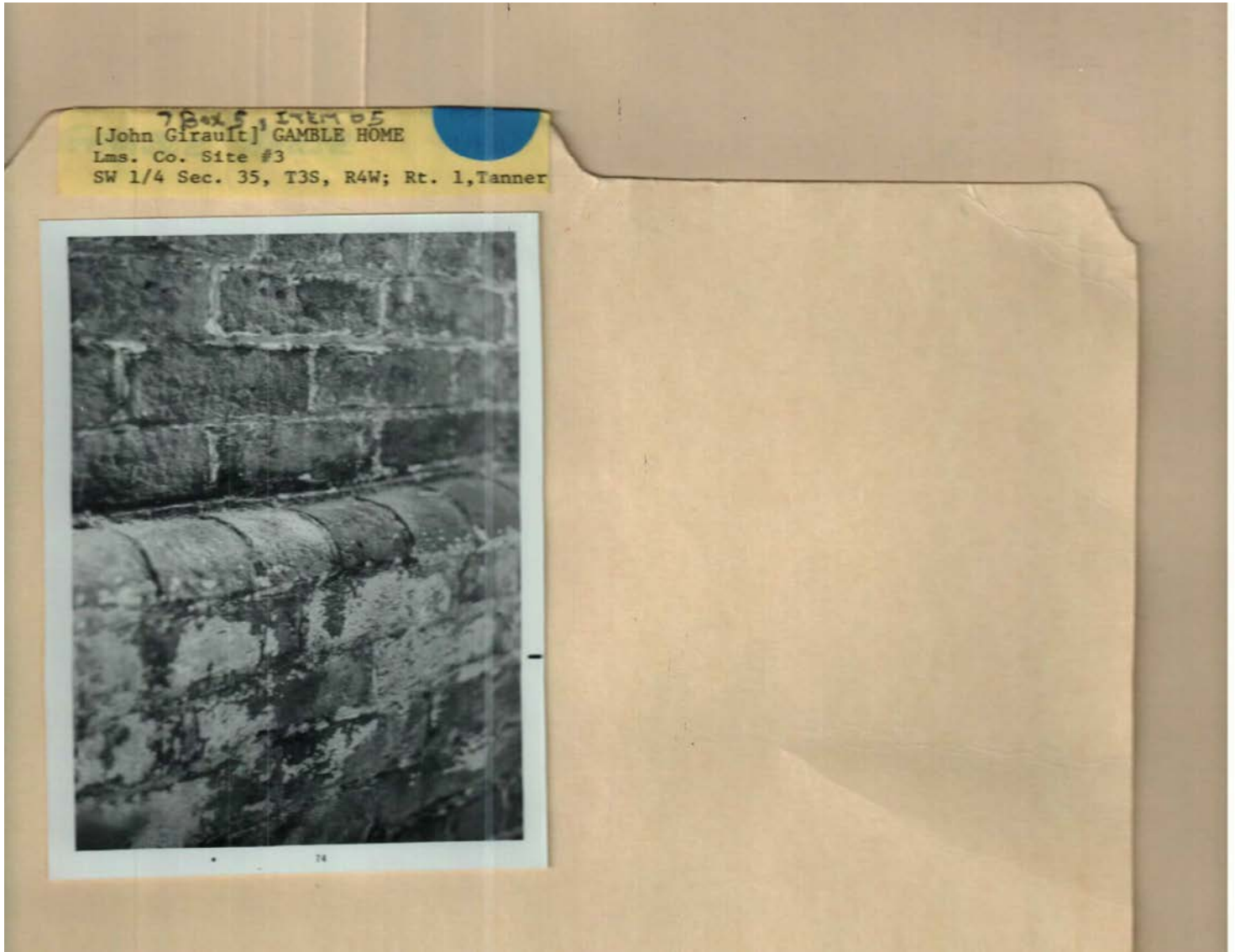

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE
This house, although the exact date of erection is unknown, was probably built in the 1830s. The abstract, in the possession of the family, reveals that a Joseph Johnson patented the land (southwest quarter of Sec. 35, T.3, R.4 W) in 1818. In 1837 he sold it to James M. Lane for \$10,000. This sum would indicate a house of considerable means stood on the land. In 1848 James Lane married Eliza Peete, whose family was one of the first to settle in Limestone County. After his death in 1874 and her death a few years later there were several years of litigation concerning their wills. The final settlement did not come until November 1, 1887. Lots were drawn as to which heir would receive what property, as there were about 3,000 acres involved. Cammilla Peete drew Lot 7, which was the southwest section of Sec. 35 T3 R4W. This was the section upon which the house stood. She, in turn, deeded it to Kate Garrett Gamble in 1897. In 1900 the land was deed by Kate Gamble to her two children: the present owner, John G. Gamble, and his sister, Kate Gamble Brawley, along with other considerations. In 1920 the two heirs divided the property and the present owner came into possession of the land upon which the house stands.

<p>DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE</p> <p>Based on the architect's review of this house it has some outstanding features. One is the brick cornices (one in Mooresville is only other know to reviewer). It has separate entry doors, which is another unusual feature to this area. There are two rooms upstairs and two down in the original part of the house. There are two separate stairs to the upstairs area. They are enclosed and there is no entry between the two upstairs rooms. In the downstairs area there is a door between the two rooms. The attic windows are 19th century additions. Originally these openings were louvered. Originally there was no porch on the house. The mantels are Adam type and the trim is Federal. The ceilings are board plus exposed beaded joists on the second floor. The chimneys have two sets of hips, this is also most unusual. The house is built of handmade brick and according to research and owner was built circa 1830. The windows are small 18 feet, and the downstairs walls have a chair rail. There has been an additional el to the back. Although the house has been closed for some time, the owners live in a modern house at the entrance to the place, it has been kept in good order. Some of the heavier pieces of the family furniture remain in the house.</p>

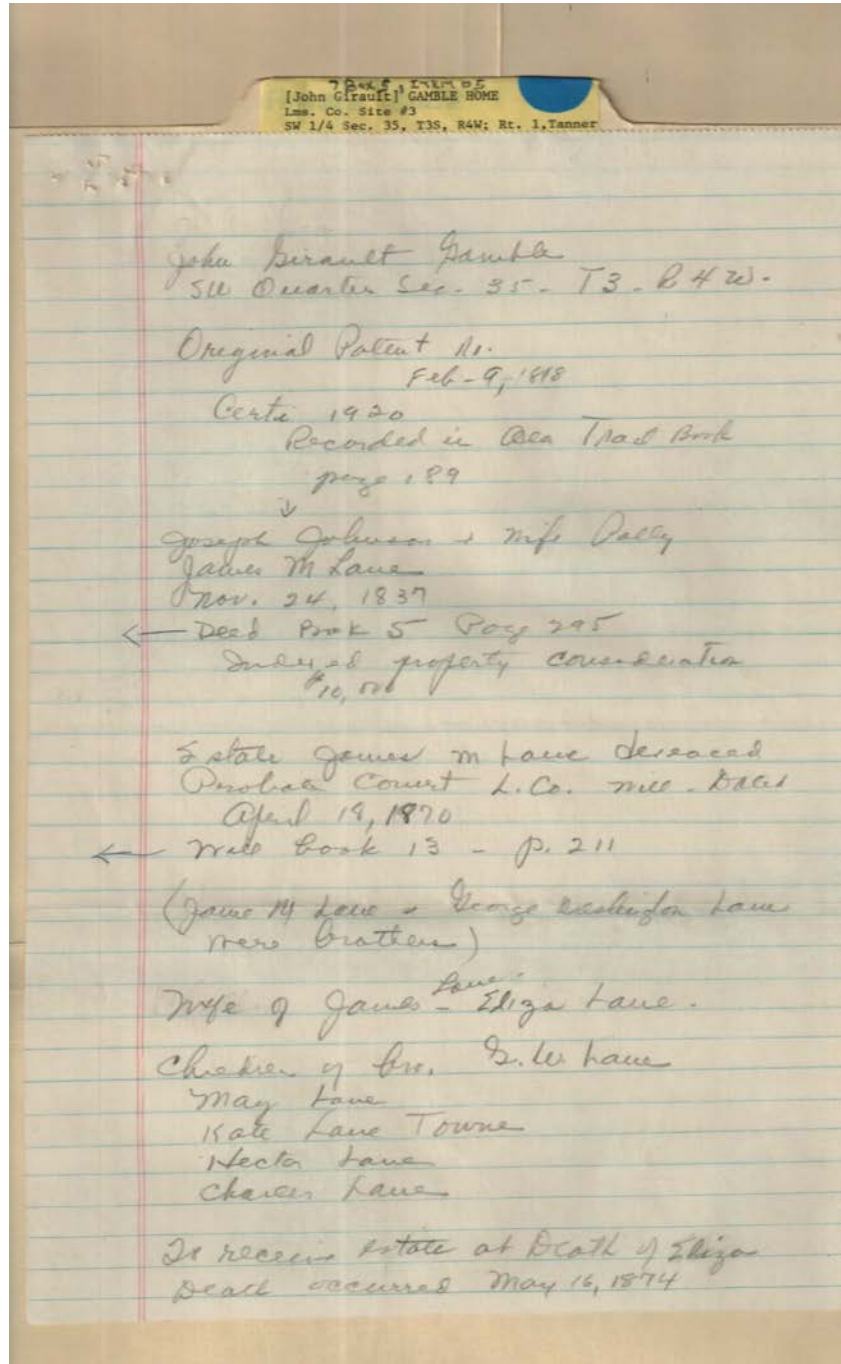

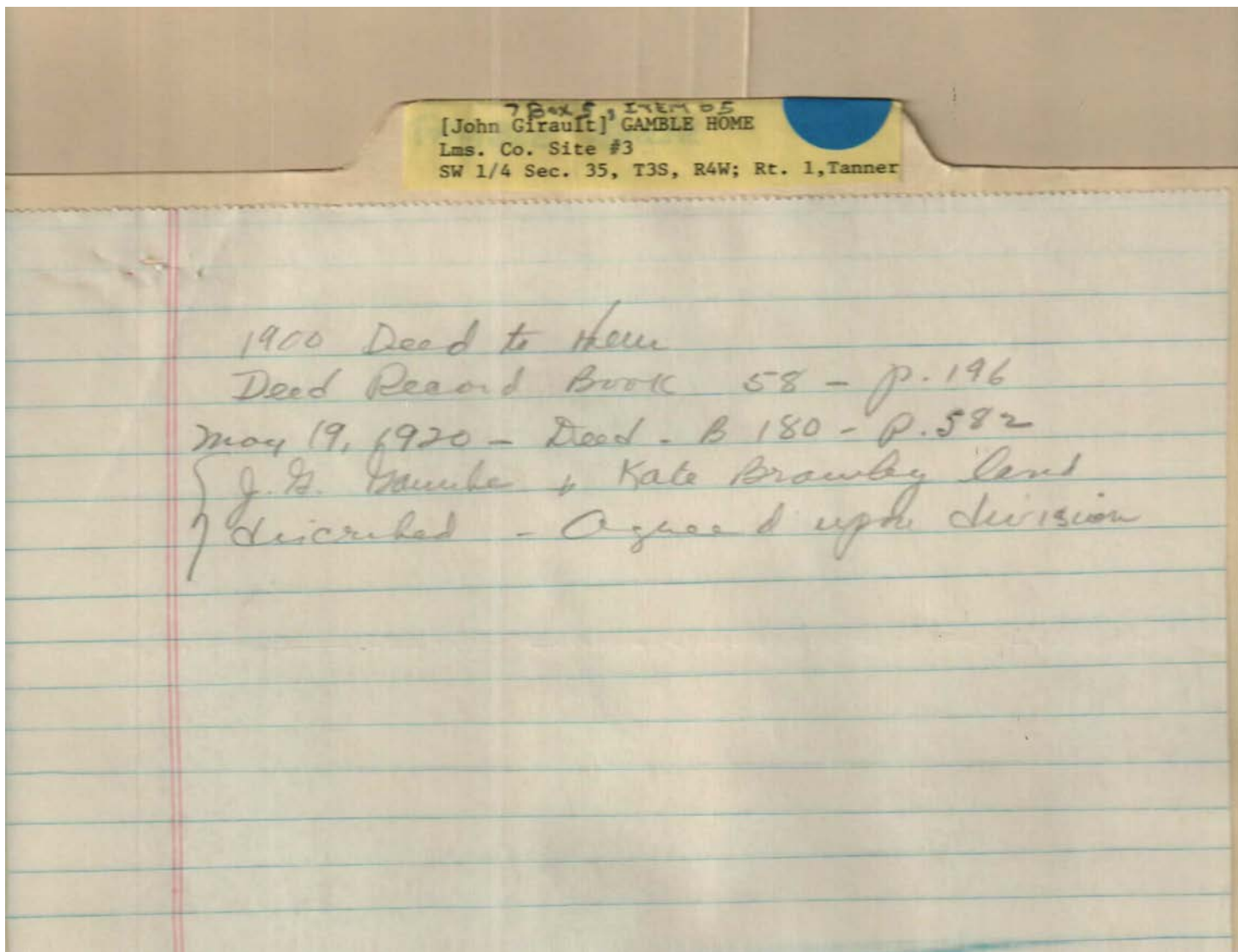
