

Cotton and other products were hauled to the old landing, put on flatboats and taken to market in Mobile, New Orleans, etc. The road is unusually wide (about 30') showing that there was much traffic. There was room enough for at least 3 wagons, if not 4, at a time: The old road boad is very visible today.
