We still have the crops of F. A. Pope & B. S. Pope on hand awaiting their instructions. The master is engaged balancing his books and he hopes that he will have every thing up by the 11th prox when we have to change our quarters, the new house will be certainly ready by that time.

My Dear Sirs

Enclosed we have your balance sheet made up to 21st Ult^o, also your account showing a balance at your credit of one hundred & nine 47/100 dollars.

You will observe that Howell has been able to pay only fifteen hundred dollars towards his account - He has another year yet to go upon. Execution has been issued against Harbour & his property will be sold on the first Saturday in May next - There are mortgages on the property before our Court amounting to twelve thousand dollars, but the land alone is estimated to be worth twenty five thousand dollars & we have ordered ten slaves to be held upon security.

The small account under our jurisdiction we have in train of collection. The account of Gilmer & Taylor has been paid.

Bill, Ricouallo has credited on the 4th inst with amount of W. L. Wynn's note for twenty five hundred dollars, discounted by us last year.

Cotton Market dull today - There has been some enquiry & offers of lower prices, but at this time we have not heard of any sale. Prices are irregular - but we may venture to quote generally at 10 1/4 to 1/4 for Mid. by.

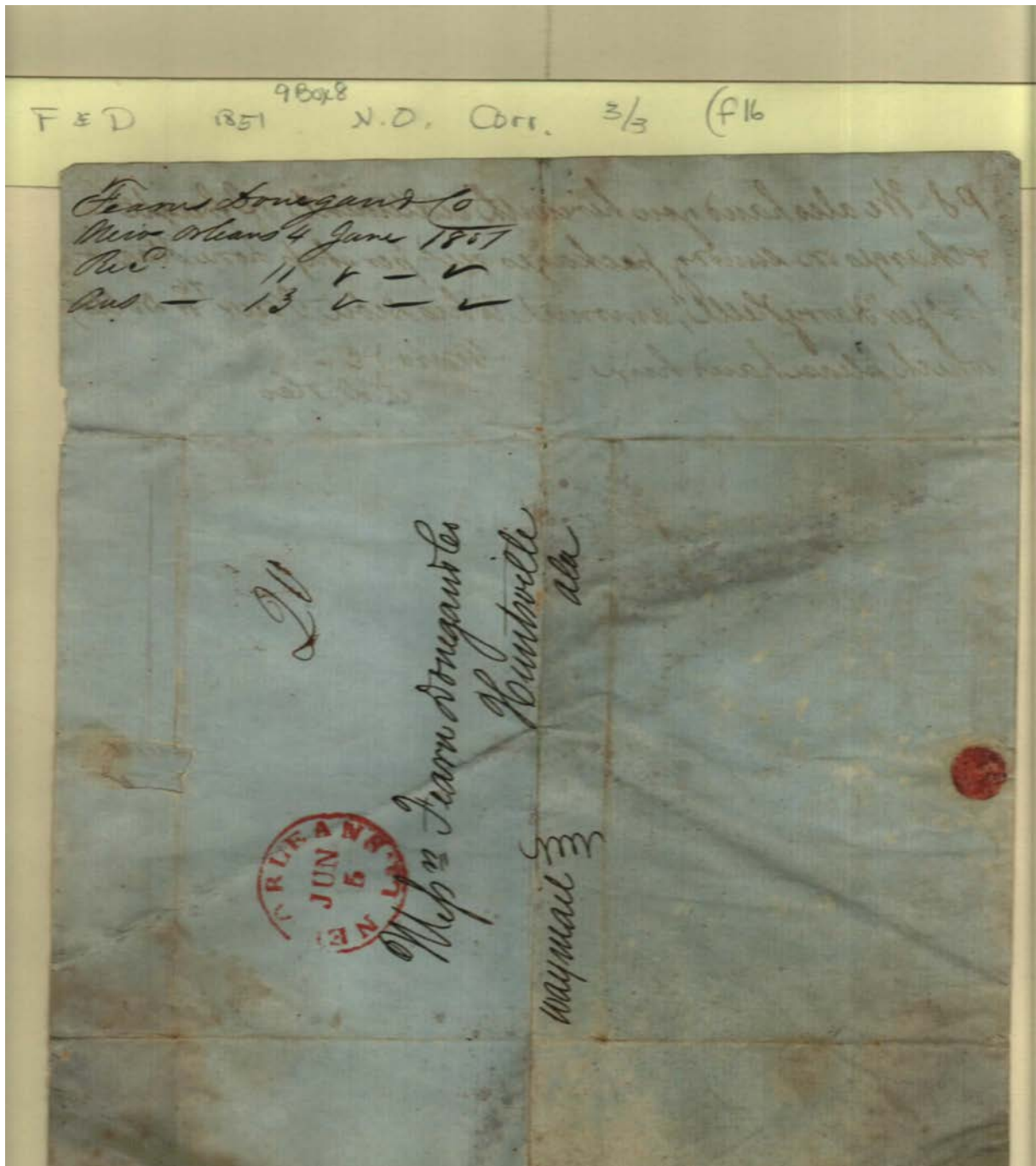

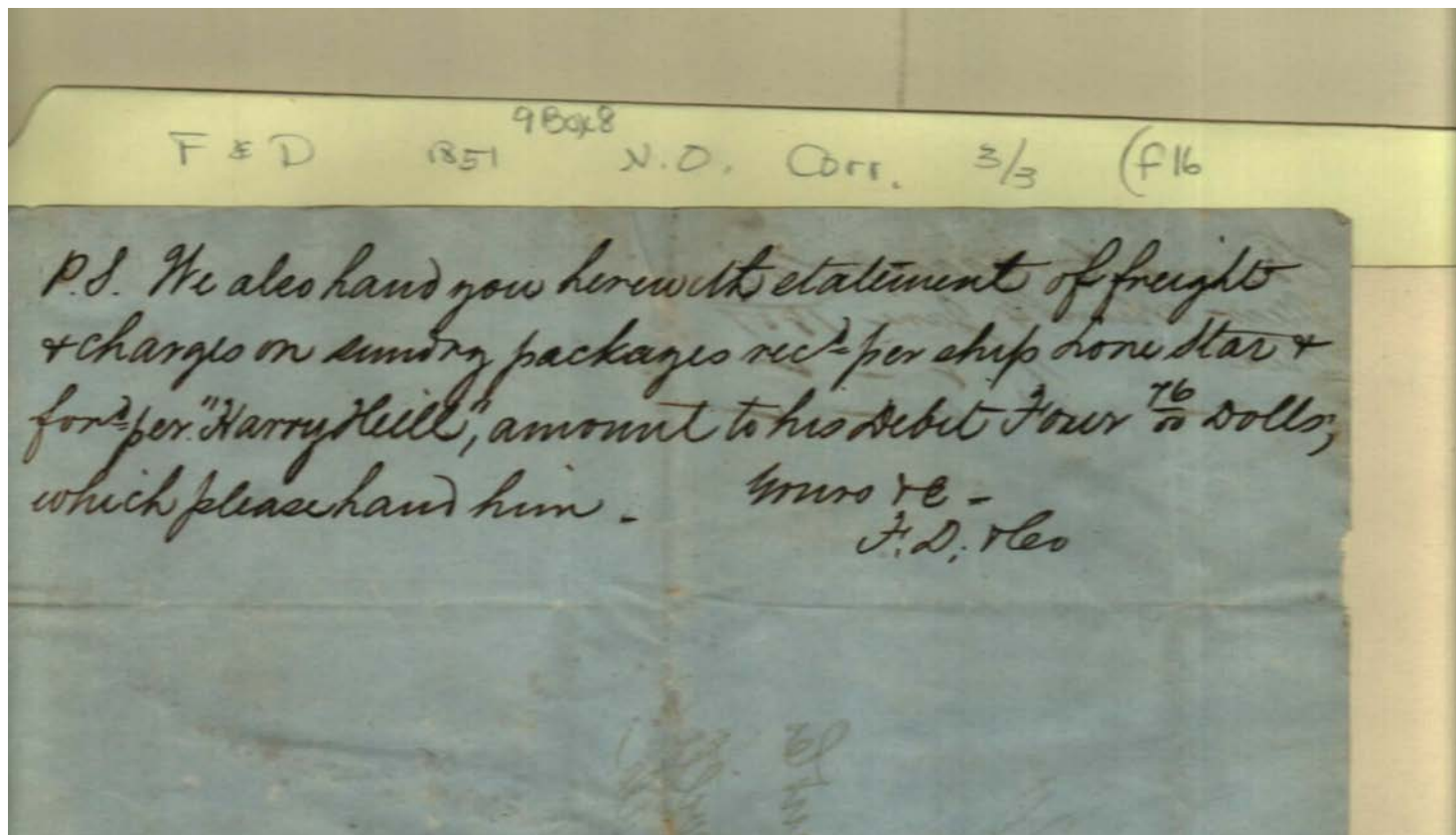

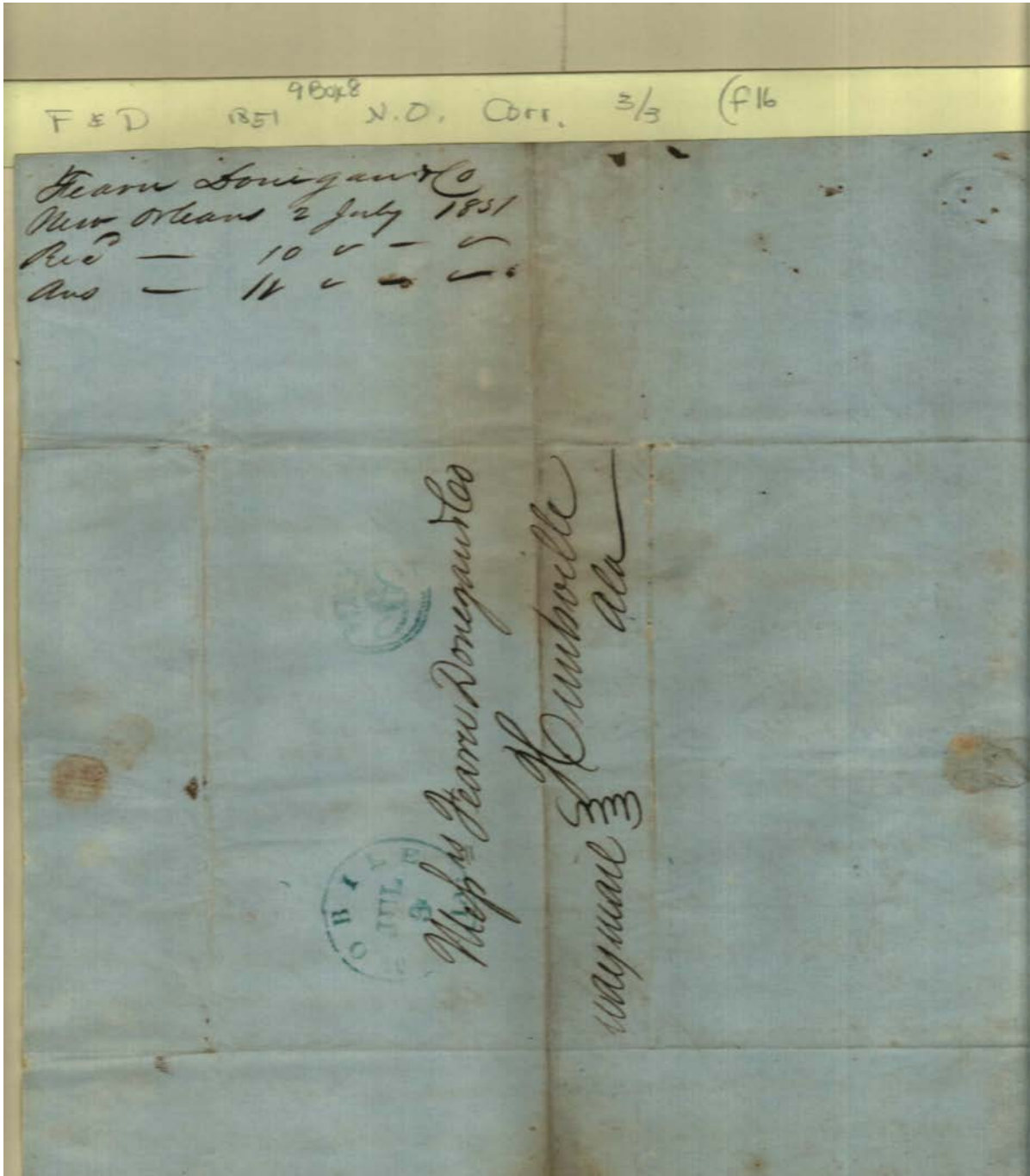

We wrote you last on the 30th Ult^o and have since received your favor of 23rd same: contents noted - on yesterday the cotton market was more active than it has been for the past two weeks & 6000 bales were sold at ~~very~~ firm prices. We assailed ourselves of the demand & sold a list of 501 bales North Ala @ 7³/₄ round: enclosed we hand you list of the parties; those marked * we have advised from here; the rest you will please advise. We have been compelled to divide some of the shipments on account of the inferior quality of the cotton, as very poor cotton is almost entirely unsaleable. We also sold on yesterday the balance of Judge Hopkins' crop - 89 bales @ 8¹/₂ round. The Judge was here & was as well pleased as any one could be, who was unwilling to take 13¹/₂ for it early in the season. We will send you list of receipts in our next; nothing from our bro Atwood for a week past: we suppose that he must be on his way home. Yours very truly

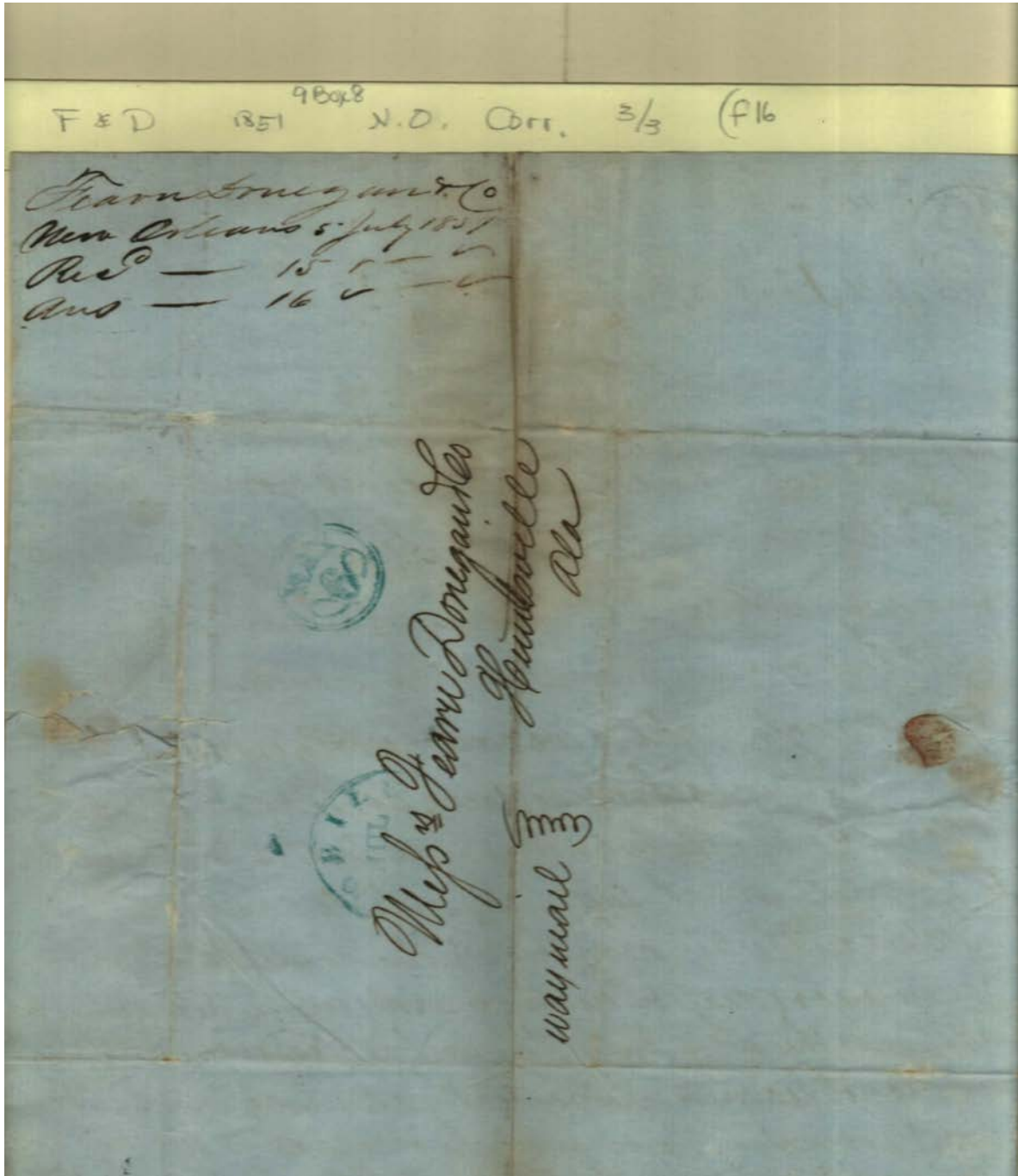

We had this pleasure last on the 2nd Inst, & have since received your favor of 28th Ult^o: contents noted - The plan you suggest of raising money; - by drawing upon us @ 4 to 6 m^{os} - is the best one at present, as the money market here is exceedingly tight, & we can hardly expect to be able much in funds before selling some of our Alabama cottons. Enclosed we hand you list of total receipts to 3rd Inst, which we wish safe to hand.

Yesterday the letters by the Europa came to hand, & they caused a good deal of inquiry early in the morning: but as it was the 4th of July the market closed very early, and we did not learn to what extent sales were made. We availed ourselves however of the occasion to sell two lots, one 471 bales at 8^{1/2} belonging to Peter Miller: the other 98 bales @ 7^{1/2} & 3 @ 6 say in all 101 bales, crop of J. D. 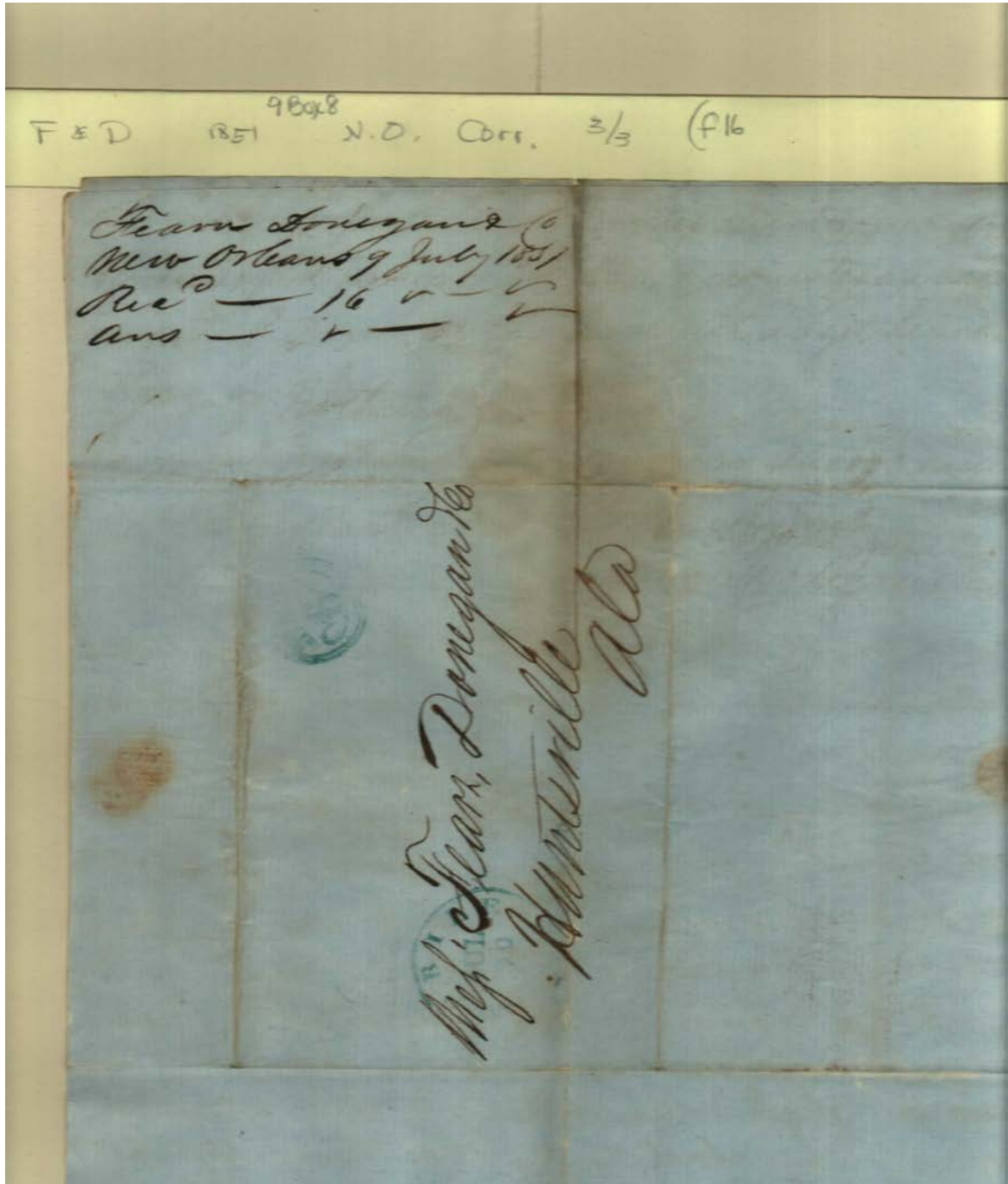

We wrote you last on the 5th Inst
and have not since had the pleasure of receiving any of
your favors. The news by the Africa & Cambria repor-
-ting a decline of $\frac{1}{4}$ th in the Liverpool market for
the week ending 28th June, has had the effect of stopping
operations in this market to a considerable degree. Buyers
are demanding a reduction in prices, which factors
even unwilling to concede. Sales yesterday about
1500 bales: this morning there is some inquiry, but
we doubt whether much will be done except at lower
rates - On Monday we sold Mr Sax. Brown's crop 112
bales at $7\frac{1}{4}$ th round. The lot of 1300 bales Alabama
which we advised you of having out, is still upon our table
and we cannot get even an offer for it at anything like
its value, which is about $7\frac{1}{4}$ th. We are anxious to sell
but are afraid that we will experience considerable diffi-
-culty in finding a purchaser.

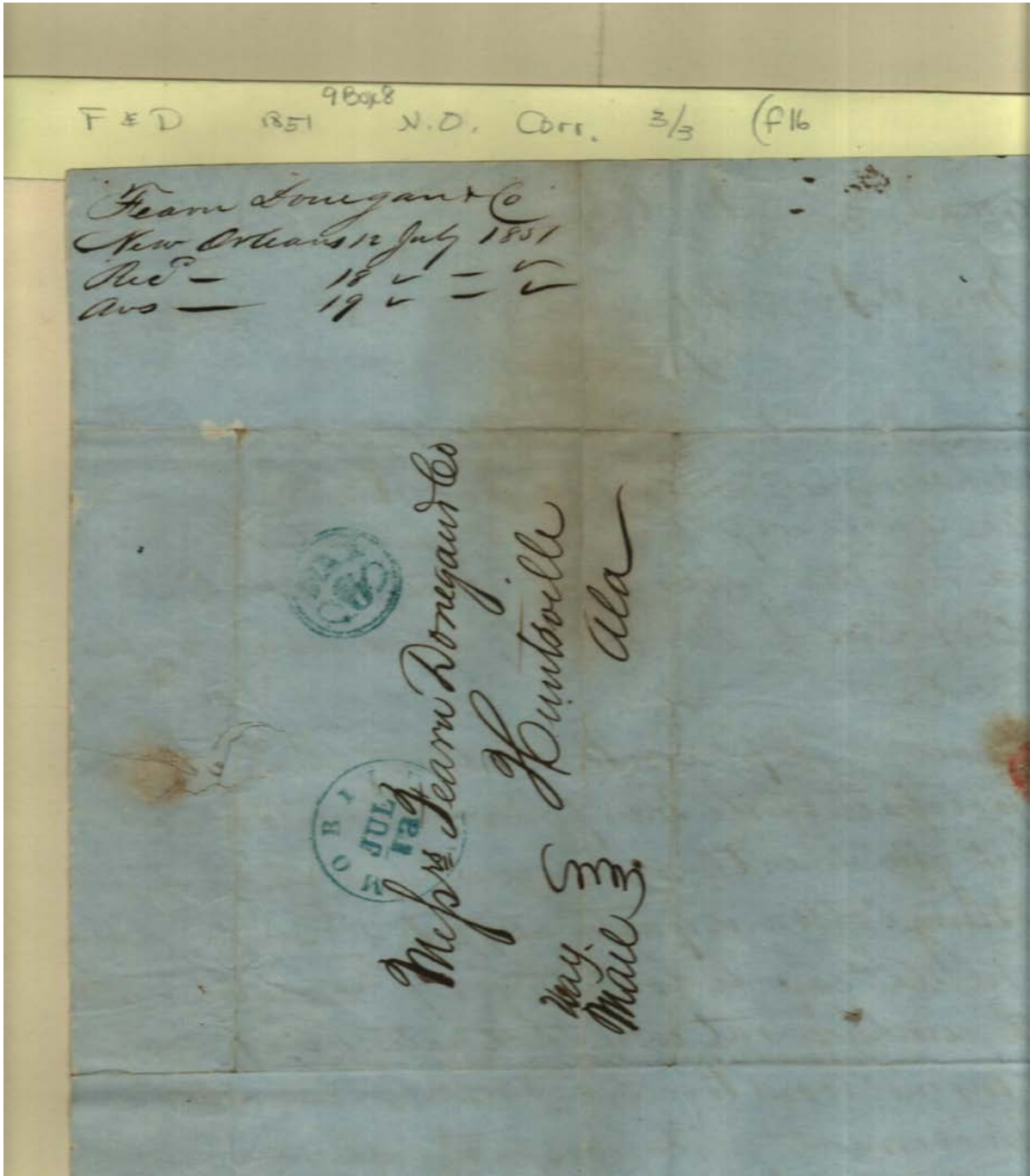

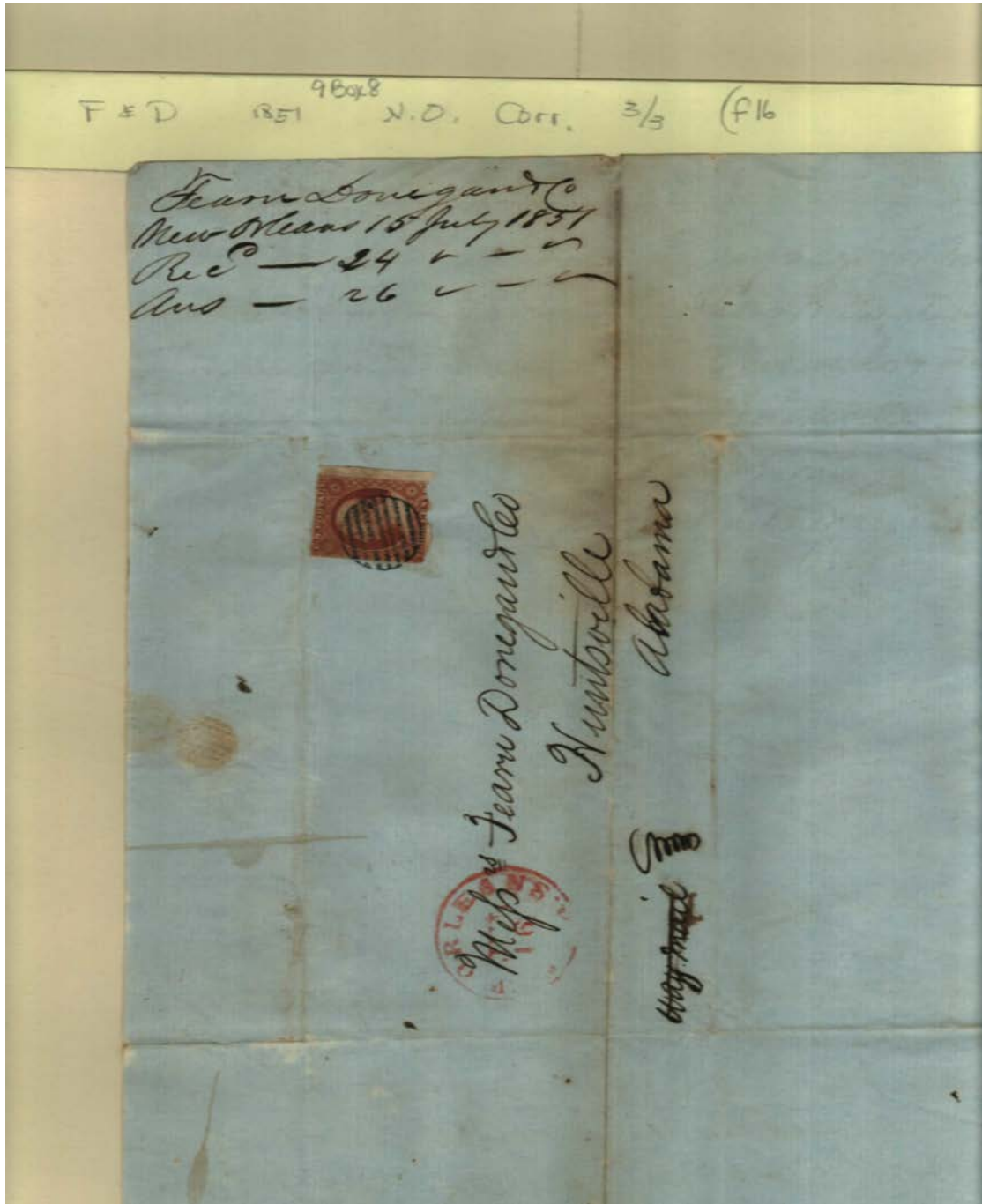

We have not been able to sell the 1300 bales which we advised you of offering - All the cottons not under limits are now upon our tables & we are only waiting for a purchaser to sell out, on yesterday there was some enquiry & 2000 bales were sold: we disposed of a list of 623 bales, all Messrs except 183 bales belonging to Bryce Willson & Co round. This clears us out of Messrs almost entirely, & we hope soon to be rid of our
