My dear James,

13. October 1848

Your favour of yesterday is this
 morning you will find a pleasing draft on Mr. Cruse, or Rev.
 of father's money for \$969⁰⁰/₁₀₀ which he pleases to call for the
 best premium you can get. Remit the proceeds to me by mail
 as early as convenient, a servant to use the money in the payment
 of some of my debts. I am happy to hear that you and Elizabeth
 have an idea of visiting Florence. We shall be extremely glad to see
 you & Ellen say, Elizabeth must come, as it may be the last
 time she will have the pleasure of your taking of her hospitality
 in her own house for some time. We shall also be glad to see
 Mrs. Hickman. This time, I have sold my land to S. M.
 Cunningham for \$125 per acre, \$2000 in cash on the 1st Jan'y
 next, and then annuities, with one year's interest on the
 last payment, being about what it goes for it. The by one view, and
 the only source of unsuccess and trouble. The price is too low at
 the present price of cotton to sell them, nor can I get my consent to sell
 them, unless to some of the gamblers, who perhaps don't want them; so I
 must turn them out for a while until I can do what I like to do
 done. I will try to get good hands for them, with the proceeds of the

 and lay them upon what we have. At present I can sell my house
 for \$5000 upon pretty good terms, if so, I will live with it. I think

 Sept. & also one from Julia Colburn of the 6th in which she mentions
 that Fannie had gone to board at the school, to receive a better education
 to learn. I do hope that she will set her mind upon her studies
 continue to improve.

and very favorable to the cotton crops, which seem to be turning out much better than anticipated. Should the rain not keep off another week or two, very favorable weather, & consequently an abundant crop of cotton, the consequences will be great. We must great raising so much cotton & get at something else. Manufacturing in the South must continue to a good thing & a year or two more of low prices, will give us to spinning & weaving.

Our town is pretty healthy now. There are labours under a religious excitement at this time. For about 12 days, the Methodists kept it up, & for the last week, the Presbyterians have been under weight. There is a number of converts, have been added to each church. I have not been near to see, not having much of faith in such things.

We have not much of interest here. Some excitement among the Politicians, as the election returns are coming in by Telegraph. The Whigg claim gains in Pennsylvania the Democrats in Ohio. There seems to be very little dependence to be put in the returns by Telegraph, so I don't pay any attention to the reports, but shall wait patiently the final result, not caring much how the thing goes. I shall not be benefited either way.
