## A Garden Bench for Indoors or Out

*Springtime in the South is a time to sit down and enjoy the season. Do just that on this bench you make yourself.*

Our bench design was inspired by the tradition-rich furniture of Southern gardens. The piece can be placed inside by a sunny window or outside in the garden. Either way, it will be appreciated for many springtimes to come.

Indoors, this bench is perfect in the sunroom or near large window areas where harsh sunlight can fade the fabrics or stained wood finishes of other furnishings. The slight curve to the seat is comfortable, but it also makes it practical. Outdoors, it helps water drain through the slats, keeping the wood from rotting.

If you are planning to leave the bench outdoors, make sure it is weather resistant. This can be done with the wood you select or with the finish you use.

Cypress is the traditional material for garden furniture. It's native to the coastal South and naturally resistant to decay and insect damage. Cedar and redwood are also suitable for outdoor use and are more readily available. With any of these woods, use only all-heart lumber, which is most resistant to decay.

Our bench is made of pine and has a weather-resistant finish. Pine and fir are easiest to find in the stock lumber sizes you will need. Both of these woods give a smooth finish and are suitable for painting.

Below are the basic directions for constructing your garden bench. A list is provided for your convenience when buying materials needed.

### Ends

Cut the pieces with a bandsaw or jig-saw; use Cutting the Pieces sketch at left to help with dimensions. From two 38-inch-long 2 x 4's, cut out identical back legs. Cut three seat supports from 17-inch-long 2 x 4's, and two armrests from 21½-inch-long 2 x 4's. From a 7-foot 2 x 2, cut two 24-inch-long front legs and two 17-inch-long stretchers.

For each side, fasten one seat support between a front and back leg, placing the bottom of the support 14 inches high (see sketch at bottom left). Use glue and wood screws. Countersink each screw in a ¼-inch-diameter hole. Peg each hole with a short section of ¼-inch-diameter dowel, and sand smooth. In a like manner, fasten a 17-inch-long 2 x 2 stretcher 6 inches from the bottom of the legs; then place the armrest atop the front leg, 24

### Winston-Orgain Home

ONE of the very earliest homes in Huntsville, this lovely two-story brick residence is presently owned by Mr. and Mrs. J. L. Orgain. A deed from LeRoy Pope to Arthur F. Hopkins in 1819 recites that it includes a brick house built by Peter Perkins. Perkins was appointed by the Territorial Legislature in 1809 as one of the commissioners who chose the town as county seat.

He is thought to have left the area in 1815, having served as clerk of the Circuit Court, member of the first county governing body, and representative to the Territorial Legislature.

Arthur F. Hopkins, a distinguished citizen, served as chief justice of the Alabama Supreme Court and as United States Senator and also as a member of the first state constitutional convention, state senator and representative. Leader of the Alabama Whig party, he also became, in 1856, president of the Mobile and Ohio Railroad.

Another notable owner of the property from 1842 to 1870 was Mrs. Jane Hamilton Childs, an early president of Athens College. In 1925 the house became the property of Mayme G. Woodward whose descendants still live there.

Lovingly preserved through the years, this is one of the ante-bellum homes that has never required extensive renovation. The entrance porch is a mid-Nineteenth Century addition. Especially noteworthy to architectural students are the windows, double flanked by additional rows of panes in a faintly Palladian manner.

Built on what were the "outskirts" of town at that time, this beautiful home serenely faces the core of redeveloping downtown Huntsville.
