REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERING TO VOTE

Qualifications:
 —Have resided in Alabama 1 year and the county 6 months by the date of application.
 —Be able to read and write the English language as demonstrated by reading and writing from the U. S. Constitution.
 —Be 21 years of age. Earliest possible date for a person to register is the day before his 21st birthday.
 —Take a non-Communist oath and an oath to tell the truth.
 —Be a citizen of the United States. If naturalized, furnish number appearing on naturalization papers.
 —Must not have been convicted of crime involving moral turpitude or other disqualifying offense as listed in the Alabama Constitution.
 (Note: College students and servicemen and their wives cannot gain a residence in Alabama or any county by being present in such capacities.)

Method:
 —Appear before the county Board of Registrars at a regular meeting.
 —Furnish witness who must sign a part of a form testifying as to the length of applicant's residence. He must sign the witness form at the Board office and must be a registered Alabama voter.
 —Fill out the application form without assistance.
 —Read and write, take oaths without assistance.

Time:
 —A person may apply to register at any time the Board is in session for registration. Meeting days vary according to special county laws. Most boards in the state meet only each first and third Monday. The Madison County Board may meet a total of 150 days for all purposes. Sessions are set at times when there is interest in registration, and three days notice is given.
 —It is unlawful for the Board to meet within 10 days of any election for the purposes of registration.
 —Hours of the opening of the Board are usually 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. However, certain days are set to remain open to 8 p.m. for the convenience of employed persons. All persons present at closing time are allowed to complete their applications. Registration is continuous, there being no interruption for the lunch hour.
 —One or two special registration days are usually held during the Christmas and spring holidays for the convenience of college students.

Poll Tax and Exemption Information
 Payment Period: Oct. 1, 1964-Feb. 1, 1965

Exemptions
Veterans of Wartime Service — Includes Korean War for period to Jan. 13, 1955. You are exempt from all poll taxes if you present proof of service to probate judge's office in Courthouse and obtain a "Poll Tax Exemption Certificate". You need do this only once as long as you live in this county. Just file certificate with personal papers — you will not need to present this anywhere. It simply provides you an exemption number which is placed on your registration record at the probate office.
Persons born Oct. 2, 1918 through Oct. 1, 1919 Exemption is automatic and requires no action on your part on your 46th birthday.
Note: It is your responsibility to know whether you owe \$1.50 or \$3.00 on poll tax. The collector has no record to show what you owe. Poll tax is \$1.50 per year.
 When you go to vote, give your full name as registered. If you registered late you may have to vote a Challenged Ballot. If you vote a challenged ballot, you have to have a "witness" who is a voter and whose name is on the qualified list who will swear they know you. Then you take the oath and vote a paper ballot. If you register late and want to take the time, you can go by the Probate Office and get a "certificate of qualification" and vote in the regular way.

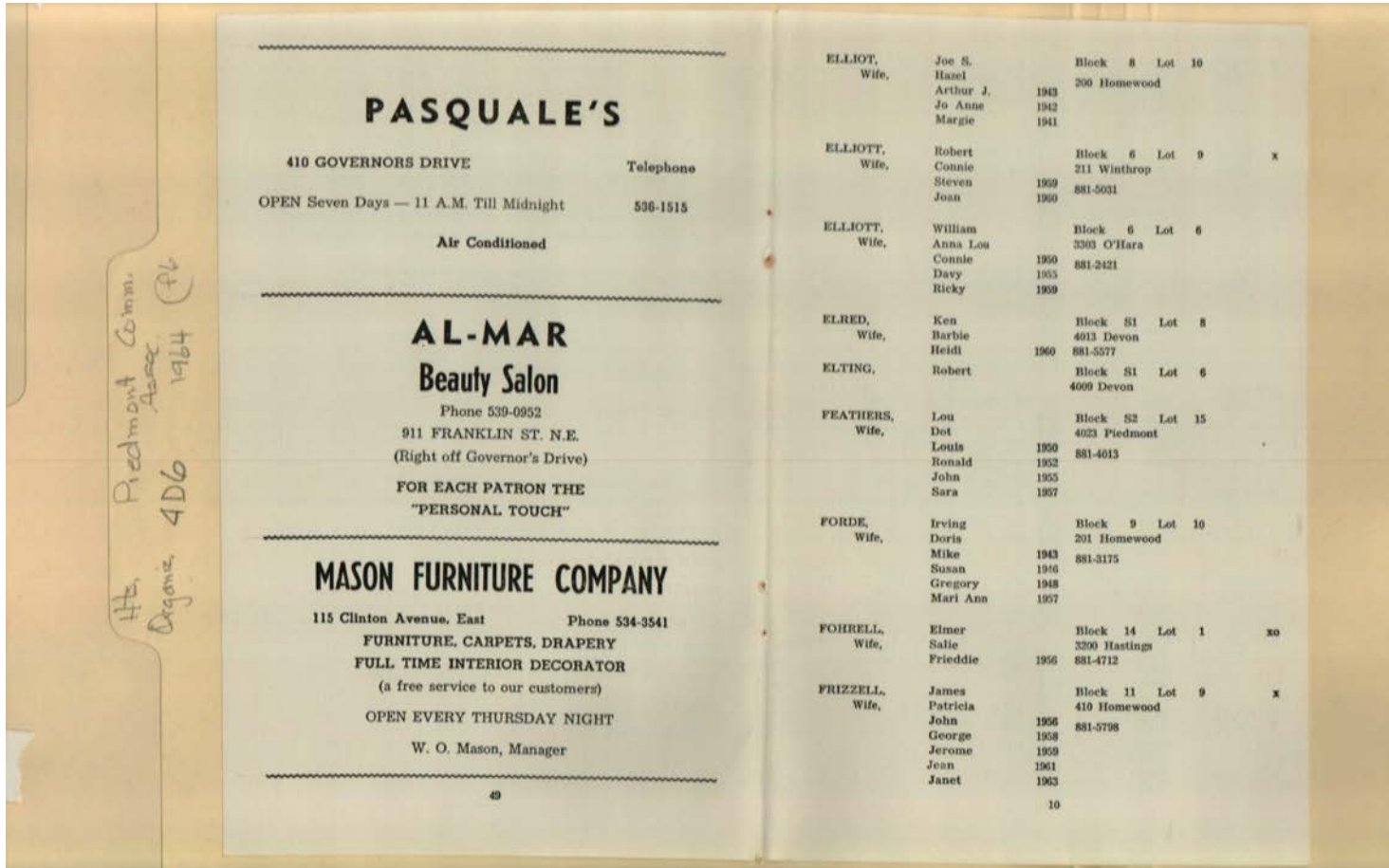

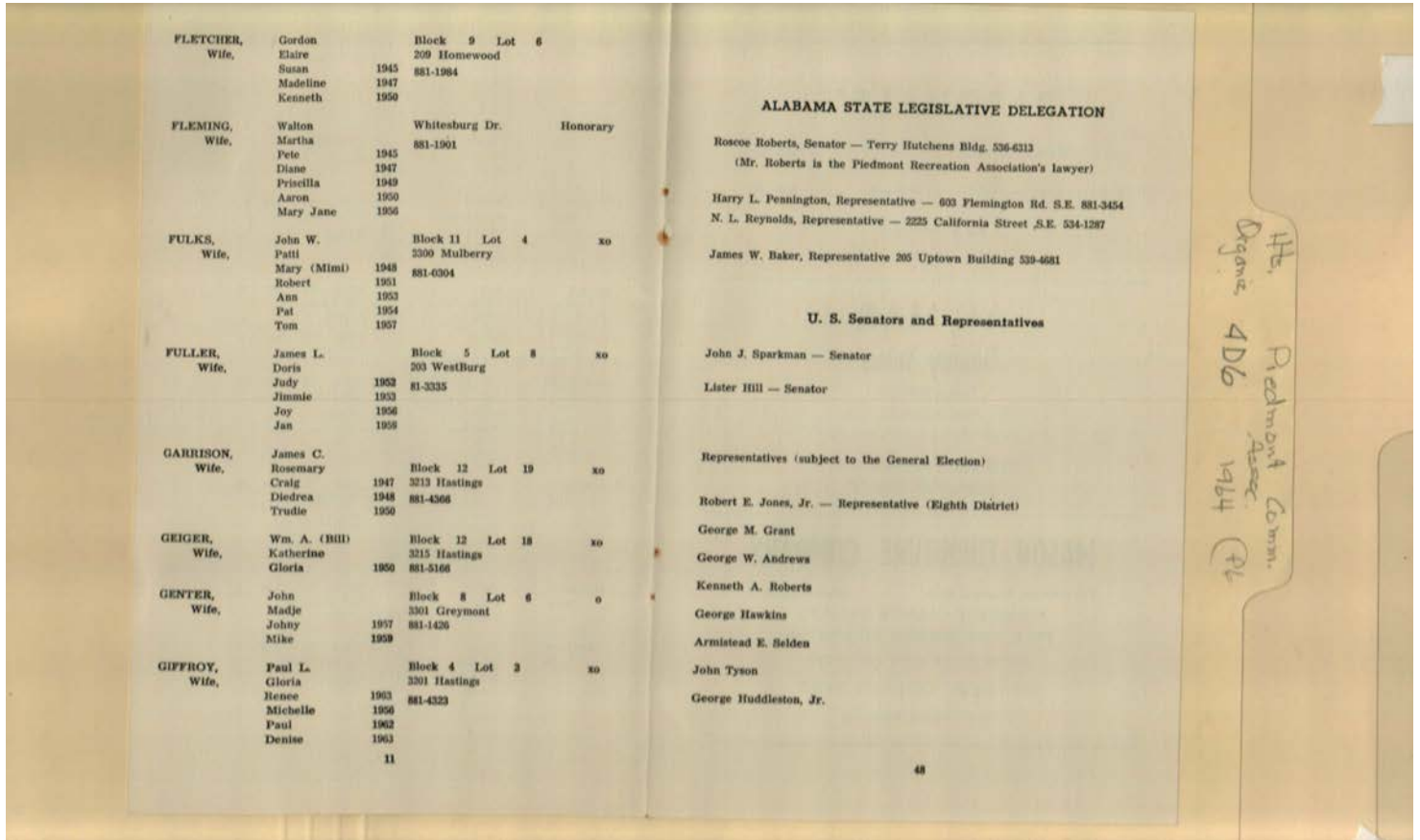

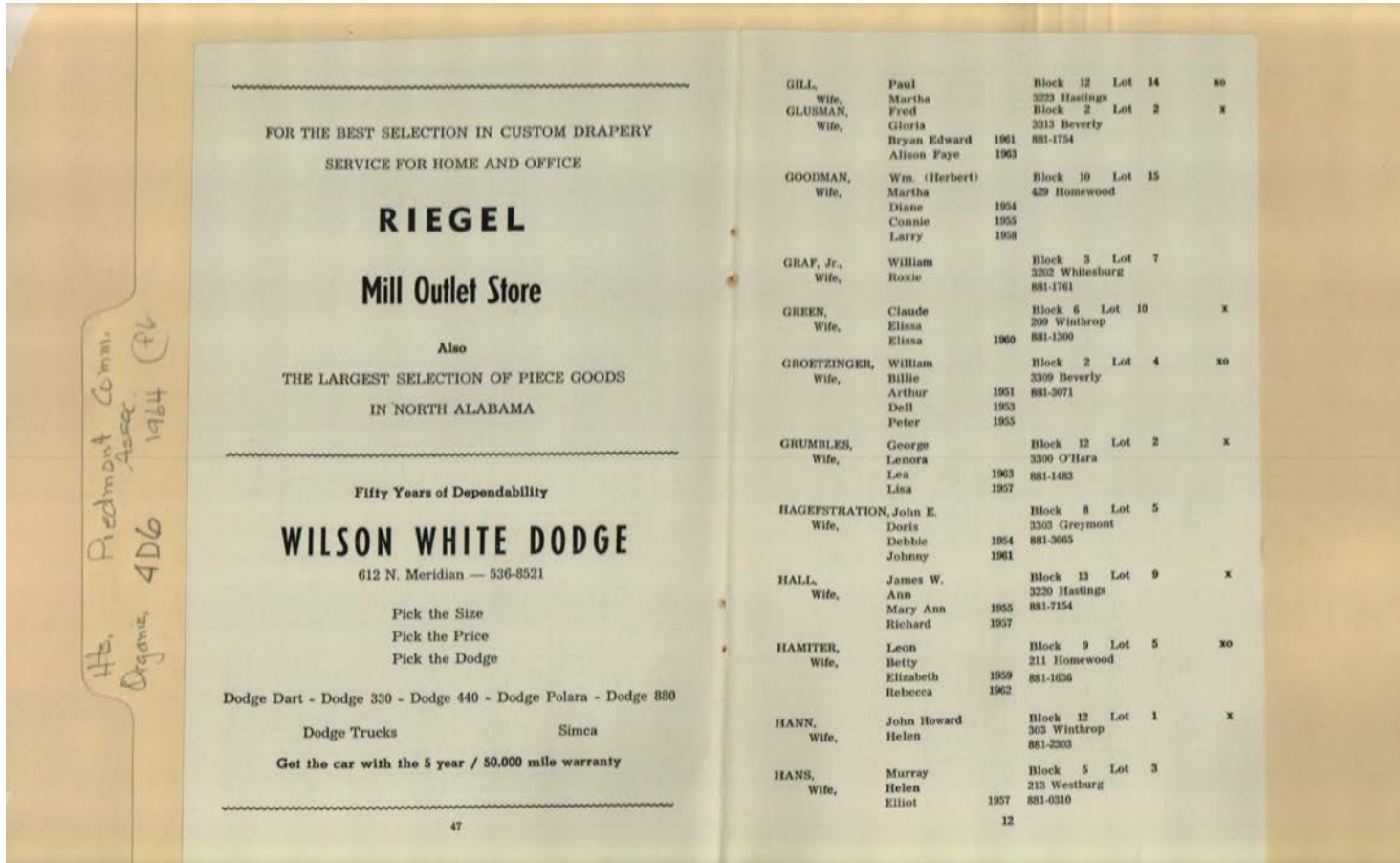

HARRIS, W. M. (Bill)	Belle	Block 10	Lot 1	xo	<p>TAXES: Assessed valuation in the City for property tax purposes is 25 per cent of appraisal value. The 1964 rate is \$4.10 per \$100 assessed value. The State sales tax is 4 percent and the City, 2 per cent, for a total of 6 per cent. The State income tax rate starts at 1½ per cent and graduates to 5 percent for taxable income over \$5,000.</p> <p>EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES: Huntsville public schools in 1963 numbered 28 (more than 800 classrooms), with one additional school under construction. Since 1955, when there were eight city schools, construction has averaged one classroom per week. The public schools serving Piedmont are: Whitesburg Elementary School located on Whitesburg Drive (Mrs. Black) Whitesburg Junior High also located on Whitesburg Drive (Cecil V. Fain) Huntsville High School located at 2304 Billie Watkins Ave. (Allan Hyatt)</p> <p>The private or Parochial Schools in Huntsville are: Madison Academy located at 201 Max Luther Dr. NW Randolph School located at 429 Randolph Ave. SE St. Marys located on Holmes Ave. Holy Spirit located on Airport Road</p> <p>Kindergartens in the area are: Kindergarten Club House at 2300 Pansy SW Madison Academy Kindergarten 301 Max Luther Circle Trinity Methodist Church Kindergarten at 607 Airport Road Whitesburg Baptist Church Kindergarten at 6806 Whitesburg</p> <p>RECREATIONAL FACILITIES: Three 18 hole golf courses — including the Municipal Course, the Huntsville Country Club and Willowbrook Country Club also a Par 3 course located adjacent to Piedmont Park. Public parks, tennis courts and play ground equipment dot the city. Monte Sano State Park provides facilities for horse back riding, picnicking and cabin rental. Scenic caves and the TVA lakes are nearby.</p> <p>THE ARTS COUNCIL OF HUNTSVILLE: This organization coordinates all of the cultural activities which includes: Civic Symphony — 62 piece orchestra — presents four subscription concerts and two concerts for school children. Distinguished guest artists appear each season. Youth Orchestra — 40 children, ages 6-18 Chamber Music Guild — presents its own concerts and also sponsors nationally and internationally known chamber music ensembles. Community Concert Association — brings four concert attractions each season. Community Chorus — composed of professional and amateur singers interested in choral music. Productions range from operettas to Handels Messiah. Admission free and membership in the chorus is open. Little Theater — sponsors an outstanding professional theatre attraction each year. Fantasy Playhouse — presents three plays during its season plus an ice show and summer benefit performance for adults. Broadway Theatre League of Huntsville — sponsored by the Huntsville Business and Professional Women's Club, brings four professional Broadway shows booked out of New York each season. Art League — composed of artists and non-artists presents lectures on art, workshops and art appreciation programs for its members and several exhibits that are open to the public. The Clothesline Show is an annual event. Cinema Arts — presents international award-winning films once a month. Also sponsors modern music concerts for the jazz-minded.</p> <p>CHURCHES: More than 100 churches representing a great variety of faiths are located here. Since 1957 more than 50 new church buildings have been constructed. Consult your phone book for the nearest church of your faith.</p>

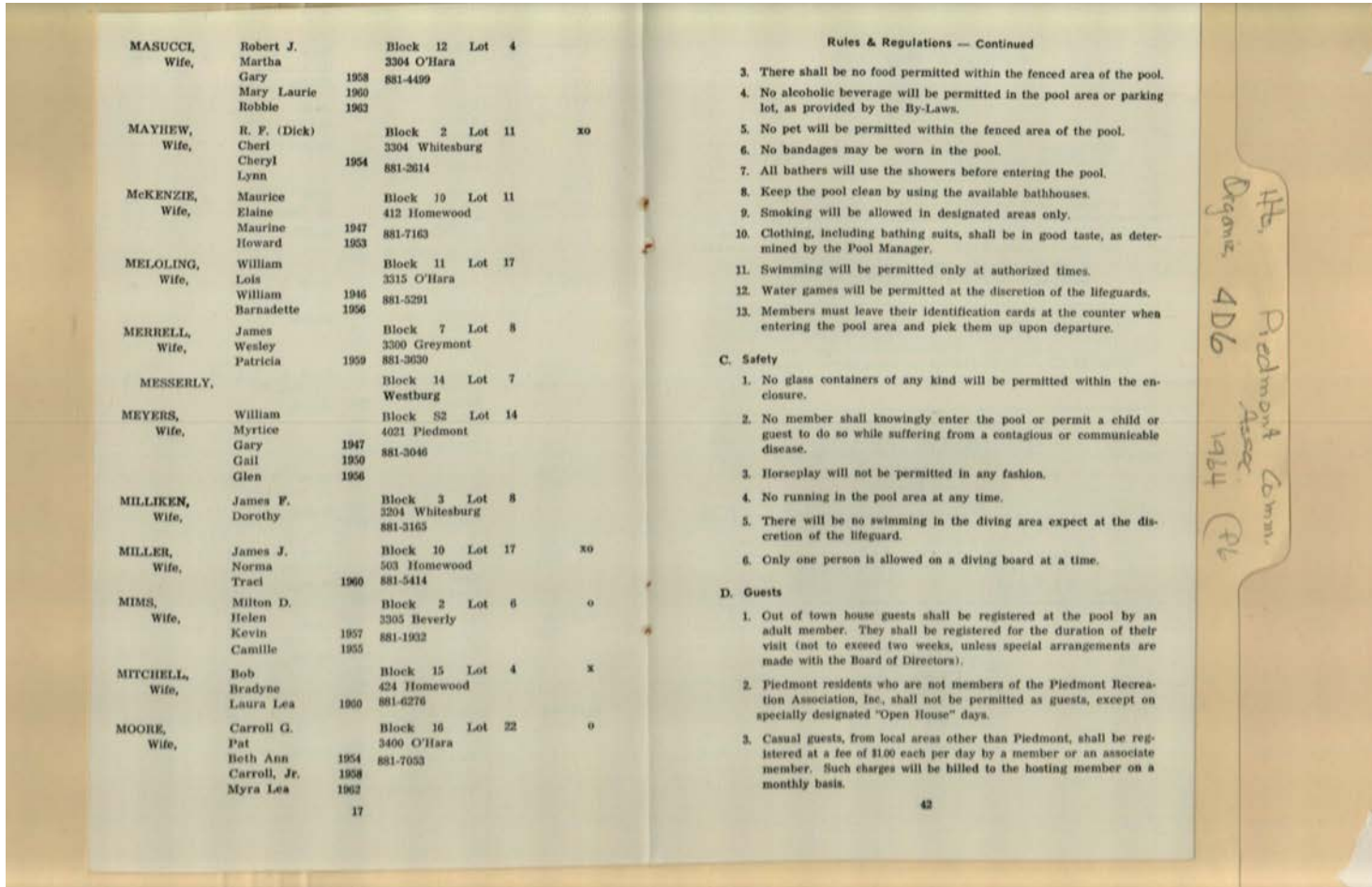

Rules & Regulations — Continued

- There shall be no food permitted within the fenced area of the pool.
- No alcoholic beverage will be permitted in the pool area or parking lot, as provided by the By-Laws.
- No pet will be permitted within the fenced area of the pool.
- No bandages may be worn in the pool.
- All bathers will use the showers before entering the pool.
- Keep the pool clean by using the available bathhouses.
- Smoking will be allowed in designated areas only.
- Clothing, including bathing suits, shall be in good taste, as determined by the Pool Manager.
- Swimming will be permitted only at authorized times.
- Water games will be permitted at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Members must leave their identification cards at the counter when entering the pool area and pick them up upon departure.

C. Safety

- No glass containers of any kind will be permitted within the enclosure.
- No member shall knowingly enter the pool or permit a child or guest to do so while suffering from a contagious or communicable disease.
- Horseplay will not be permitted in any fashion.
- No running in the pool area at any time.
- There will be no swimming in the diving area except at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- Only one person is allowed on a diving board at a time.

D. Guests

- Out of town house guests shall be registered at the pool by an adult member. They shall be registered for the duration of their visit (not to exceed two weeks, unless special arrangements are made with the Board of Directors).
- Piedmont residents who are not members of the Piedmont Recreation Association, Inc., shall not be permitted as guests, except on specially designated "Open House" days.
- Casual guests, from local areas other than Piedmont, shall be registered at a fee of \$1.00 each per day by a member or an associate member. Such charges will be billed to the hosting member on a monthly basis.
