rooms in the Tennessee Valley; it was 'the' place to stay when one had business in North Alabama. At its opening in January, 1930, the management threw a formal ball attended by all the prominent families of the area. For thirty years most of the civic clubs used its meeting rooms and all important social functions occured within its walls.

The money for its construction was put up by a group of Huntsville businessmen who incorporated in February, 1928, and construction began late that year.

Although the architect and general contractor were from outside Huntsville, the Directors were proud that many local firms had subcontracts, including the Huntsville Transfer and Building Material Company which supplied the sand, gravel and brick, and Mason's Furniture Store which supplied three carloads of furniture. However, the tile, marble and terazzo work went to an Atlanta firm and a Birmingham company did the painting. It had Otis elevators. The total cost of the hotel was over half a million dollars.

The hotel was named for a local boy, Russel Erskine, who had left Huntsville early and made a great success of himself by becoming president of the Studebaker Corporation. He was a descendent of two old Huntsville families, the Russels and the Erskines, and although he was unable to attend the grand opening ball, his family were the honored guests.

The Meyer Hotel Company managed the business until 1935. There was a boom when Redstone Arsenal was reactivated, but the sudden growth of the city created a rash of new motels which took customers away from the by then old building. During the 1970's an attempt was made to revive the hotel but it failed and the structure is now vacant.





> Structures qualifying under condition 1 are automatically certified historic structures. automatically certified historic structures. Those structures located within a district (conditions 2 and 3) must be certified by filing Part 1 of the Historic Preservation Certification Application with the State Historic Preservation Officer. He will forward the application to the National Park Service staff who then rules on whether or not the structure is of historical significance. to the district and provides written notification of the decision to the owner.

REHABILITATION: The Tax Reform Act of 1976 provides major tax incentives for rehabilitation by owners of commercial historic structures. Rehabilitation means the renabilitation by owners of commercial historic structures. Rehabilitation means the process of returning a property to a state of utility, through repair or alteration, which makes possible an efficient contemporary use while preserving those portions and features of the property which are significant to its historic, architectural and cultural values. This does not require restoration although a restoration would also be eligible for the same tax benefits if it met all the requirements. For an owner to take advantage of the rehabilitation provisions of the tax law, he must have the rehabilitation certified by the Secretary of the Interior. This is accomplished by filing Part II of the Historic Preservation Certification Application with the State Historic Preservation Officer at any time during the rehabilitation work although to ensure acceptance it is advisable to submit the proposed rehabilitation plans prior to the proposed rehabilitation plans prior to the start of construction so that any items the start of construction so that any items which do not meet the standards may be corrected. The State Historic Preservation Officer will forward the application to the National Park Service for review and evaluation and they will then notify the owner whether the project is consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation. Upon completion of the rehabilitation work, the owner must notify the National Park Service, through the State Historic Preservation Officer, that the project has been completed and submit appropriate materials documenting it. If the

completed work meets the Standards for Rehabilitation, it will be certified and the owner will be eligible to take advantage of the tax incentives. When evaluating rehabilitation work, the National Park Service will take into consideration both the exterior and the interior of the structure, any site improvements, and adjacent new construction. The Tax Reform Act deals with the entire site and structure so that the whole property receives the tax break.

THE TAX ADVANTAGES: The Tax Reform Act of 1976 provides two separate tax advantages for rehabilitation.

1. THE 60-MONTH AMORTIZATION DEDUCTION may be used by an owner for depreciating any capital expenditure incurred in connection with a certified rehabilitation of a certified ristoric structure in lieu of depreciation deductions otherwise allowed. A certified rehabilitation means any rehabilitation of a certified historic structure. allowed. A certified rehabilitation means any rehabilitation of a certified historic structure which the Secretary of the Interior has certified to the Secretary of the Treasury as being consistent with the historic character of such property or the district in which it is located. It does not require any minimum amount to be spent on rehabilitation work. amount to be spent on rehabilitation work. The 60-month amortization deduction applies only to rehabilitation expenses incurred after June 14, 1976 and before June 15, 1981. This provision allows an owner to deduct capital expenditures incurred in rehabilitation over a sixty month period rather than being added to the adjusted basis of the structure and depreciated over its useful life.

2. ACCELERATED DEPRECIATION

is useful life.

2. ACCELERATED DEPRECIATION DEDUCTIONS may be taken at the owner's election on certified historic properties which are substantially rehabilitated. A substantial rehabilitation is one in which the expenditures for a 24-month period ending on the last day of any taxable year (reduced by any amounts allowed as depreciation or amortization with respect thereto) exceed the greater of 1, \$5,000 or 2 the adjusted basis of such property. The adjusted basis (initial cost of the property plus the costs of improvements less the amounts allowed as

depreciation) is determined as of the first day of the 24-month period. Accelerated depreciation applies to the total property, rather than just the rehabilitation expenses, and allows the owner to depreciate the property as though he were the original user of the property. The accelerated depreciation deduction applies to expenses incurred after June 30, 1976 and before July 1, 1981. It has not yet been determined but it seems probable that a taxpayer will not be allowed to take both the 60-month amortization deduction and accelerated depreciation deduction. However on a substantial rehabilitation the owner may elect to take either the accelerated depreciation deduction on the entire property or amortize over five years the rehabilitation expenditures. A lessee does not qualify for the rehabilitation tax incentives of the 1976 tax act but a life tenant can.


For either method of tax deduction outlined above, the Secretary of the Interior must certify that the structure is in fact a certified historic structure before the tax consequences accrue. However, the National Park Service will review rehabilitation plans for structures not yet designated as certified historic structures if it appears likely that they will receive such status.

DISADVANTAGES OF DEMOLITION: The DISADVANTAGES OF DEMOLITION. The Tax Reform Act of 1976 is written to encourage the preservation of historic structures and to discourage their demolition. Therefore, for demolition purposes, any structure located within a registered historic district will automatically be considered a certified historic structure pulses the Secretary of the Interior certifies. unless the Secretary of the Interior certifies prior to demoiltion that the structure is not of historic significance to the district. To obtain this decertification, the owner must submit Part 1 of the Historic Perservation Certification Application to the State Historic Preservation Officer who will then forward it to the National Park Service for review. The owner will receive written notification of their decision. If an owner
