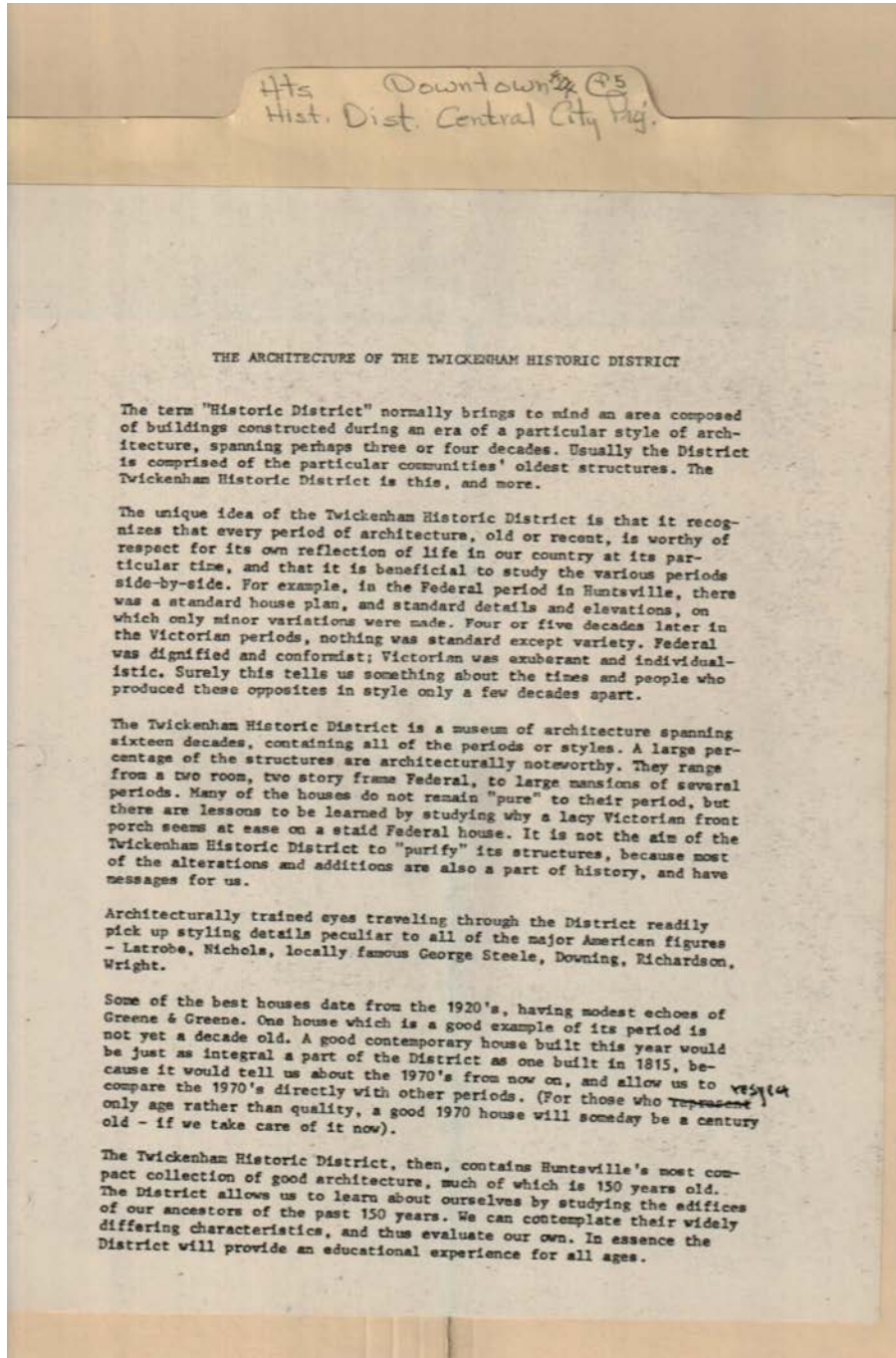
This expansion period was extended even further when Redstone Arsenal became the center of guided missile and rocket research and development shortly after the war. During the last twenty years Huntsville has become one of the key cities of the South as its economy expanded to meet the needs of the Space Age.

With the second rapid influx of population, Huntsville took a forward step by extending its city limits to include most of the surrounding metropolitan areas so that its growth could be developed in an orderly way.

Huntsville today retains a rich heritage which its citizens have created through the years, and at the same time is teeming with such activities as building new industrial plants, new stores, new roads and highways, new airport facilities, new public utilities, new banking facilities, new parks and playgrounds, new schools, new public buildings, new churches, new civic organizations, in short all those things so vital to an energetic and purposeful community life.
