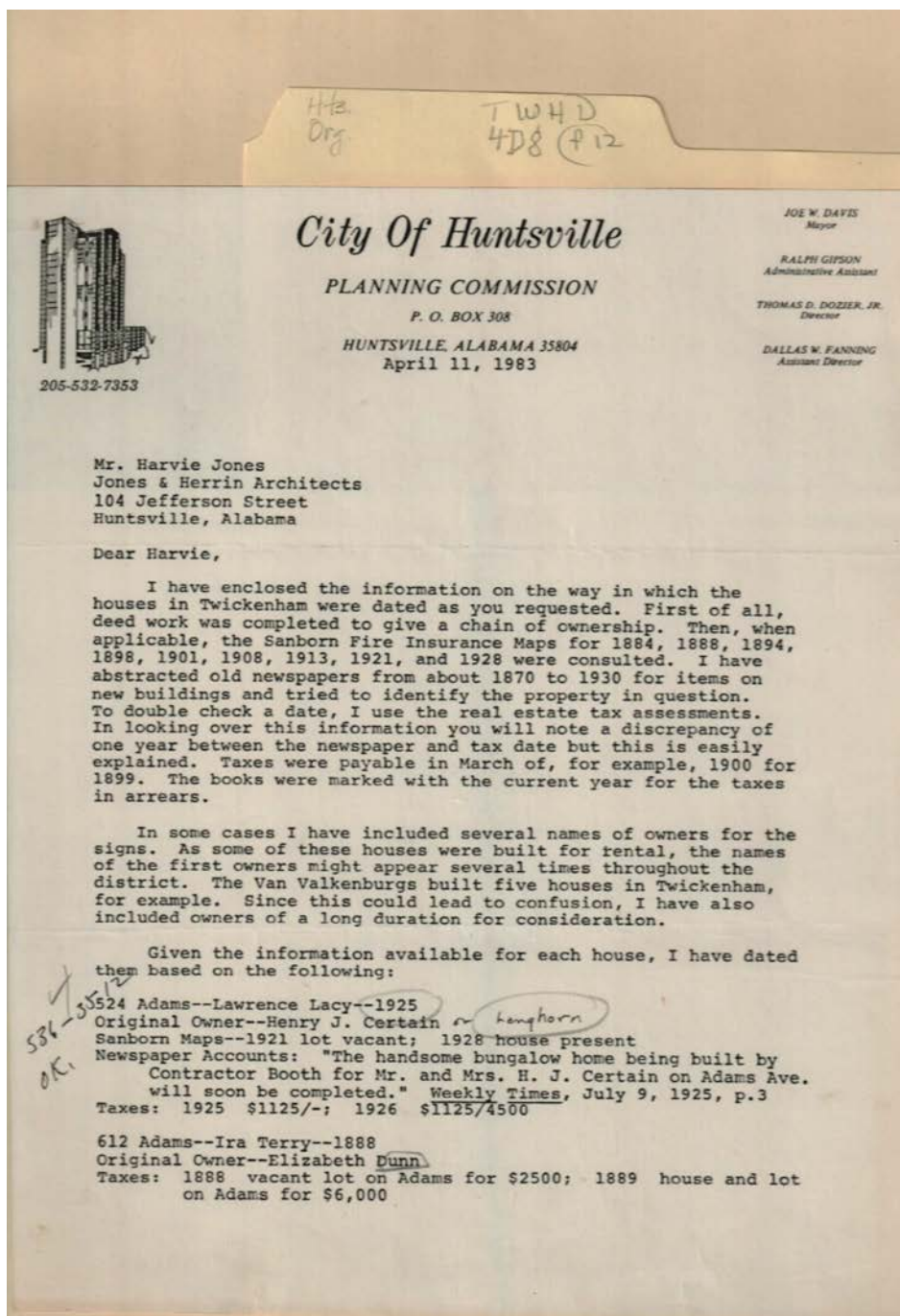

Newspaper Accounts: "A handsome two-story frame residence is nearing completion on Adams, the property of Mrs. Julia Clanton." Democrat, July 20, 1892, p.3 This tract is the only property Mrs. Clanton owned on Adams in the early 1890's.

"Mr. J. H. Landman has awarded a contract for the construction of a compartment (sic) house on Eustis near Lincoln. Work has already begun and will be pushed to completion. 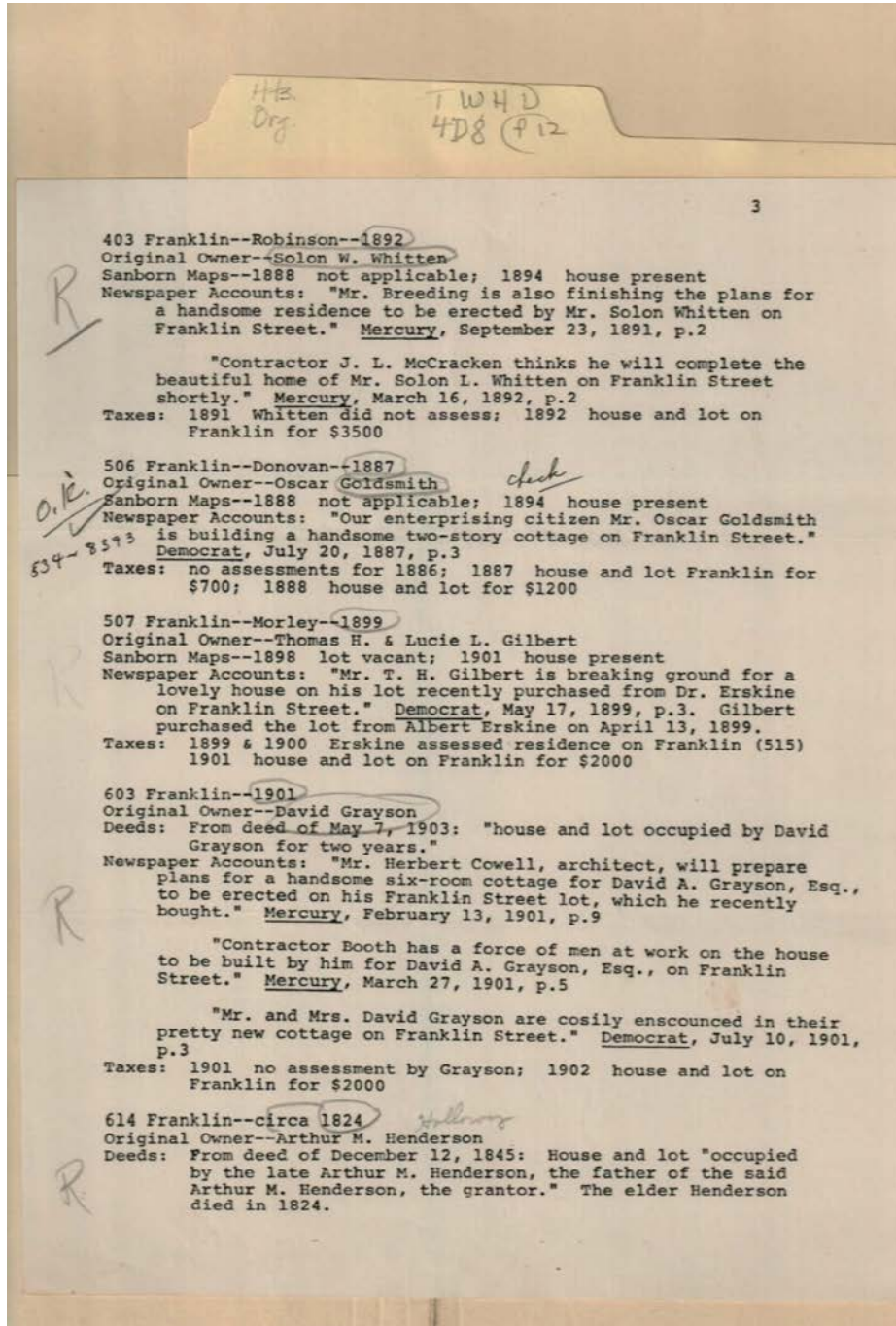

Democrat, August 17, 1910, p.3. Although the location given is incorrect, I have written a note on the file that previous accounts correctly placed the house at Greene and Gates.

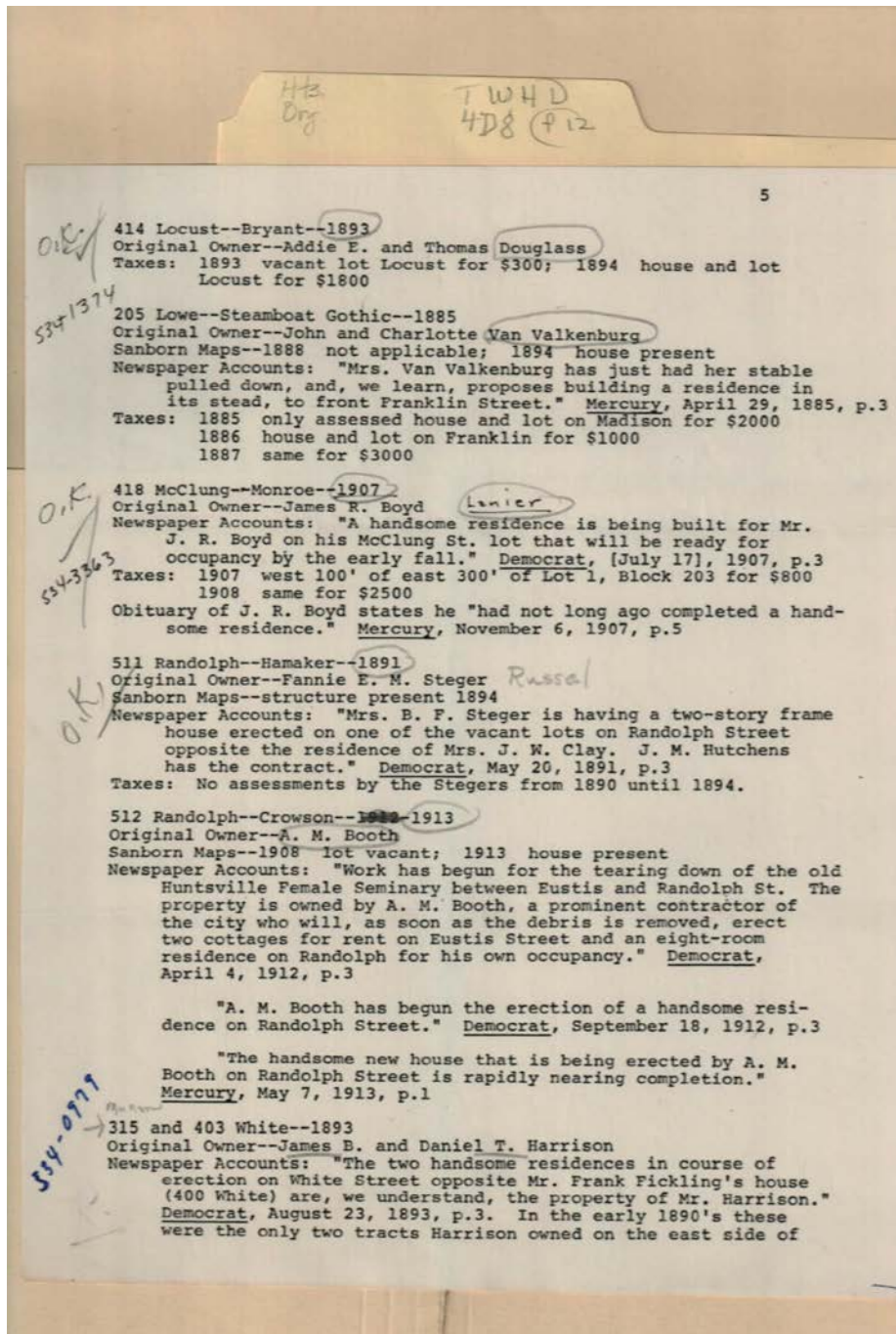

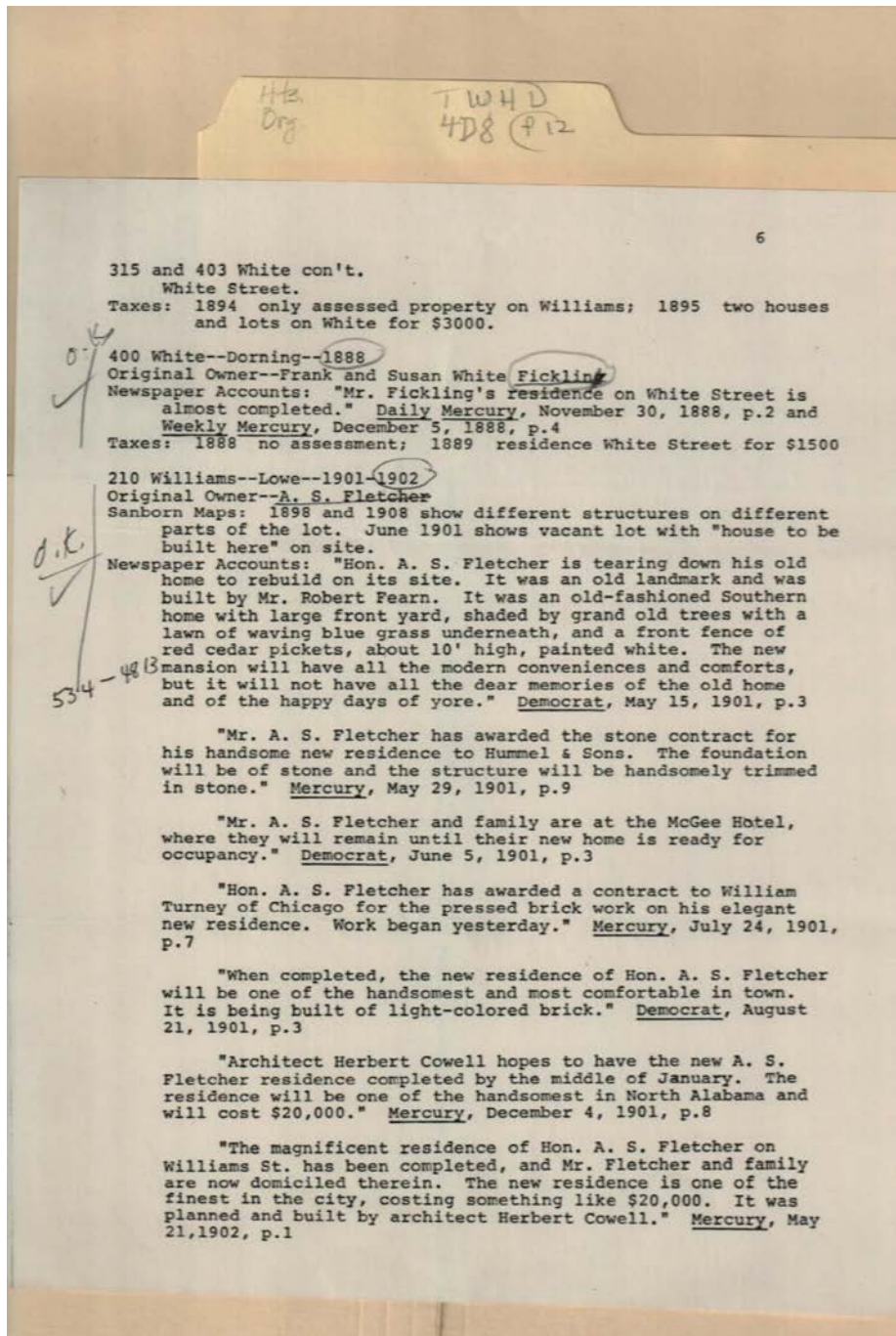

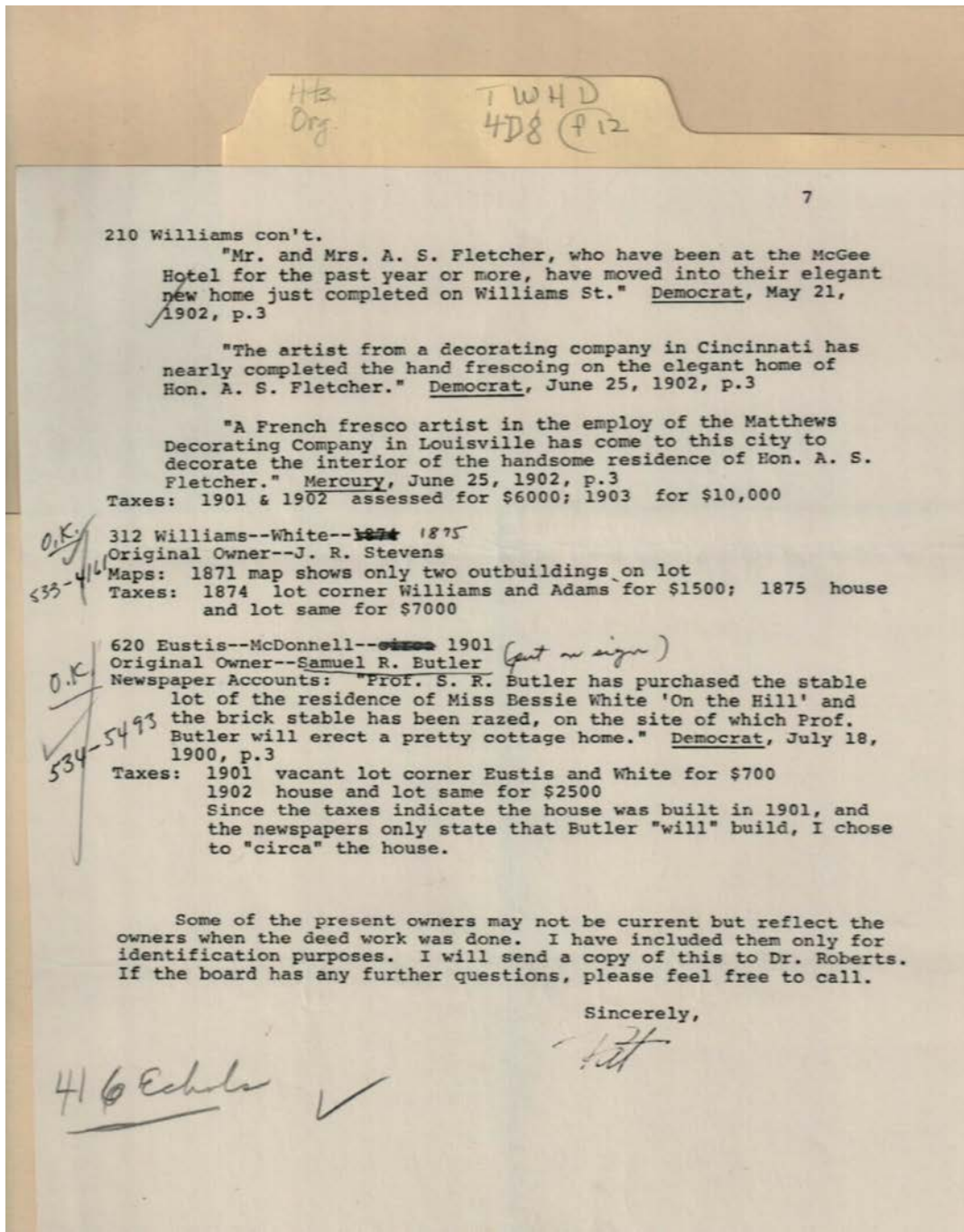

"Mr. and Mrs. A. S. Fletcher, who have been at the McGee Hotel for the past year or more, have moved into their elegant new home just completed on Williams St." Democrat, May 21, 1902, p.3

"The artist from a decorating company in Cincinnati has nearly completed the hand frescoing on the elegant home of Hon. A. S. Fletcher." Democrat, June 25, 1902, p.3

"A French fresco artist in the employ of the Matthews Decorating Company in Louisville has come to this city to decorate the interior of the handsome residence of Hon. A. S. Fletcher." Mercury, June 25, 1902, p.3

1902 house and lot same for \$2500

Since the taxes indicate the house was built in 1901, and the newspapers only state that Butler "will" build, I chose to "circa" the house.

Some of the present owners may not be current but reflect the owners when the deed work was done. I have included them only for identification purposes. I will send a copy of this to Dr. Roberts. If the board has any further questions, please feel free to call.
