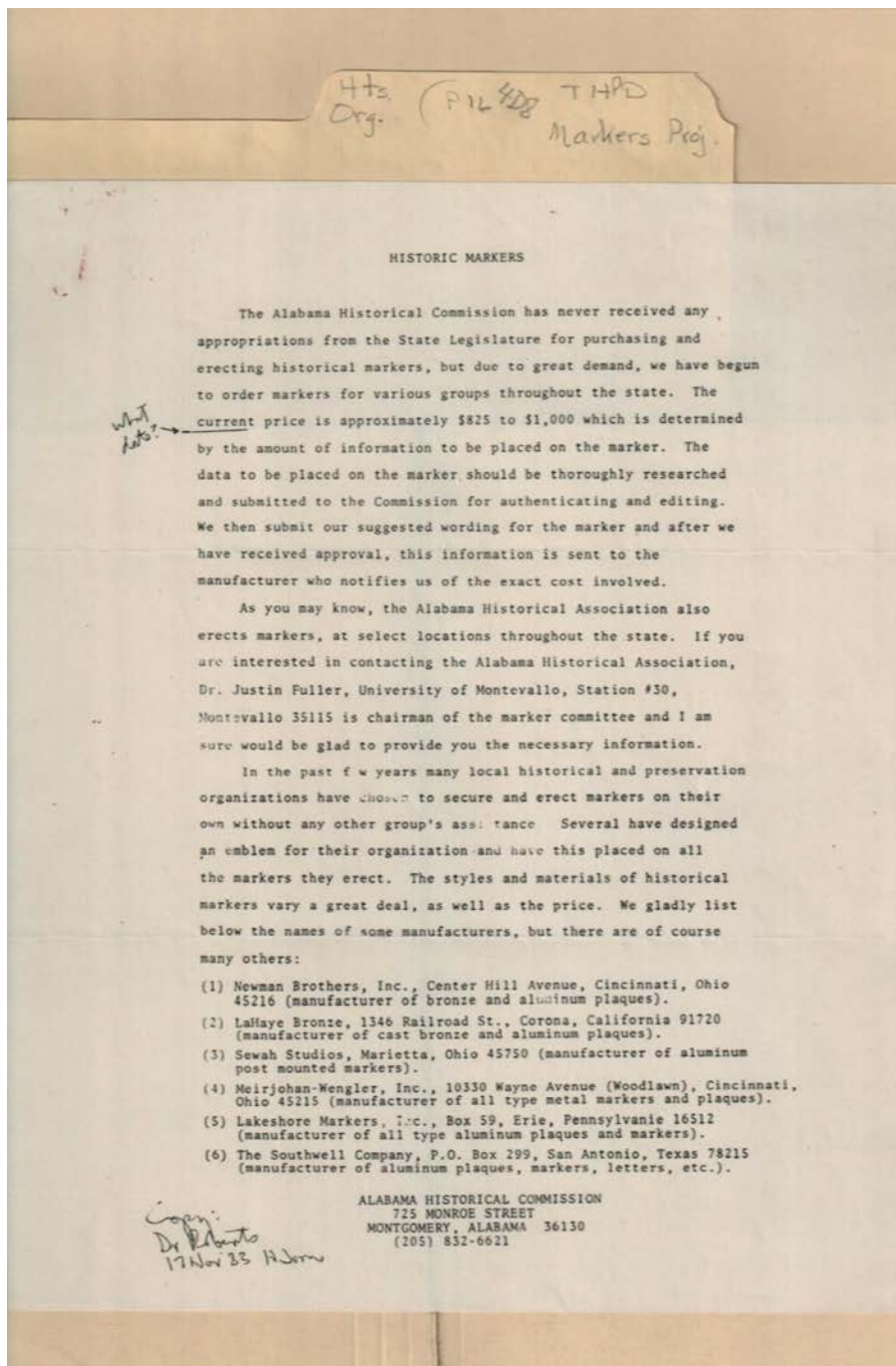

voided by Proclamation of Governor Pickens on February 1, 1825. LeRoy Pope, first and only president.  
 Located in Huntsville on west side of Square.

**SITE THE HUNTSVILLE INN** - A three-story brick building erected before 1817. Here, President James Monroe was honored at a public dinner on June 2, 1819, while on a three-day visit to the Alabama Territory. Here, also, the First Alabama Legislature convened on October 25, 1819, while Huntsville was the first Capital.  
 Located in Huntsville on east side of Public Square.

**SITE ALABAMA'S FIRST CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION** - Here, on July 5, 1819 forty-four delegates from the twenty-two Counties in the Alabama Territory met to frame a State Constitution which was accepted and signed August 2, 1819. Convention leadership was furnished by two Huntsvillians, John Williams Walker, president, and Clement Comer Clay, chairman of a committee appointed to draft the document.  
 Located in Huntsville on northwest corner Franklin and Gates streets.

**FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH**, Huntsville, Alabama - Organized June 15, 1818 by the Rev. Gideon Blackburn, D.D. One of the state's oldest Presbyterian churches. This site was selected for the first church building, dedicated on October 13, 1822. The second, and present, sanctuary was dedicated on May 18, 1860. Names of all ministers who have served this church are recorded on plaques in the sanctuary. This marker erected on 150th anniversary of organization.

Located here 1872-1964, **SAINTE BARTLEY PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH** - Oldest Negro congregation in Alabama. Organized 1829 by William Harris, a slave, who was minister more than 50 years. Original church, called Huntsville African Baptist, stood 4 blocks south in Old Georgia Graveyard. In 1870, this church and 3 others formed Indian Creek Primitive Baptist Association. Congregation occupied brick church on this site 1872-1964. In 1965, moved to new building 3020 Belafonte Ave., N.W. Present name honors Bartley Harris, saintly second minister. Other pastors: Felix Jordan, Eli Patton, Richard Moore, Amos Robinson.  
 Marker erected in 150th anniversary year.

**THE BIG SPRING** - John Hunt for whom Huntsville was named lived in a cabin near this spring about the year 1805. Erected by Judge David Campbell Chapter, 1948.  
 Located on west side Court House Square behind First National Bank in Huphsville. DAC.

**BELL FACTORY** - Earliest important textile mill in Alabama; Incorporated by Patton Donegan Company in 1832; 3,000 spindles and 100 looms operated by skilled slave labor; In production as late as 1885; Name derived from "bell" used to signal workers; Erected by Judge David Campbell Chapter, 1957.  
 Located 5 miles east of Huntsville toward New Market. DAC.

**CONFEDERATE MONUMENT** - Located on Courthouse Square, Huntsville. UDC.

**CONFEDERATE DEAD** - Memorial shaft in Maple Hill Cemetery, Huntsville. UDC.


**MARENGO**

**A COUNTY OLDER THAN THE STATE-MARENGO COUNTY** - Created February 7, 1818 by Alabama Territorial Legislature from lands ceded by Choctaw Indian Nation. Named for Marengo, Italy, where Napoleon won victory over Austrians in 1800. After Napoleon's defeat, some of his exiled officials came here in 1817 in vain attempt to establish Vine and Olive Colony. County seat, Linden, surveyed in 1824; named for Hohenlinden, Bavaria, where French won another victory over Austrians.  
 Located at Marengo County Courthouse at Linden.

**JEFFERSON BAPTIST CHURCH** - Established as Mt. Pleasant Baptist by Elder James Yarbrough in 1820 with 27 charter members. By 1834 it had 150 members. Church among oldest in Demopolis area. Buried in church cemetery are John Gilmore, Reuben Hildreth and John Sample - Revolutionary War veterans who founded Jefferson and helped establish this church.  
 Located in Jefferson north of Alabama Highway 28.

**SPANISH WEST FLORIDA** - Spain seized colony, 1780, from British during American Revolution. Ceded to Spain in 1783. 32° 25' northern boundary, crossed present Alabama-Mississippi here. Colony extended south to Gulf, from Georgia to Mississippi River. In 1795 Spain ceded area to U. S. but kept Mobile and Pensacola.  
 Located on U.S. Highway 80 between Prairieville and Faunsdale.

**GAINESWOOD** - Built 1842-1860 by General Nathan Bryan Whitfield 1799-1868, accomplished planter of the Canebrake, using imported materials and artisans. Glorifying the Greek Revival Architecture by combining Doric exterior, Corinthian grand ballroom,

Gentlemen:

Our daughter and her husband, Dr. Jeff Rothermel (NASA Meteorologist) moved to Huntsville this year, and we had the pleasure of visiting them and your nice city last March. As we drove around on our self-conducted tour, we were impressed with the Huntsville community, your community spirit, and the quality of the residences in the old, preserved part of Huntsville near the downtown area. The Huntsville area seems to be a nice place to live and work, and we are glad that our children are there.

There is something in our State of Ohio with which you could help us. Our family has had a summer home for 80 years in Lakeside, Ohio. Lakeside is on the Lake Erie islands area shore between Port Clinton (The Walleye fish capital of the World) and Sandusky. This year, Lakeside has been recognized as a National Historic District, having begun as a private Methodist Church conference area in 1873. Many of its structures have been listed specifically as having national historic significance, such as the Victorian-style Lakeside Hotel on the waterfront. Many cottages and homes deserve historic recognition also. Structures throughout the "grounds" have been maintained in excellent condition. Some have been preserved with their original furnishings, which are also close to or over 100 years old.

If possible, I would like to obtain the specifications of the signs which are in front of the dwellings in old Huntsville, such as the physical size, printing, mounting, color, etc. It would be helpful also if you could provide any rules and administrative procedures used to identify Huntsville's dwellings as historically significant locally, and to standardize locally such identification.

I have been asked by the Lakeside Association to recommend appropriate procedures for identification of structures within the grounds, and I shall use your data as a basis for a voluntary proposal to the Association's executive staff. One of their goals is to promote their historic status, and to involve as many property owners as possible, thereby enhancing community spirit.

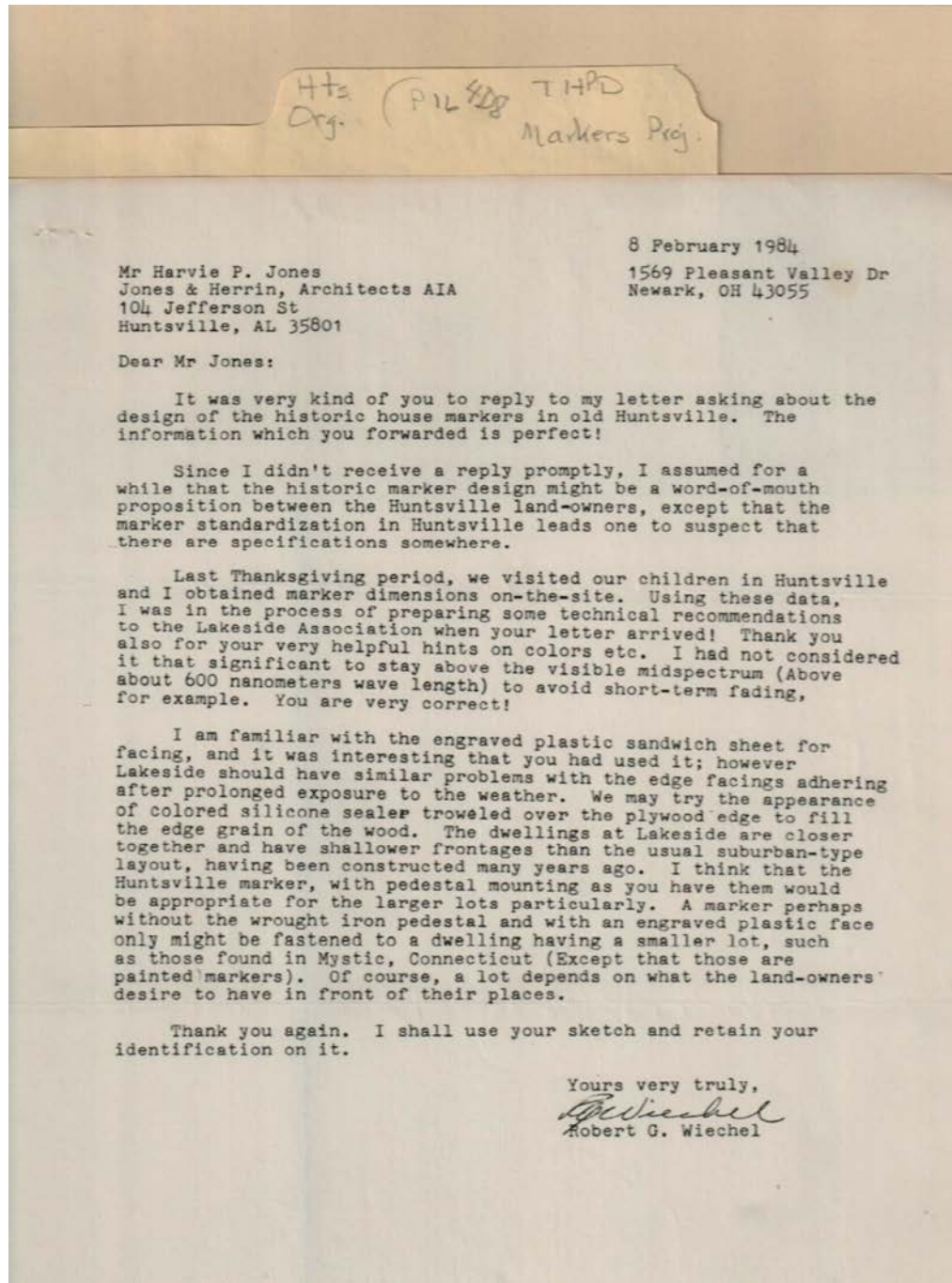

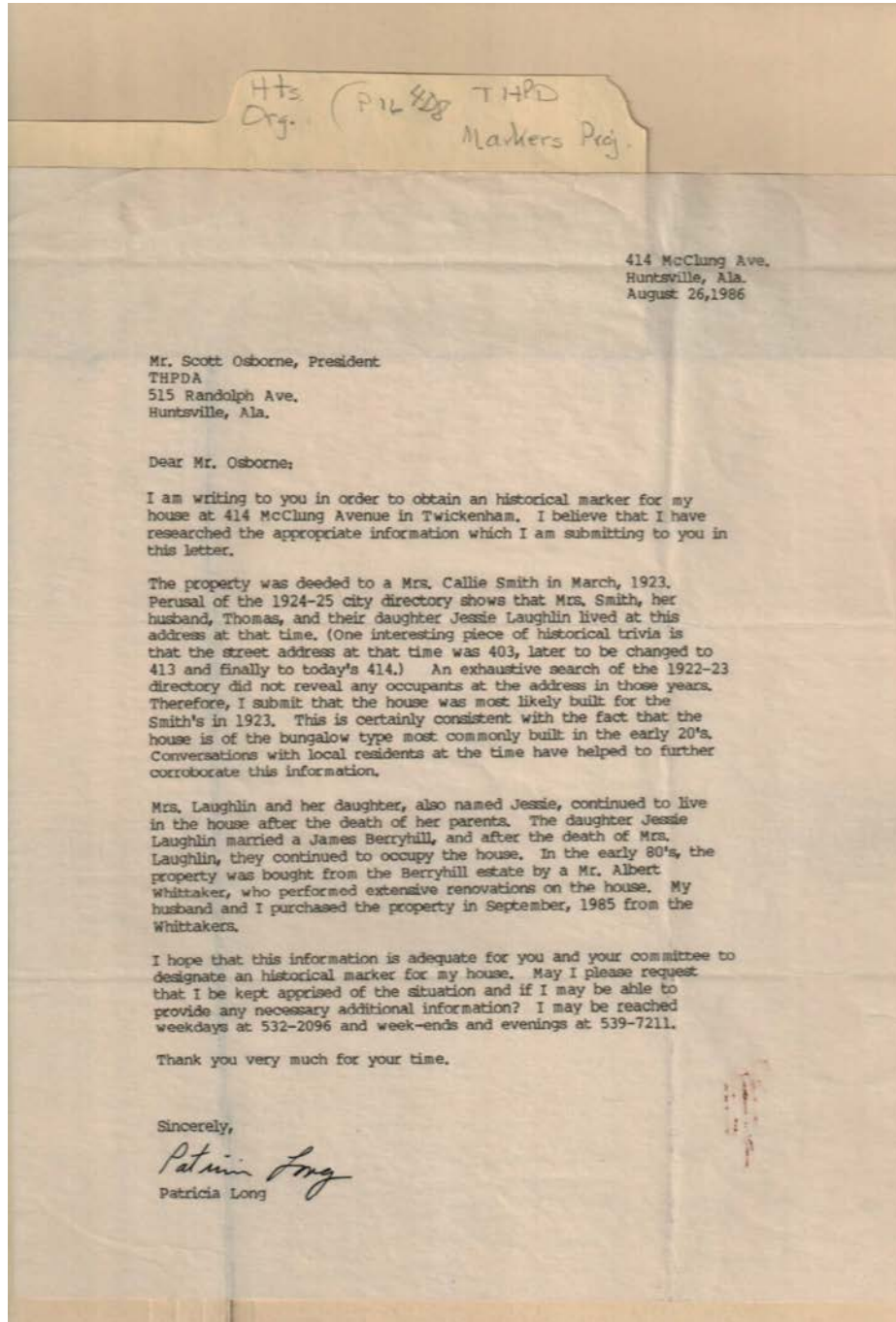
