	<p>Iolani Palace is of brick with a facing of cement and concrete block trimmings with towers rising 76 feet above the ground. The roof is mansard. Because of termite destruction, heavy repairs were necessitated in 1930; interior wood framing was replaced with steel and reinforced concrete; some wood flooring removed; the basement was remodeled; a roof of concrete slabs was laid instead of the old slate. The hardwood doors and stairs were preserved and even the ornamental plaster cornices and ceilings. Four gates. A wide stair climbs from King Street driveway to a colonnaded lanai (veranda), paved with tiles. A similar veranda runs on each of the four sides; similar balconies stand above, and all are bounded by the four square towers at the four corners.</p> <p>Iolani Palace is the only true palace under the American flag. It housed the last rulers of Hawaii, King Kalakaua and his sister and successor Queen Liliuokalani. The Provisional Government took over eleven years later and changed the official designation to "Executive Building". Thus the title remained until 1935 when a resolution of the legislature restored "Iolani Palace." Because more office space was needed by the government of a growing kingdom, the old Iolani Palace built in 1845 was razed in 1878 and the present palace constructed. The plan of the first palace influenced the second, main floors show similarity; a central hall; a large reception or throne room on one side; on the other, two smaller apartments. Iolani Palace now houses the State Legislature and the basement is used as committee rooms of the legislature. What is now the Governor's private office was the private apartment of King Kalakaua and afterward Queen Liliuokalani.</p>

MEMORANDUM CONCERNING
A PROPOSED HISTORICAL DISTRICT
FOR
HUNTSVILLE

GENERAL PURPOSE

In order to preserve a part of Huntsville's past, it is proposed that a historical district be created which would include that architecture most worthy of preservation within an easily defined area. The creation of such a district would not affect the present type zoning regulations concerning usage, but would require that future developments within the area be in keeping with the architectural tone of the antebellum structures of the nineteenth century.

PLAN

It has been proposed that a survey be made by the local members of the American Institute of Architects, the Huntsville Historical Society and the Antiquarian Society of Huntsville with the advice of the National Trust for Historic Preservation and with the cooperation of the City Planning Commission to define and evaluate the contents of the proposed area and to determine the interest of the property owners concerned in the preservation of the historical and economic values of the area.

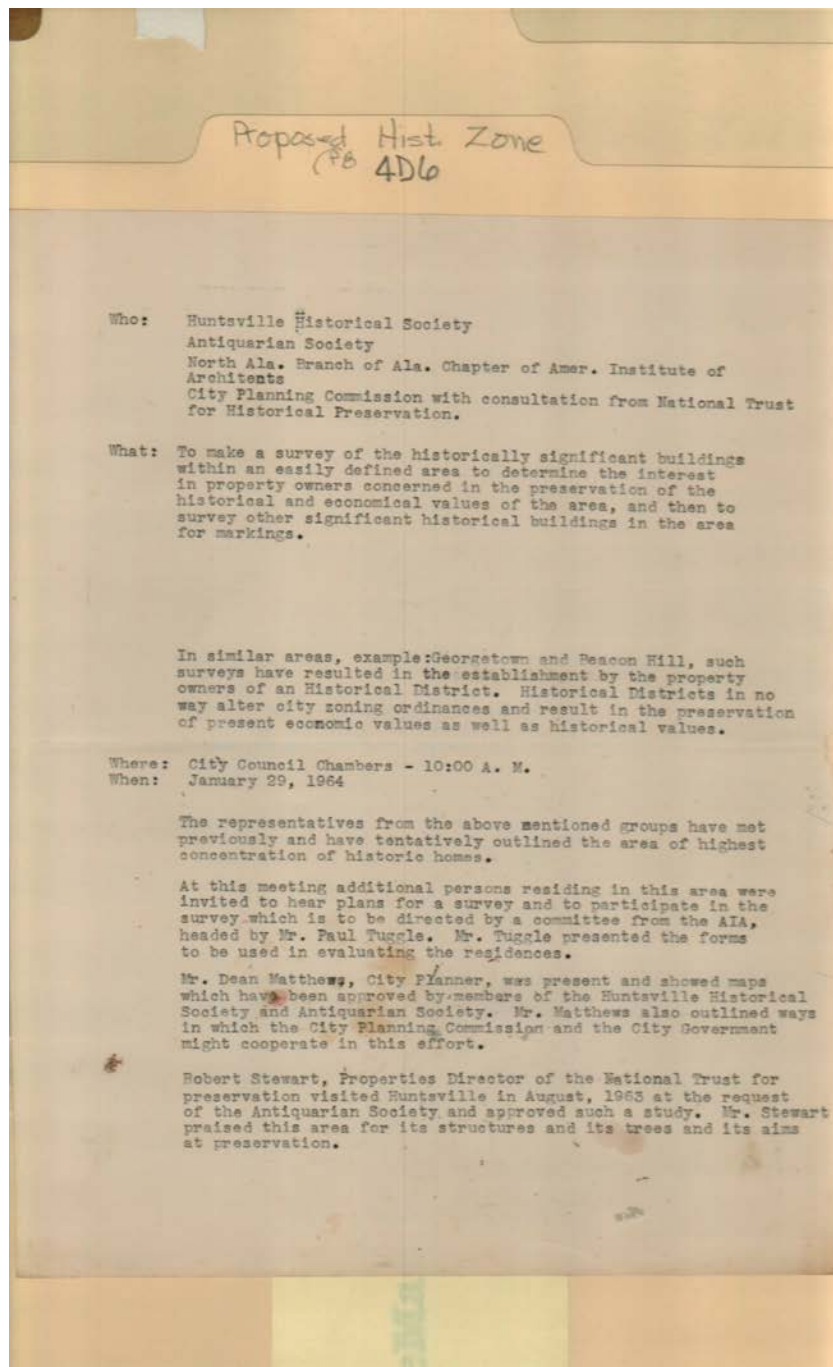
