Dear Sir

I am in receipt of your favor of ^{the} 14th inst. and am very well satisfied with the ^{sale of} little girl in your charge, except the delay of payment which puts me to some inconvenience. I expect to apply the proceeds in payment of the note to Philip and a balance on a note in the Huntsville Bank, a certainment on which last note, or the whole, about \$100, falling due, I believe, in June. If it suits your convenience I should like to knock off any reasonable per cents or pay you the annual coms - for advancing, and let you take the note, or, at any rate, so much of it as will cover what you paid to Philip. If you will take ^{the} whole note on these terms and pay the instalment in Bank, as required, I will indorse to you if made payable to me. If the first part of the proposition to wit, the releasing from the note and advanced to Philip, upon terms proposed, suits you best that will be satisfactory to me. If it does ^{not} agree with your convenience to spare the \$125 - let me know promptly, and I will send you a check on Nashville for that sum. Philip had

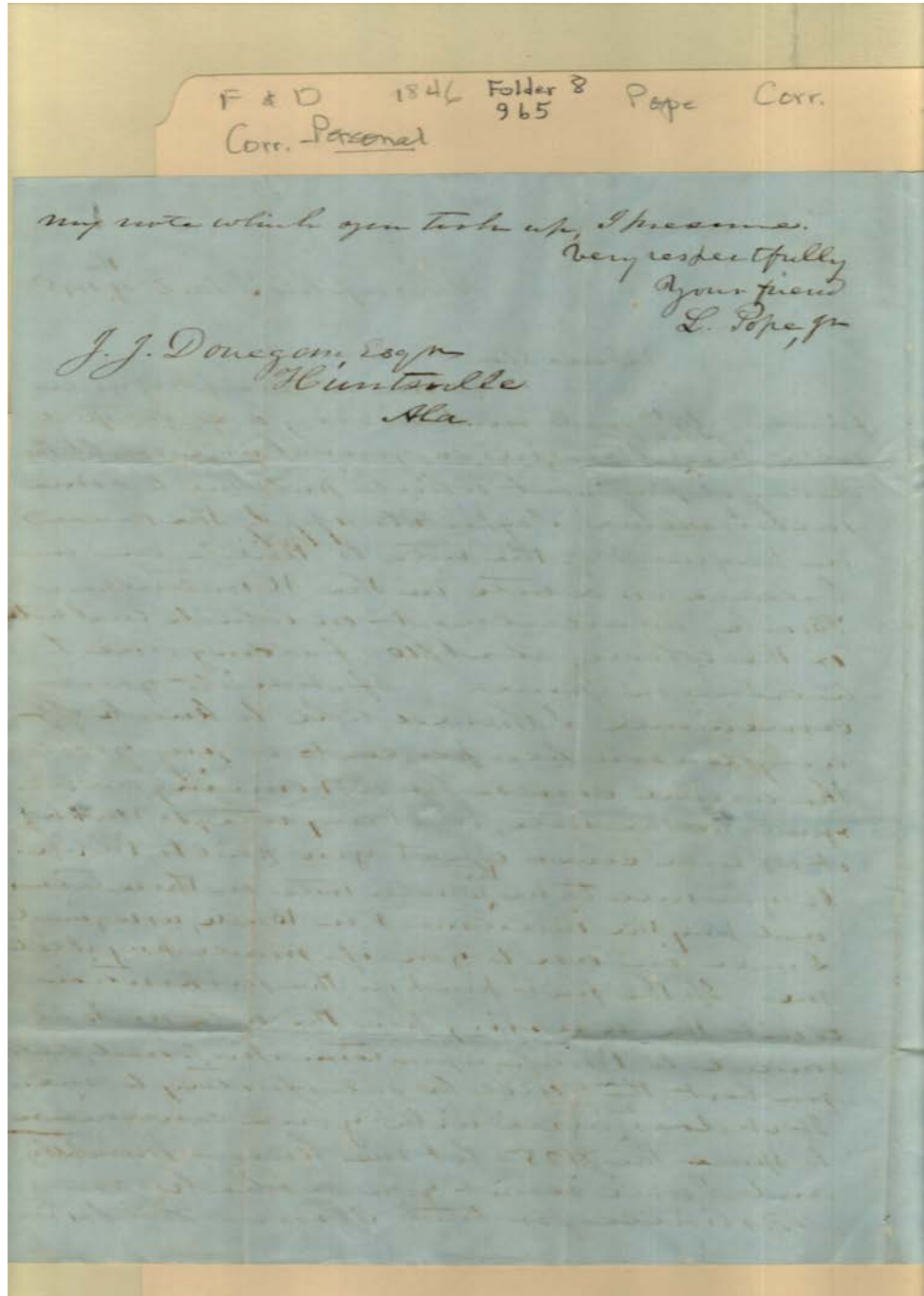

As you have arranged your claim against the estate of the Boardman, it seems to me proper that the Administrator should have the note in hand of Mr. Titus, surviving partner of Nelson & Titus. It will require your order to get this note. And if you will authorize me I will procure the same and give it a proper direction.

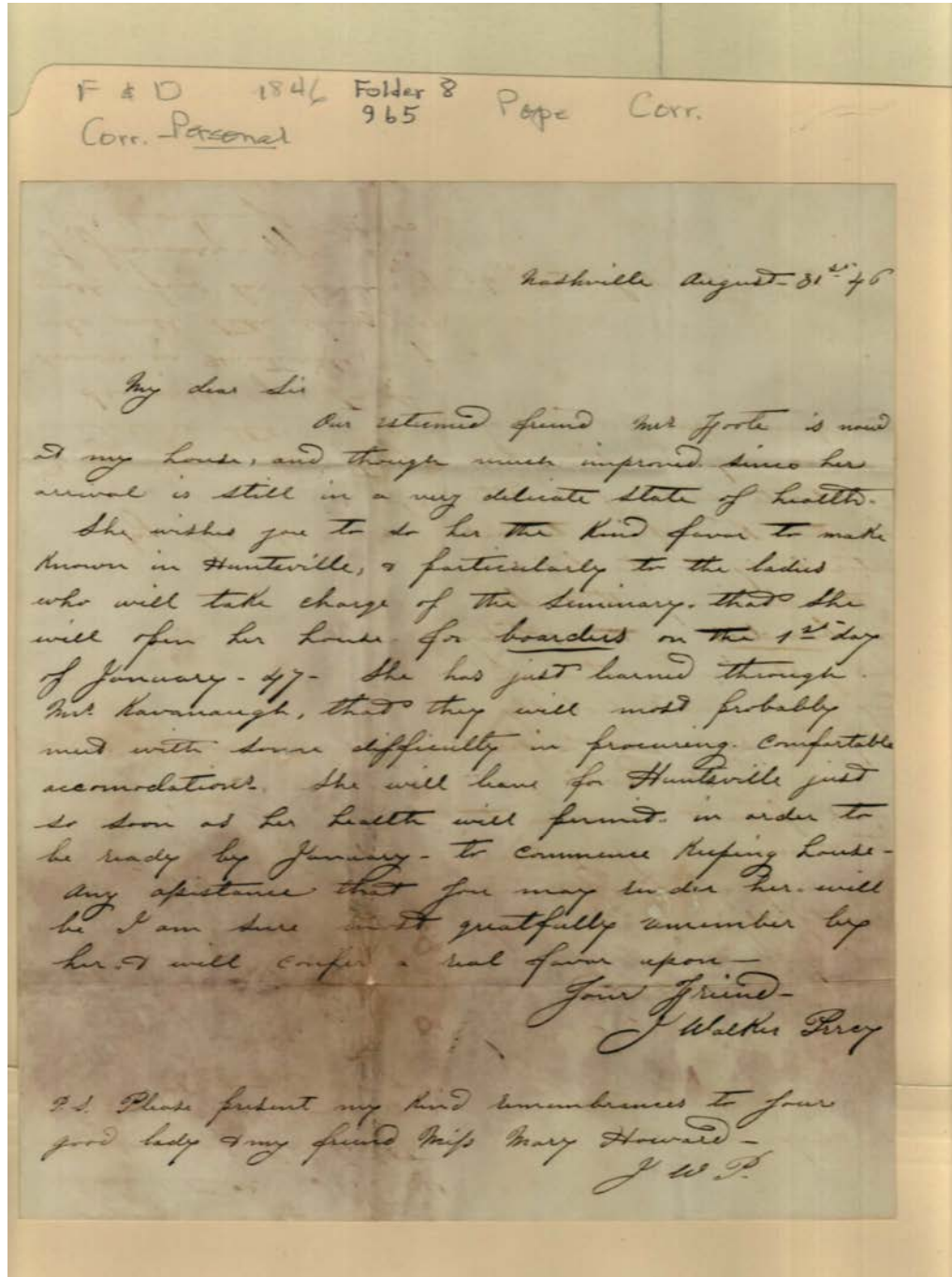
