9. PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION (Include Original & Present Condition)

The original building was a basement and three stories. A monumental type structure, the exterior is of limestone. The building was enlarged in 1940 by adding basement and first floor space at the rear of the building. In 1963, additional space was added to the basement and first floor by adding North and South wings to the rear of the building.

The first floor and basement are used by the Post Office Dept. The second and third floors are used by the U.S. Courts and the Justice Department for office and courtroom space. The courtroom was completely remodeled and new furnishings installed in 1968.

The building is air conditioned and modern in every respect and is in excellent condition. The building lobbies and hallways are marble floors and wainscoting, with mahogany woodwork, brass appointments, and delicate fretwork on the ceilings and walls.

10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (History, Personages, Events, Sources of information, etc.)

The Government purchased the site from private parties for \$6,000 with the deed executed on December 17, 1903. The Post Office was completed for occupancy on April 15, 1913. Barnes Brothers of Logansport were awarded the contract for \$112,177.76 and J.K. Taylor was serving as Supervising Architect, Treasury Department, during the time of construction.

Mr. Charles W. Moore was serving as Postmaster at the time the building was constructed. He was followed by M.W. Camper on February 12, 1915, Henry A. Cathey, January 22, 1923, Jesse G. Moore, August 27, 1931, Owen P. Anderson, June 1, 1936, Mrs. Mable J. Anderson, January 14, 1937, Albert W. Darby, January 11, 1938, and Donald Holt, April 30, 1953.

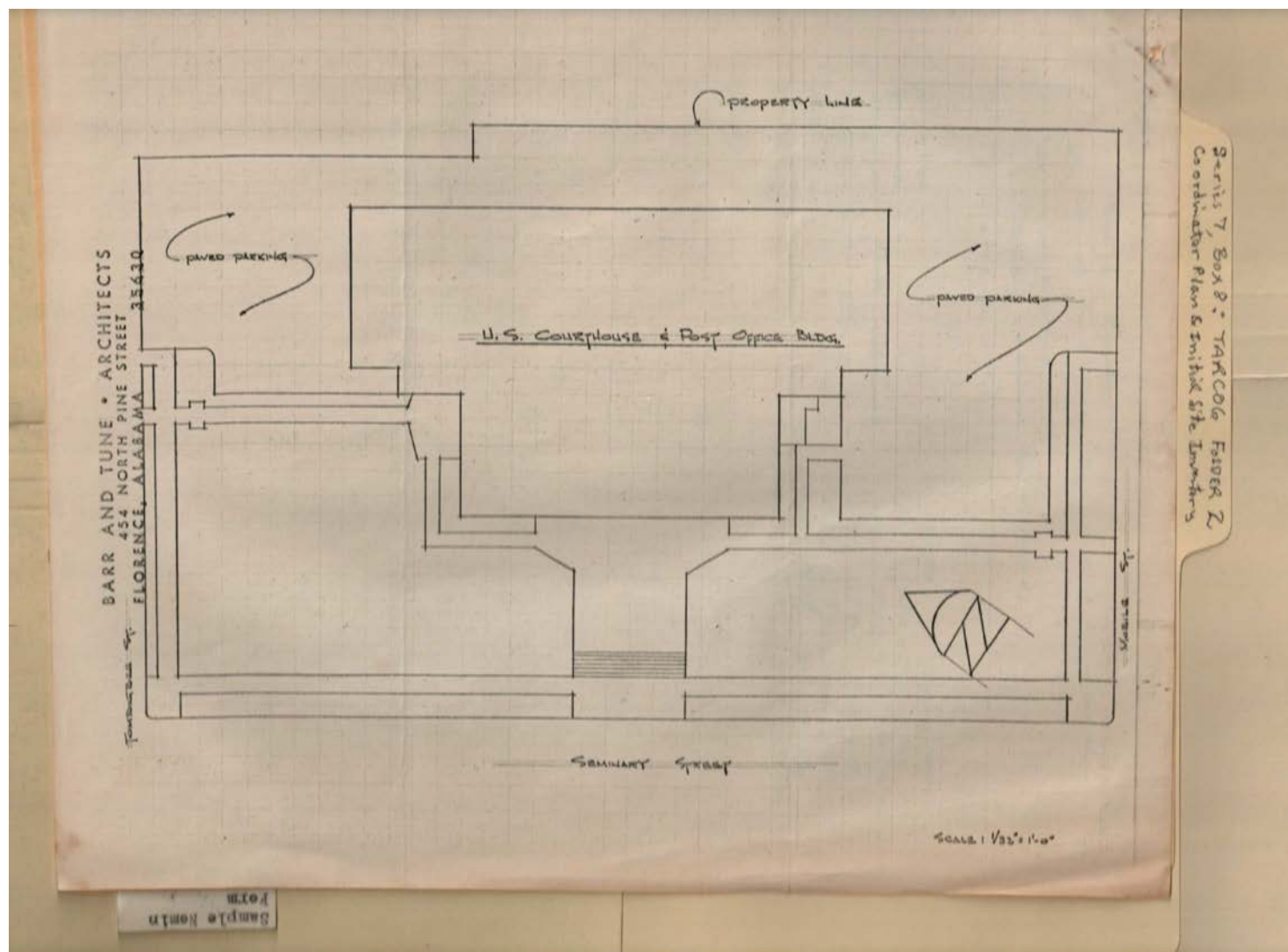
