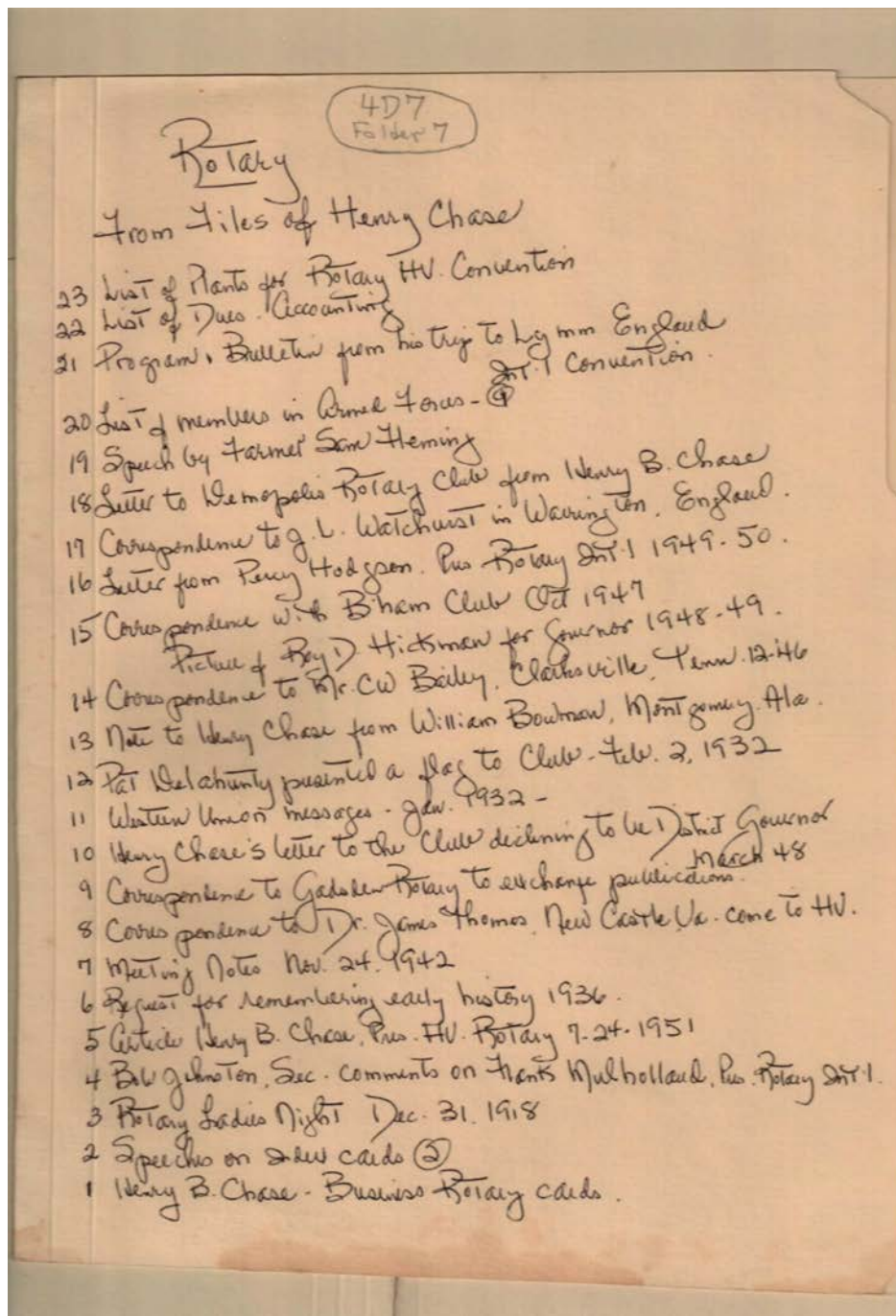

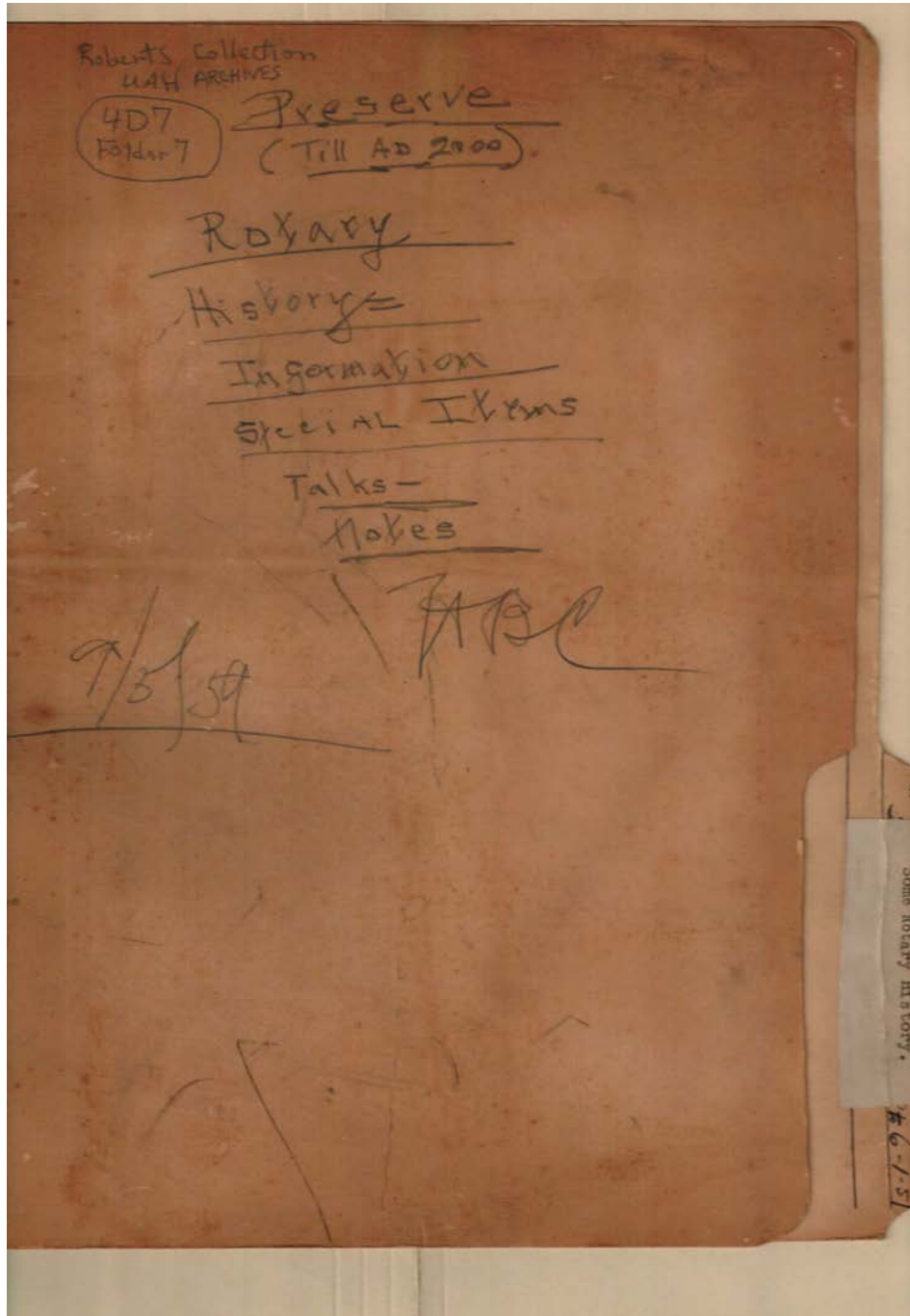

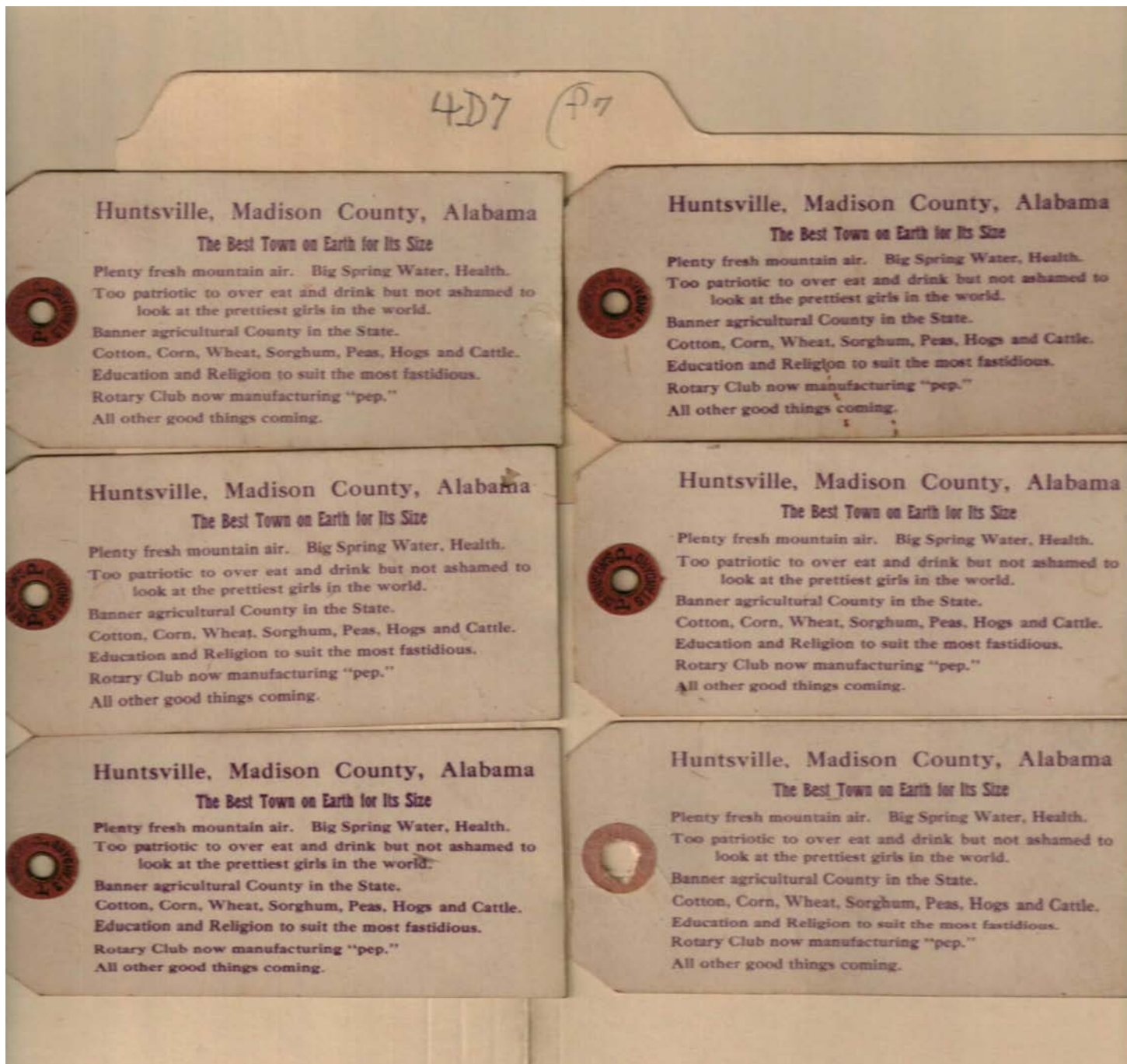

2 Our old Meeting Places;
 Basement West Clinton HIGH School when Bob
 JOHNSTON was our secretary. Meals served by
 _____ forerunners of the PTA?
 The Parish House for a time.
 Our own Club Rooms over the PROFFER Bank (?)
 on S & corner Spr., now over Vance Thorntons
 office--our own kitchen outfit. One meeting
 there is most vivid in my memory. I was seated
 beside Mr Cyrus McCormick, multimillionaire of
 International Harvester Co. --scared; but he was
 so easy to talk to, such a plain human being.
 As my most man of large affairs, Bill CONNER
 another old time member and an old hill road
 man was also a seat mate and it was a wonderful
 evening for us. Mr McCormick was later made our
 first Honorary Member. How few in this room know
 what the McCormicks really meant to Huntsville!
 I shall refer to them again in a minute.
 Third Floor of the Elks Building for a long
 time with our own outfit, work by two flights!

3 Methodist Annex for a long stretch.
 My recollection is that we met at Truickham Hotel

 pianist from Toronto, all members of the household,
 their afternoon musicale all added so much to the
 happiness of Huntsvillians. Miss Grace Walker was
 head of the household was a wonderful woman. The
 Grace Club is named in her honor and functions today

 Church St and is aided and assisted by this club as y

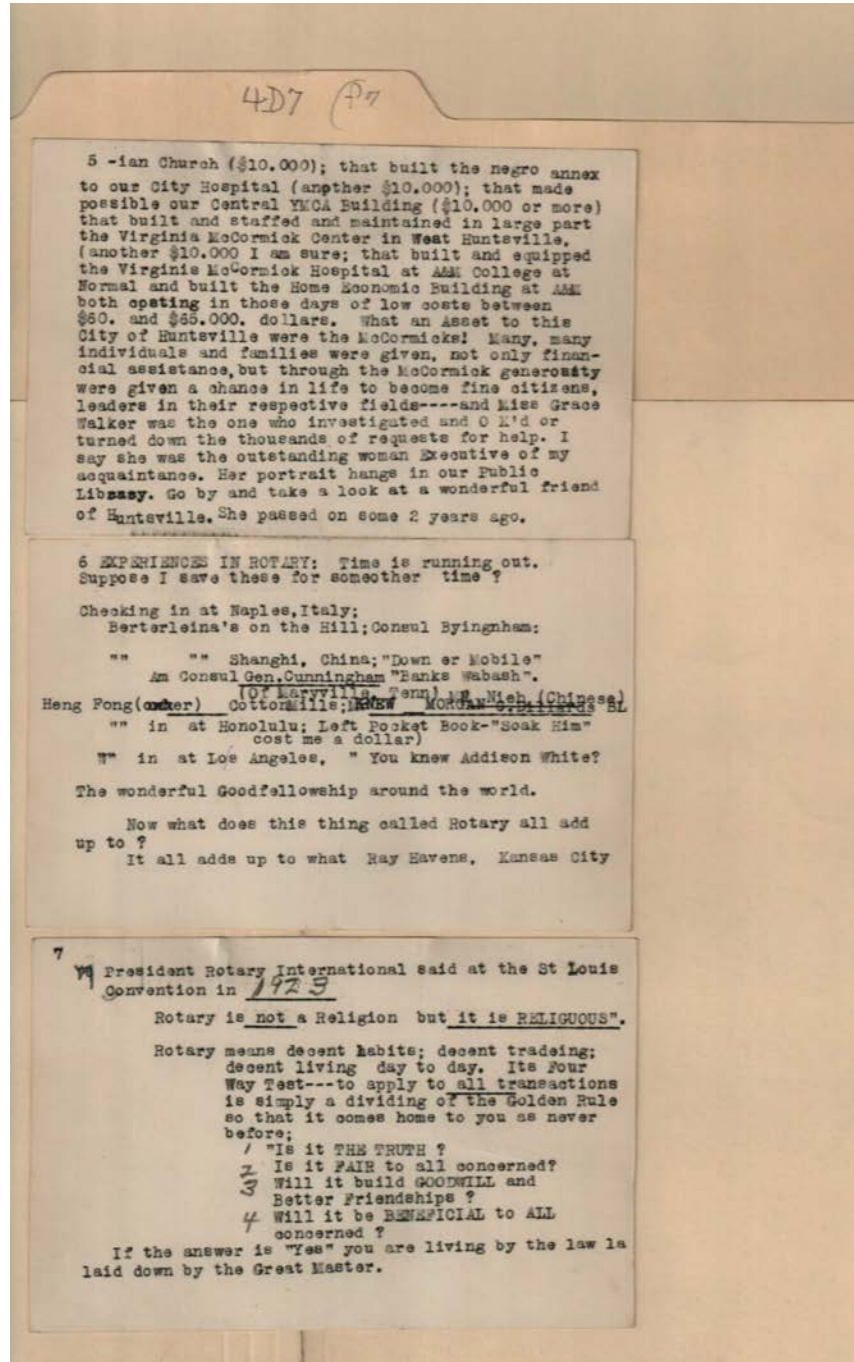

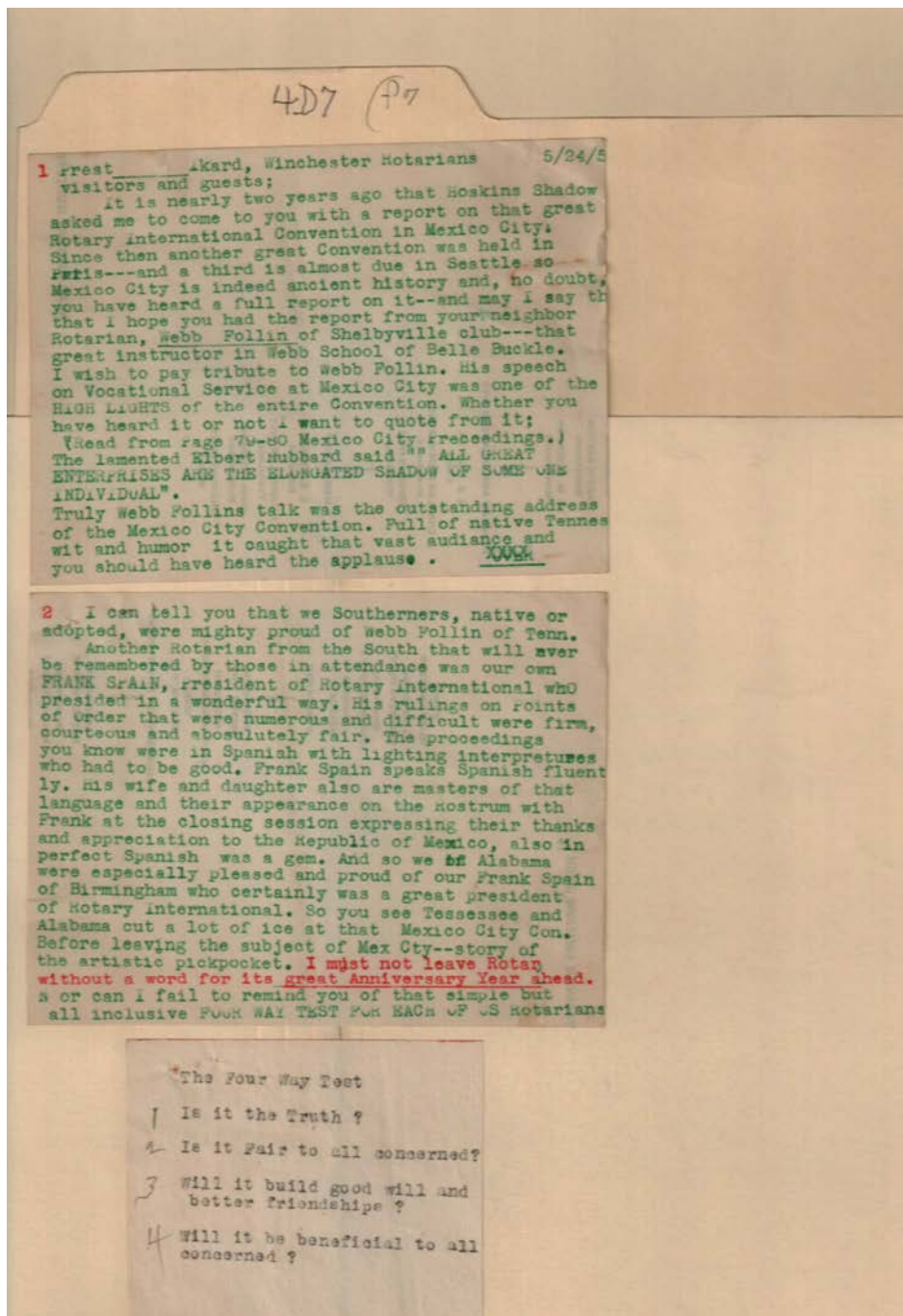

Ala and Tenn.

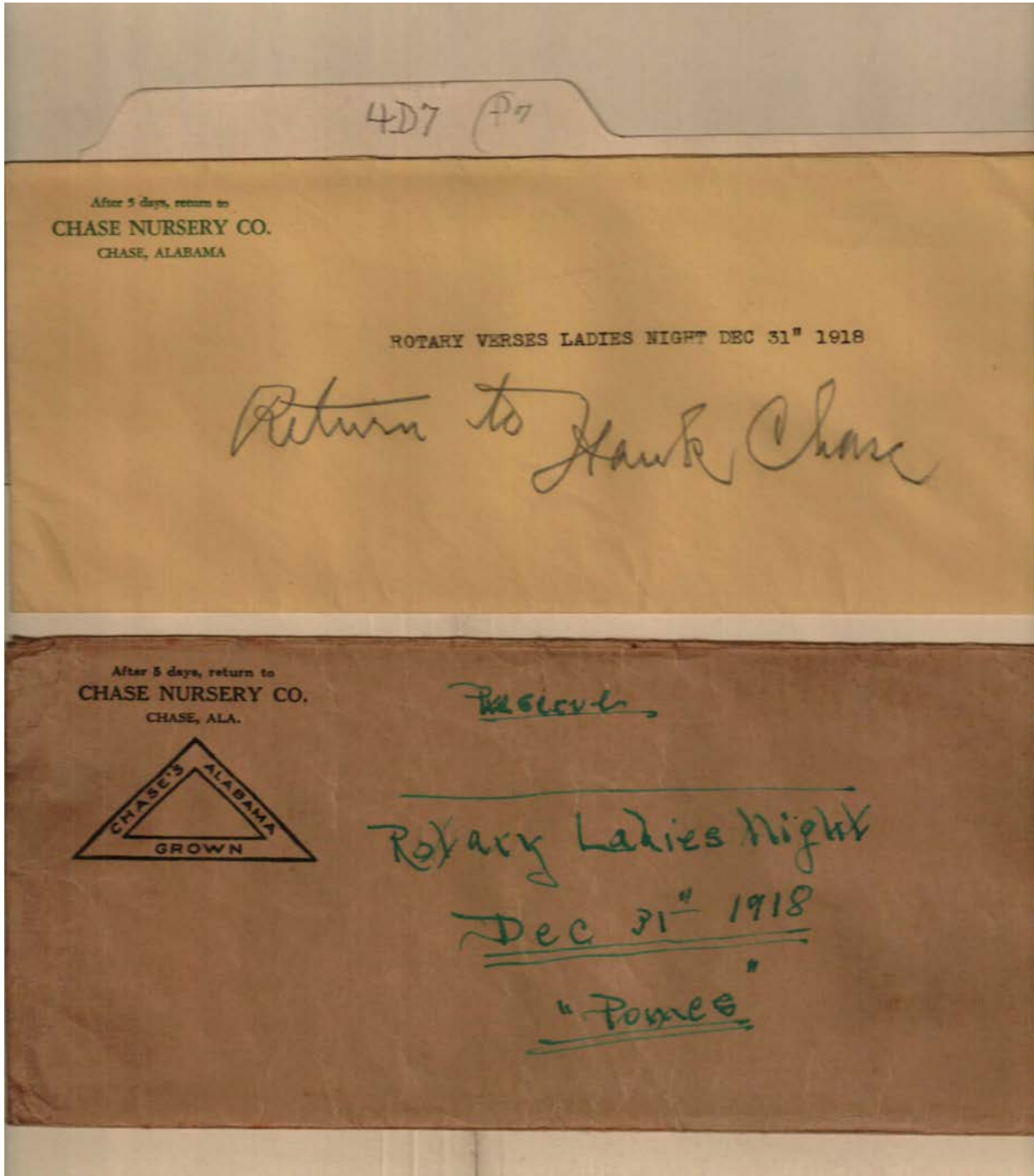

Just a little side light on Frank Mulholland:--
Age? Guess. Married? Guess. Born in Disco Michigan,
(population 200 and no railroad) son of a Methodist Minister

trip over was on a cattle boat and after landing and looking

My dear Jim:

Your cordial letter of August 18th warms the cockles of my heart. Congratulations on securing the old homestead in New Castle, Virginia. I know that you and your wonderful wife will have lots of pleasure out of that old home, and with your winter home in Miami Beach, you should be comfortably fixed.

And so you moved the Wisteria! Now you tell Ethel that when the time comes next Spring to do some planting around that New Castle home, or if you do not leave there for Florida until early November, and want to do a little planting this Fall, give me an idea of those things that you should have. If they are anything in the nature of ornamental nursery stock leave it to me to take care of you insofar as I can possibly go. We no longer grow fruit trees, grape vines, shade trees nor anything of that type. We do grow the smaller shade trees like Pink blooming Magnolias, Dogwoods, etc.

Now then if it is possible for you to work out a visit to the Huntsville Rotary Club, any time at all this Fall, you will certainly have a most appreciative audience. Yesterday we had our new District-Governor, following a Club Assembly Monday night which lasted nearly four hours. He is Jim Upchurch from Montgomery, and made a very fine talk to our Club at Noon. He certainly is filled with Rotary spirit. Just keep me in mind and when the time comes, call me long distance, charges reversed, or use Western Union if the time is short, bearing in mind that our regular Rotary Meeting is Tuesday at 12:30 P.M. On last Monday night, we had the pleasure of a very interesting talk by Farmer Sam Fleming, relating especially to his classification. The subject that I have selected for my topic, this evening, touches to some extent on what he had to say. My own classification is allied so closely to the interest of the farmers through our close contact with them and during the last few years, there has been so much argument as regards the excessive cost of everything the farmer has to buy as compared with the low price at which he markets his product, I am impelled to submit a few facts and figures which will bring to you a clearer insight, especially, with regard to the price the farmer has to pay for implements.

The price of any commodity is high or low by comparison. The farmer believes the things he buys are high because some of the things he sells are low. It is but natural for him to scrutinize the prices of equipment needed in the operation of his farm more carefully than the prices of commodities and luxuries he purchases with money earned by this equipment. The farmer is no different in this respect than other men in business. People as a rule do not argue much about the prices of things desired for the pleasures of life, but when it comes to necessary expenses of business they are very cold-blooded in their reasoning. It is easy to reconcile the mind to the purchase of things that give pleasure, no matter what the price, and in such purchases all members of a man's family add their encouragement and approval.

I feel that the universal use and operation of automobiles has had much to do in compelling the farmer to exercise more caution and economy in buying implements and, in so far, this factor has been generally felt as will be indicated by some figures that will follow: in this county, it is estimated that there are 4,000 automobiles. The population of the county is, approximately, 50,000, which is about one automobile to every twelve persons in the county. The cost of the maintenance and operation can be estimated at \$125.00 per year per car, at least, giving us the total cost for the maintenance and up-keep of all the automobiles of the county, approximately, a Half Million Dollars. A large per cent of these automobiles is owned by the farmers and our observation is that automobile owners will finance and operate their cars and practice economy on much needed new farming equipment.

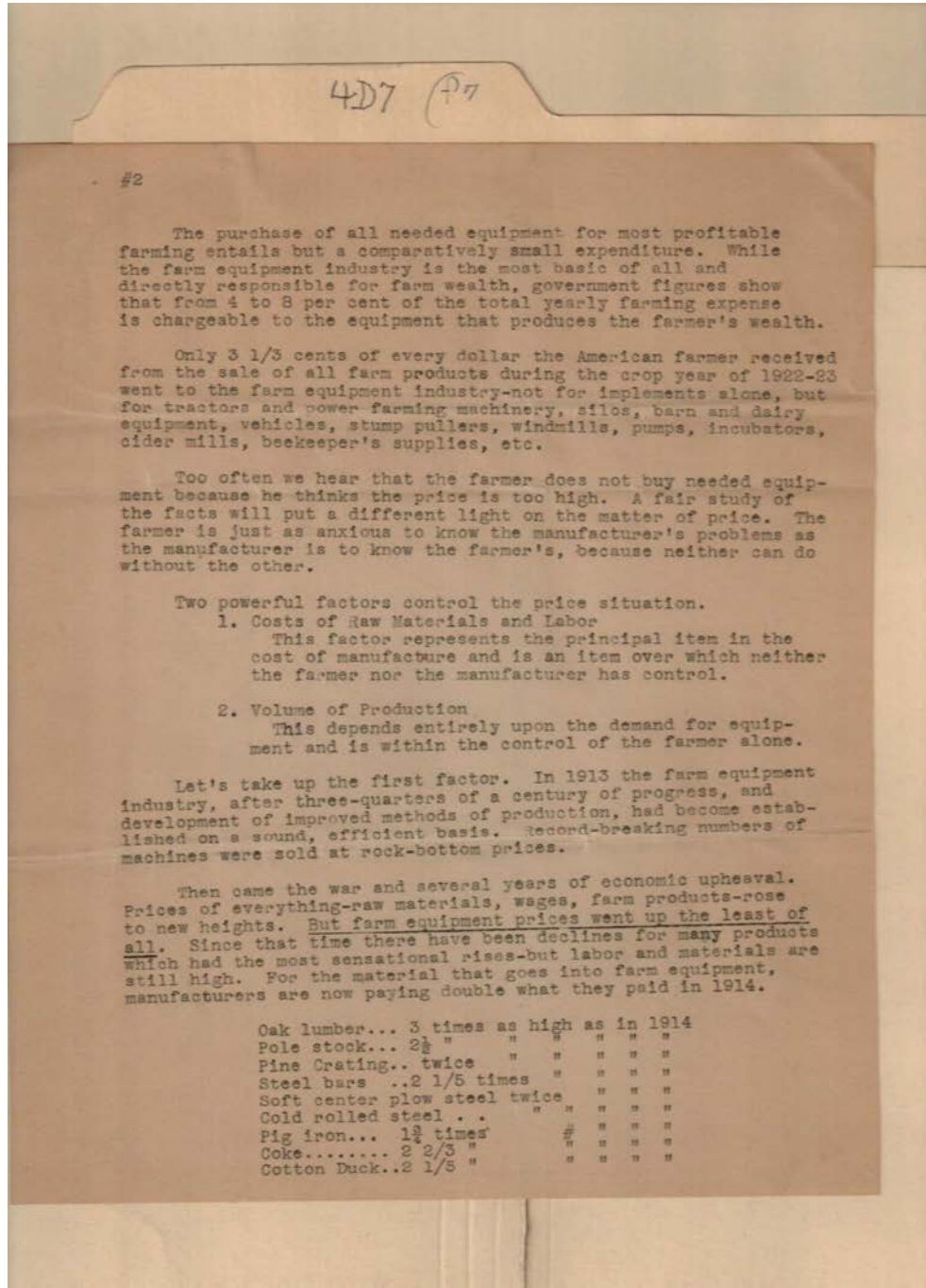
We do not urge the farmer to purchase new equipment so long as that he now has is giving good service, but it is poor economy to delay buying new equipment which would increase profits. The farms that produce the greatest profit are the ones best equipped with modern labor-saving machines.
