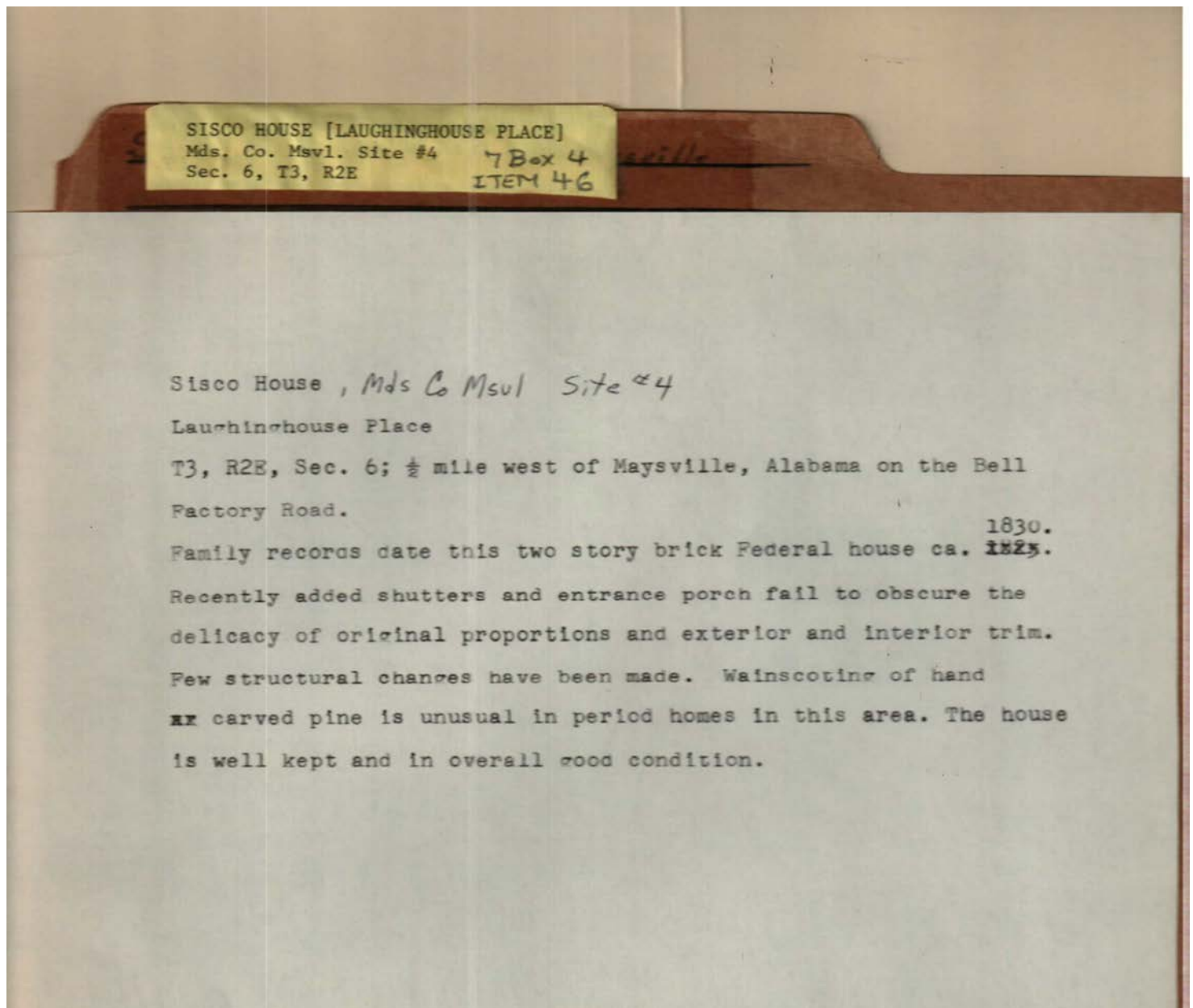

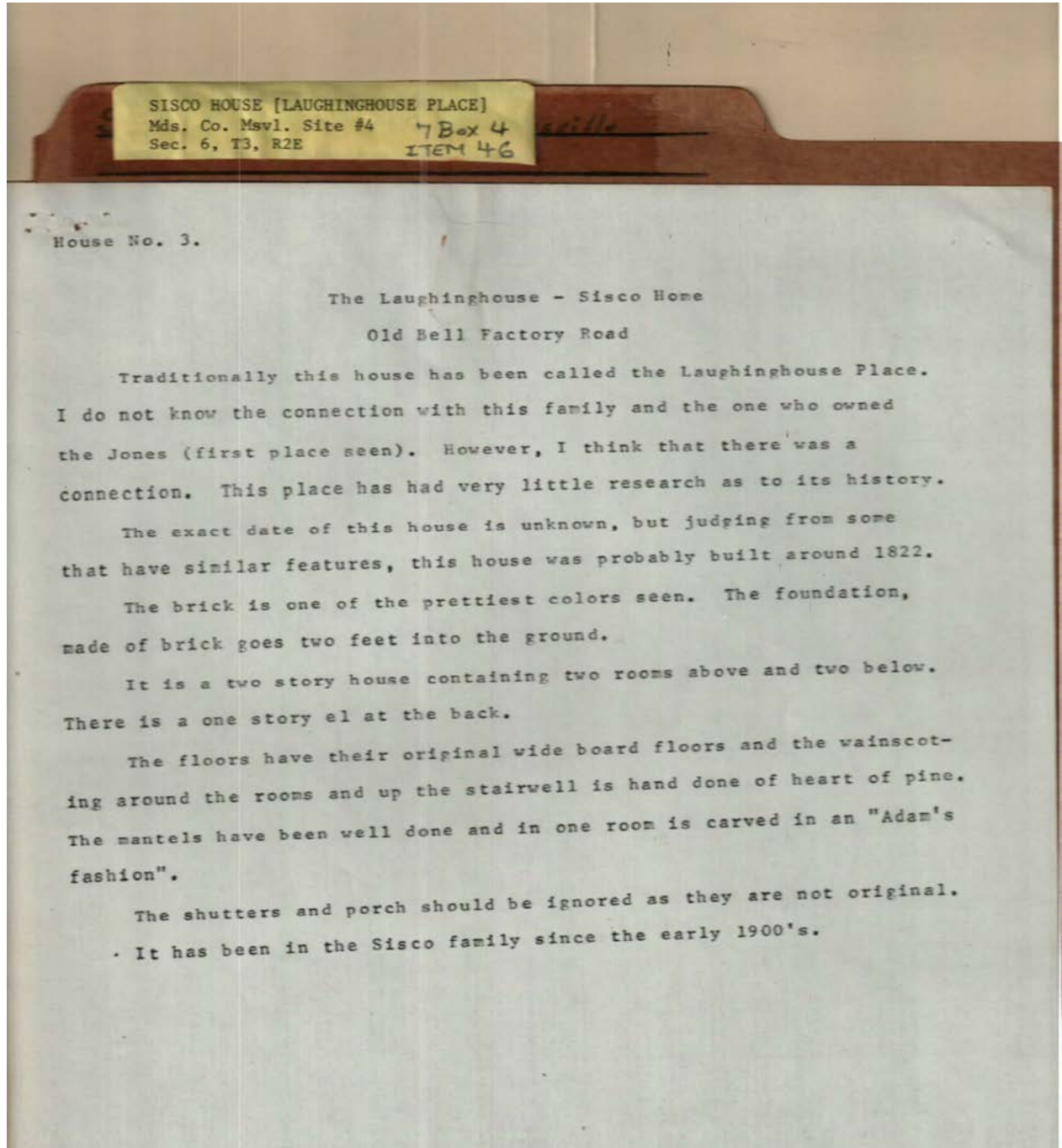

Rafters are 4"x4" yellow poplar. Original floors are wide pine.
Tradition says "niggers" waded up the road and burnt the
bricks "by alternating layers of logs and wet bricks."
Kitchen, den, bath added. Shutters changed. Windows changed.
Double front doors, louvered paneled. Reped-carved trim
Plain staircase - Gk Rev trim
