8. Condition: Church has been rebuilt but chimney indicates much old structure was on site. Graveyard well kept and graves marked but not all identified.

9. Present Use: Church & graveyard.

10. Areas of Significance: Graveyard is burial place of Capt. Doran. Grave is marked by tombstone bearing the following data: Major James Doran, Oct. 28, 1890, age 76 yrs. Another grave has marker showing War 1812 veteran - Boulton, Born 6/16/1778, died 1844. Site also contains Russell family: Lynn Y. Russell, wife of Maj. Russell died 3/12/1893 age 92 years.

11. Architectural Description: Church structure is modern but has a brick chimney that appears to date around mid or late 19th cent. Church is simple construction, rect. shaped of painted lumber with concrete block foundation curtain.
