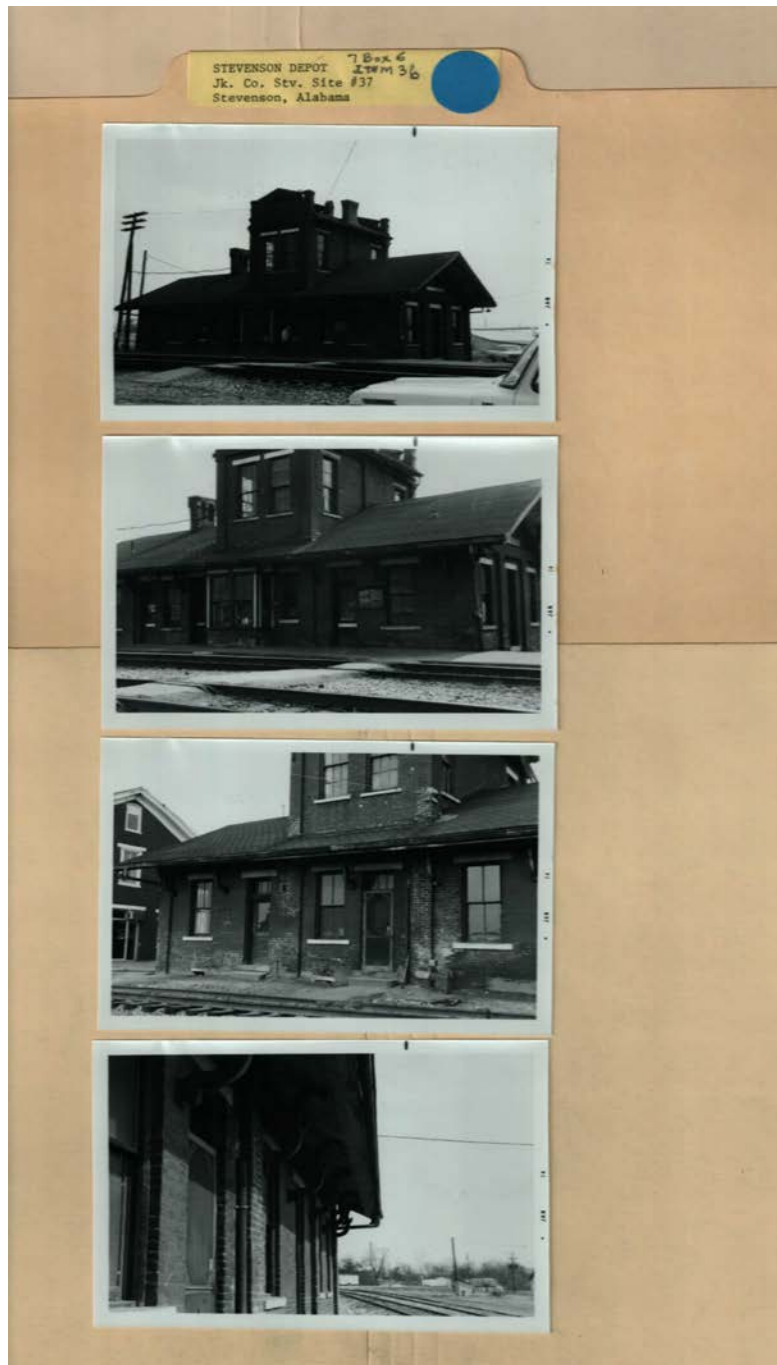

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This old depot is one of a very few of it's period left standing in the United States today. It was the site of much Civil War activity by both the Federal and Confederate Troops. It is a mid-19th Century brick, one-story structure with a 2nd floor tower room. It was pictured in Harper's Weekly in 1862.
