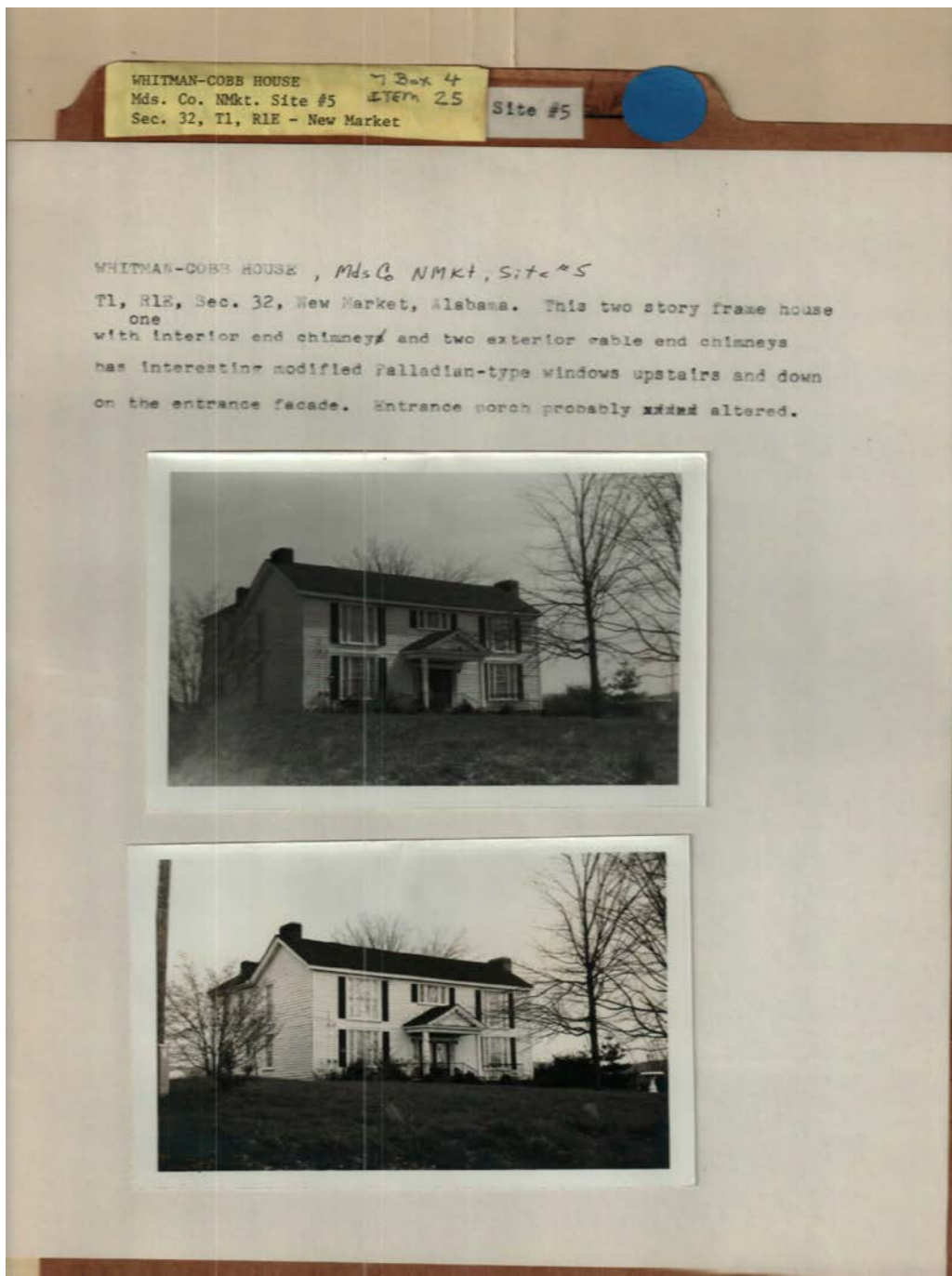

Amusingly "Empire" wooden mantel; GK Por baseboards - oddly turned balusters, old newel; roded GK Por woodwork unusual "under stair" treatment
