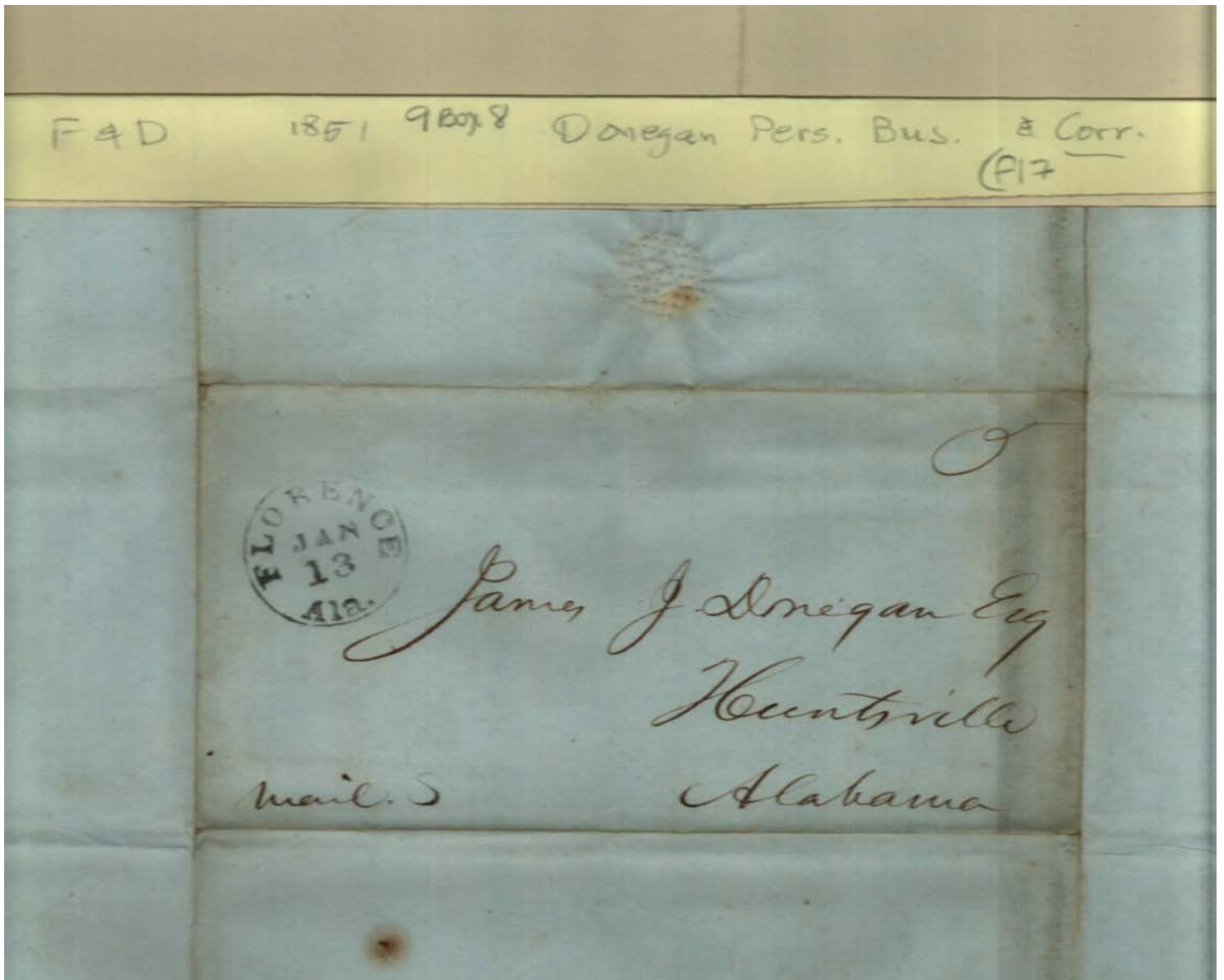

My dear James

12 January 1851

I have to acknowledge receipt of your last two favours, the last enclosing the receipt of the land which you lent H. D. Smith, which will be very satisfactory to me. We are to have a meeting of the citizens of the County, a tomorrow, and also a meeting of the County Commissioners, to take some action in relation to the Rail Road. I can't say, at what will be done, but if the people thought there was any chance of getting the road located on this side of the river, I should not wonder probably do something in the way of subscribing, but an impression has got out of you abroad, that the location is already fixed & determined upon, that the South side of the river is to have the road. What truths there may turn up in this regard, I can't say, but it will have its effect, to dampen the ardor of our people.

I have taken the ground, that the matter is not yet determined, & that much will depend upon our subscriptions list. Mr. Patton will leave this, on Tuesday, & he will be with you on Wednesday and will take the result of our doing of it - tomorrow.

We are all tolerably well. I am now suffering under a slight attack of Indigestion, but hope to be over it soon.

The Ladies meet with me in good love to you all. Ellen is preparing for a large dancing party on Tuesday evening to be given to the different newly married couples of the County.

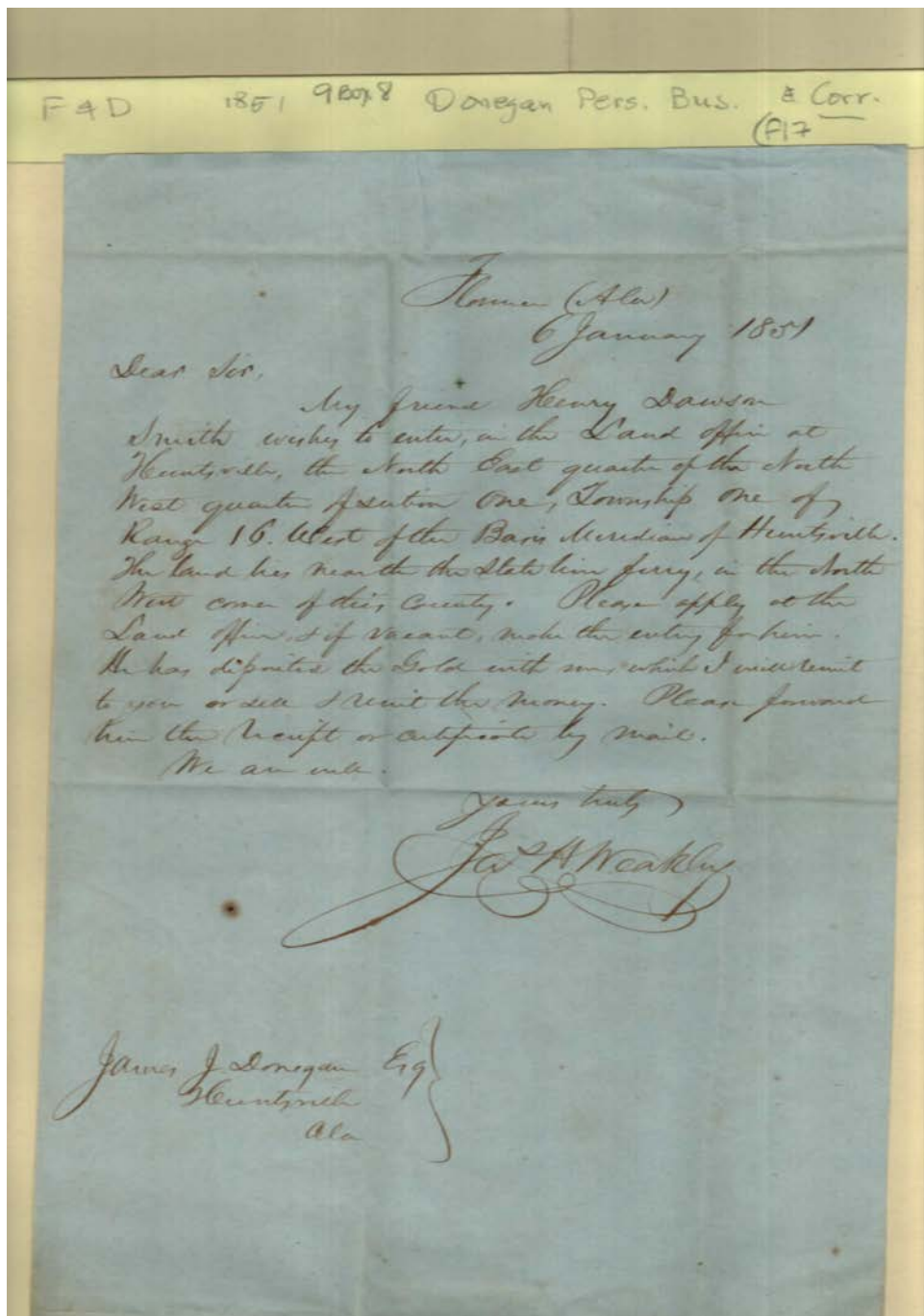

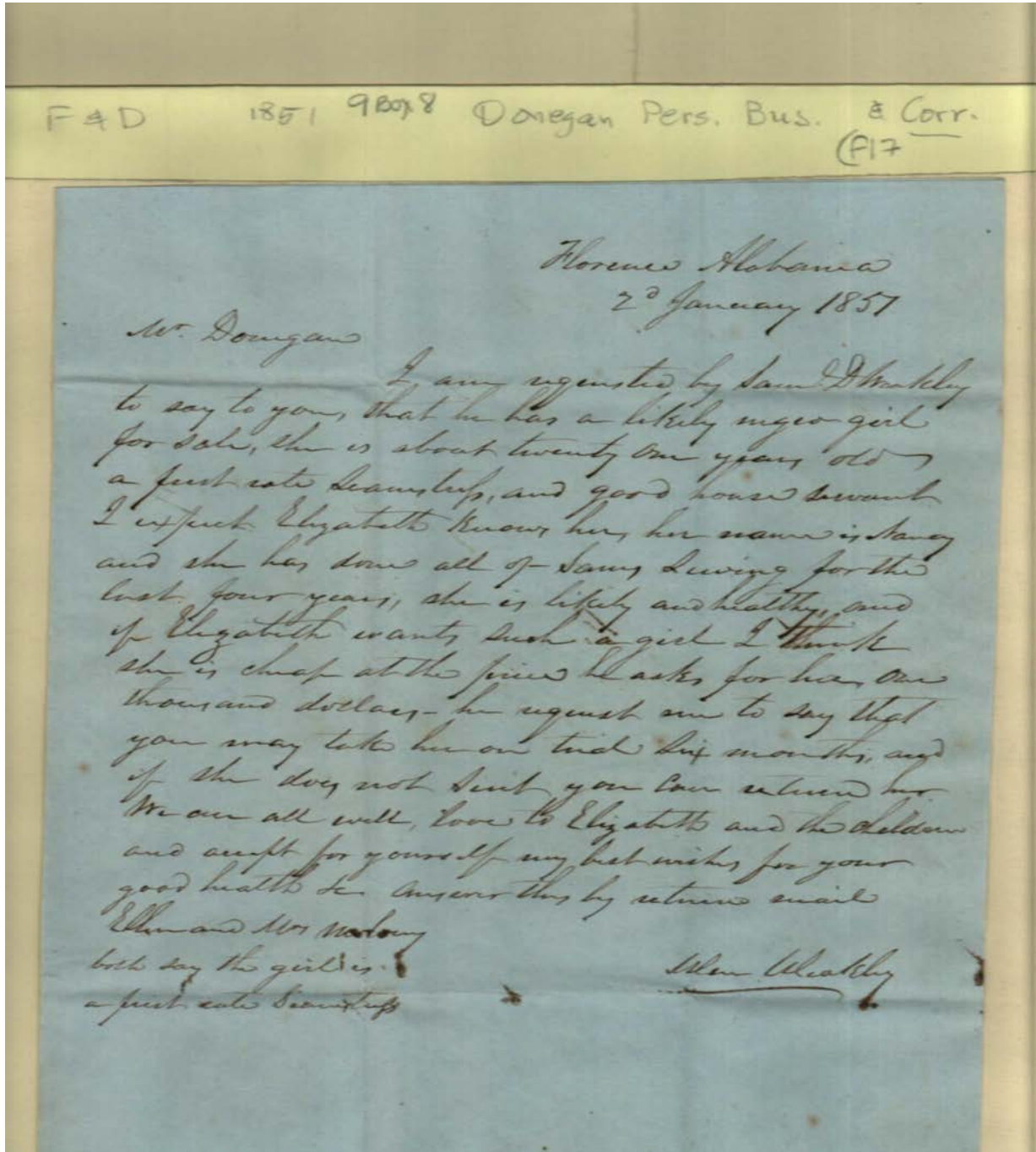

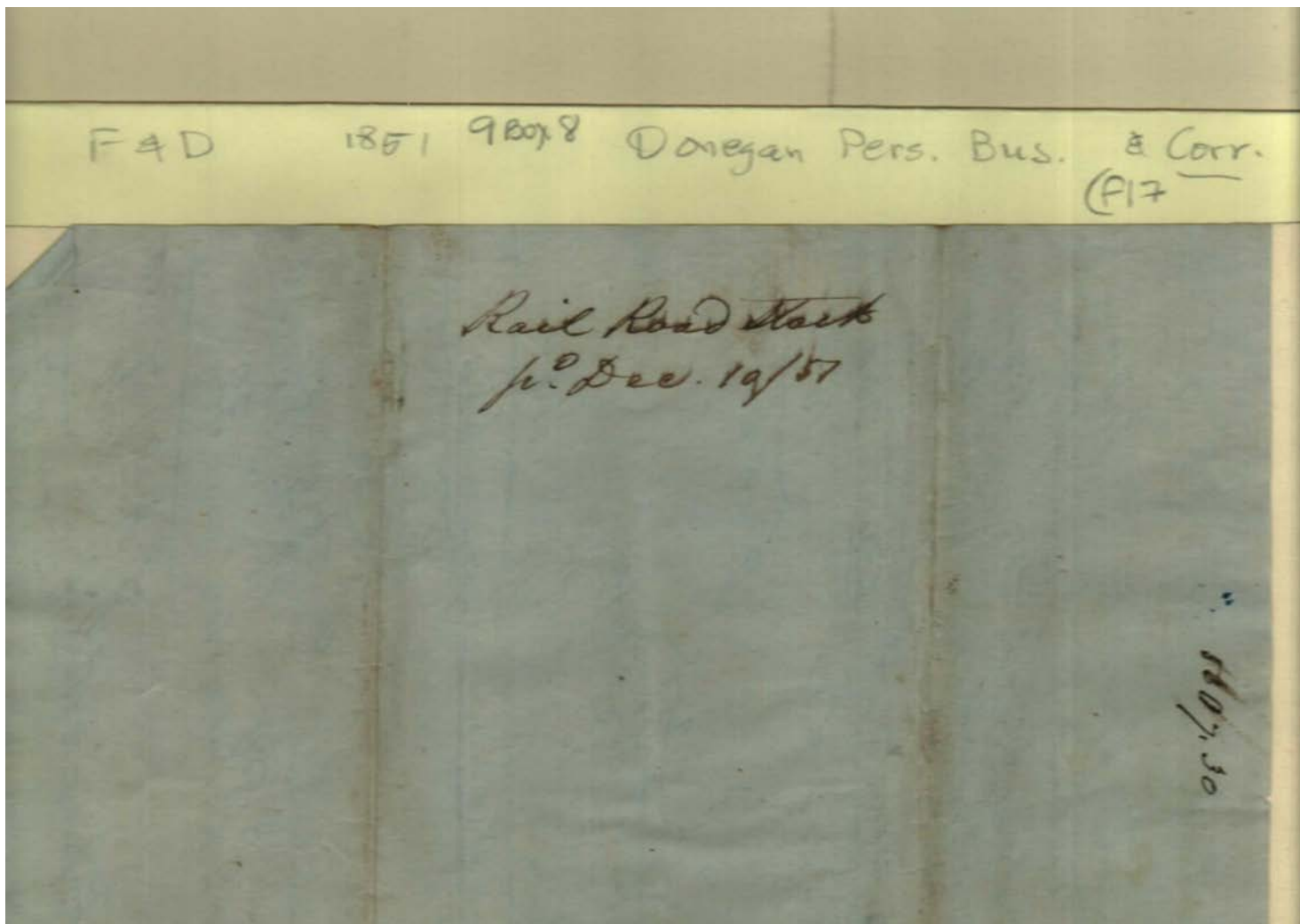
