STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The office was constructed in 1895 by E. M. Wallen and Company of New Decatur, Alabama. It was immediately occupied by law firm of John A. Lusk and Robert N. Bell, who purchased lot and erected the building--Mr. Lusk was sole occupant from 1900 and sole owner from 1905--Mr. Lusk practiced law in Guntersville from 1883 to 1939. M. F. Lusk became partner with his father in 1935, and was joined by his son, Louis B. Lusk in 1957.-

John A. Lusk served as solicitor of 9th Judicial Circuit, 1885-1894, was elected to State Legislature in 1902; was appointed Associate Railroad Commissioner in 1908; was elected to State Senate in 1907 and again in 1915--Member of Alabama Code Committee in 1907. He was esteemed as a member of the Bar, and in public and private life.

11. Architectural Description: This is an example of the commercial use of Richardson Romanesque. The building is made of brick and rusticated limestone and contains the only walk-in vault, beside those in local banks, in the town. Doors, windows and trim of oak, and many of the finials in carved oak look as if made to order in 1895. The rooms consist of library, three office rooms and large reception area. Built on a slight rise, it is entered from a flight of stone steps.


