Mobile Observes Gorgas Centenary

The late Major General William Crawford Gorgas was honored in his native Mobile, on October 1, the hundredth anniversary of his birth, with impressive and fitting ceremonies, under the direction of Mr. Henry Schaub, Chairman, and Mr. Martin J. Johnson, master of ceremonies.

A bronze bust by Bryant Baker was unveiled by General Gorgas' daughter, Mrs. W. D. Wrightson of Washington, D. C.

Major General Silas B. Hays, deputy surgeon general of the Army, made the featured address, and read the following statement from General Matthew B. Ridgeway, Army chief of staff: "People will enjoy until the end-of-time, the fruits of the labors of this great man."

Dr. O. C. Carmichael and Mr. Thomas W. Martin had spoken at a testimonial dinner the previous evening. The whole brilliant occasion should have been especially gratifying to Mr. Martin, whose enthusiastic admiration of General Gorgas has led to his being widely acclaimed—to his being placed in the Hall of Fame in New York and to the establishment of the Gorgas Scholarship Foundation.

Opelika Celebrates Centennial

Opelika began the celebration of her one-hundredth birthday with a Centennial Ball at Fort Dallas Smith Armory on Saturday night, September 4. Miss Barbara Glenn, Queen of the Centennial, and David Canon, Chairman of the Opelika Centennial Corporation, led the Grand March.

The following week citizens and visitors devoted to taking stock of century-long development and progress. Sunday the emphasis was on religious life, climaxed by an inter-faith meeting at Moore Stadium.

Monday was Historical Day, featuring the crowning of the Queen, a parade, and at night the premiere of "Panorama of Progress," a huge historical pageant, performed by more than 400 local citizens. Tuesday spotlighted Youth; Wednesday, the part played by Railroads and other modes of Transportation. On Thursday Military Achievements were recalled, and soldiers and patriotic organizations were honored.

Friday's activities emphasized Business and Industry and included filling and sealing a "time capsule" to be opened in 2054. Agriculture was Saturday's theme.

Jack Boozer Heads Calhoun Society

The Calhoun County Historical Society was formed in the home of Mrs. C. W. Daugeette at Jacksonville, Alabama, Sunday afternoon, October 24, 1954. Mrs. Daugeette presided and introduced Mr. Rucker Agee, past president of the Alabama Historical Association.

In his interesting and informative talk Mr. Agee pointed out that Calhoun County has a rich historical background, that when the county was formed the tide-water planters from the older, settled states moved in with their families and dependents, transplanting their culture here in the wilderness. From this culture sprang many fine men and women. He said that county historical societies should preserve local records and do research on local people. This work has many facets, such as genealogy, the preservation of old buildings, marking of historic places, exploration of land titles, and the preservation of source materials.

Mr. Jack Boozer proposed a formal motion that the group organize and form the Calhoun County Historical Society. The motion, seconded by Mr. T. Weller Smith, carried.

The following officers were elected: Mrs. C. W. Daugeette, honorary president for life; Mr. Jack Boozer, president; Dr. Robert P. Felgar, first vice-president; Mr. T. Weller Smith treasurer; and Miss Nancy Claiborne Roberson, secretary.

The meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the president. Those present and not previously mentioned are: Mrs. Cliff Carson, Mrs. Rutledge Daugeette, Mr. Horace Lex Stevenson, Dr. Emmett B. Fields, Dr. T. E. Montgomery, Mr. William E. Gilbert, Miss Nancy Claiborne Roberson. Members received into the Society during the next two months will come in as charter members. Former residents of the County are invited as well as those now living in Calhoun.

The executive committee will be composed of members from all sections of the county. Persons desiring to join should send name, address, and one dollar to Miss Nancy Claiborne Roberson, P. O. Box 324, Jacksonville, Alabama.

The people of Opelika have done a fine thing in reconstructing their past, and are to be commended for making the whole occasion so gay and colorful, even mirth-provoking, with the old-fashioned beards, quaint dresses and bonnets, and rollicking square dances.

Wheeler Exploits Recalled

Perpetuating the memory of the life and patriotic services of "Fighting Joe" Wheeler was the theme of the 25th Annual Convention of the General Joseph Wheeler Memorial Association, held at Wheeler on September 10, the General's birthday.

Mrs. Joe E. Cooper of Huntsville, Association president, officiated. Tribute was paid Miss Annie Wheeler, the General's daughter, a gracious hostess and a "hero" in her own right. Mrs. C. C. Johnson presented a bouquet, and she was serenaded by four little boys, singing, "Let Me Call You Sweetheart." Also she heard her father's favorite song, "Onward, Christian Soldiers," led by Carlisle Davis. Redus Christy Collier, Jr., of Decatur, in a miniature uniform of a Confederate General, recited "My Daddy Was a Rebel."

Welcome to visitors was given by C. C. McWhorter, Chairman of the Lawrence County Board of Revenue; and in the response R. K. Bell of Huntsville said: "We are here to rededicate ourselves to carry on the fine and noble principles which stood out so in General Wheeler's life."

Dr. Festus Cook of Montgomery, who made the address, reasoned that "as no state in the Union has a spot more rich in tradition than is found right here, . . . a state shrine should be made of the Wheeler homestead to preserve the hallowed ground just as it is today."

A petition was signed for the issue of a General Wheeler Memorial stamp.

Young Redus Collier's recitation of "My Daddy Was a Rebel" was featured at the U. D. C. Convention held in Roanoke, Virginia, early in November, and a national magazine will carry the Birmingham *News* picture of Miss Annie Wheeler adjusting his little uniform.

Brannon Honored in Creek War Marker

An Alabama Historical Association marker recently placed on Highway 241 in Russell County commemorates the site of Fort Mitchell, built by Georgia militia in the Creek War, 1813-1814, and occupied by U. S. troops until after the Indian removal in 1838.

The cost of the marker was donated by admirers of Peter A. Brannon as a token of esteem for his effective career in discovering, preserving and publicizing facts of our history. Mr. Brannon is a leading Indianologist, and recognized as an authority on the Southern Indian.

"My appeal to you is to recognize this and to take action today while the opportunity is still available."

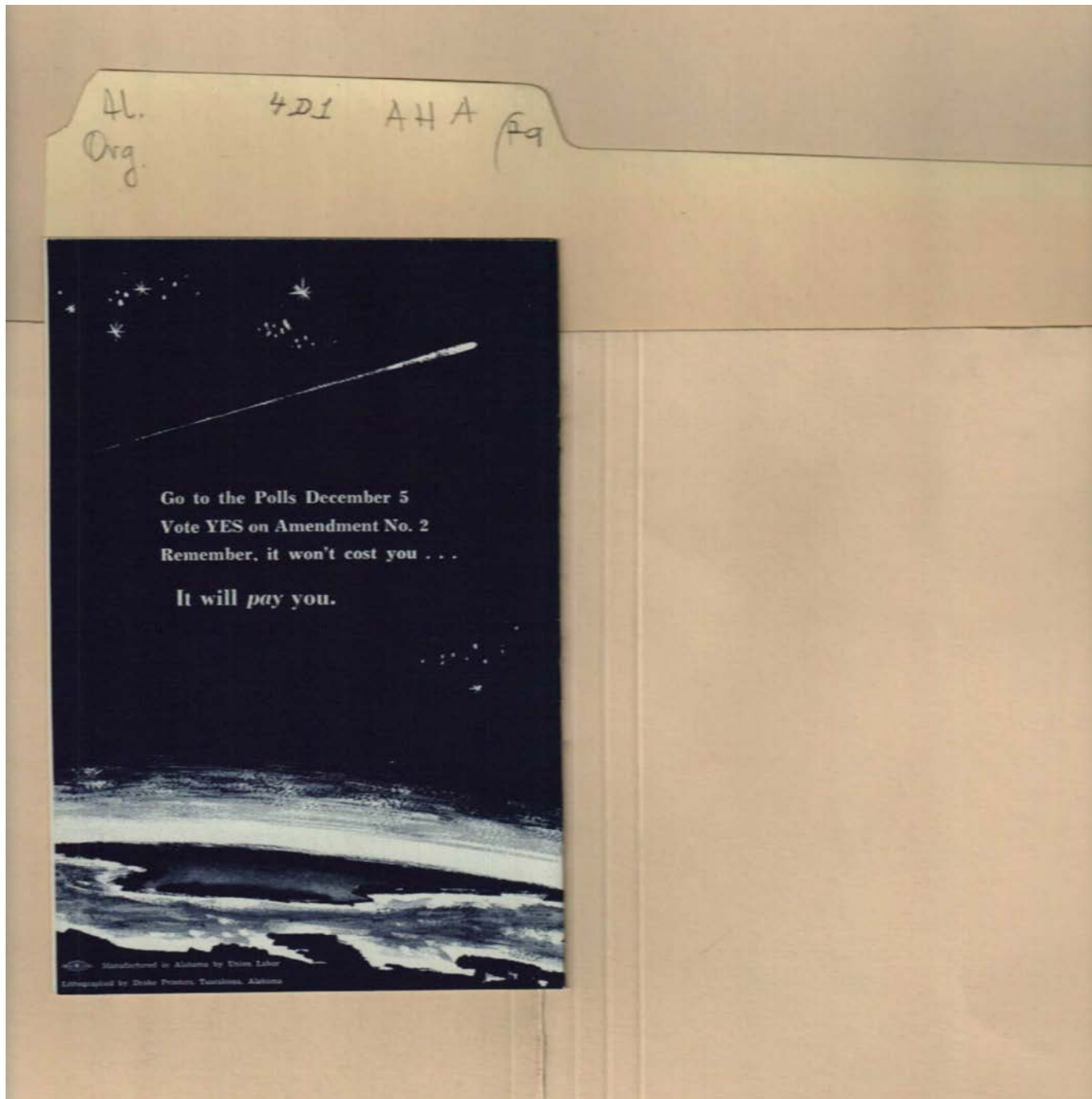

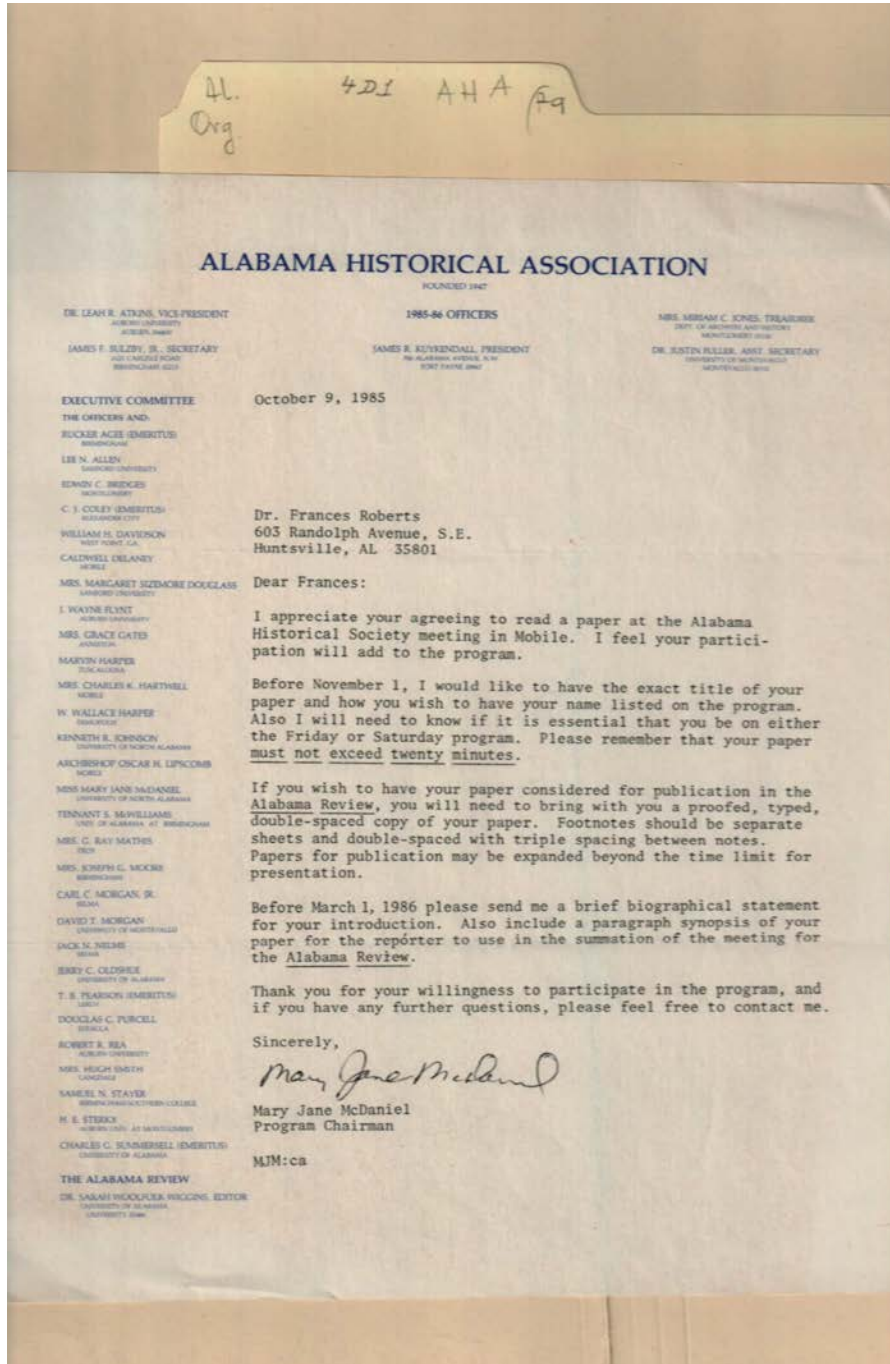
