We are in receipt of your favor of 2<sup>d</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> Inst, contents of which are here noted. Please find enclosed copy of the last statement of James A Carnes acct. Since this statement was rendered Col Carnes, his acct has been credited with \$2010 as per statement herewith, showing balance due out 10.06.87 to life proceeds of his life for \$2000 due on 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 1856. We also hand you enclosed copies of all accounts rendered Mrs Mary A & S H Lester during the time they did their business with us. The Ella Clark arrived about the 17<sup>th</sup> Inst & commenced discharging on the 19<sup>th</sup>. We made a Warehouse entry of her cargo instead of a transportation bond entry. We had no instructions to do so however at the time, but are this morning in receipt of a letter from Saml Tate Presr containing instructions to that effect. We credited to day balance at credit Mrs Patton Donegan & Co say \$5013.<sup>74</sup> in Exchange on New York

The sold to day Hewett, Norton & Co. accept of Atkinson Thomas & Co. for \$5900 due 15<sup>th</sup> Dec next @ 5 1/2 % per annum discount - being in want of funds to pay for Post Office Exchange. Mr. C. H. Lee - broker - was the purchaser.

The Cotton market was more active during the past week than any other week during the season. about 16000<sup>1/2</sup> bales having been sold at steady prices - Our quotations are for Good Middling to Good Making 10 to 11 1/2 % Yours very truly

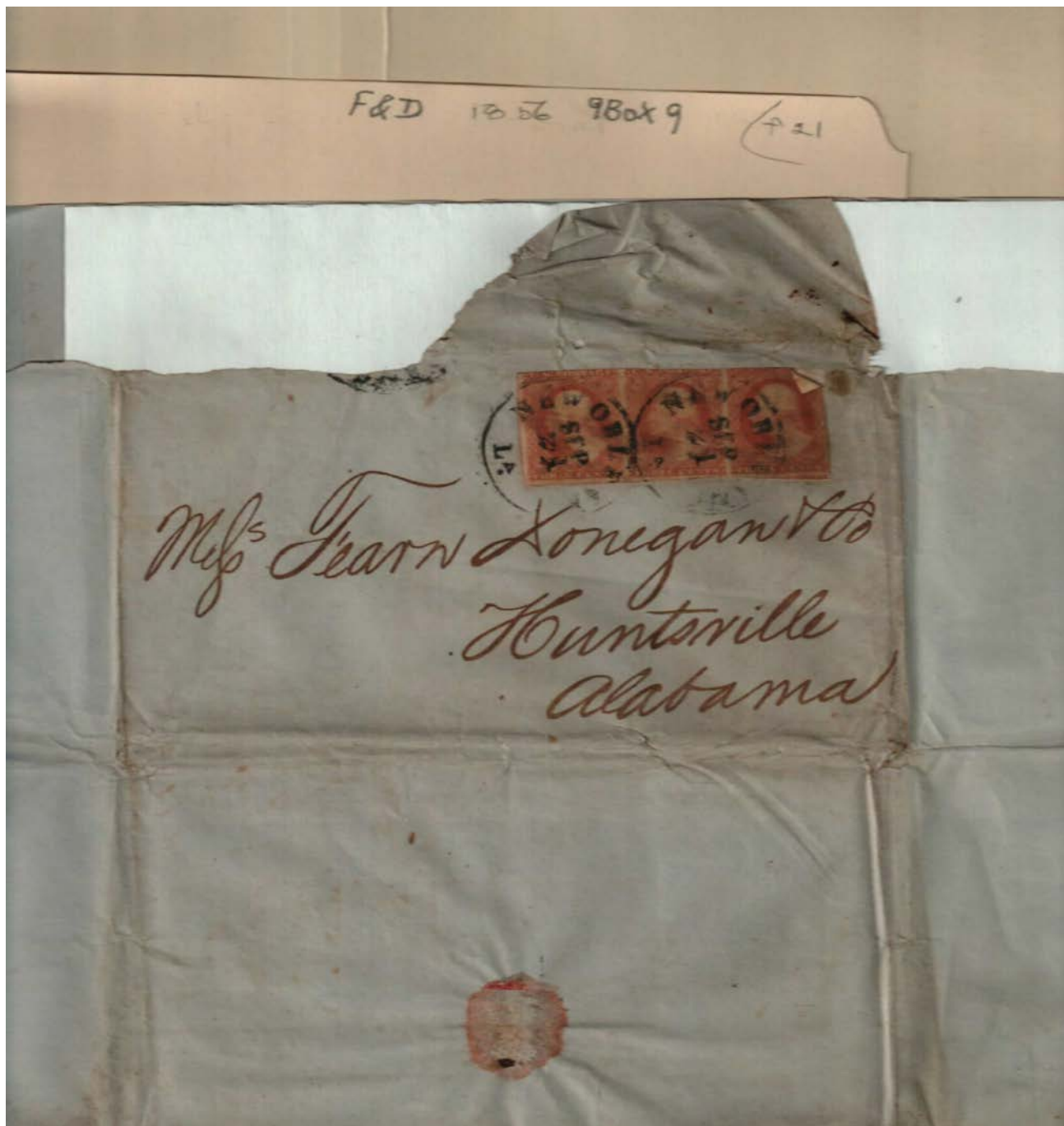
