STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

John Snodgrass, the builder of this house, was one of the earliest settlers in Jackson County(1) and was prominent in the early affairs of the county. This house, according to architectural *Review* ~~survey~~, is believed to have been built between 1820 and 1840. It is a two-story ante-bellum type, with a cellar that is purported to have been a "slave pit". The cellar has a fireplace ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ which indicates that it may have been used as sleeping quarters.

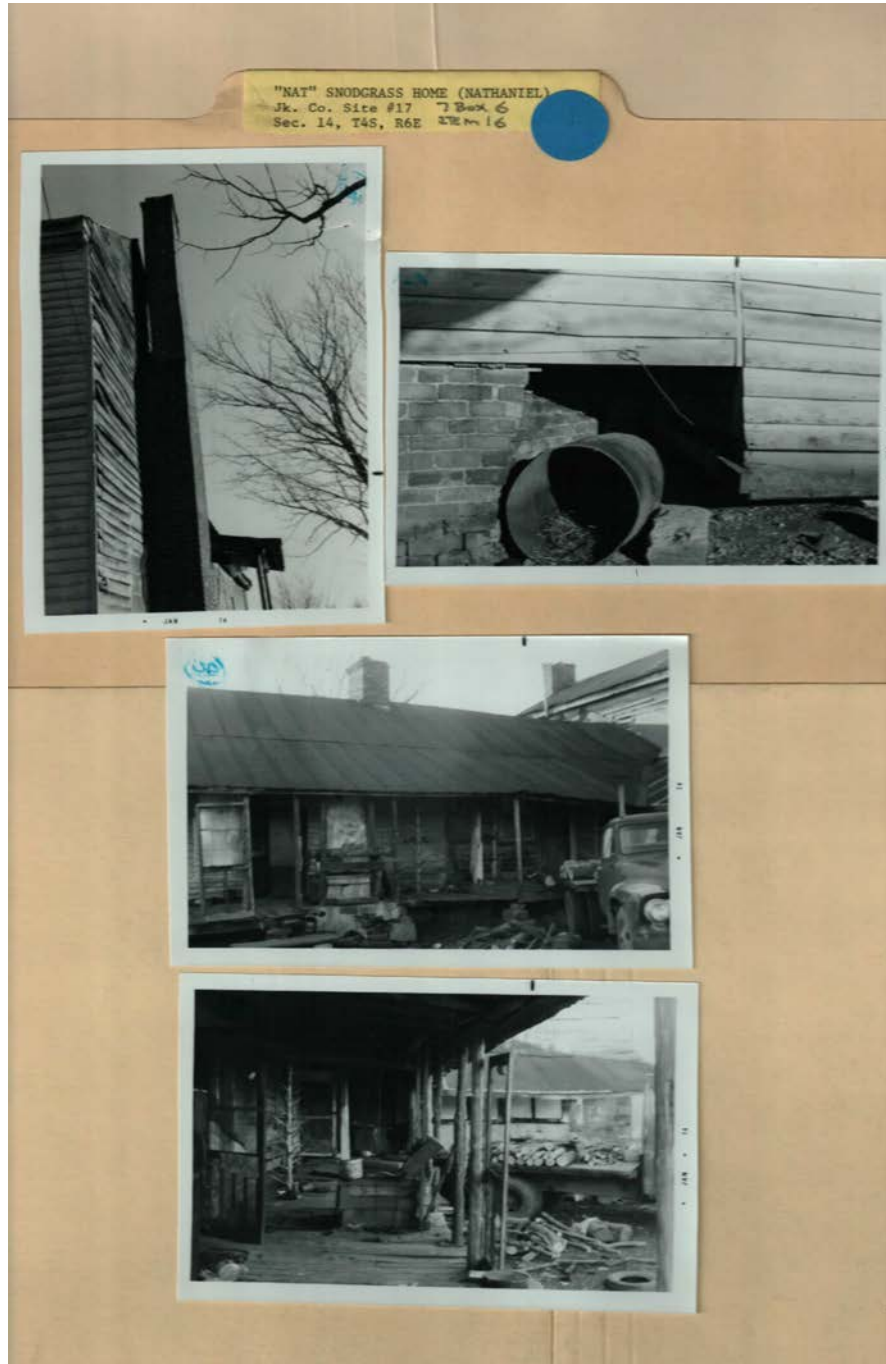
