Historical significance of site or structure if known These houses which are minor variations on the same basic design, appear to have been built by the same builder for the boom speculative market then existing in Bridgeport. The houses are said to have been designed by architect Stanford White, but this needs documentation since the design evidence makes it questionable. Regardless of the architect, the group forms an example of a row of 1890's luxury speculative housing. It should be considered for historic district status since it also is an important physical reminder of Bridgeport's beginnings.

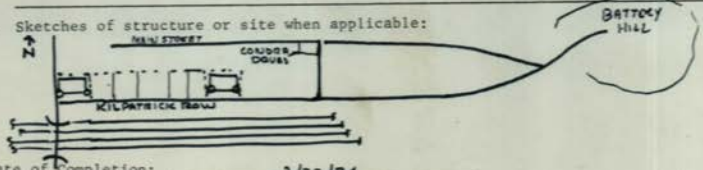

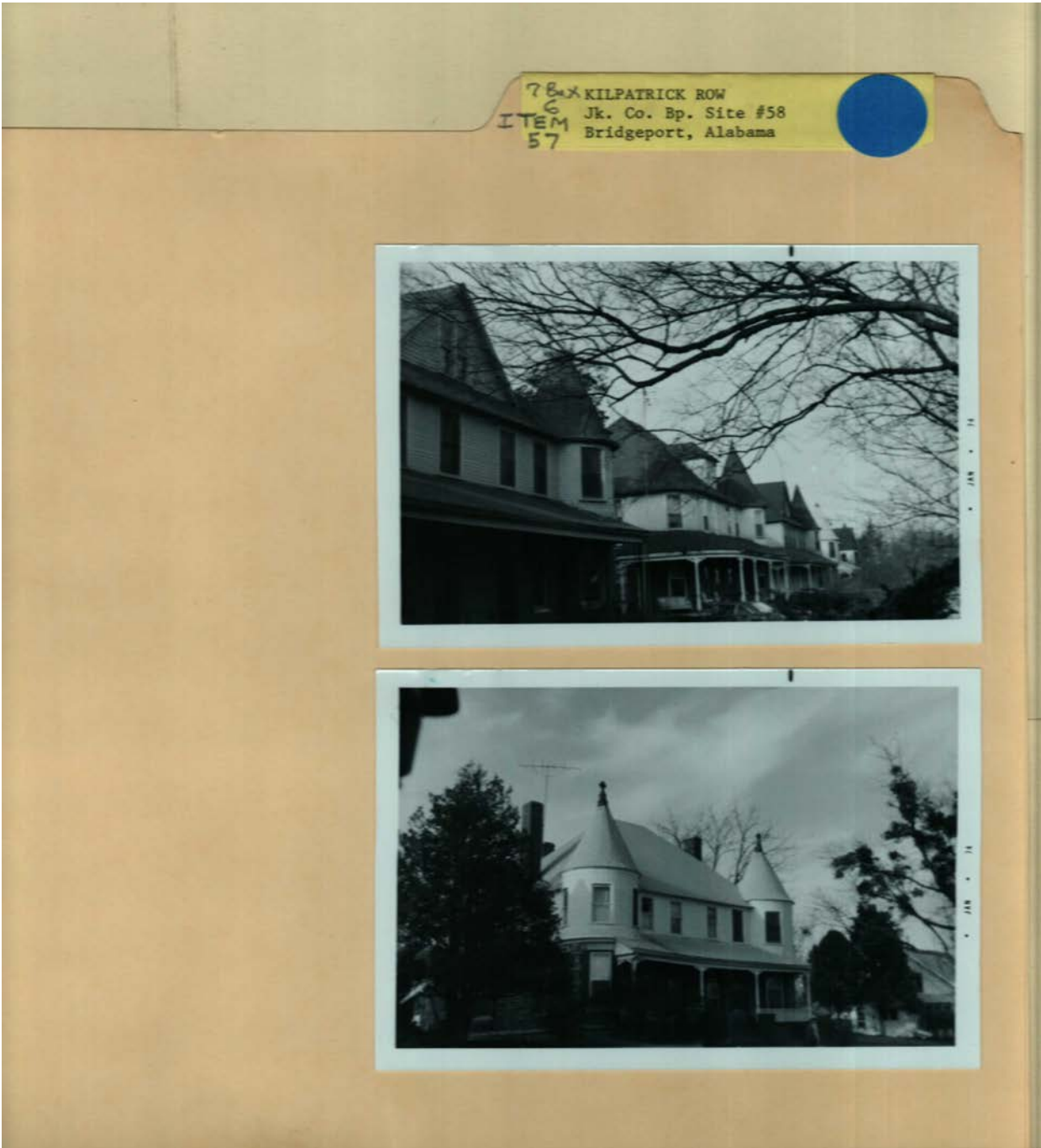
