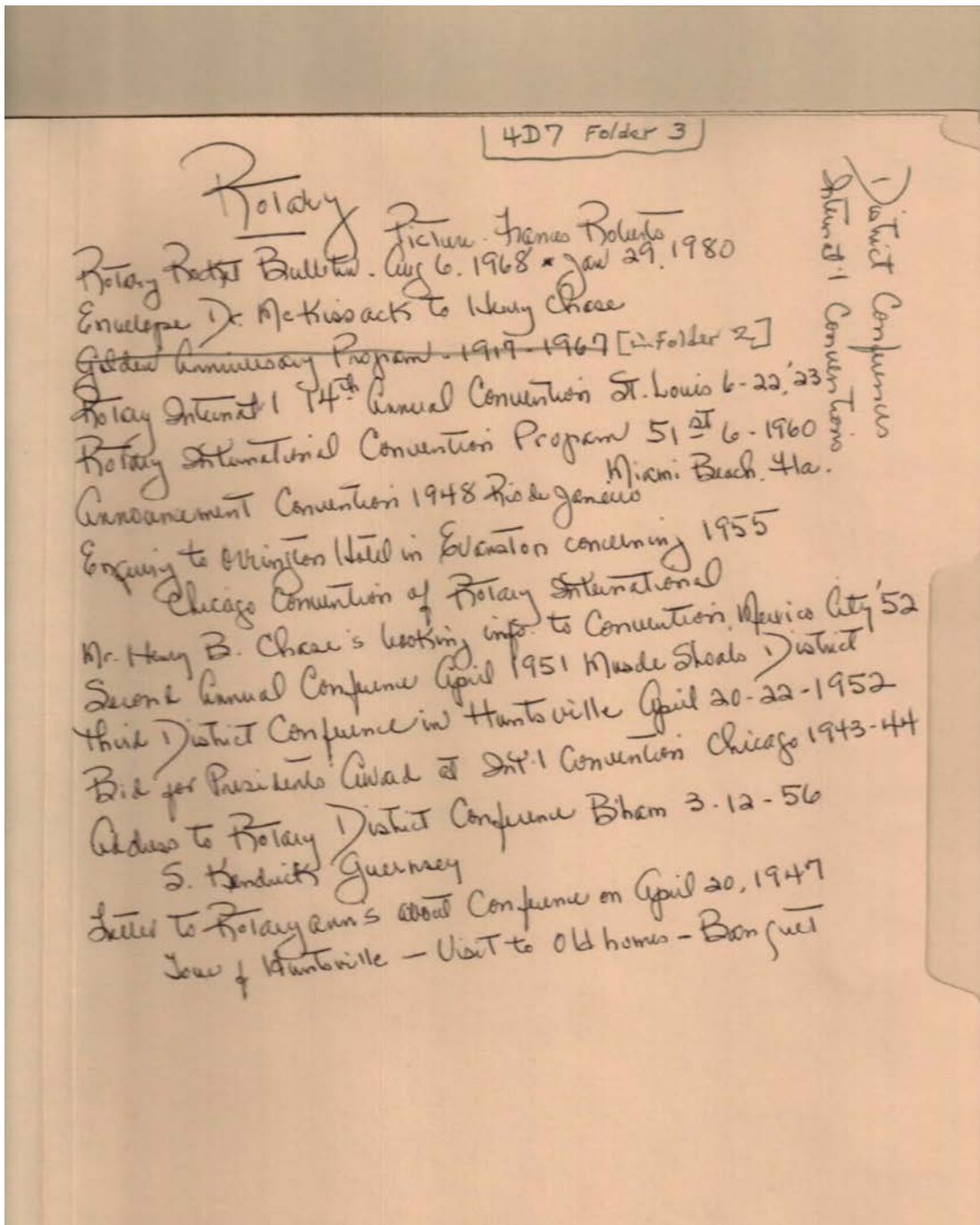

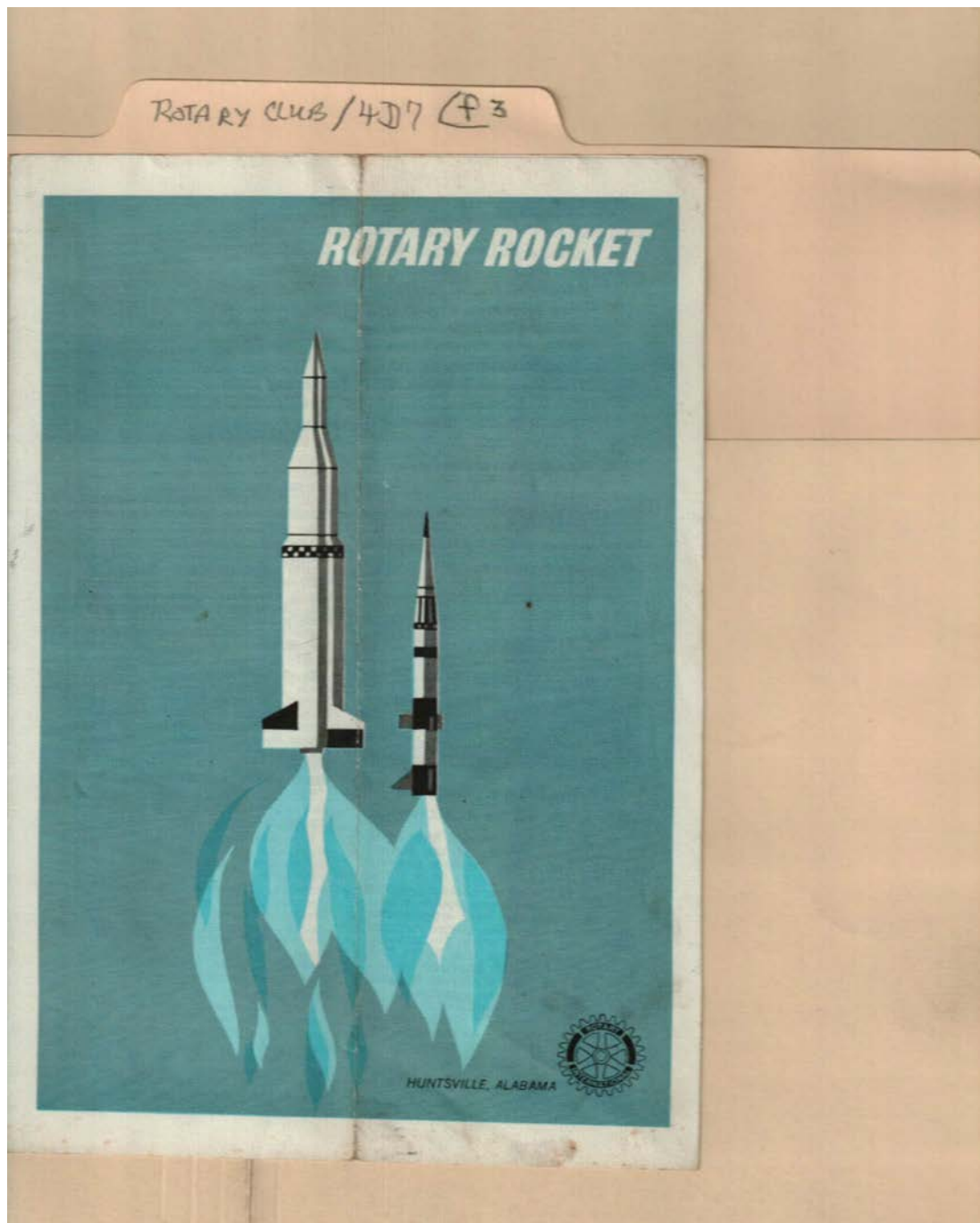

**DR. FRANCES ROBERTS and
 MRS. ANNA WATTS ROBOROUGH**

Dr. Frances Roberts and Mrs. Anna Rosborough, members of the Burritt Museum Board, will present a program on "The Howard Weeden Story." The museum has a room allocated to the collection of the art and poetry of Miss Howard Weeden, a local artist of the late 19th century who gained national recognition for her work. Dr. Roberts, who co-authored with Mrs. Burke Fisk the volume entitled *Shadows on the Wall, the Life and Works of Howard Weeden*, will give the significance of this artist's contribution, and Mrs. Rosborough will present a number of her poems and paintings to illustrate her combination of art and poetry.

DR. FRANCES ROBERTS:
 Dr. Roberts is a native of Gainesville, Alabama. She received a B.S. Degree from Livingston State College

in 1937. She later received M.A. and Ph.D. Degrees from the University of Alabama.

Dr. Roberts taught in Huntsville public schools from 1937 to 1952. She joined the full-time faculty of the University of Alabama in Huntsville in 1953, where she has since remained. She is presently Professor of History and Chairman of the Department of History and Political Science.

She is the author and co-author of several textbooks on Civics and History.

Dr. Roberts is: President of the Alabama Historical Society, Member of Burritt Museum Board, Member of Huntsville Civic Survey Board, Member of Twickenham Historical Preservation Board and Chairman of Madison County Historical Survey, now in process.

MRS. ANNA WATTS ROBOROUGH:
 Mrs. Anna Watts Rosborough is a native of Madison County and was educated in local schools.

She later became a teacher in the Huntsville public school system, where she served until 1939 when she was married to Mr. Thomas Whitaker Rosborough, of Eugene, Oregon. Since Mr. Rosborough was an executive in a large lumber company, most of their life together was spent in Oregon. During the last few years, however, they resided in Texarkana, Texas, where he had been reared. Following his death, Mrs. Rosborough returned to Huntsville.

For more than a decade, Mrs. Rosborough has been very active in local civic affairs. She has made a significant contribution to the Community in her work with the Burritt Museum. She has been especially active in promoting the Howard Weeden Collection and also has had the primary responsibility

for the restoration of the old cabin and the blacksmith shop on the premises. Her efforts have resulted in the acquisition by the Museum of numerous items for exhibit.

Mrs. Rosborough is a member of Church of Christ, Daughters of the American Revolution, Huntsville Garden Club, Study Circle, Alabama Historical Society, Burritt Museum Board, Antiquarian Society and Twickenham Historical Preservation Society. She is a charter member of the Grace Club, one of Huntsville's oldest clubs, which was organized about the same time as the Rotary Club.

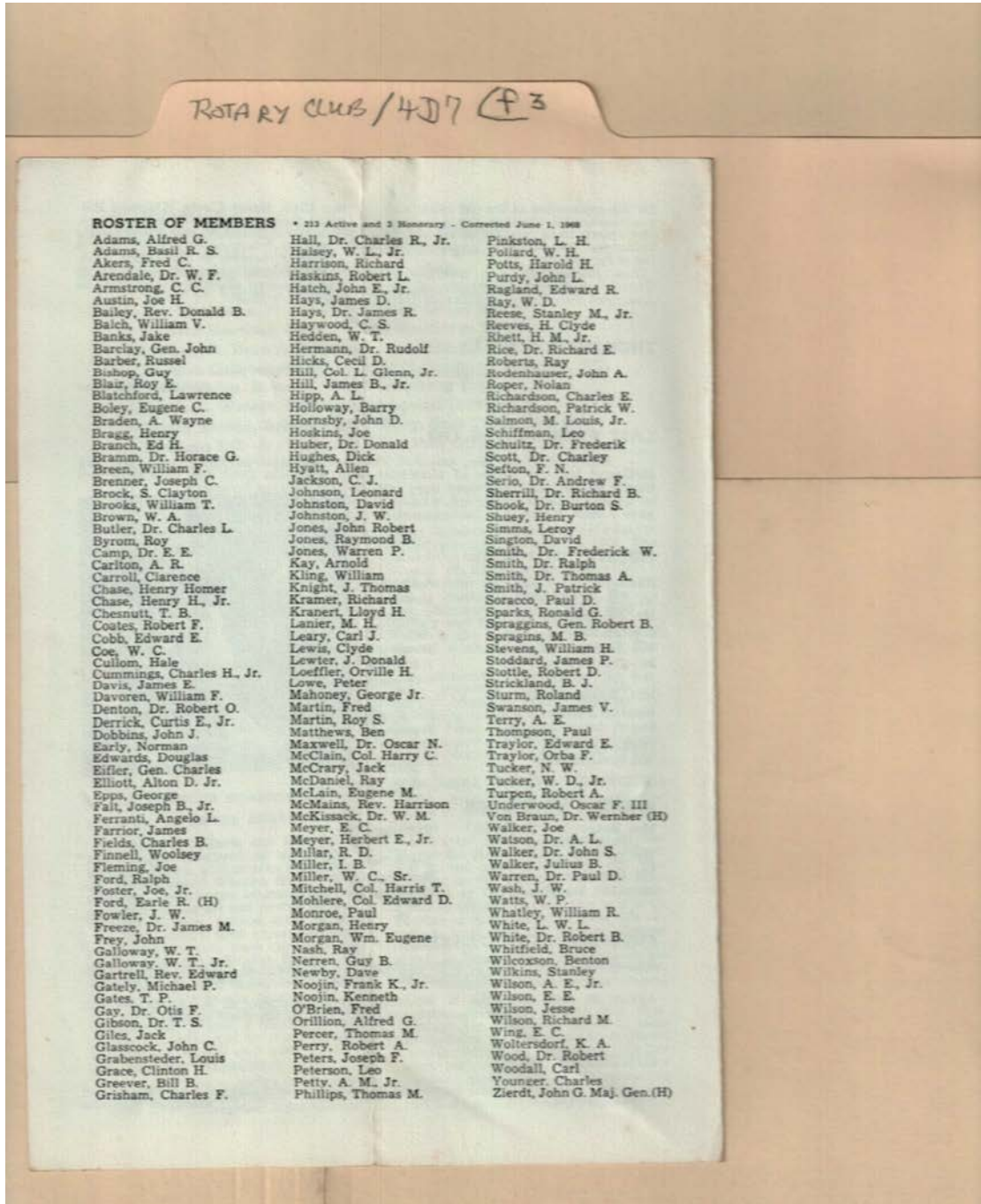

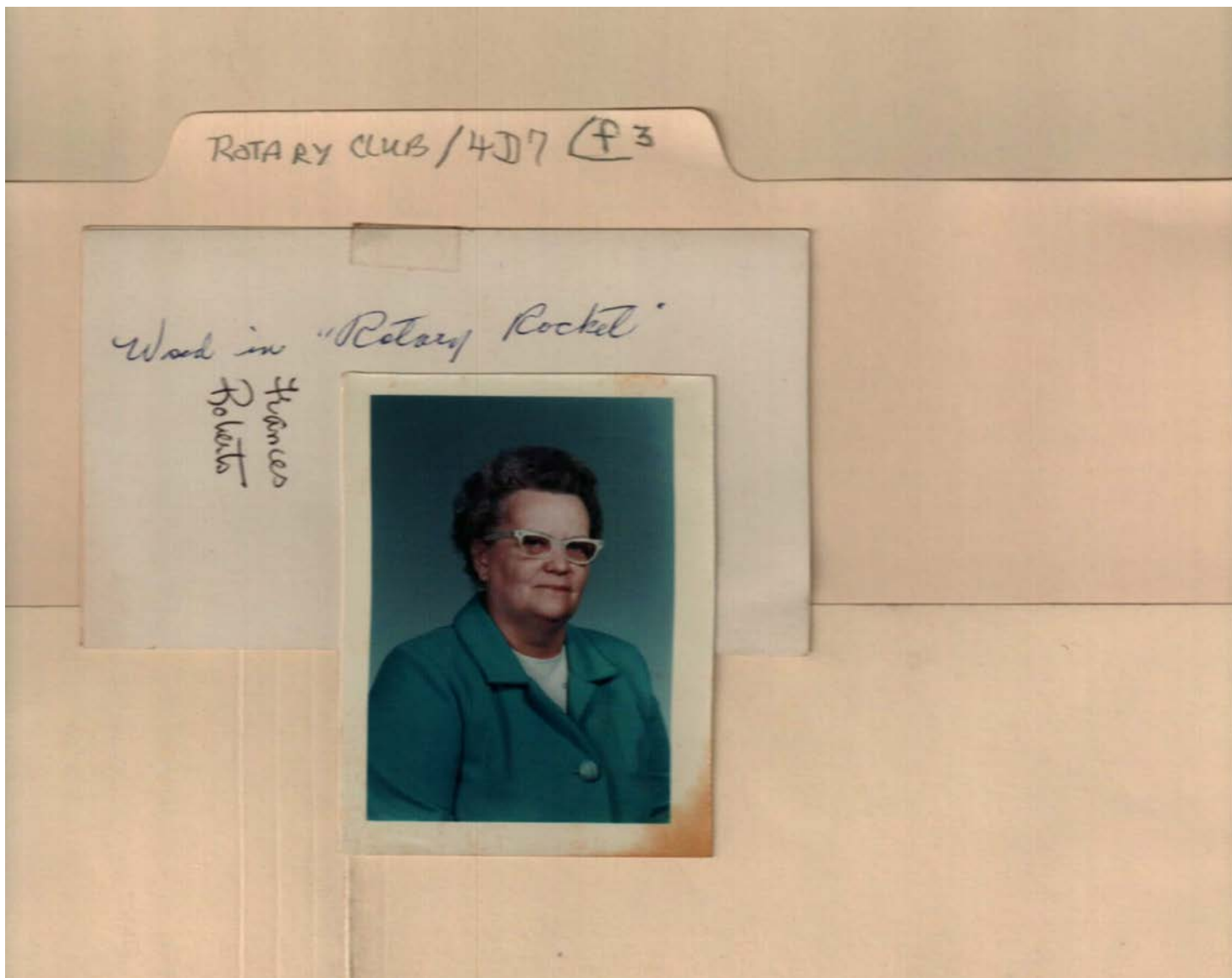

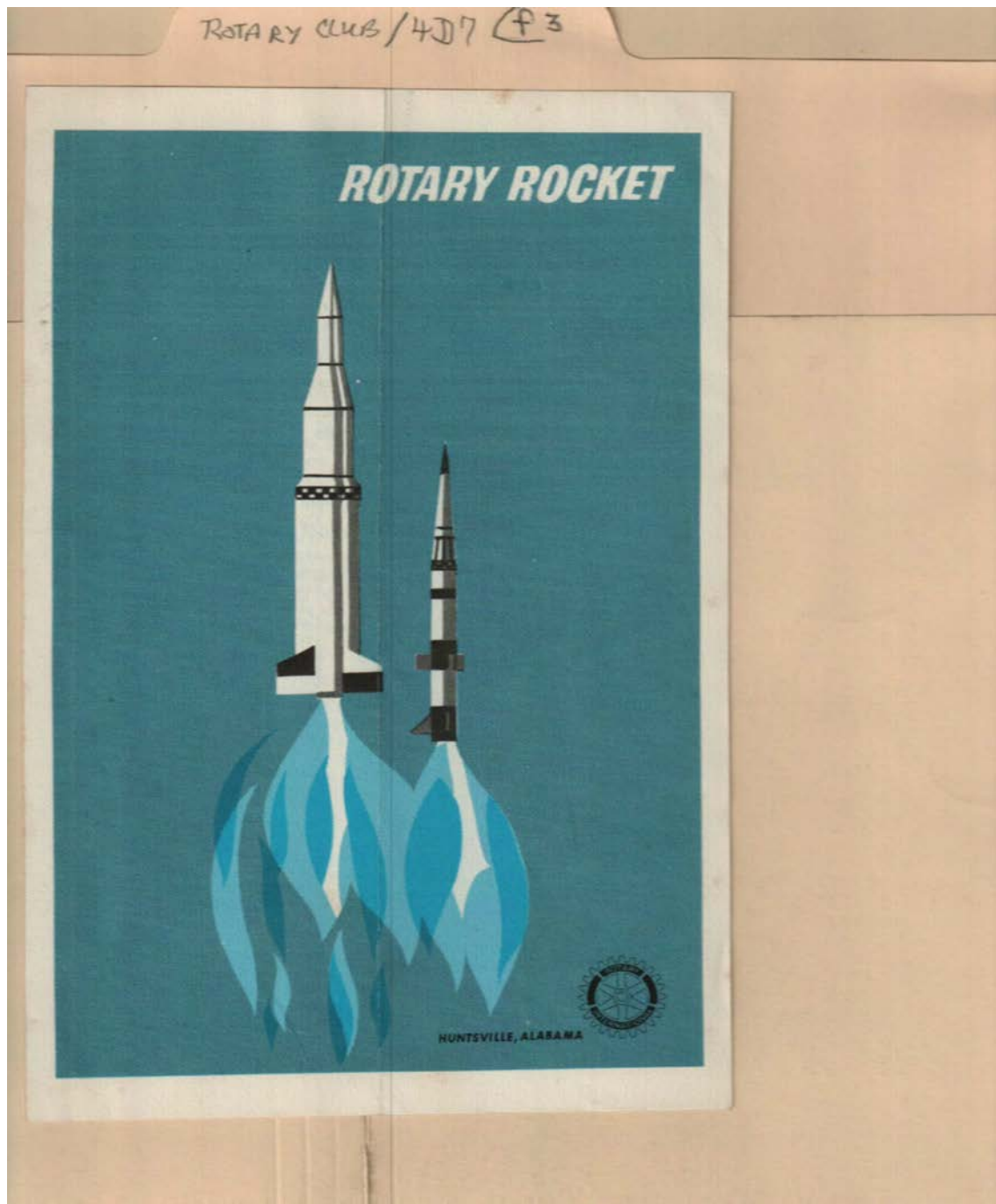

Henry B. Gray, III, is a native of Birmingham, Alabama. He earned degrees from Yale University, Auburn University and the Army War College, and has since been engaged in operating a beef cattle farm near Eufaula.

He served in the Governor's Cabinet for eight years: six years as the Administrator of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the State of Alabama, and two years as the State Adjutant General.

He has served as Chairman of the Board of First United Methodist Church of Eufaula, Chairman of Eufaula's Zoning Board of Adjustment, President of the Board of Trustees of the Lakeside School, Governor of the Alabama District of Kiwanis International, and President of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association. In 1969 he was selected as Eufaula's Citizen of the Year, and in 1972 he was selected as Alabama's Cattleman of the Year.

He is a Brigadier General in the Alabama National Guard, and is Deputy Commander of the 167th Corps Support Command.

Brief Story of the Convention

MONDAY, JUNE 18

The greatest convention in point of numbers in the history of Rotary International opened exactly on time with a symbolic pageant that for sheer poetic beauty has never been equaled in the history of the organization, the effect of which was to bring the mass of Rotarians and their guests cheering to their feet quite ready to sing "The Star Spangled Banner," "God Save the King," and "America."

Against a massive background of foliage and flowers, "The Rotary Garden of Nations" conceived by Otto Le Bron of the Rotary Club of Chattanooga and rearranged and produced by Joseph Solari of St. Louis and a corps of young girls and Boy Scouts, was presented to the musical accompaniment of the Rotary Band of Superior, Wis., and the choral singing of the Italian Chorus of St. Louis under the direction of Prof. J. D. Molino.

The vast auditorium, massed with humanity for the opening of the Fourteenth Annual Convention of Rotary International, was made almost pitch dark to start the evening's ceremonies, the lights being gradually brightened as each feature of the opening developed until the spectacle ended in a most brilliant display of lighting. At the sound of a trumpet a spotlight revealed the single figure of Columbia standing at the top of a long flight of steps covered with green and leading to a terrace banked with brilliant blooming plants and palms. A chorus of welcome was sung by the Italian Chorus and then a shrill whistle note brought twenty-eight Boy Scouts into the hall through the audience, each bearing the flag of one of the nations represented in Rotary. Marching on the stage after a brief maneuver the flags were placed in sockets leading up the graceful flights of steps and along the terrace.

Another fanfare and from the top of the terrace in sets of fours trooped twenty-eight young women, garbed in classic robes, each wearing about her brow a band of flowers that represented the national flower of the nations in Rotary—each of the girls being one of those nations. They bore on their shoulders a huge garland with which they descended to the main stage and presented a dance typifying the salutes of the visiting nations and their joy and exaltation at being present at such a gathering. Concluding their dance the maidens ascended the stairway to the terrace and their garland is twined among the flags, the two ends being caught up behind Columbia and at the sonorous opening strains of the triumphal march from "Aida," played by the band and sung by the chorus, the completed rope of flowers was drawn to the top of a golden flagpole with the Stars and Stripes which formed the central feature of the picture that will form the permanent background of the convention sessions. At the same time a huge Rotary wheel in glittering gold and blue was illuminated twenty feet above the heads of the people on the stage and against the massive curtain of foliage.

John Henry Lyons of the Rotary Club of Tacoma, Wash., sprang to the stage as the last of the young actors and actresses filed off and led the huge audience, now on its feet cheering the spectacle to the echo, in the singing of the national anthems.

Chairman James F. Finlay of the International Committee on Convention Program, with brief introduction, presented President Herman Spoehrer of the St. Louis Rotary Club who welcomed the Rotarians to St. Louis. President Spoehrer said:

EXCERPTS FROM ADDRESS OF WELCOME BY PRESIDENT HERMAN SPOEHRER, ROTARY CLUB OF SAINT LOUIS, MO.

In greeting you this evening as president of the Rotary Club of Saint Louis, which has assumed the role of your host during your stay in this city, I find myself in a very, very embarrassing situation. It is not possible for me to do the usual thing and present you with the keys of the city. You see, some thirteen years ago Bruno Batt came here and Rotary was given the keys to the city. They were taken to headquarters at that time and the gates of Saint Louis have been wide open to Rotarians ever since. In fact, as soon as we found the keys were gone—we removed the gates. Every membership card in Rotary International is a certificate of ownership of the heart and home and hand of everybody in Saint Louis. It makes no difference from which of the twenty-six countries represented by this wonderful display of national emblems you hail from. It makes no difference what language you use to express the

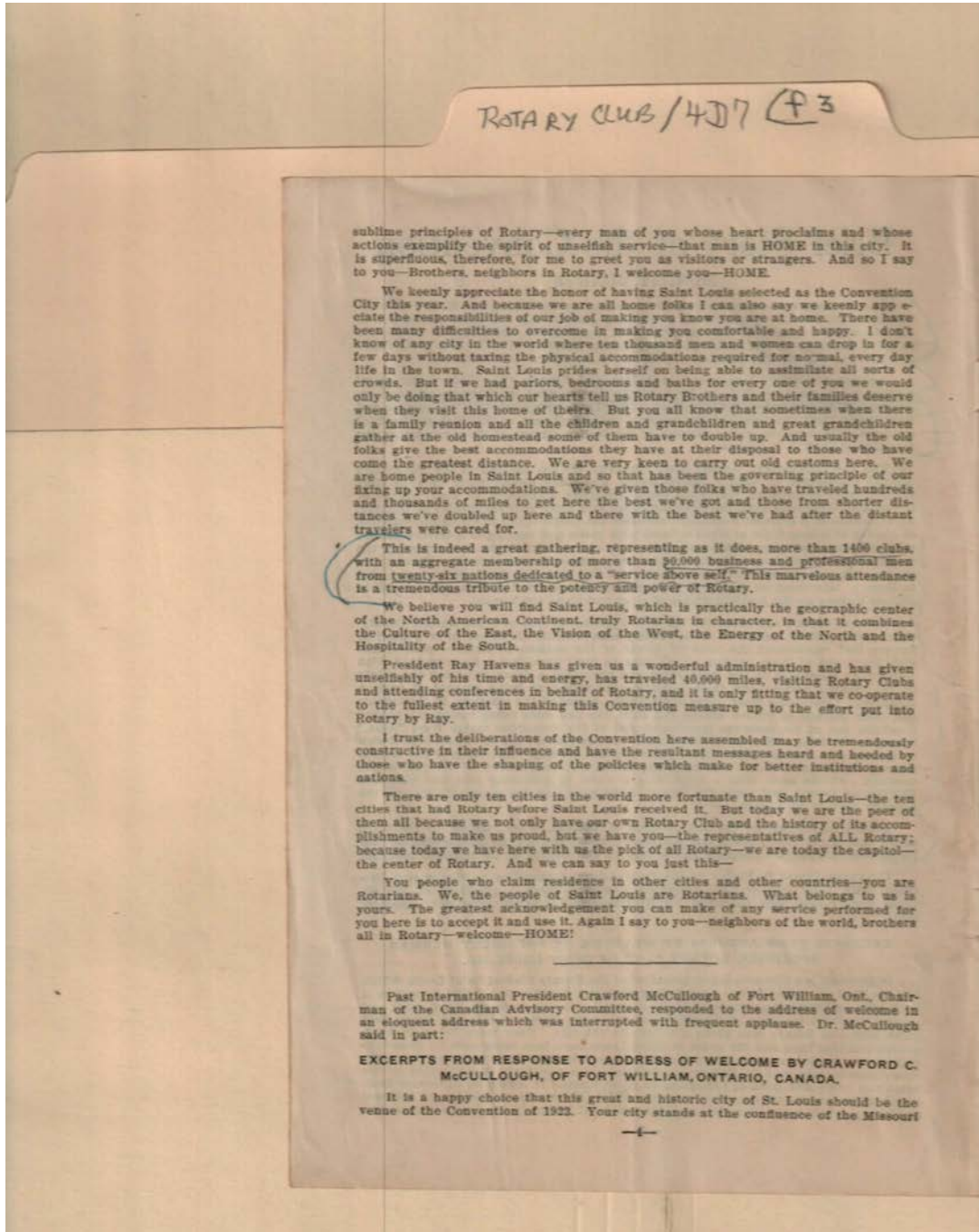

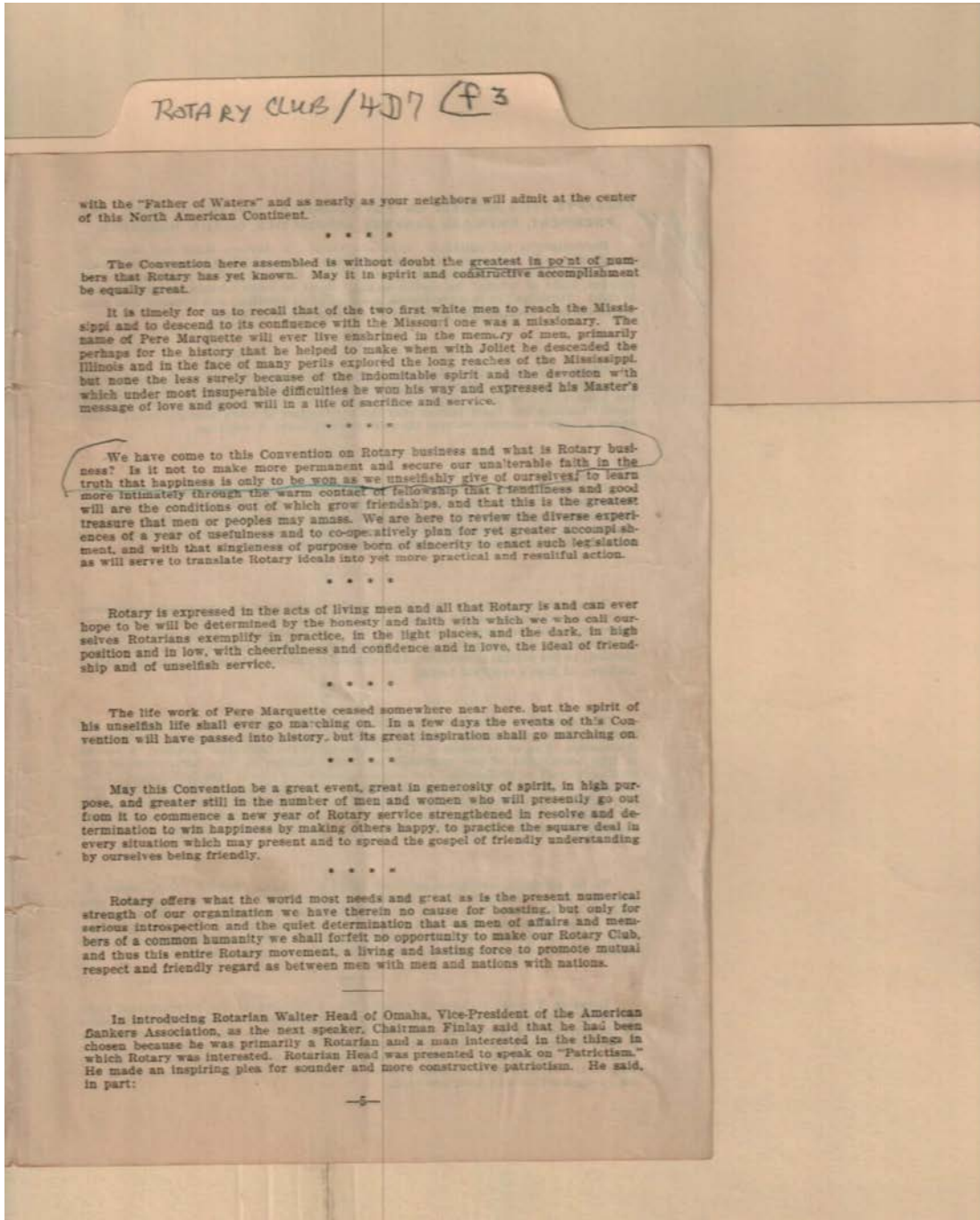

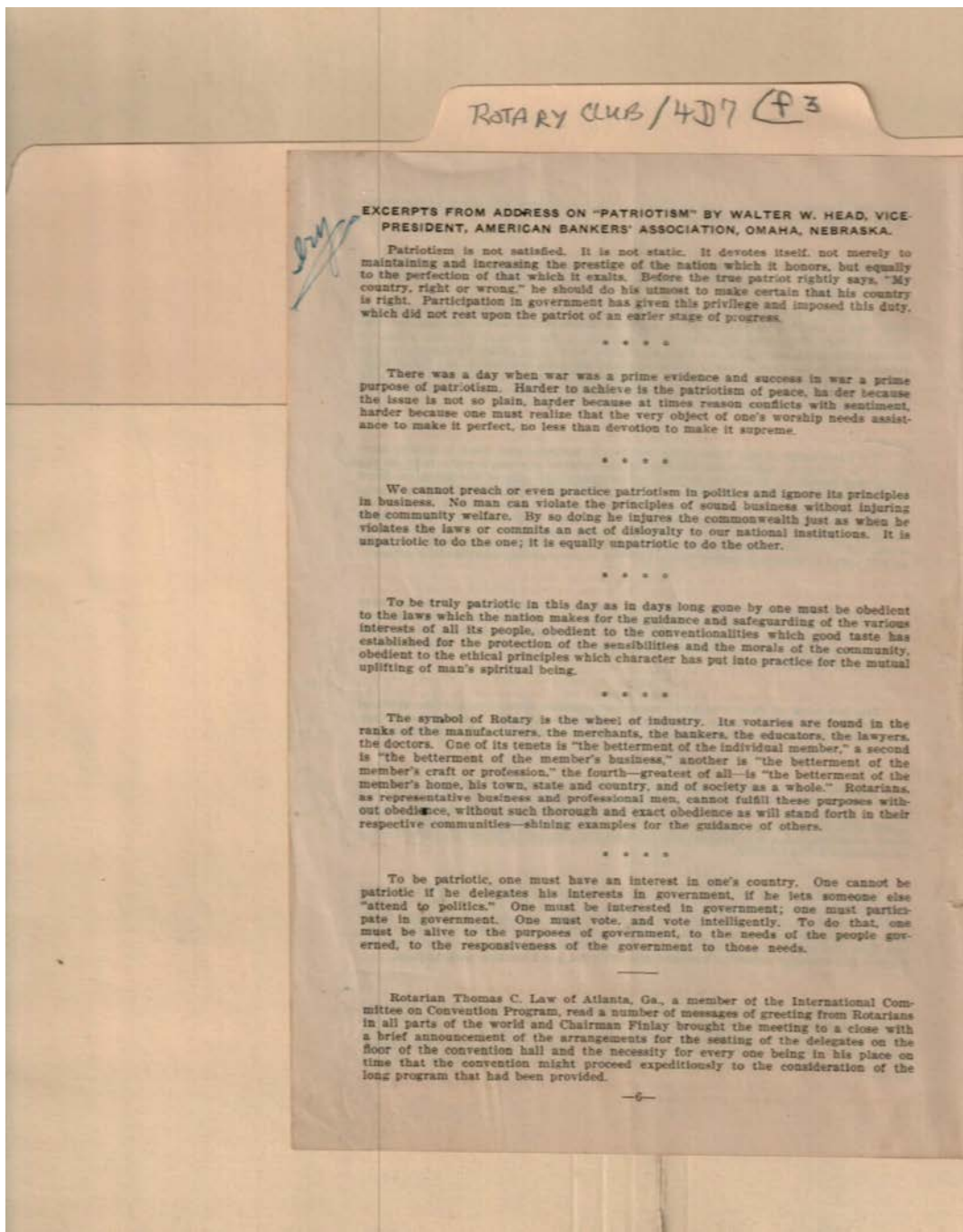

EXCERPTS FROM ADDRESS ON "PATRIOTISM" BY WALTER W. HEAD, VICE-PRESIDENT, AMERICAN BANKERS' ASSOCIATION, OMAHA, NEBRASKA.

Patriotism is not satisfied. It is not static. It devotes itself, not merely to maintaining and increasing the prestige of the nation which it honors, but equally to the perfection of that which it exalts. Before the true patriot rightly says, "My country, right or wrong," he should do his utmost to make certain that his country is right. Participation in government has given this privilege and imposed this duty, which did not rest upon the patriot of an earlier stage of progress.

* * * *

There was a day when war was a prime evidence and success in war a prime purpose of patriotism. Harder to achieve is the patriotism of peace, harder because the issue is not so plain, harder because at times reason conflicts with sentiment, harder because one must realize that the very object of one's worship needs assistance to make it perfect, no less than devotion to make it supreme.

* * * *

We cannot preach or even practice patriotism in politics and ignore its principles in business. No man can violate the principles of sound business without injuring the community welfare. By so doing he injures the commonwealth just as when he violates the laws or commits an act of disloyalty to our national institutions. It is unpatriotic to do the one; it is equally unpatriotic to do the other.

* * * *

To be truly patriotic in this day as in days long gone by one must be obedient to the laws which the nation makes for the guidance and safeguarding of the various interests of all its people, obedient to the conventionalities which good taste has established for the protection of the sensibilities and the morals of the community, obedient to the ethical principles which character has put into practice for the mutual uplifting of man's spiritual being.

* * * *

The symbol of Rotary is the wheel of industry. Its rotaries are found in the ranks of the manufacturers, the merchants, the bankers, the educators, the lawyers, the doctors. One of its tenets is "the betterment of the individual member," a second is "the betterment of the member's business," another is "the betterment of the member's craft or profession," the fourth—greatest of all—is "the betterment of the member's home, his town, state and country, and of society as a whole." Rotarians, as representative business and professional men, cannot fulfill these purposes without obedience, without such thorough and exact obedience as will stand forth in their respective communities—shining examples for the guidance of others.

* * * *

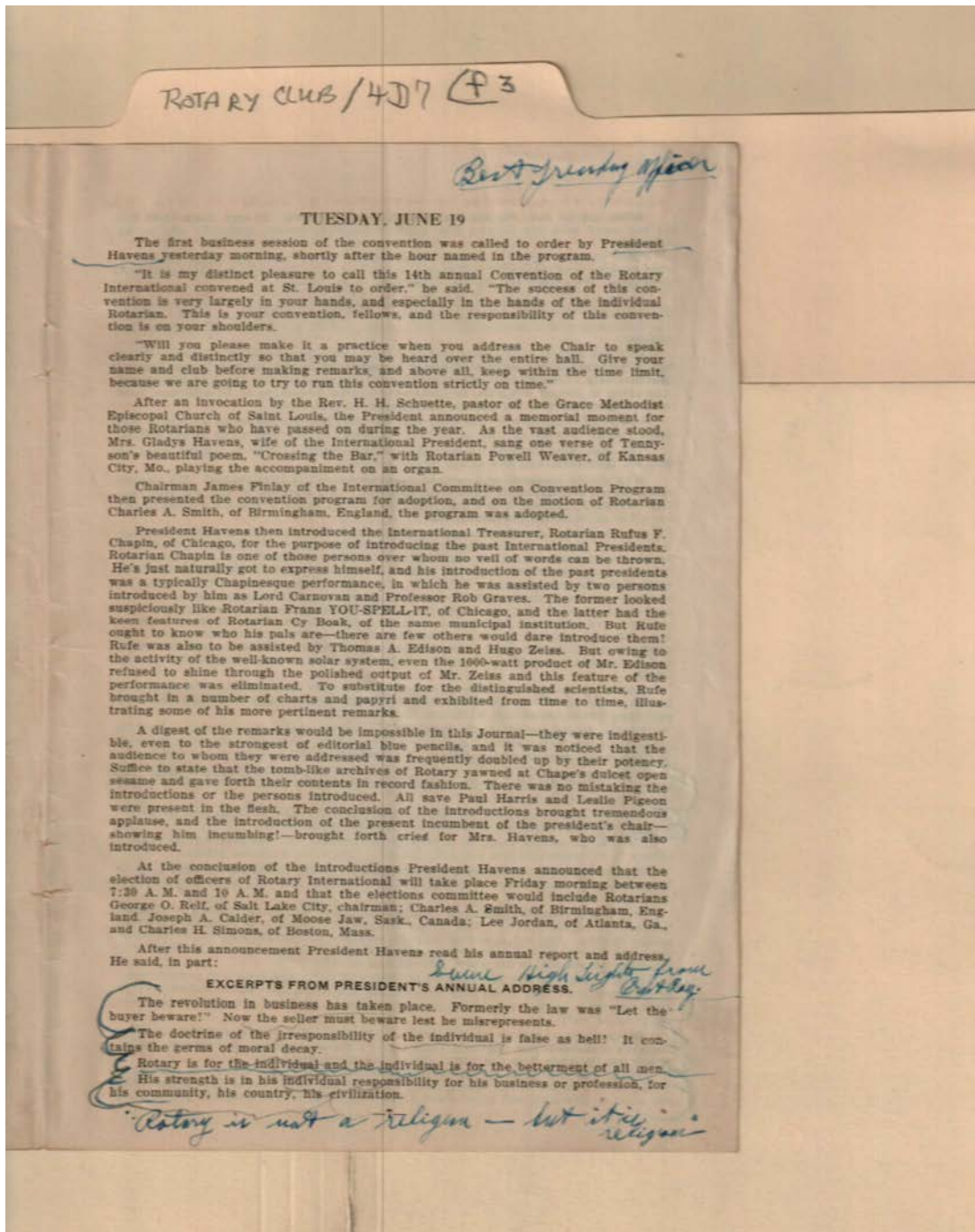
To be patriotic, one must have an interest in one's country. One cannot be patriotic if he delegates his interests in government, if he lets someone else "attend to politics." One must be interested in government; one must participate in government. One must vote, and vote intelligently. To do that, one must be alive to the purposes of government, to the needs of the people governed, to the responsiveness of the government to those needs.

Rotarian Thomas C. Law of Atlanta, Ga., a member of the International Committee on Convention Program, read a number of messages of greeting from Rotarians in all parts of the world and Chairman Finlay brought the meeting to a close with a brief announcement of the arrangements for the seating of the delegates on the floor of the convention hall and the necessity for every one being in his place on time that the convention might proceed expeditiously to the consideration of the long program that had been provided.

Rotarian Robert K. Hanson, of Newark, N. J., addressed the convention on "Block Playgrounds." He said, in part:

EXCERPTS FROM ADDRESS OF ROBERT K. HANSON, OF NEWARK, N. J.

As the value of city property increases, it very often becomes a difficult matter for a recreation commission or the Board of Education to secure an appropriation for the purchase of property for playgrounds, especially if the property has several buildings on it. To obtain play space for the congested sections is a real task for those interested in the play life of the community.

The selection of the streets for block playgrounds was determined by an intensive survey of congestion, lack of playground facilities and juvenile delinquency.

It was necessary that the streets selected should not be main arteries of travel. After the streets were finally selected, it was necessary to engage a playground director to build up an organization of older boys and girls from the neighborhood to assist him in teaching games to the different groups arranged according to ages.

The equipment for each center consisted of very simple apparatus such as volley ball and net, basketball, jumping rope, rubber quoits, bean bags, ten pins and other small equipment. One of the most important supplies is granolite paint which was used to divide off the different sections of the block and to make rings for the ring games and outside lines for volley and basketball. Most of the games used were free-hand games or those which can be played with home-made equipment.

Each street in our Newark plan was divided into four general sections, and in each of these sections there were again subdivisions. Each 50-foot division had two volunteer secretaries who kept record of the games played. At eight o'clock the attendance was taken. The operating time was from 6:30 p. m. to 8:30 p. m.

The results attained are:

1. Provides play space for congested sections of the city.
2. Gives opportunity for volunteer service.
3. Brings about co-operation on the part of the neighborhood agencies.
4. Provides self expression of the child and is a factor in character building.
5. Brings the parents and the children together.
6. Re-creates neighborhood life which is fast diminishing in America.
7. Provides an opportunity for city officials to render personal service to the citizens.
8. Brings the playground to the children.
9. Reaches maximum number of children for minimum expense.
10. Is a great Americanization medium.

Rotarian William C. Everett of Dallas, Texas, addressed the convention on "Educational Loan Funds." He said, in part:

EXCERPTS FROM ADDRESS OF WILLIAM C. EVERETT, OF DALLAS, TEXAS.

About four years ago a committee of the Dallas Club recommended the organization of a Loan Fund to assist worthy young men in completing their education.

The club adopted the report and appointed an Educational Committee of five to carry out the provisions of the plan as outlined. This committee was appointed to serve five years with an arrangement for one member to retire each year. That provides for such a gradual change in the personnel of the committee that the continuity of the work is not likely to be disturbed. When there is a vacancy the

Recent issues of the magazine are also available at this counter, and non-subscribers may leave requests for future issues containing convention stories.

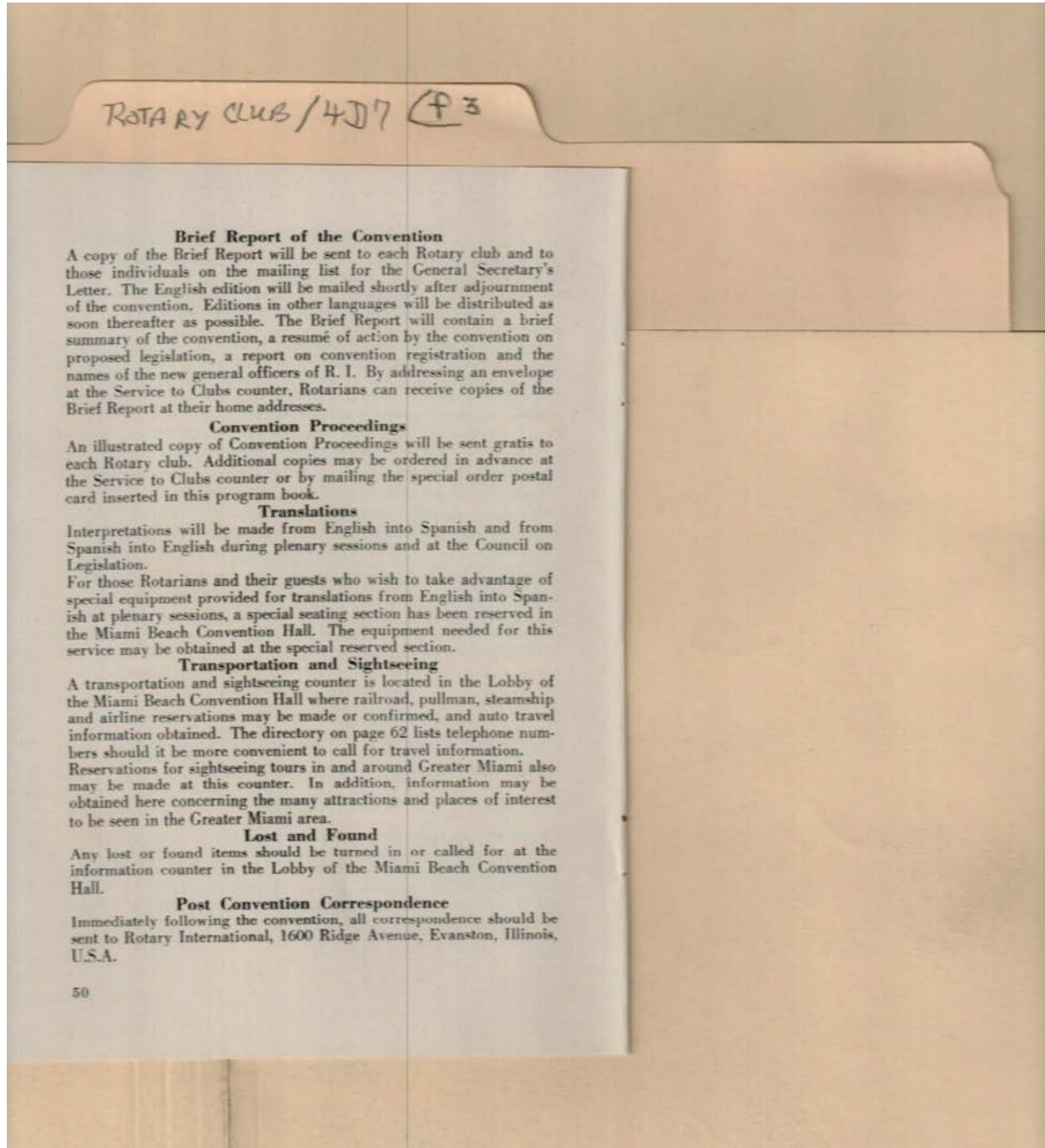

Monday, 11 o'clock - for Rotary Ann - April 21, 1952 - from Hotel Russel Erskine

Busses to load at ELEVEN A. M. - leave promptly on TOUR OF CITY

TOUR OF CITY: East on Clinton to Hutchen's Corner - then to right to North Side of Square - left to Randolph St, past Madison County Court House, pointing out The Church of Christ, First Methodist Church and the Central Presbyterian Church - on out Randolph and point out the Cabaniss Home (built by George Steele around 1832 - second owner was Septimus D. Cabaniss. Because house has remained in same family since 1843, most of the original furniture is in the place where first used.)
(1844- built)

Turn right on White street and right to Eustis St. Point out the White home, and next the Mayhew home (built 1843 - two traditions: silver buried on lawn during Civil War - Mrs. Mayhew hid Mr. W. D. Chadick in flour barrel in a downstairs closet for four hours while Federal soldiers looked for him!) Continue on Eustis and point out the Episcopal Church - (built in 1845-47). Continue to South Side of Square and point out First National Bank and mention "Cotton Row" (Also tell that the Big Spring is immediately behind First National Bank and that we will tour by it on return to the Hotel in the afternoon.)

Turn left on Madison Street. Point out City Hall and Library - turn left on Gates Street and pause at the marker on the left - where in 1819 the First Assembly of the State Legislature of Alabama met and Alabama became a "State of the Union"... Continue on Gates - point out the First Presbyterian Church and the Robinson Home - (built in 1826 - called "Spite house" - supposed to have been built tall to cut off view on the Pope home on hill behind it!) ...

Turn right on Lincoln and go to Echols Hill - pause to point out the Pope Home (on highest hill overlooking Huntsville LeRoy Pope built in 1815..of brick made in Tennessee and shipped down the river on barges to Ditto's Landing - now Whitesburg - and brought from there by wagons - LeRoy Pope is called "The Father of Huntsville"... tell about "Big Springs"...

To California and around to the right to McClung Hill... point out the old homes on McClung, especially the Darwin Home - (built 1835 - has chair Sleeph Hollow of 1765 - LeRoy Pope Walker's Desk....

On down Williams - pointing out the Captain Mastin Home - (built on land bought from LeRoy Pope in 1819 - Pope having bought it from the United States in 1809 - and built Mastin home around 1823). Point out the Bibb home - stating that it will be visited during the afternoon.

Turn left on Franklin Street - pointing out the Erskine Home, 527 Franklin (built around 1818); Neal Home (built in years between 1819 - 1826. Birthplace of Morgan the Raider of Civil War Days and fame; Bassett Home, 600 Franklin St., (built about 1819-23); the Hollowell Home, 601 Franklin St., (built about 1835); then on over Highway 241 to Monte Sano Mountain.

Go into State Park section and circle the driveway to the "Lodge" in the Park, pause to show one of the cottages which may be seen to the right as we leave the "Lodge" Drive...then past the "Dude Ranch", and on to the roadside view station where we will stop for six minutes - allow guests to step from bus to rest for a three minute "view" if they wish.... go down mountain to Pratt Ave and out Highway 72 to the Chase Nursery Road - turn left into the Chase Valley. Point out the A. & M. School and tell any facts you know about that....

Continue on highway 241 to red light at Lincoln Mills...turn right at Kildare and go to Huntsville Country Club....arrive at 12:15 At latest....

son from 12:30 to time to board busses at 2:30 P.M. Leave promptly....

rive in city and come in on West Holmes St., turn right and go out Franklin Street to Williams Street and stop at the Bibb Home. (We should be here at 2:45 P. M.)

Stay at Bibb home no longer than twenty minutes. Take busses at 3:05 for Moore Home - BUT stop between Chase and Cummings homes. Point out Pynchon Home (built 1835); Lane Home (Built prior to 1835); Geron Home (built 1825)...

We visit the Moore Home (now home of Milton K. Cummings)...we stay here not longer than 20 minutes....leave and walk to the Chase home, where we will see the home and have refreshment.

Take busses at 4:15 P. M.

Busses to go down Adams Ave. to Newman Avenue..point out the Smith Home, 704 Adams (built before 1854) and the Smith Home is on 4 levels! Used as school, together with "Smith Academy" (now Dillworth Home....built some time before 1854....

On down Newman to California Street - turn left and go by the Maple Hill Cemetery - pause near old section of the Cemetery...then on to Randolph Street and back to town. Go down beside the First National Bank and turn right - pause at the Big Spring...and on to the hotel. This should then be 4:40 P. M.

Note to guides: Please look over your "Reminder" and note along this route the homes of Rotary members - as we pass a home mention that resident is Rotary Member. Be sure to mention any other points of interest you know as we pass along the route.

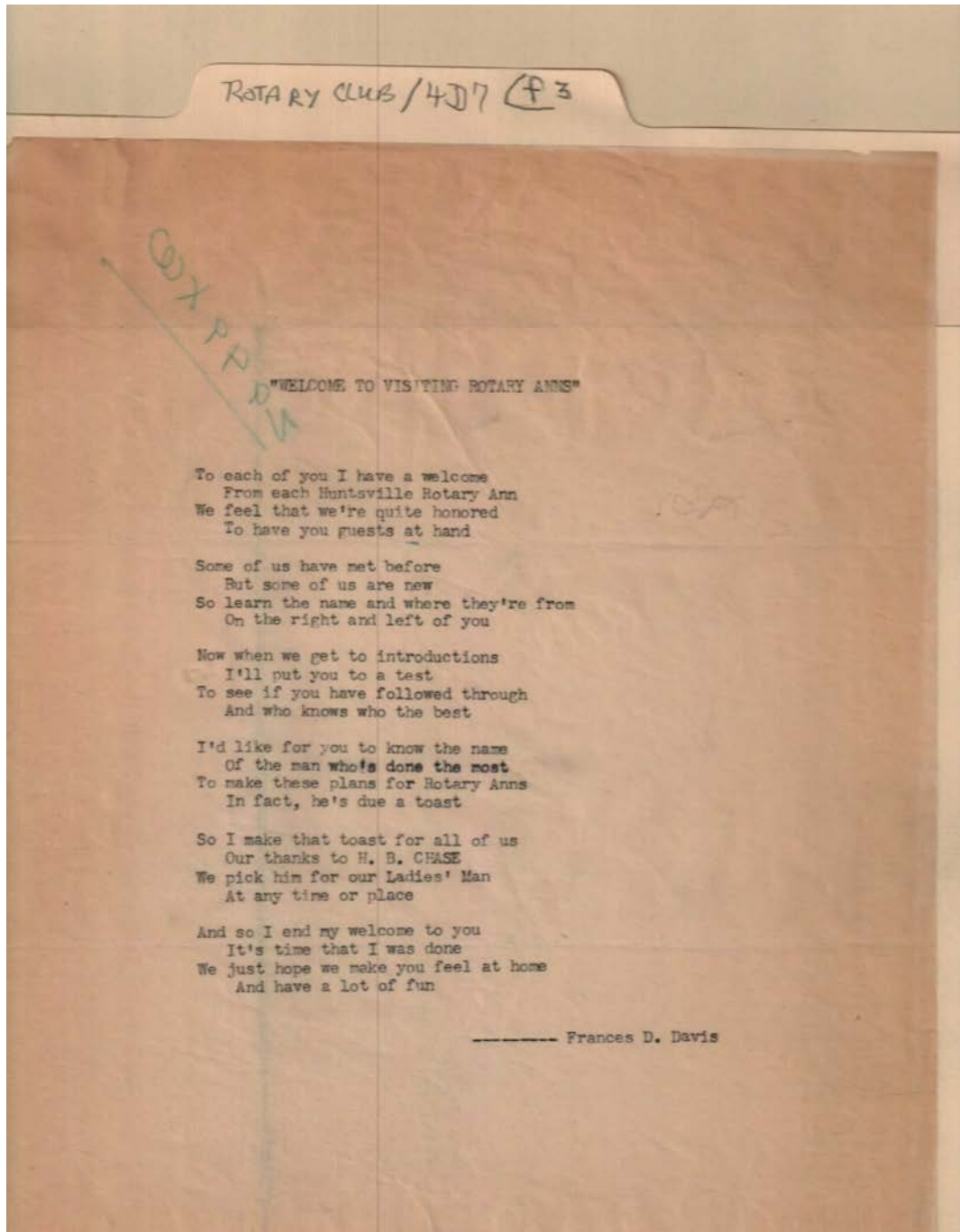
