4. Historical significance of site or structure if known This home was erected by a leading physician, Dr. P. B. Lusk, of the Lusk family, who lived here for 35 years, and from 1930 to 1971, was occupied by another prominent physician - Dr. P. B. Lusk, & Dr. W. H. Huckaby. This structure has been nominated to the National Register of Historic Places.
