Nancy,

I reviewed the Affidavits of Applicants For Family Supplies and haven't been able to connect them with the Freedmens Bureau, which didn't begin operations in Northern Alabama until August, 1865, nor with a State of Alabama entity. In the latter case I rule them out because they include a "loyal to the U.S.Government" clause, and it seems to me that the state government would not have been able to institute such a program so shortly after the last Confederate forces surrendered on May 4, 1865.

It's possible that they were issued by a special agency of the the U.S. Treasury Department, one whose functions was to "licensed trading with insurrectionary states." There was an office in Huntsville (the First Special Agency) and records of that office are in the National Archives, Record Group 366.2, 1861-66, 23 lin.ft. (I don't know if the Atlanta branch of the National Archives holds these records.)

If you have a contact in D.C. maybe he or she would be willing to research the records for you.

I searched HeritageQuest census records for the person who signed the forms, June P.(or A.) Wentz, but came up empty. I also looked up some, but not all, of the applicants. Some were listed in Madison County in 1860 or 1870.

Levi Jones is listed in Jackson County. He crossed out the part of the affidavit that dealt with the "loyalty oath" but apparently still received approval!

I'll keep looking.

Established: In the Department of the Treasury, under authority of an act of July 13, 1861 (12 Stat. 257), as amended, permitting licensed trading with insurrectionary states.

Functions: Supervised trade and commerce in areas of the Confederacy occupied by U.S. forces. Under acts of July 17, 1862 (12 Stat. 589), March 2, 1863 (12 Stat. 820), and July 2, 1864 (13 Stat. 375), **received and collected abandoned, captured, and confiscable property.** Under Treasury Department regulations of July 29, 1864, established "freedmen's home colonies" to provide employment and welfare assistance to freed slaves. Restrictions on commerce east of the Mississippi River lifted by Presidential directive, June 13, 1865. Treasury enforcement of regulations concerning captured and abandoned property curtailed, June 27, 1865.

Successor Agencies: Division of Restricted Commercial Intercourse and Abandoned and Confiscated Property, Office of the Commissioner of Customs, Treasury Department; Bureau of Refugees, Freedmen, and Abandoned Lands, War Department (1865-72).

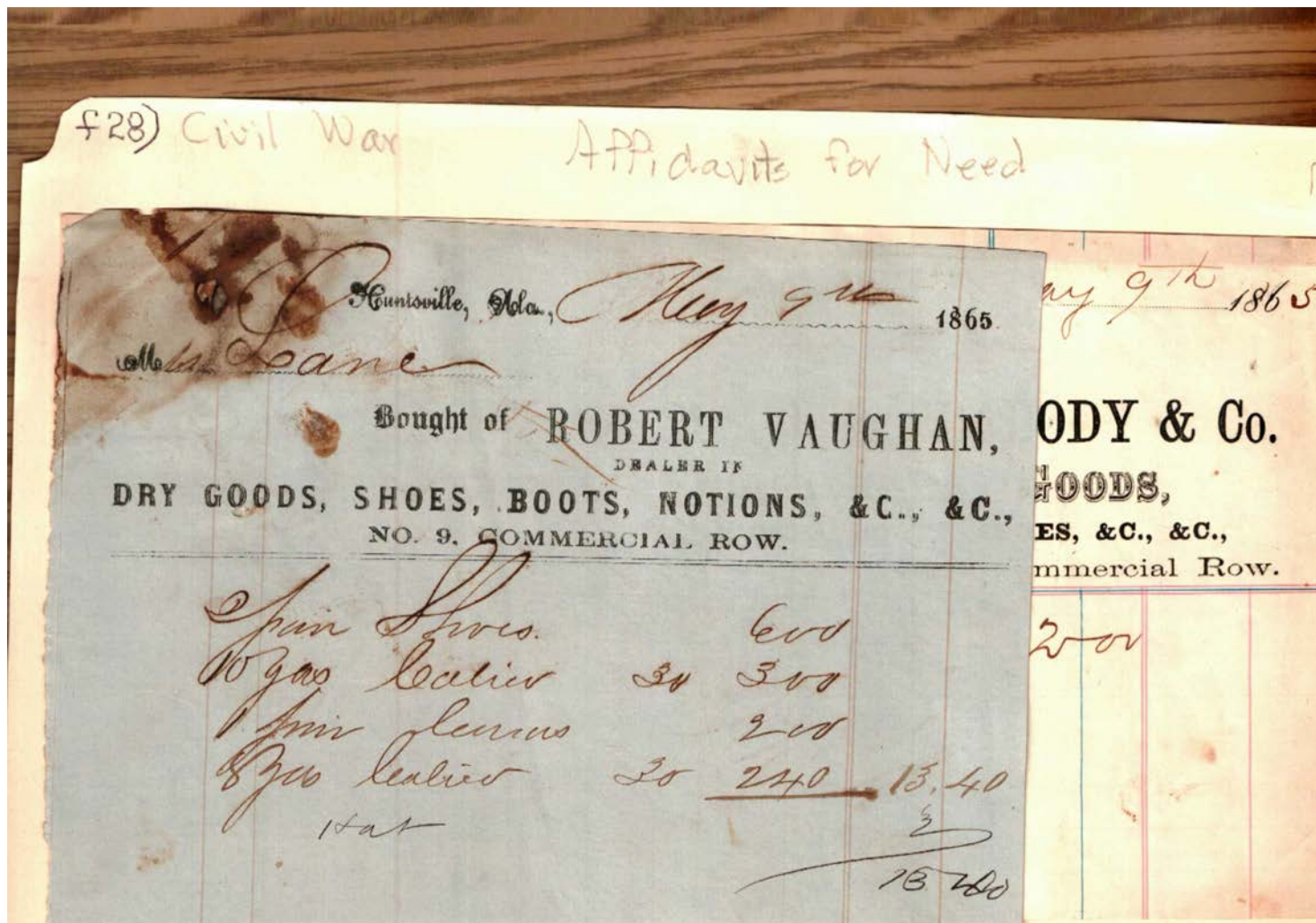

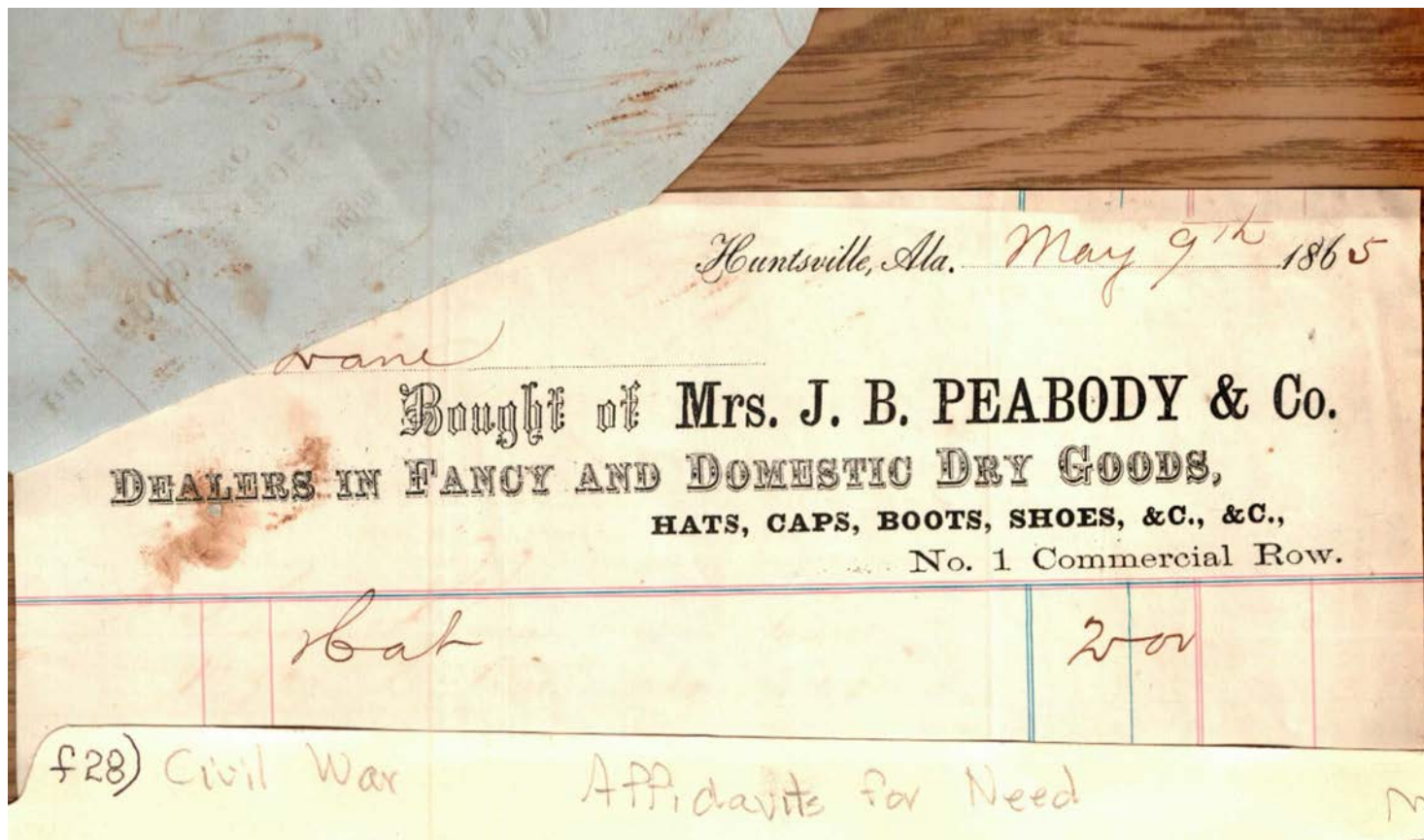
