Admission to the Hospital for private patients is by one of the physicians or dentists currently certified as a member of the University Hospital Medical and Dental Staff.

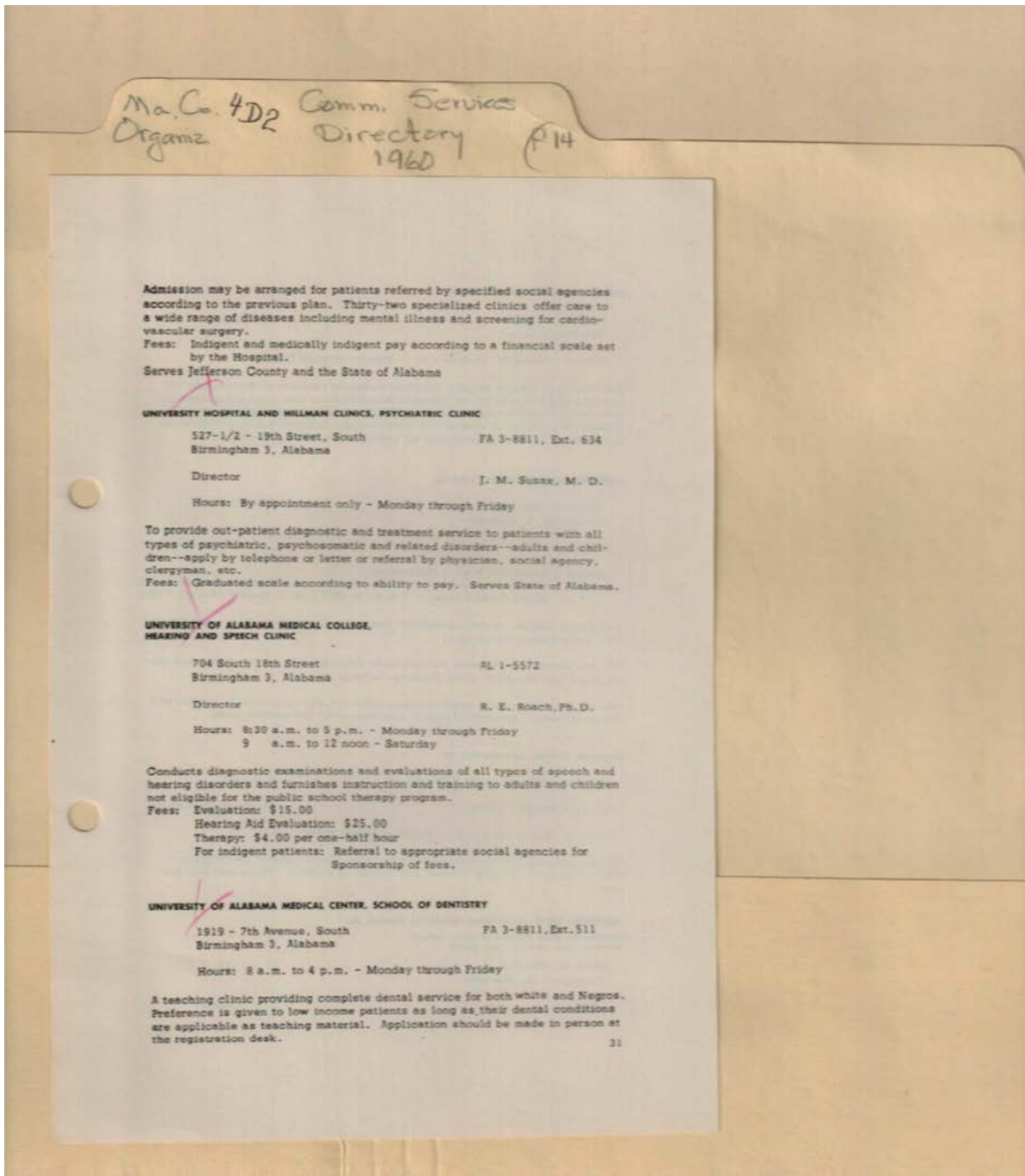
