Company when the colonists asked for military help against Indians. Says Capt. Pettus had served in the Low Countries under Sir Thomas Dale. ^{East Indies} Stanard says Sir Thomas Dale died in 1619, Stanard says Col. Pettus died after 1660. Was Member of the Council from 1641 till 1660.

In 1643 Col. Pettus was granted 500 acres of land for transportation of 10 persons, among them "Thomas Pettus jr." (Croz. vol. 6, p. 258). But in 1671 Thomas Pettus was a minor. "Thomas Pettus jr." died before Thomas the minor was born. In 1671 Nathaniel Bacon, Sr. was named "ffee" for Thomas Pettus, "orphan" by his mother to collect from the estate of Capt. John Grove (his stepfather) money due as hire of a negro woman. (McIlwaine's Min. of Gen. Court, p. 253). Col. Pettus left a will, but James City Co. records were destroyed in Richmond in 1865. In York records for 1698 there is a reference to "a difference between Mr. Edmund Berkeley and Maj. Lewis Burwell, only surviving executor of the will of Col. Thomas Pettus". Edmund Berkeley was Col. Pettus's daughter's stepson, and Maj. Burwell married the niece and heiress of Nathaniel Bacon. Bacons were related to Pettuses in England. (See appendix.) Nathaniel Bacon left a legacy (a negro girl named Moll) to "Miss Elizabeth Pettus of Littleton, daughter of Col. Thomas Pettus of the same place", if she "lives to be 21 or marries". (Valentine Papers p. 806) She did not marry. Died in 1700. In James City there is a power-of-attorney, dated 1701, to James Bray from "Mary Mann, of Abington Parish, Gloucester Co., executrix, by will of Elizabeth Pettus, daughter of Thomas Pettus, Gent., dec'd." (Valentine 806). Mary Pettus Berkeley Mann's will (Wm. & Mary Quar. vol. 6 of 2nd series, p. 138) names sister Ann and brother-in-law Philip Hunley. Philip and Ann Hunley had son Caleb, whose daughter Mary married Capt. William Davenport (1746-87). Their daughter Elizabeth Davenport, b. 1771, married John White Capt. Thomas Pettus, the minor of 1671, was a vestryman of Bruton Parish, James City Co. (Weade's "Churches and Families of Virginia"). A

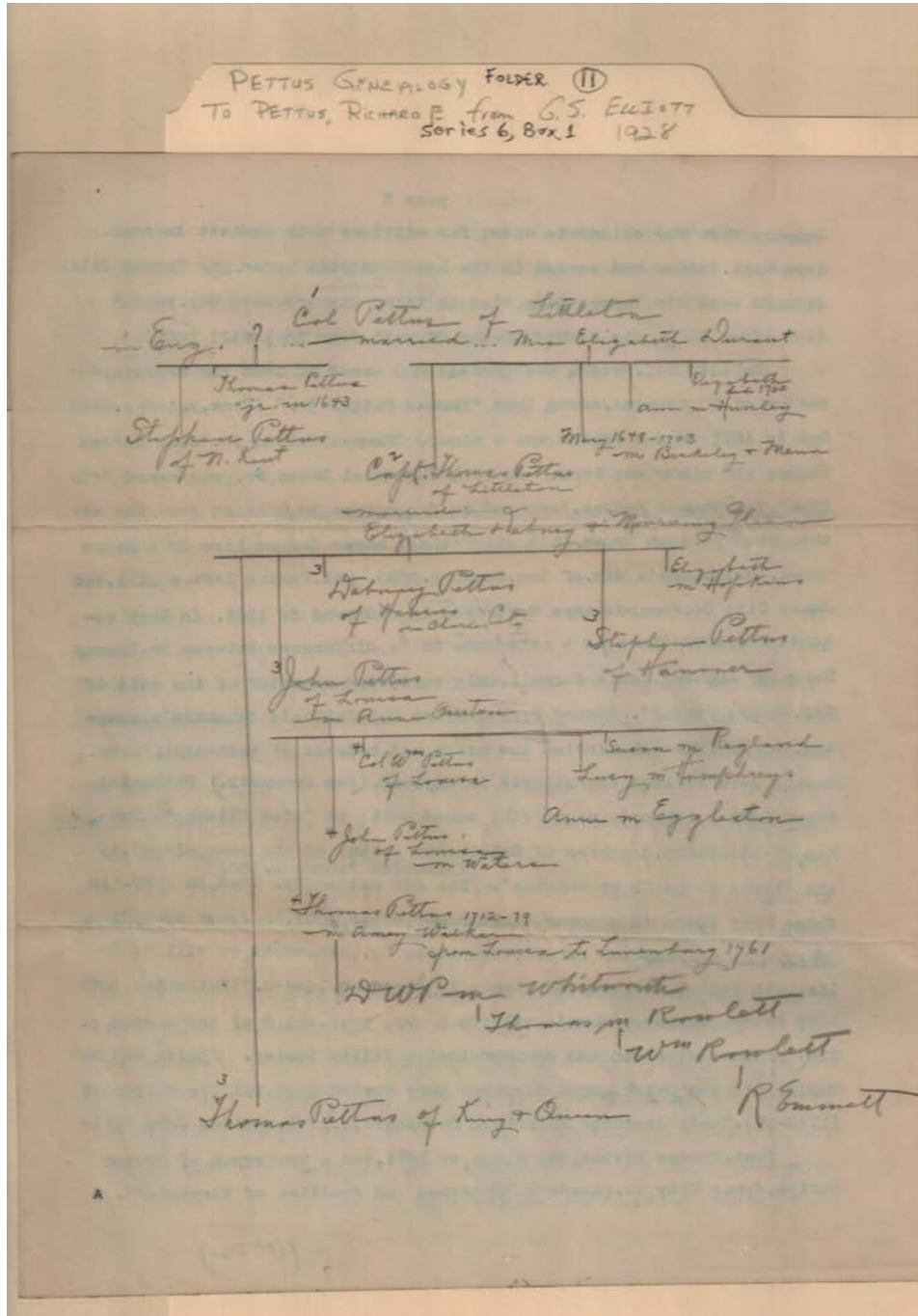

metal plate bearing his name is on a pew in old Bruton Church at Williamsburg. He married (some say in 1675) Elizabeth Dabney (see over) and after her death Mourning Glenn. Elizabeth is called the mother of his children. Records say Mourning Glenn Pettus Bray (married James Bray after Capt. Pettus's death) was "a tertor". (vol. 3, Va. His. Rec. p. 154) Children of Capt. Thomas and Elizabeth (Dabney) Pettus: Thomas, John, Dabney, Stephen, and Elizabeth. These will be given the number 3, 3rd generation in Virginia. Lineage will be in parenthesis, in reverse. For Dabney line see page 24. For Stephen, page 26.

²Elizabeth Pettus married, about 1723, Dr. Arthur Hopkins. Col. C. J. Colcock, a descendant of this marriage, collected Pettus and Hopkins data, and gave the writer much valuable assistance; much that is available & now was not known when Col. Colcock was working, 40 years ago. He was a zealous genealogist and pioneered in Pettus research, but his Pettus data is not as accurate as his Hopkins data. One of his authorities, Mrs. Eastham of Louisa Co., confused generations. And there were so many Thomases and Johns and Annes, it is wonderful that she got so much correct. She wrote me that what she knew of Pettuses she learned from her grandfather's widow while she was a child. But she gave us clues to work on. Col. Colcock's papers are in the library of the Virginia Historical Society, Richmond, as a loan (was told by the secretary) from Mr. Walter Lee Hopkins.

³Thomas Pettus (T., T.) tithed in King and Queen in 1705 (Crozier, vol. 6, p. 212). Was Clerk of "Lower Church", Blissland parish, New Kent, 1735-45. *(Blissland, Va. Register p. 27)* Possibly the Capt. Thomas Pettit, mentioned in Va. State Papers, vol. 1, p. 114, as being in King and Queen in 1707. And a Thomas Pettitt was justice in Hanover, 1714. (Bean's "Peoples of Virginia", p. 98). There were Pettits in Virginia. Also Pettises. And the names are often confused by copyists. Pettus often written Pettis where we know it was Pettus.
