History & Accomplishments

On a knoll overlooking the reflecting pool stands the Garden's administration building.

In just seven short years since its groundbreaking, the Huntsville Botanical Garden has become one of the most active and dynamic gardens in the country.

The 112-acre site on which the Garden is located was provided for our use by the U.S. Army through the Alabama Space Science Exhibit Commission and the City of Huntsville. A remarkable site, the land combines both typical lowland and highland forests, gently rolling meadows and an unusual bog area.

The natural beauty of the site has been enhanced with the development of various gardens, tended meadows and acres of lawn. Paths meander through the shady woodlands of the Dogwood Trail and wildflowers quietly populate the Nature Trail which leads to a fern glade. Spectacular rose, daylily, herb, iris, and butterfly gardens rival or surpass those of mature botanical gardens. Maple trees line a promenade which encircles a glistening reflecting pool. A picturesque orchid greenhouse, a turf demonstration

area, a crop demonstration garden, and brilliant color beds blend with the other inviting elements of the existing garden.

The Garden is justly proud of its efforts in the field of conservation. It has taken a lead in the promotion of environmental stewardship through classes, the Botanical Garden newsletter, the mulch program and the Christmas tree recycling campaign. The Huntsville Botanical Garden is Huntsville's official site for the annual Arbor Day celebration.

Our botanical garden plays an important part in stimulating the study and understanding of the sciences. Each year 1,500 students from Huntsville and Madison County spend a day at the Huntsville Botanical Garden learning about the role plants play in their lives. Summer offers young students the opportunity to attend Camp Botanica. A week of activities instills in these campers a sense of wonder for nature and a commitment to be good stewards of Planet Earth. Over 60 educational workshops and programs serve over 1,800 participants of all ages and the botanical

resource library boasts over 800 volumes. Other exciting educational opportunities exist through partnerships with local universities. One such partnership provides a Biological Laboratory for Student Research at the Botanical Garden. The lab's first shuttle flight experiment flew successfully aboard Columbia in October of 1992.

Yet it is the community interest and involvement of which we are most proud. Over 4,000 members constitute the core of believers — those individuals who are actively involved in the Garden's development, its educational opportunities and its lively, imaginative and fun activities. All await with anticipation the Spring Plant Sale, the Moonlight Stroll, the "Tour of Elegant Gardens," the "Of Food and Flowers" dinners, Cornucopia and the Teddy Bear Tea Party. This grass roots support is the Garden's true strength.

The Garden is built on a sound foundation. Our superb staff of 13 includes an executive director, director of horticulture and two educational directors. Much of the Garden's infrastructure is in place: an administration building, education annex, greenhouses, roads, bridges and irrigation and drainage systems. All of this is on a solid financial footing — a feat accomplished principally through private support with key infusions of funding and in-kind services from the City of Huntsville and Madison County.

- Completion of Administration/Education Building and arrival of first greenhouse.

1991

- Completion of Master Plan, providing the road map for the Garden's future direction.

To Date

- Over 4,000 individuals are Garden members, approximately 2% of the Huntsville population.
- Over two million dollars contributed.

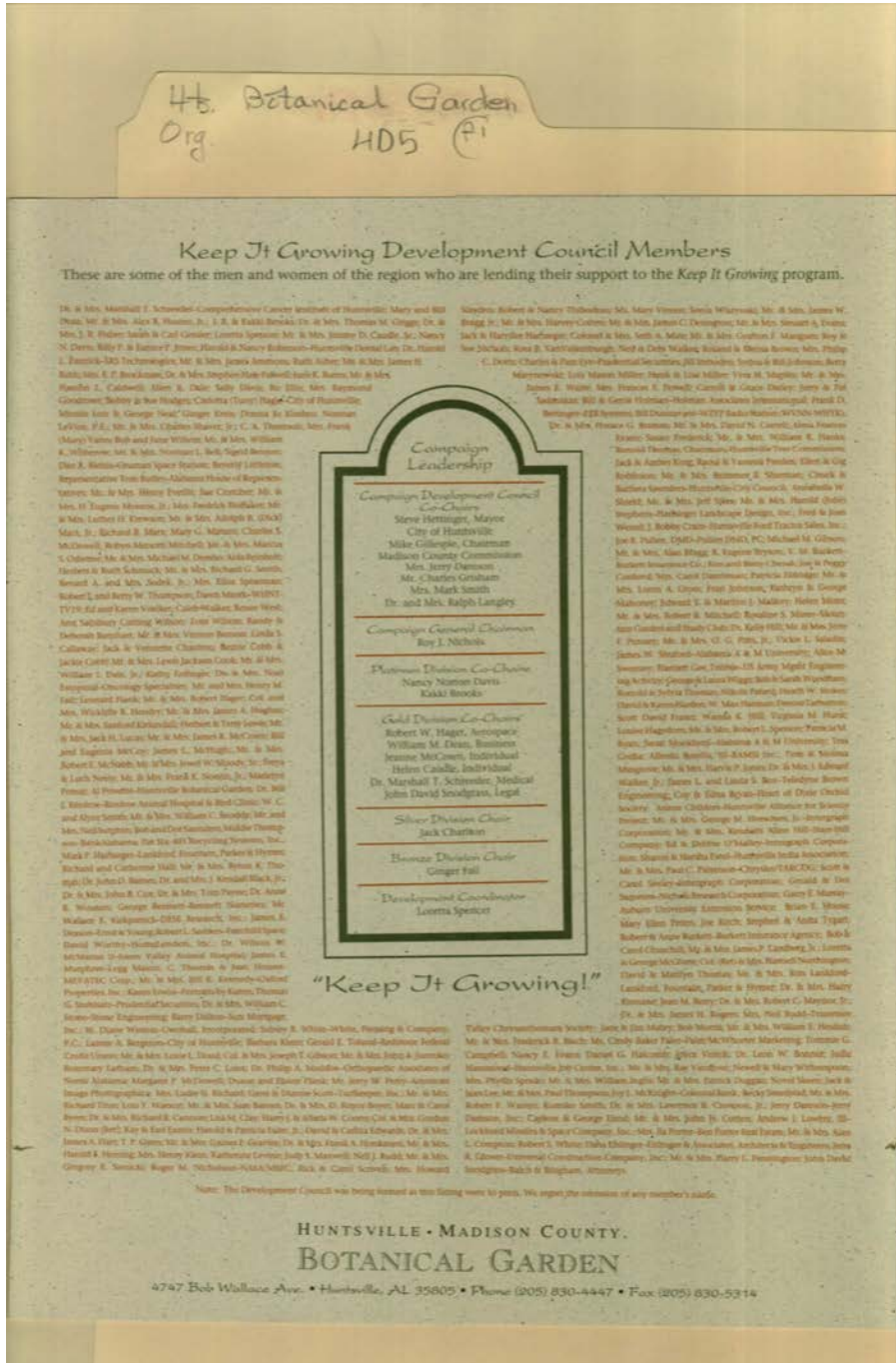
