hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof the said Wil-
liam Robinson doth fully acknowledge he the
said William Robinson hath granted, bargained
sold & conveyed and by these presents doth grant
bargain, sell convey unto the said Nathaniel
Herbert his heirs, Executors, Administrators, assigns,
a certain House & Lot or part or parcel of Lot
No 41. in the plan of the Town of Huntsville
in said County & Territory, being the House &
Lot wherein Anderson Captain William Wyatt
formerly & Mrs Hogan lately lived, containing
with all singular the hereditaments
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
appertaining - To Have & To Hold the aforesaid
House & Lot or part or parcel of Lot No
41. in the plan of said Town of Huntsville,
with its hereditaments & appurtenances unto the said
Nathaniel Herbert his heirs, Executors, Administra-
tors assigns from the day of the date of these
presents forever - in as full, ample a manner
as it may be in the power of the Commissioners &

Mississippi Territory of the United States Madison
 County Ark. To the Honorable Abner Jones Esq
 of the Superior Court of said county in chancery
 sitting.

Humbley complaining Theweth unto your
 Honor your Orator John M. Armstrong of the
 county aforesaid, that Sometime in the month
 of June in the year 1815. He and one Reubin
 Higginbotham happened together in the town
 of Huntsville, and your orator played together
 with the said Reubin at cards at a game
 called Loos and divers other games and your
 Orator and the said Reubin betted together for
 divers Sums of money and the said Reubin then
 and there won off your Orator divers Sums of
 money amounting to the Sum of three Hundred and
 eighty seven dollars which your Orator lost with
 the said Reubin at the said game of Loos. And
 in consideration of said Sum of money so won
 by said Reubin from your Orator at the game
 called Loos. your Orator afterwards, to wit on the 18th
 day of September in the year 1815. executed his note under
 seal or due bill to said Reubin for the said Sum of three
 hundred and eighty seven dollars aforesaid and of this day
 and year last aforesaid. And your Orator swears
 that Theweth that the said Reubin well knoweth
 that the consideration ^{of said due bill} was for money won at gaming and
 unlawful betting on cards at the game of Loos and
 that the said note or due bill was consequently null
 void and of no effect or obligation, but combin-
 ing and confederating to and with a certain
 William Plevins whom your Orator prays may
 also be made a defendant in this bill of complaint.
