D. Statement of Significance: Isiah Moore, lawyer, signer of Ordinance, gov of Ala. & U.S. Senator.  
Born Stokes County, N.C. ca. 1785, d. June 9, 1845 at Castle, Tenn.  
Mr. & Mrs. Collier of Washington County. Began law practice in 1810  
in Nashville. Repeal legislation of Dec. 2nd of 1817 repealing the 1st  
Ala. Constitution by. Member of Const. Conv of 1819, presided over that  
body in 1820, elected to Congress in 1822, serving till 1829. Elected  
Governor without opposition. After beginning of construction of Muscle Shoals  
canal and Mr. James Tarleton to Acworth, also brought about the  
 treaty of moving Rabbit Creek where the Choctaws called their lands  
in Ala. & this he did good. On March 3, 1831 Moore resigned to take  
 seat in U.S. Senate. He departed in 1837 by New River, Chapman  
 moved to Texas in 1843 and died there 1846.
