 in to the Tangara as the State will yield me nothing until  
 it is worked out - I am able to buy a sufficient quantity  
 of upper leather hides in the County but do not long

Would it be in your power or in Mr Robert  
 Fearn to let me have the use of 5000 three hundred  
 and fifty dollars for a while to buy pumpkins for the  
 use of this sum of money to buy American hides in or  
 learn I would pay you a good interest and give you  
 an unaccountable bill for the money if not in your  
 power please to show this to Mr Robert Fearn  
 and if you <sup>can</sup> oblige me write to me and I will forward  
 the bill to your house in Orleans to buy the hides  
 for me if convenient let me hear by Return  
 of mail whether in your power or Mr Fearn

The people here are holding on to their cotton expecting higher prices. Should I get more cotton than I can pay for success I should be glad to purchase for your Factory. I think I shall be able to pay balances without borrowing this year. I want to get off some cotton to your house in N.O. as soon as I possibly can. I can buy a lot of about 20 bales good cotton at 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cash. ought I to make this trade a net. let me hear your opinion on it. any advice you can give me about cotton at any time will be thankfully rec<sup>d</sup> I can ship you this season I think 15<sup>0</sup> or 20<sup>0</sup> bales pretty good
