Panoply '85 Has Tents Above and Below

The dances, plays and concerts at Panoply '85 are strictly artistic, but putting stages underneath the dancers, actors and musicians is strictly business.

At the arts festival opening to students Thursday and to the general public Friday at 5 p.m., arts happenings will be going on all over Big Spring Park, but the principal events will take place on three stages that are in reality three temporary theaters sheltered by tents, with solid stages, lighting and sound equipment and seating for their audiences.

The Arts Council, which sponsors the four-day festival every year, does not have the wherewithal to build three sturdy stages in one week and dismantle them the next, but civic-minded and arts-oriented businesses have assumed the obligation.

Parisian and *The Huntsville Times* have sponsored Panoply stages every year, beginning with the first Panoply in 1982. For the Business Committee for the Arts, this will be the second consecutive year to sponsor a stage.

PARISIAN HAS BEEN a stalwart supporter of the arts festival in several ways, not only in the major matter of building stages. Other contributions include donating the funds for a professional dance floor to be used at Panoply and at other times of the year by The Arts Council's member organizations.

According to the president of Parisian, Donald Hess, "Parisian strongly believes in supporting every community in which we operate."

Other Huntsville arts organizations to benefit from this policy of Parisian include Fantasy Playhouse, the Broadway Theater League and the Huntsville Museum of Art.

Parisian has agreed to contribute \$25,000 over the next five years to Panoply.

On the state level, Parisian's support of such cultural organizations as the Alabama Shakespeare Festival and the Alabama Symphony Orchestra was recognized by the Alabama State Council on the Arts and Humanities in 1984 when it gave Emil Hess, the chairman of the board of Parisian, its annual Business Committee for the Arts Award.

Since the Parisian stage at Panoply is the one equipped with a professional dance floor, most of the major dance attractions will be there, although the number of dance companies participating in the festival this year will make it necessary to present some of them on other stages.

DANCE HIGHLIGHTS on the Parisian stage will include the Odomankoma Kyerema Cultural Troupe of dancers from Ghana Friday at 7:30 p.m., the Bienville Ballet from Mobile Friday at 9:35 p.m. and Sunday at 12:30 p.m., Ballet UAB from Birmingham Saturday and Sunday at noon and Saturday at 6:05 p.m., the finals in the Panoply choreography competition Saturday at 8 p.m. and Dance Alive from Florida Sunday at 1 p.m. The culminating event for Panoply, the awards ceremony for all competition winners, will take place on the Parisian stage Sunday at 6:30 p.m.

The Huntsville Times stage, a more intimate stage than the one provided for this year, according to Katherine Lester, co-chairman with Trisha Bragg for Panoply '85.

Not only has *The Times* stage been enlarged but also it has been moved, says Mrs. Lester. In former years, it was too convenient to the pond that is home to Big Spring Park's colony of ducks, who frequently insisted on providing a quacking chorus for the actors and musicians.

The new location for *The Times* stage is on Williams Street across from the Huntsville Hilton, near the new gazebo.

The principal event on *The Times* stage will be the drama competition Saturday at 10 a.m., when actors will perform for judging in solo and duo dramatic excerpts. Other highlights of the festival scheduled for *The Times* stage will be "Lady Bug" (Annie Hickman) Saturday at 12:25 p.m. and Sunday at 3:30 p.m., a performance by saxophonist Neal Ramsay Saturday at 4:40 and 7:45 p.m. and the Shelby County Big Four company of folk musicians Sunday at noon, 2:40 p.m. and 5:15 p.m.

PANOPLY STAGES ARE now dispersed so that any possibility of sound from one impinging on another is averted. The stage sponsored by the Business Committee on the Arts is being built between the Big Spring lagoon and the Senior Center well to the north of the other stages.

It is on the BCA stage that the music competition will be held Saturday at 2:30 p.m. This competition is not in music performance but in music composition, and the audience will be able to hear the first public performances of a number of original musical works.

"Cinderella" and "Side by Side by Sondheim" will be the major visiting theater events of Panoply, and both will be done on the BCA stage. "Cinderella," performed by the Punch and Judy Players of Tuscaloosa, will be seen there Friday at 7:45 p.m. and Saturday at 4:10 p.m. "Side by Side by Sondheim," a production of the Tuscaloosa Community Players, will be on the BCA stage Saturday at 8:20 p.m. and Sunday at 5:05 p.m.

Panoply will open tomorrow for fifth-graders only. For the general public, Panoply hours will be Friday from 5 to 10 p.m., Saturday from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. and Sunday from noon to 7 p.m.

All events at Panoply are free.

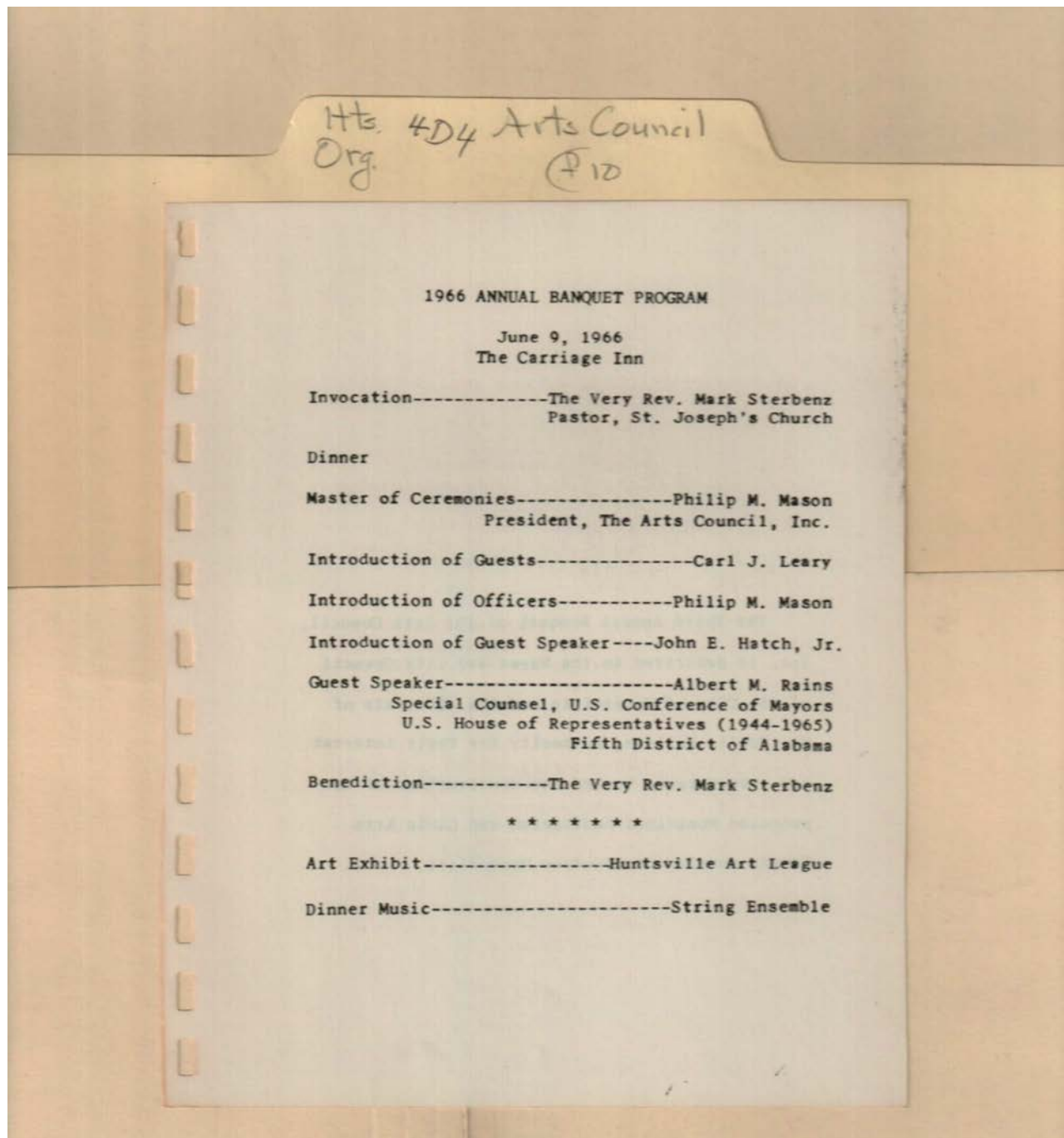
Mr. Rains continues to work for the betterment of Housing and Urban Development for the American people. He is also the author of his new book "With Heritage So Rich".

Mr. Holder has also presented some of the film programs to organizations in Huntsville. A daytime workshop between 10-15 people was held each Wednesday and was organized by Arleen Biehl.

Jury Show

The first Annual HALMA Jury Show for Northern Alabama and adjoining areas was initiated this year in February and March. Two hundred fifty excellent entries were received, out of which 59 were selected by a panel of three well-known professionals in art. The jurors were Dr. Ralph M. Hudson, Head, Department of Art, Mississippi State College for Women; Walter H. Stevens, Associate Professor of Art, University of Tennessee; and Dick Godwin, scenic artist and designer of St. Louis.

The Jury Show was the first major art event of this stature held in Huntsville. The jurors selected "Interior of My Studio; A Real Allegory" by Brack Walker of Auburn, Alabama, for the \$1000 purchase award. This painting is now owned by HALMA and is the first of a collection of contemporary art for the forthcoming Huntsville Museum permanent art collection.

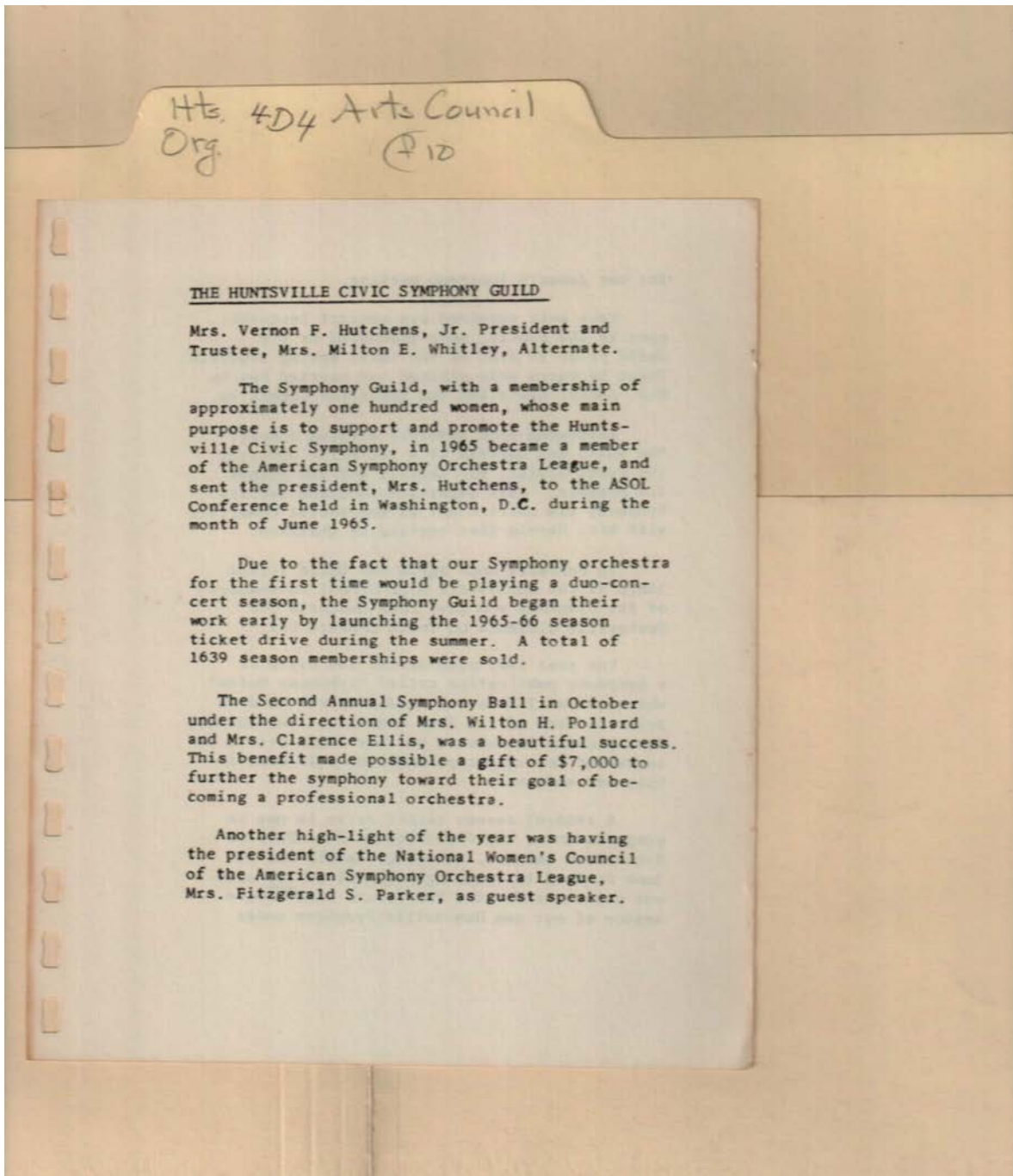
In November: The ACE participated in the annual Arts Council Open House with a display of paintings by children under six and selected ACE publications.
