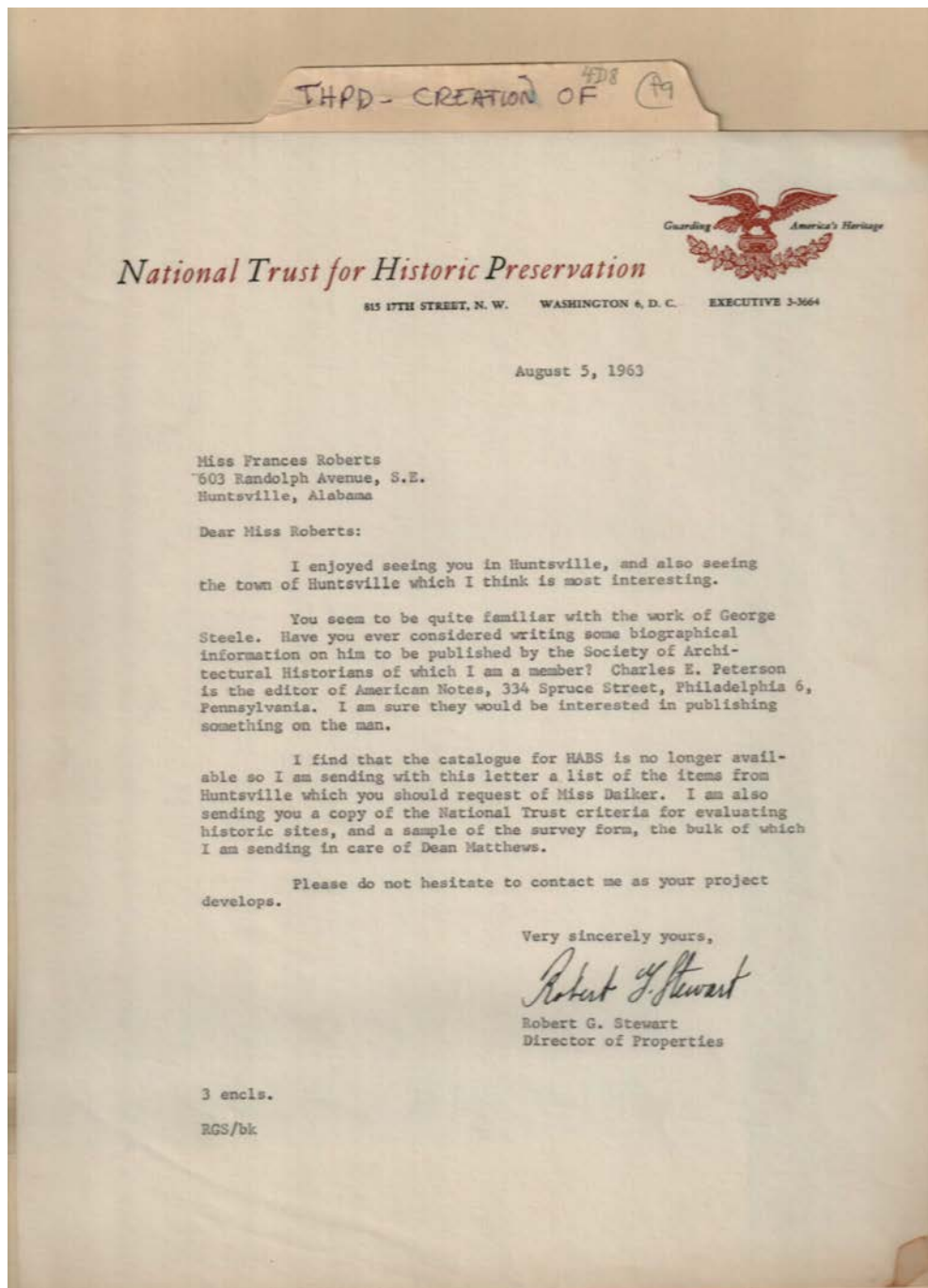

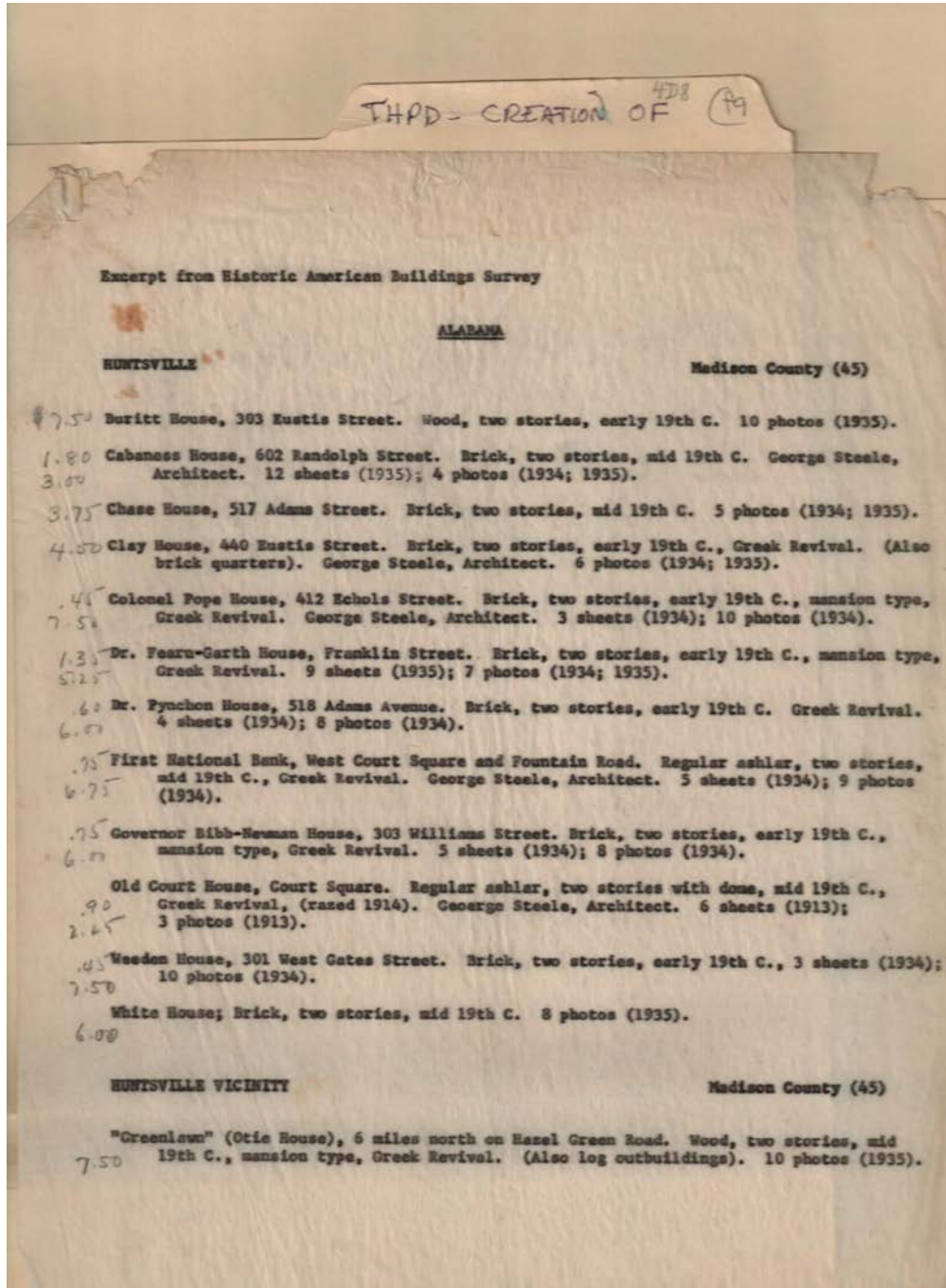

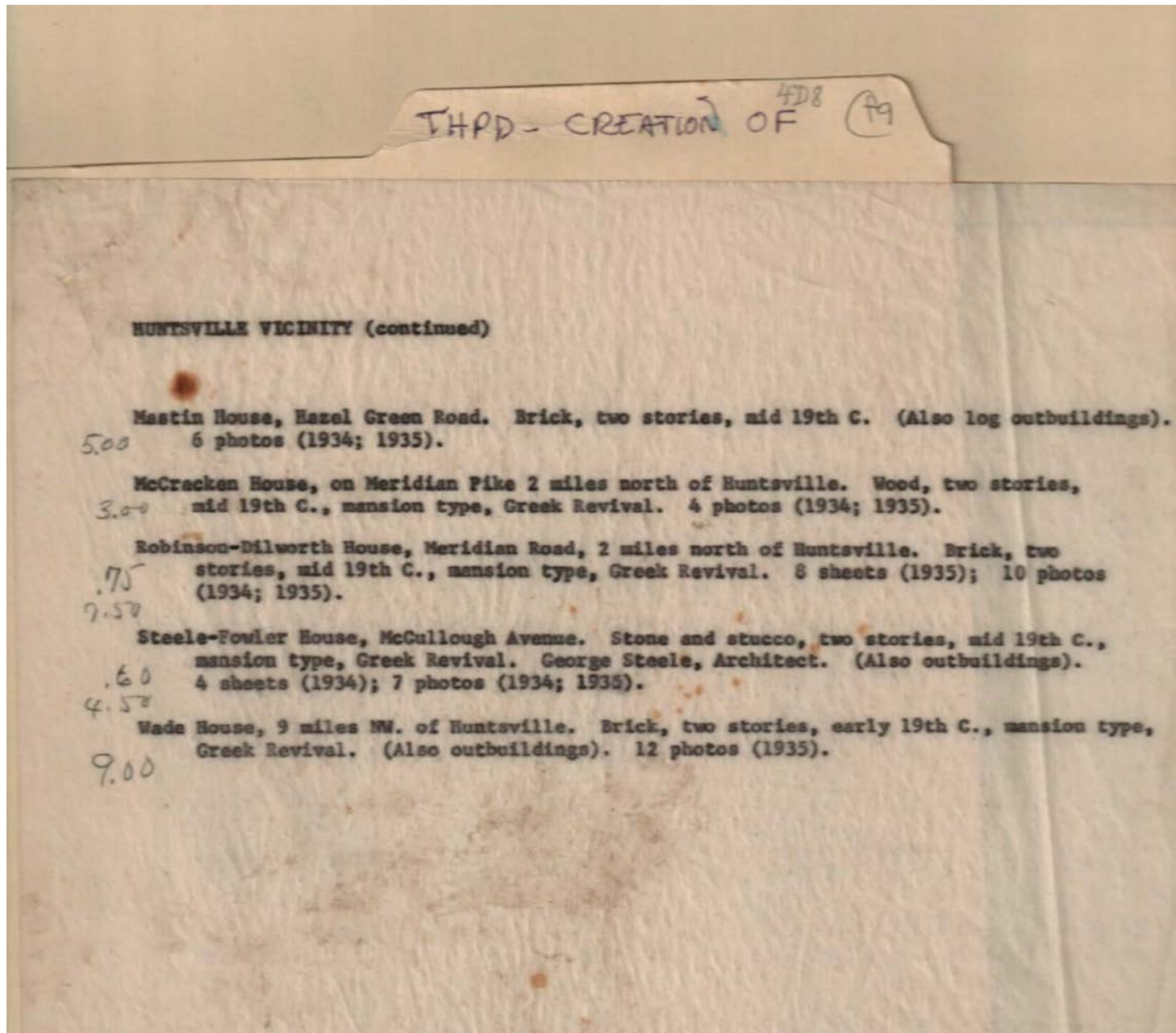

Dear Mrs. Fisk:

You may count me in on any movement to preserve any historical asset of Huntsville. I have written Mr. Record not once, but thrice, regarding my feelings about the court house and its contents, and also to this district's commissioner although, from what I know of him, I'd not imagine him to be the least interested in anything which happened as early as 1900, much less the 1800's. Mr. Record has promised that he will see to the safekeeping of our papers, but having once heard Mr. Spencer tell the Grand Jury, when inspecting the CH, that "once we get them microfilmed, we can get rid of that old stuff", waving at the old Probate Record Books, ^{1800's} the contents of the files, the loose papers, have much in them which was never recorded. It makes me heartsick.

I reminded Mr. Record people go to Williamsburg, but not to see 8 story buildings, in the modern manner. I told him I could not, due to my husband's health, attend any meetings, but to be sure I was much opposed to the destruction of that fine example of a type of architecture which has endured many hundreds of years, without ever having "gone out of style."

My daughter told me the "newscaster" for the TV made a very slighting reference the other night to the opposition-- that no one said anything, till all the plans were made. For one thing, the people in the county knew nothing of what was going on. The Huntsville Times--whether by design to keep us in the dark, I know not, never published anything at all about it in the edition which is sent out of town, till Mr. Leuherson proposed a change. Since then, they have printed a little, but that of course after the Court said there was "no objection," and it would be full steam ahead.

Did you notice that line in this month's Reader's Digest--that in the US one generation razed a landmark, and the next raised a fund for its restoration?
Any nation which forgets its past, has no future.

THPD - CREATION OF ⁴⁰⁸ (19)

- 4 -

A. In the case of a proposed alteration or addition to an existing building, that such alteration or addition will not materially impair the architectural or historic value of the building;

B. In the case of a proposed new building, that such building will not, in itself or by reason of its location on the site, materially impair the architectural or historic value of buildings on adjacent sites or in the immediate vicinity;

C. In the case of a proposed new building, that such building will not be injurious to the general visual character of the Historic Mobile District in which it is to be located;

D. In the case of the proposed demolition of an existing building, that the removal of such building will not be detrimental to the historic and architectural character of the District or that, balancing the interest of the City in preserving the integrity of the District and the interest of the owner of the property in the use of benefits of his property, approval of the plans for demolition is required by considerations of reasonable justice and equity; in the latter event the Board shall issue an order postponing demolition for a period of not to exceed six months. If the Board concludes that the demolition should be postponed, it shall, before issuing any final order with respect to such postponement, afford the applicant an opportunity to appear before the Board to offer any evidence he may desire to present concerning the proposed order. Within the period of postponement, the Board shall consult with the Historic Mobile Development Commission and others to ascertain what the City or other agency or organization may do to preserve such architecturally or historically valuable building and shall make recommendations to that effect to the Board of Commissioners or otherwise cause the building to be preserved.

E. In the case of a proposed addition to an existing building or the case of a proposed new building, that such addition or new building will not adversely affect the Master Plan of the City of Mobile.

c. Form of Decision. Every decision of the Board, in passing upon plans for buildings located or to be located in Historic Mobile Districts, shall be in the form of a written order stating the finding of the Board, its decision and the reasons therefor.

d. Recommendations for Changes. The Board shall not disapprove any plans without giving its recommendations for changes necessary to be made before the plans will be reconsidered. Such recommendations may be general in scope, and compliance with them shall qualify the plans for reconsideration by the Board.

e. Member Disqualified from Voting. Any member of the Board who shall be employed to design or construct a building or who shall have any proprietary, tenancy or personal interest in such building requiring approval of the plans by the Board shall be disqualified from voting thereon.

SECTION SIX: APPEALS

1. Procedure for Appeal. Any person aggrieved by a decision of the Review Board may, within 15 days thereafter, appeal therefrom to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mobile. He shall file with the Architectural Review Board a written notice of appeal specifying the decision from which such appeal is taken.

2. Transcript of Proceedings. Upon receiving notice of appeal, the Architectural Review Board shall transmit to the Board of Commissioners a certified copy of the proceedings in the case. The issue shall be tried by the Board of Commissioners solely on the question of whether the Board, in rendering its decision, has acted beyond the limits of its powers or abused its discretion.

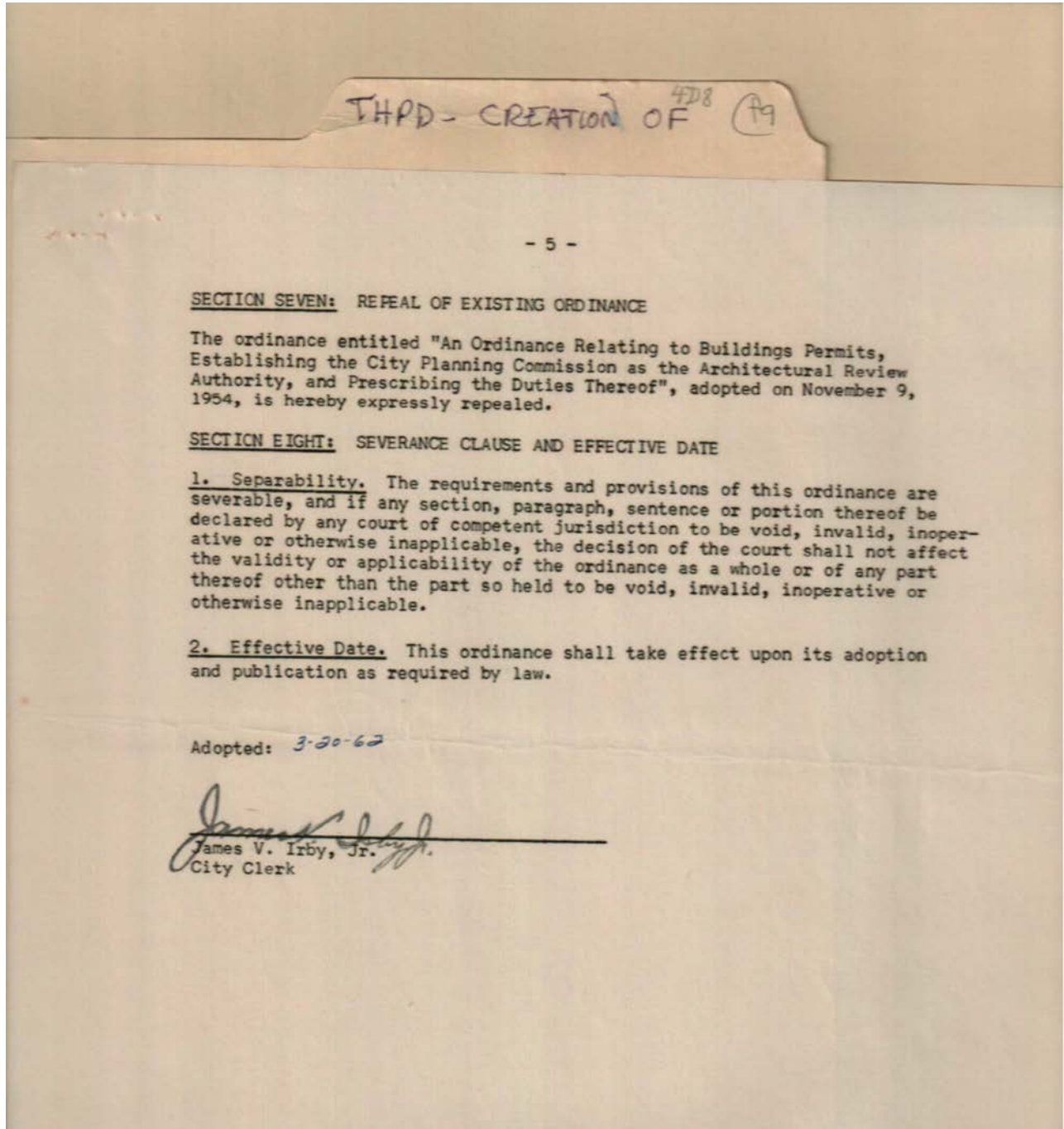

Section 11. The Constitution and by-Laws Committee shall have the responsibility of reviewing the Constitution should the need arise and consulting the advice of an attorney before recommending changes therein; it shall review the By-laws as the need arises and see that all copies of Constitution and By-laws in use are kept current.

Section 12. The Finance Committee shall present a tentative budget to the Executive Board in June for its approval, after being approved by the Board the budget shall be presented to the Society in June for adoption. The Committee shall assist the Treasurer in collection of dues and otherwise aid in matters of finance.

Section 13. The Floral Decorations Committee shall be responsible for decorating for regular meetings and for social affairs of the society.

Section 14. The Guides Committee shall organize a corps of volunteers to serve as guides at Oakleigh at the times the house is open to the public; the chairman shall supervise the revision of written instructions for guides; all material furnished the guides is to be verified by Research and Museum Committees.

Section 15. The Grounds Committee shall supervise the beautifying and cleaning of the grounds, replanting flowers and shrubs when necessary in cooperation with professional help when available.

Section 16. The Historic Markers Committee shall be responsible for placing of markers on historic spots.

Section 17. The Hospitality Committee shall have charge of refreshments for all social affairs and the morning coffee.

Section 18. The House Furnishings Committee shall supervise the repairing, replacing and arranging of furniture and furnishings.

Section 19. The Maintenance Committee shall supervise the general cleaning of the building and maintenance of equipment except those responsibilities assigned to Executive Secretary.

Section 20. The Membership Committee shall approve all names presented to them in writing signed by two members and report the name or names to the Society to be voted upon by acclamation. No name shall be voted upon unless the candidate for membership has given his or her consent.

Section 21. The Museum Committee shall receive, record, handle and exhibit historic items and keep careful records of same. At least one member of the City Museum Committee shall be a member of this Committee plus the Chairman of Art and House Furnishings Committees.

Section 22. The Music Committee shall provide music for occasions as requested by the Program Committee.

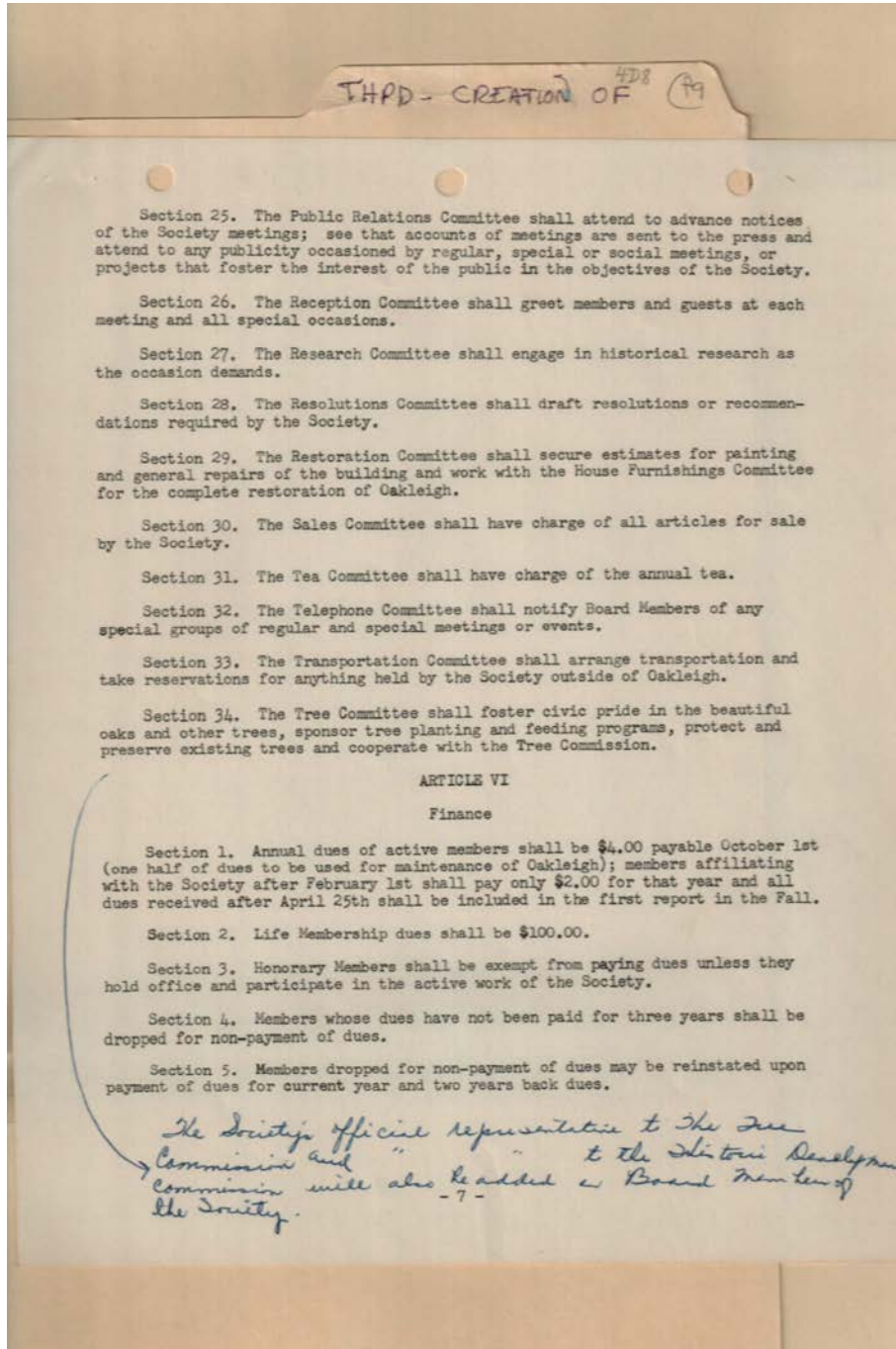
Section 23. The Program Committee shall provide a speaker for each meeting and arrange for a gift to be given each speaker unless the speaker is a professional lecturer charging a fee.

Section 24. The Publications Committee shall have charge of publishing or sponsoring the publication of all material for the Society.

Gentlemen:

At the third quarterly meeting of our Society, held on September 16, the important topic of a new courthouse for Madison County was discussed. Your chairman, Mr. James R. Record, who is a charter member of our Society, was present at the meeting and explained the Commissioners' plans. A number of our members and guests expressed concern at the proposed removal of our present courthouse. Various means were suggested for using the building, but no conclusions were reached and no vote was taken to register the stand of our Society on this matter.

Due to the interest expressed by members at this meeting, it was deemed wise to hold further discussion on the subject. Therefore, a special meeting was held on September 23, at which time the following recommendations were agreed upon. These recommendations have been circulated to the entire membership of The Huntsville Historical Society and have received the approval of the majority of the members.

Recommendations

Should the County Commissioners decide to replace the present courthouse, The Huntsville Historical Society urges their consideration of the following recommendations:

First: That the Madison County Records Commission function as set forth by the laws of the State of Alabama to safeguard the valuable and irreplaceable records of our County. We urge that this Commission take action to see that any temporary storage of our records during an interim rebuilding period be in a fireproof building, where our records will not only be safe, but will be accessible to the public for reference. We further urge that the Madison County Records Commission have a voice in the construction of any permanent building designed for housing the records of this County and that this Commission see that the State Laws governing the construction of such buildings be adhered to.

Second: The Huntsville Historical Society recommends that any building placed on our public square for use as a courthouse be of a timeless architectural design, in keeping both with the buildings that remain from the past to grace our city and those that may be designed in years to come.
