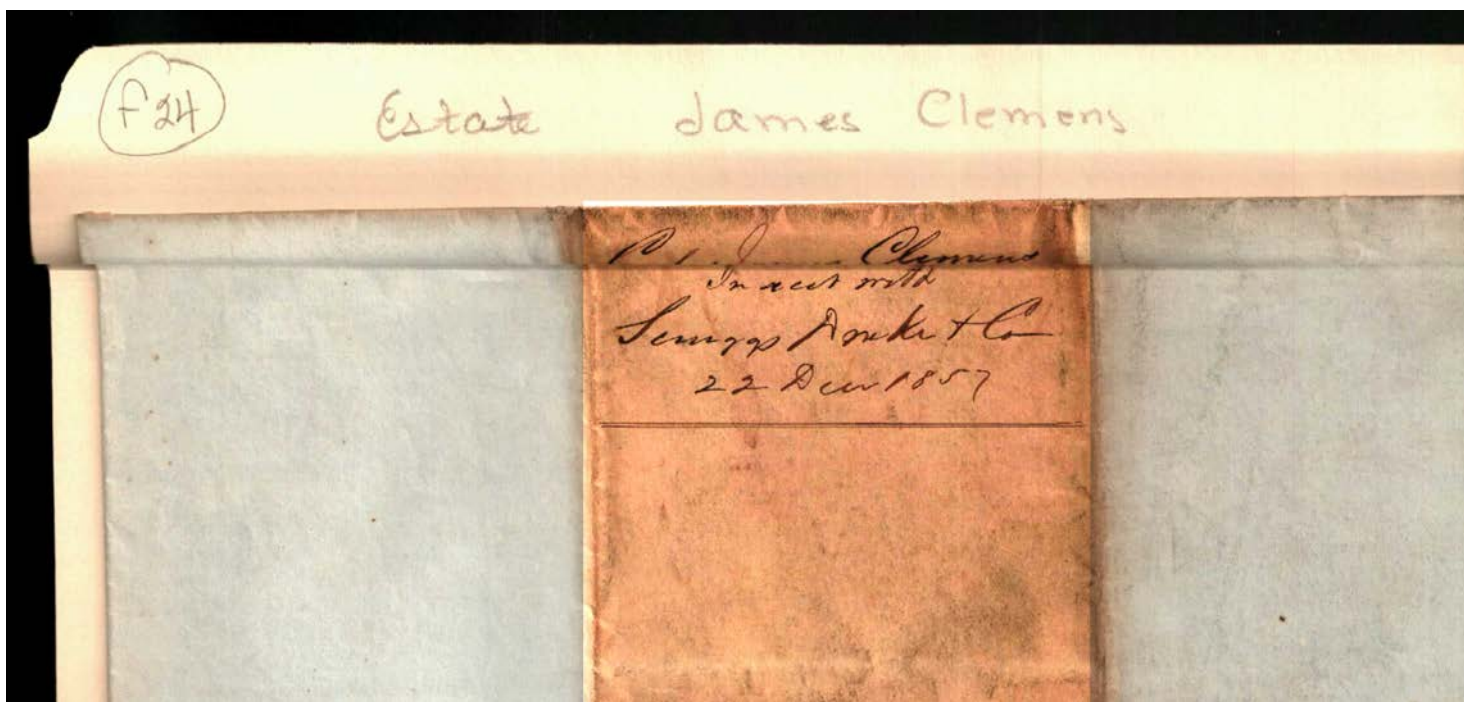

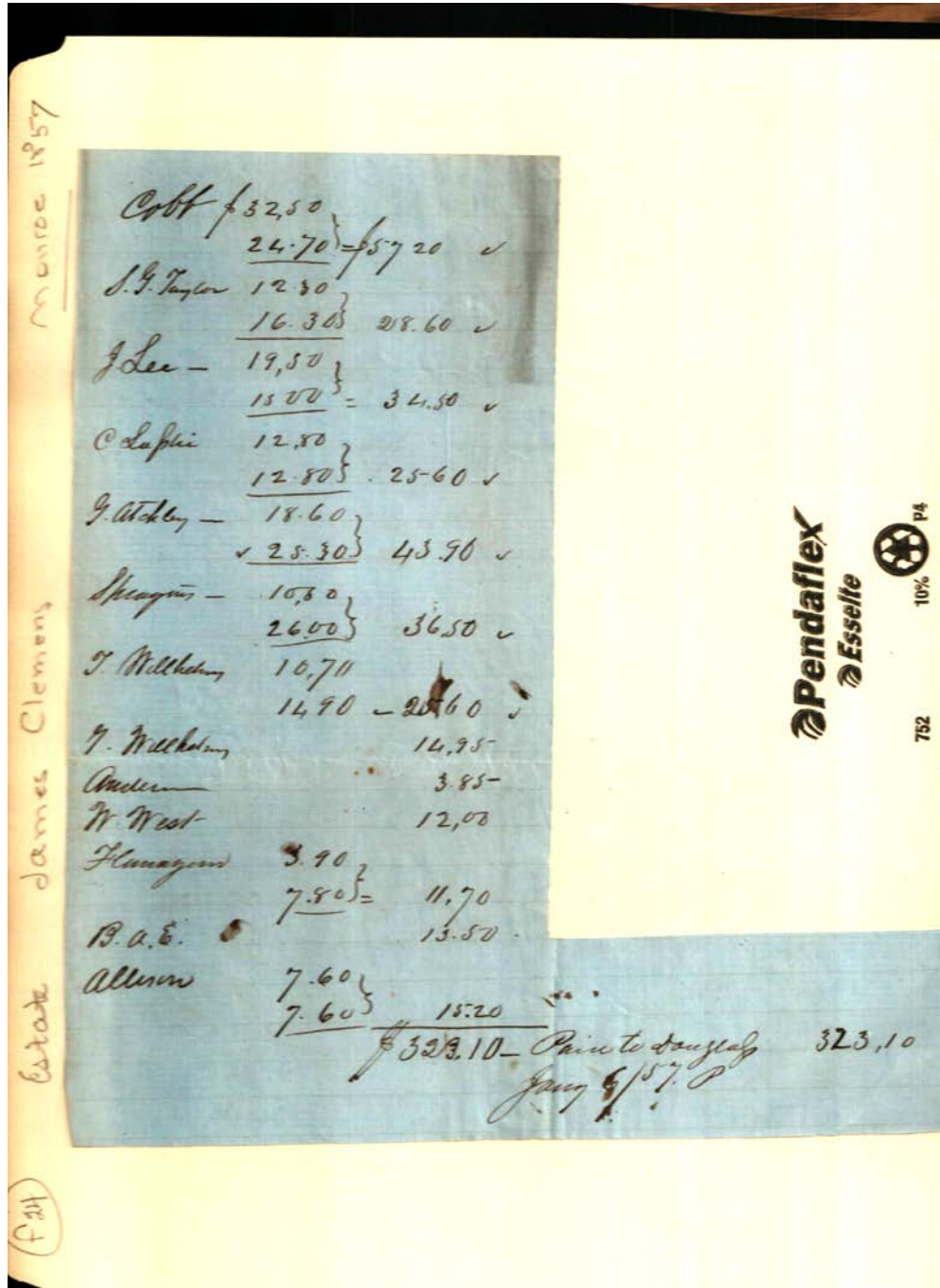

Know all men by these presents that we Alexander Ewing & Mary J. Ewing his wife, James Landman & Julia Landman his wife, Richard Jamar and Sarah Jamar his wife, and John M. Lynch and Nancy Lynch his wife, all of the County of Madison & State of Alabama, in consideration of the sum of five dollars to us in hand paid, by Elizabeth Langley & Samuel H. Langley, of the County of Pitt & State of North Carolina, the receipt whereof, we do hereby acknowledge as well as for these other good & valuable considerations, have bargained, sold, quitclaim, & by these presents do bargain, sell & quitclaim, unto Elizabeth Langley & Samuel H. Langley, of the County of Pitt & State of North Carolina, all the right, title & interest, whatsoever, which we or any of us have, in & to those certain tracts or parcels of land, situate in the County of Madison & State of Alabama, now in the possession of George Q. Ragland, & of which Samuel Hatton, late of said County of Madison deceased, was seized & possessed at the time of his death, & which are described as follows, to wit: The South East quarter of Section two, the West half of the South East quarter of Section three, excepting about one & eight acres off of the South West corner thereof, the East half of the North East quarter of Section ten, the

 to hold the right, title & interest in the said
 lands hereby conveyed & quitclaimed or intended
 to be conveyed & quitclaimed unto the said
 Elizabeth Langley, for & during the term of
 her natural life, and after her death, unto
 the said Samuel H. Langley, his heirs & assigns
 forever. But this conveyance is intended to
 operate only as a quit claim deed to said lands,
 and not otherwise.
