The Erskine-Dilworth Residence, located at 515 Franklin St., was originally the home one of Madison County's most distinguished physicians, Dr. Alexander Erskine. In 1843 Dr. Erskine purchased the property from Robert Fearn and it is believed that the dwelling was constructed shortly afterward.

Coming to Huntsville in 1817, Dr. Erskine became associated with his brother-in-law, Dr. Albert Russell and then Dr. Thomas Fearn. Later he and his son, Dr. Albert R. Erskine formed a medical partnership which lasted until his death in 1857. For many years Dr. Erskine served as president of the State Board of Medical Examiners and was active in the promotion of the use of quinine in the treatment of malaria.

After his death, the family continued to occupy the home until the passing of his widow, Mrs. Miss Susan C. Erskine. In 1889 Mr. & Mrs. William J. Mastin bought the

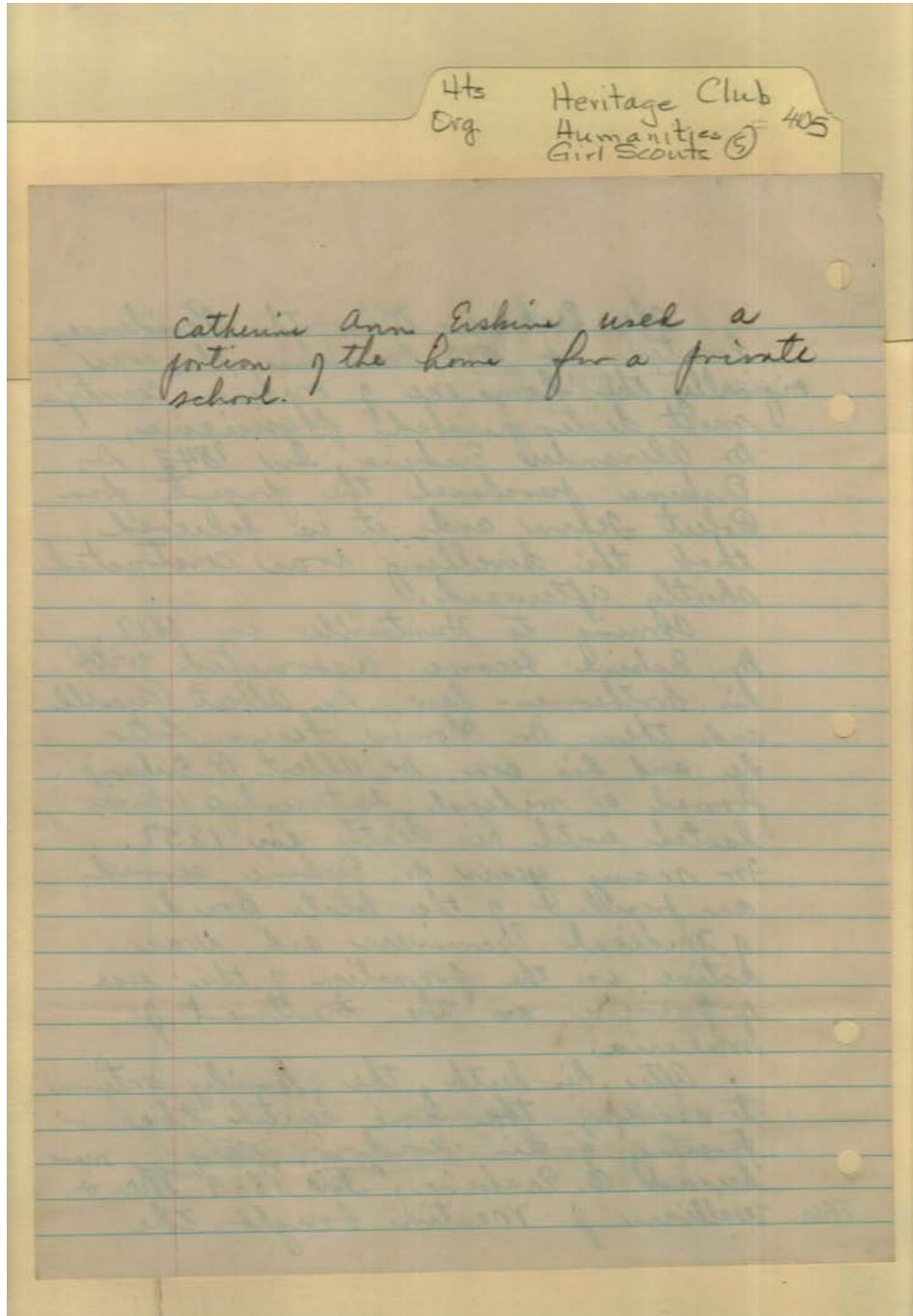

property, and made it their residence for many years. Since Mrs. Mastin was the granddaughter of Dr. Erskine, the property remained in the same family until his death in 1924. Mrs. Mastin willed the home to her daughter Mrs. R. P. Crocket and it remained in her possession until the present owners, Mr. and W. P. Dilworth, Sr., purchased the property in 1941.

The Dilworths sought the help of Mrs. Eugene Gill and Miss ~~Mrs. Mabel Mastin~~ descendant of the Erskine family, who furnished them with ^{or} pictures of the original structure.

In restoring the home to its original ante-bellum beauty and charm, with the exception of the stairways, the house stands today ^{much} as it did when it was Erskine and his wife a center of much ^{the} social life of early Huntsville.

Architecturally speaking the two story structure was planned for livability as well as beauty.

DILWORTH HOME
Once used to house the Smith Academy, this residence is now the home of Dr. and Mrs. T. E. Dilworth, Sr.




HUTCHENS HOME
Planned and built by Governor Thomas Bibb for his daughter, Mrs. Adaline Bibb Bradley, this home is now owned by Mr. and Mrs. M. M. Hutchens.



YOUNG HOME
This unusual home has been occupied by the Bassett family since the 1830's and is now owned by Miss Soyphe Lowe Young.



CHASE HOME
The Chase home, referred to as The McDowell-LeVert home, was built in 1848 by William McDowell, a brother of Mrs. Clement C. Clay. General Mitchell used the house as Union occupation headquarters for this region.



WATTS HOME
Built by LeRoy Pope in the early nineteenth century, this residence has been the home of some member of the Charles Patton Family for five generations.
