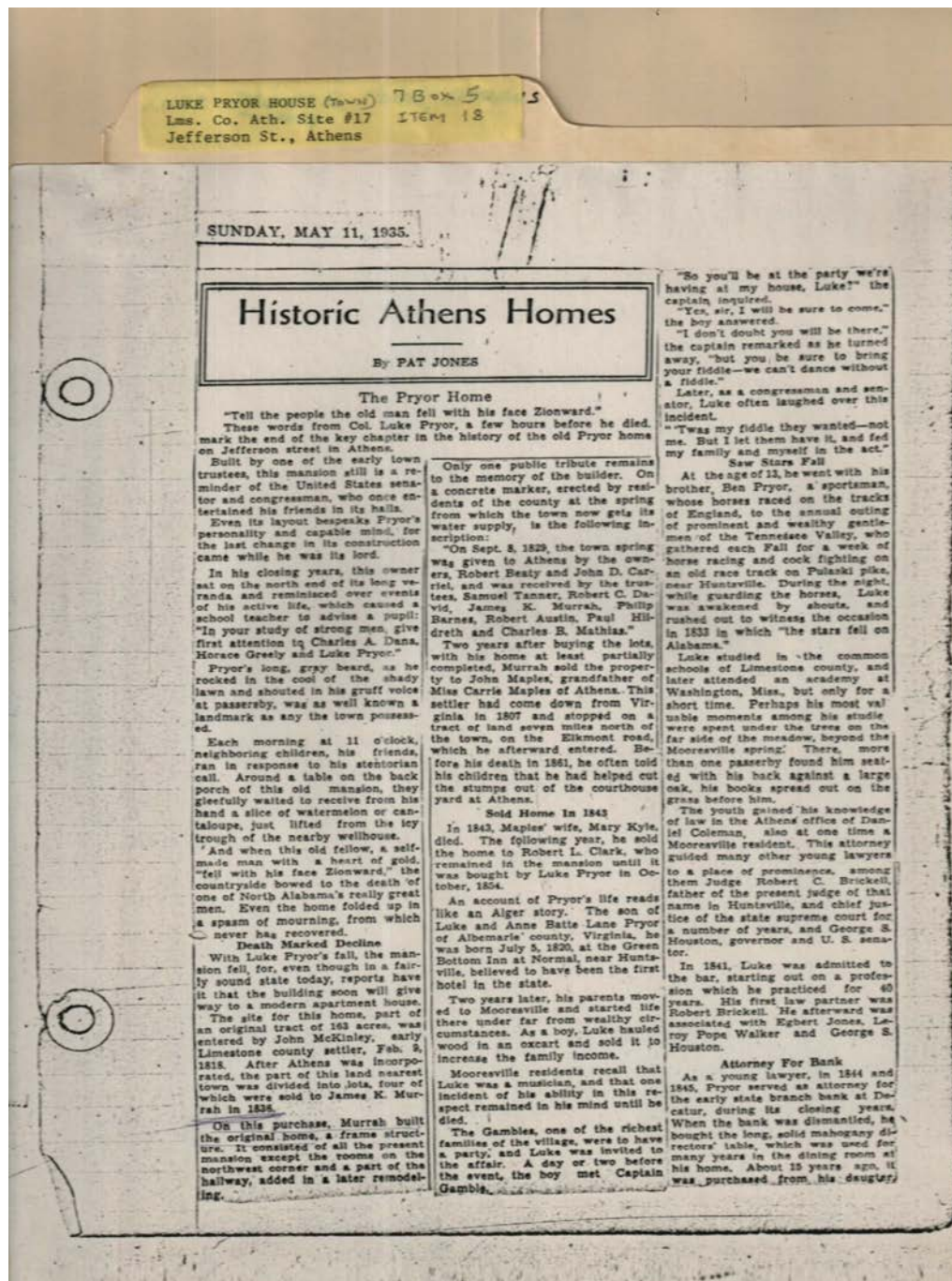

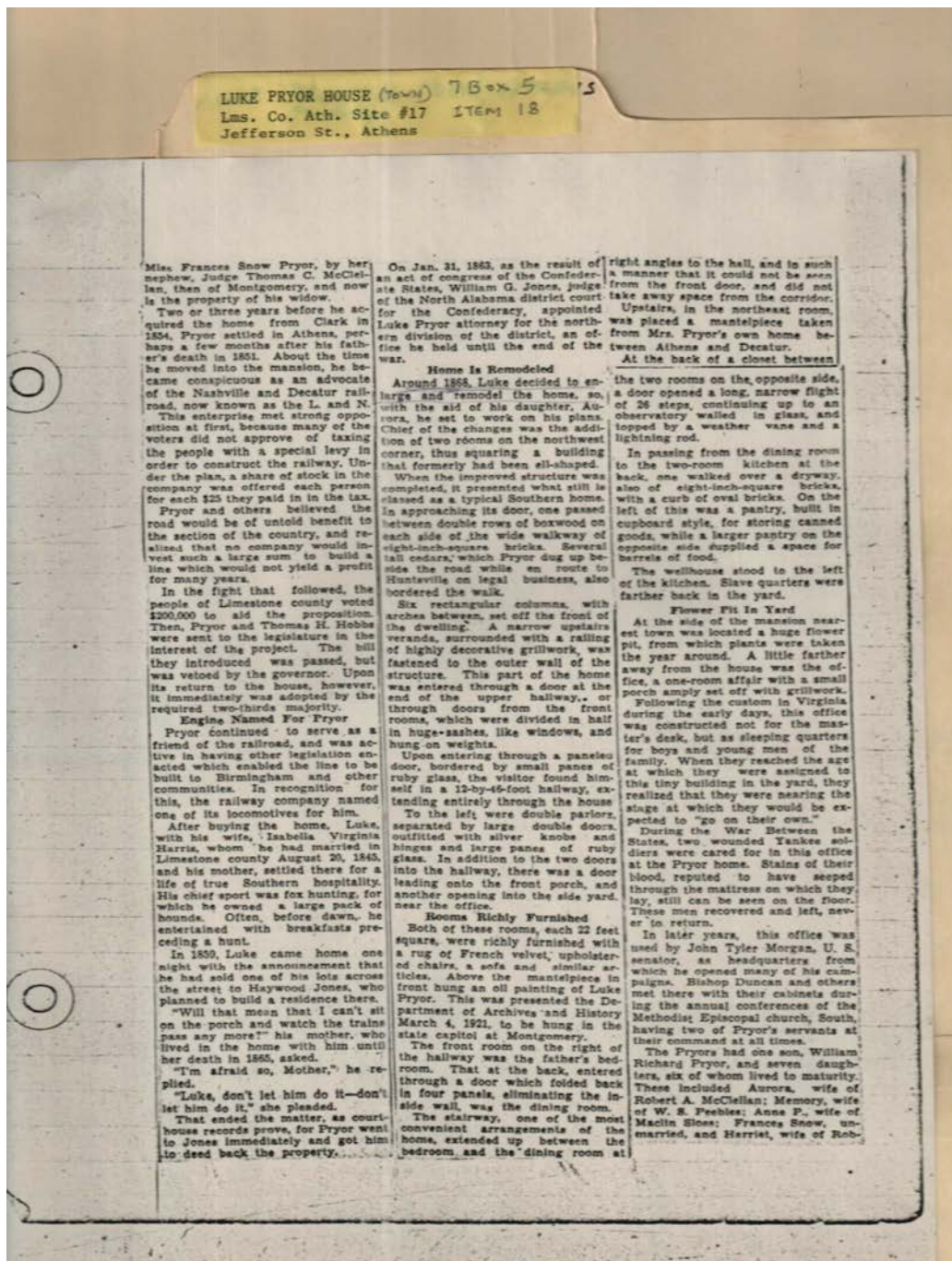

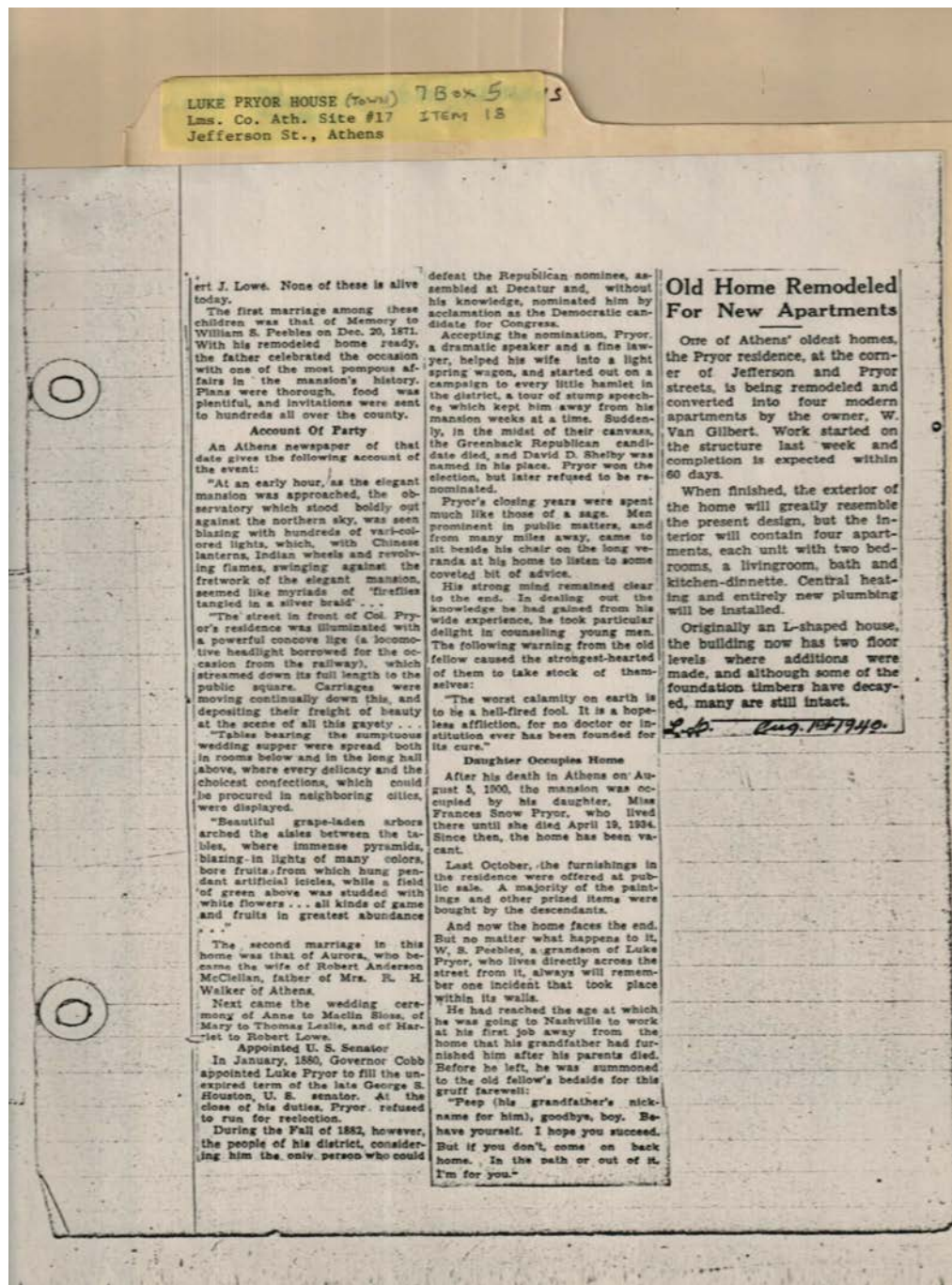

on July 5, 1822 at the Green Bottom farm
at Normal, near H. Miller. Two years later
his parents moved to Mississippi. In
1841 he was admitted to the bar. From
1844-45 served as attorney for the early
state branch bank in Waco, Tex. He served
as Senator and Congressman. In Jan. 1880
Gov. Cobb appointed Luke Pryor to fill the
unexpired term of Sen. George Houston.
He was nominated for Congress in 1882.*
