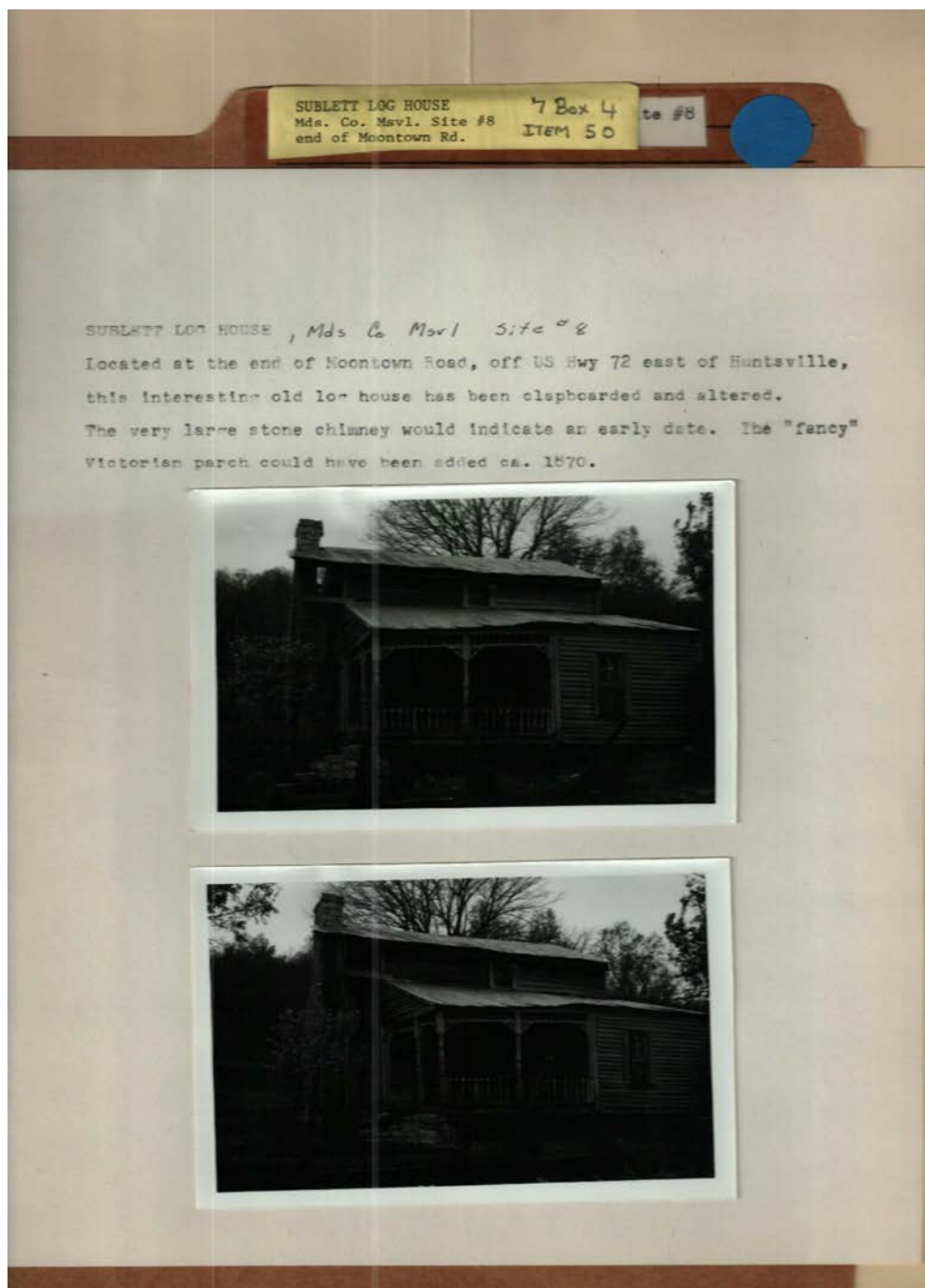

Once the county was ~~covered~~^{settled} with housing this type;
~~now very few~~^{comparatively} remain. Most gone, most gone, log houses are
an important part of the architectural and historical
heritage of Madison County - in order to be preserved
some of them must be recognized formally.

They were typical housing of the small ~~to~~^{small} homestead
in the nineteenth and early twentieth century. Many of them
were still in existence and in use in the first half of
the twentieth century. Unfortunately, historically and
aesthetically, they have been replaced with modern housing
