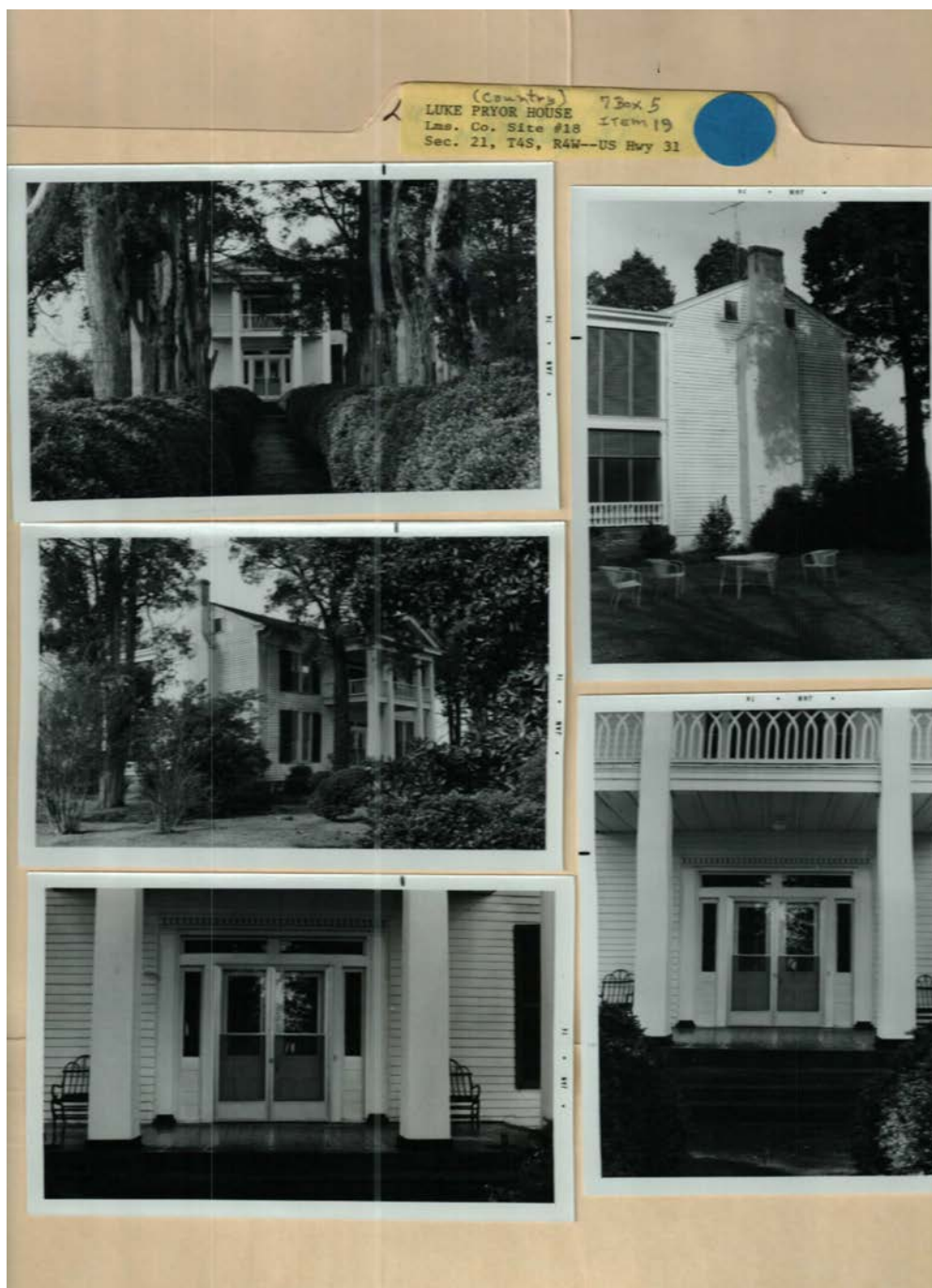

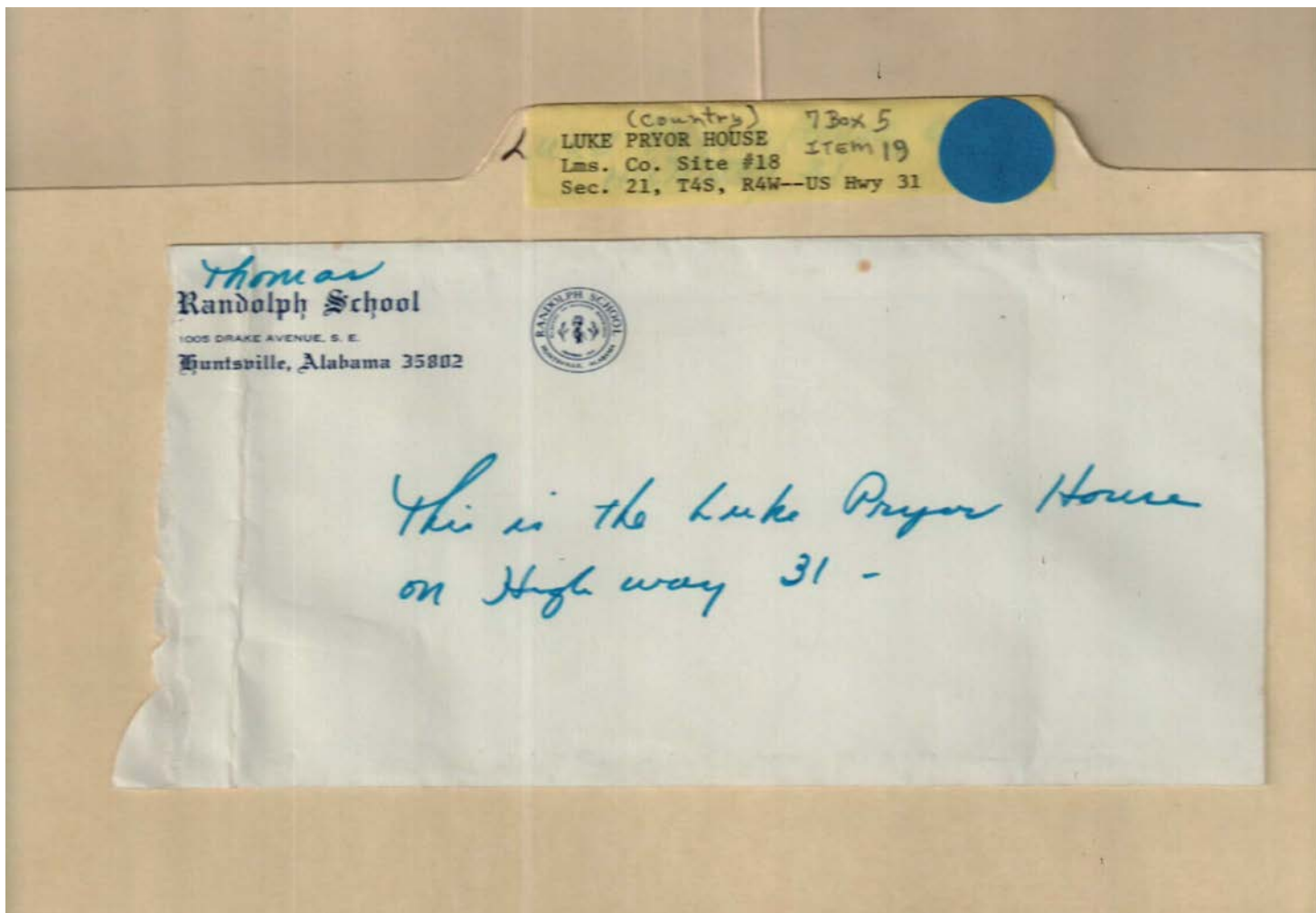

arrangement. Two-story box columns with
balcony inset. Porch has design in Federal
with some Greek Revival trim, & portico -
design "backs to yellow" even though it is
transitional - dentil work over portico -
leaded glass panes in double front door, on
door & down sides. 4 square columns -
porch is stone high. Georgia boxwood
down front walk.
