... Saturday I wish Mrs Robertson she writes
How does Bob like the life of a farmer for I felt
incurious if I saw not satisfaction that which Bob
had bought him and if you can go to see some
days would I fear not being his dear love for you
and tell her I would be astonished if I provided
a greater measure than formerly when I returned
for I have become wonderfully attached to you
all since I entered this glorious prison & I think
I said or rather Mrs Goldsmith will you think you
could have before she leaves for Europe but I don't
think Ellen or myself have any reason to believe
we shall be so fortunate as to get a chance to go
What are you going to do with yourself next session
& who will teach at the academy. I wish if you
were here you would wish that you could change
places with any one so you could return to the
Huntsville again for there are no warm hearted
southerners here or yet least any few but the
school is filled with cold hearted unfeeling Yankees.
I must close this harrassing of some sort by writing
you promise to write occasionally & deliver my
messages to Kate also much love to all the girls
not forgetting better. Ellen is sick with the measles

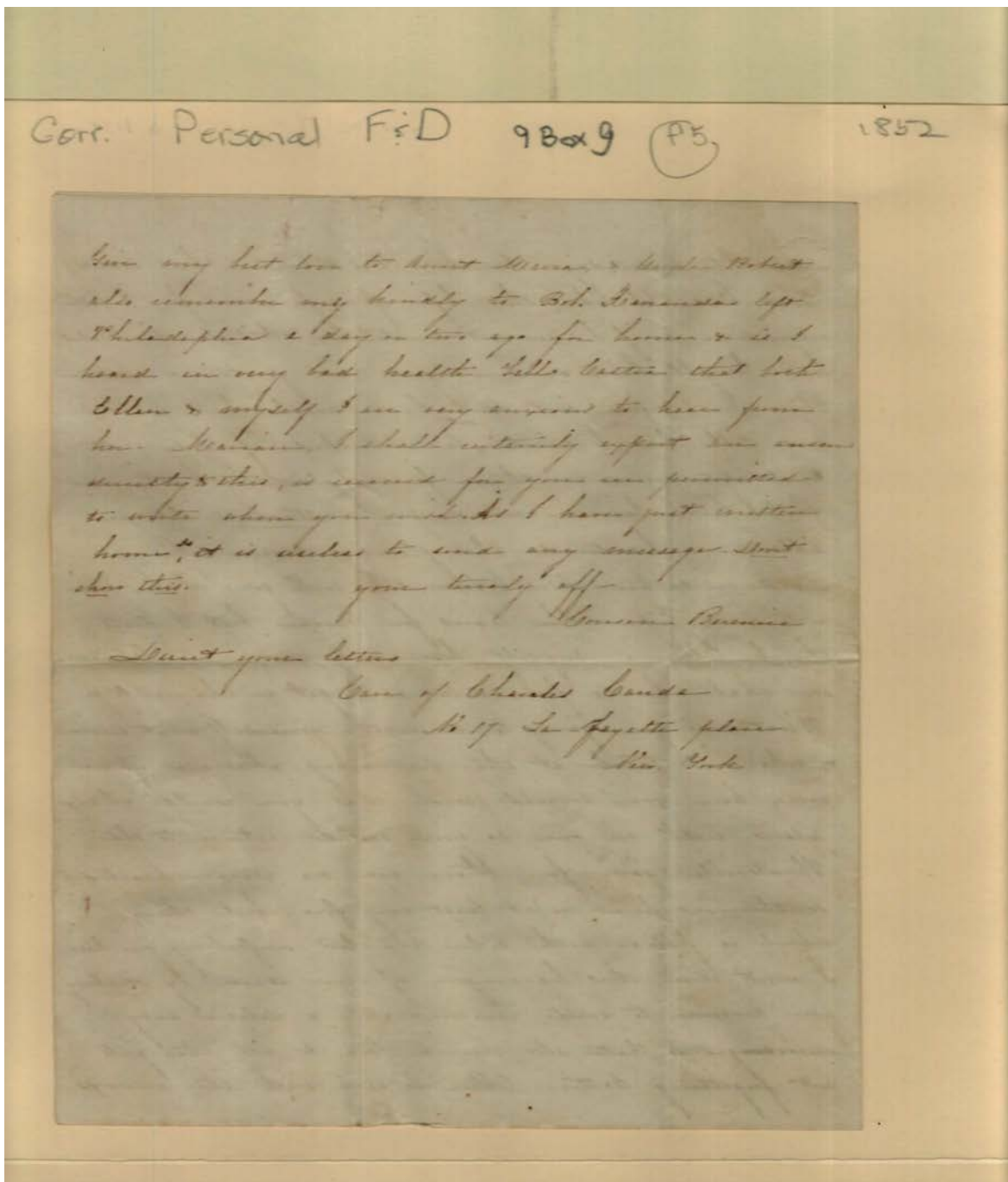
