

In the very early Victorian era xxix the original two story section of this ca. 1814 house was rebuilt in its present plan, essentially 12 story. An ell at the rear, constructed ca. 1820, remains untouched in its original state. A 1970 renovation replaced the old kitchen with a "keeping" room, in keeping with the rest of the house. The property is still in the hands of the McCrary family for whom Thos. Freeman patented the land in 1809.
