Rotary Club number two was organized in San Francisco, California in 1902. By 1910 groups had been organized in New York and Boston and ^{that year} Rotary held its first ^{national} convention in Chicago. During the same year it became an international organization when a club was organized in Winnipeg, Canada.

The Rotary flag was officially adopted in November of 1914. The Rotary wheel in colors of blue and gold was mounted in the center of a white flag. Except for the changes made in the design of emblem in 1924, the flag's appearance remains basically the same.

The National Rotarian began publication in January, 1911. As organizations were formed around the world Rotary publications by the thousands began to appear in many different languages.

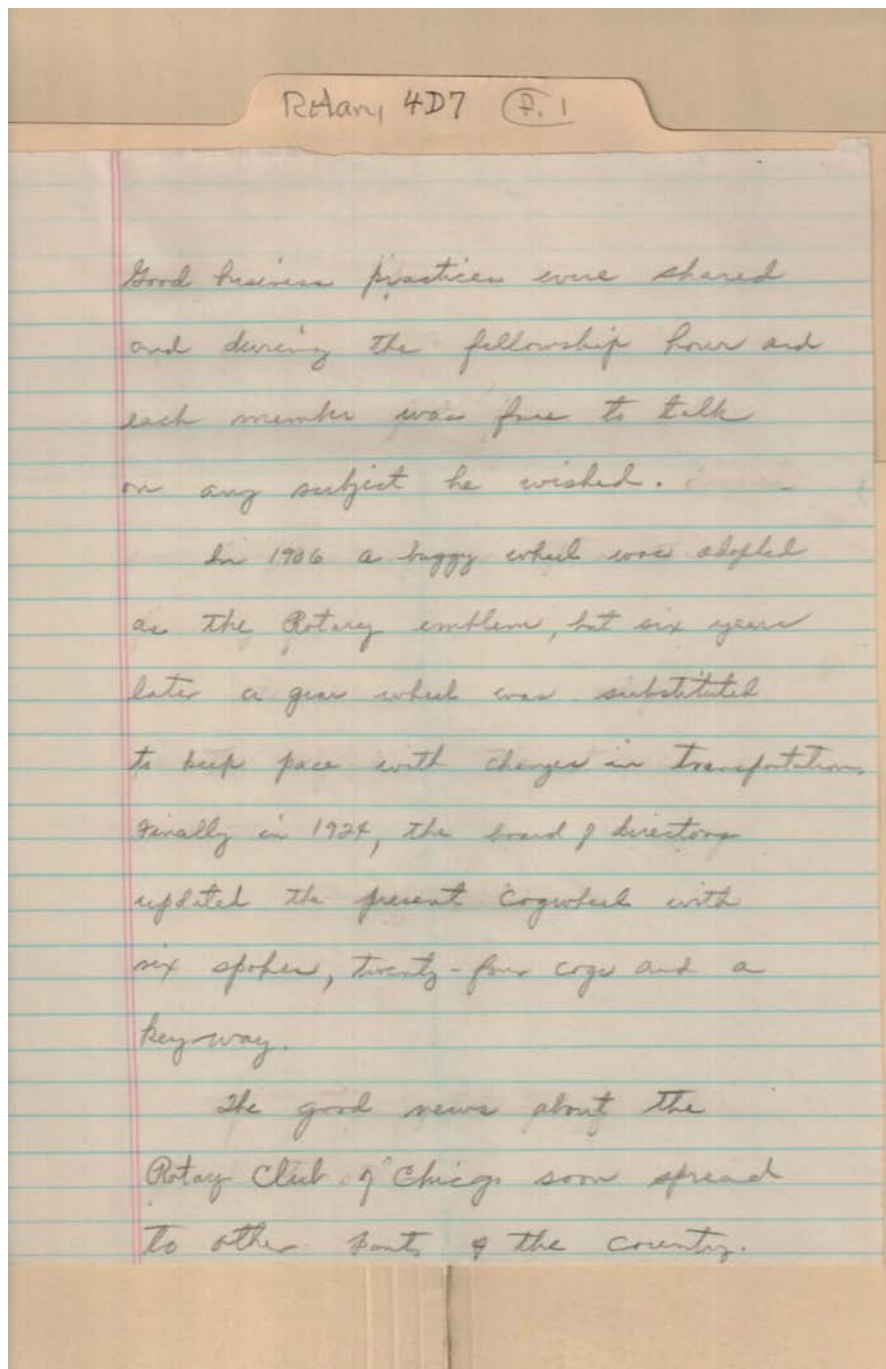

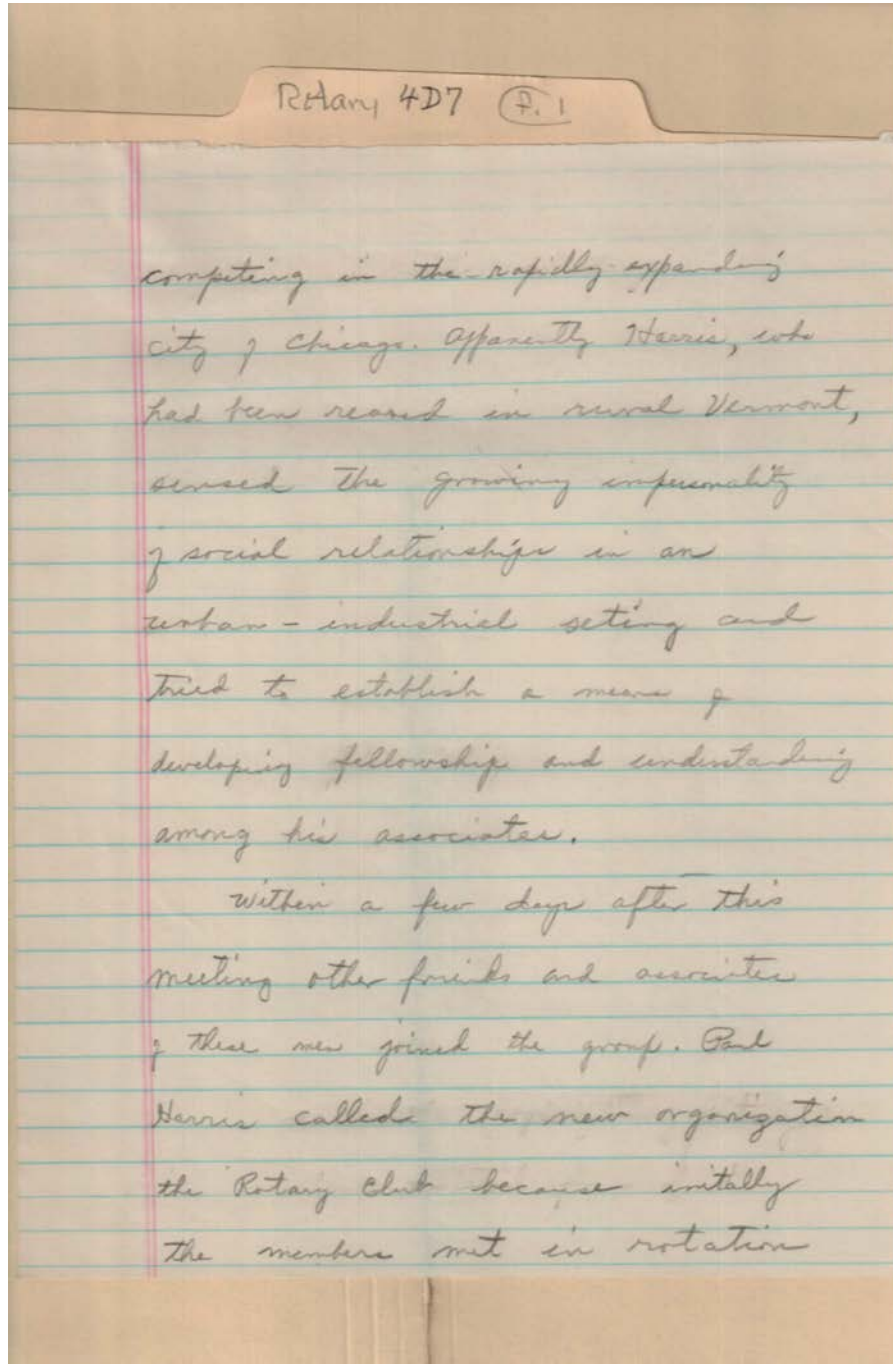

groups were business and professional men who believed the ~~the~~ quality of everyday life could be improved by organizing civil clubs that required high ethical standards for membership.

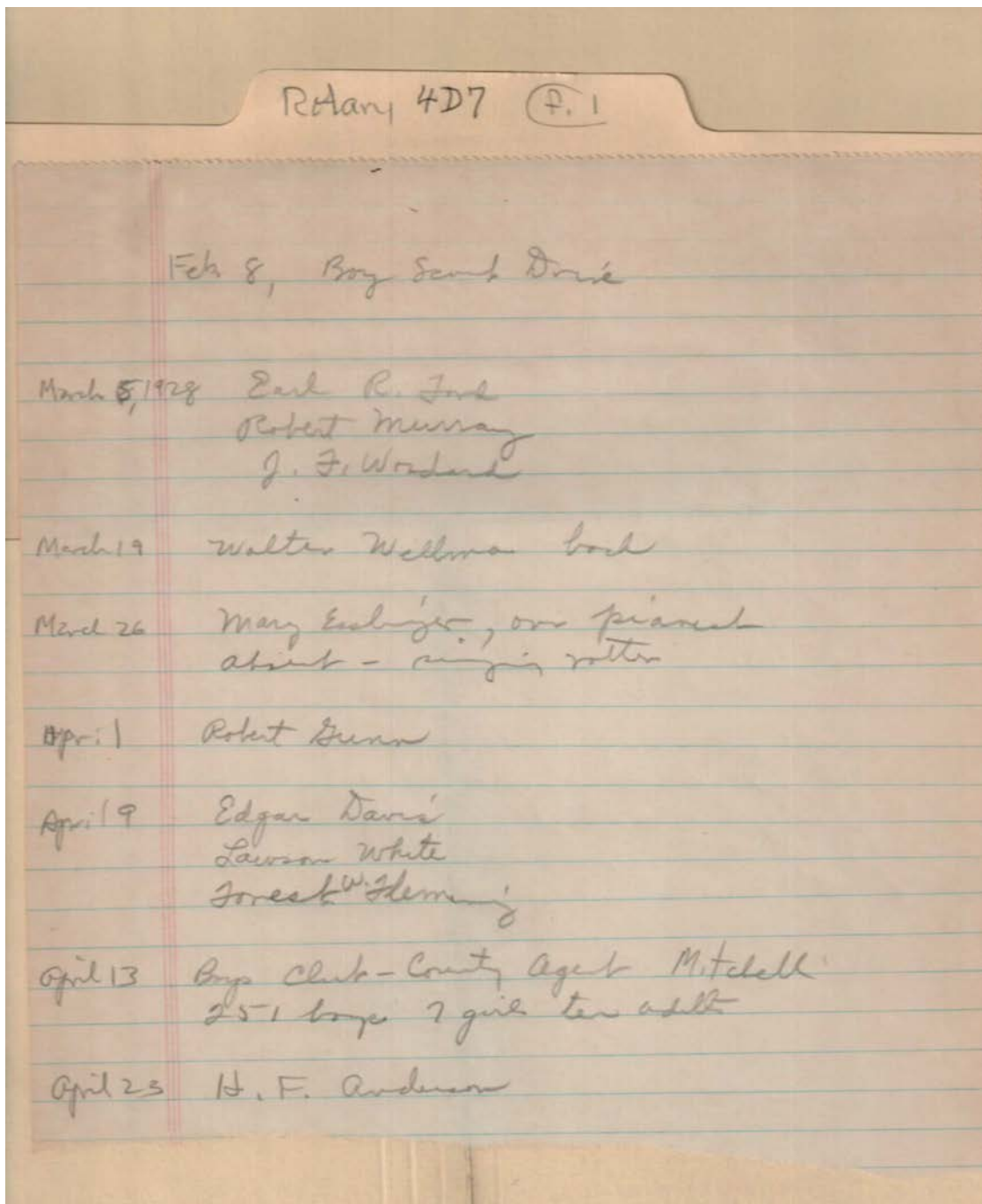
