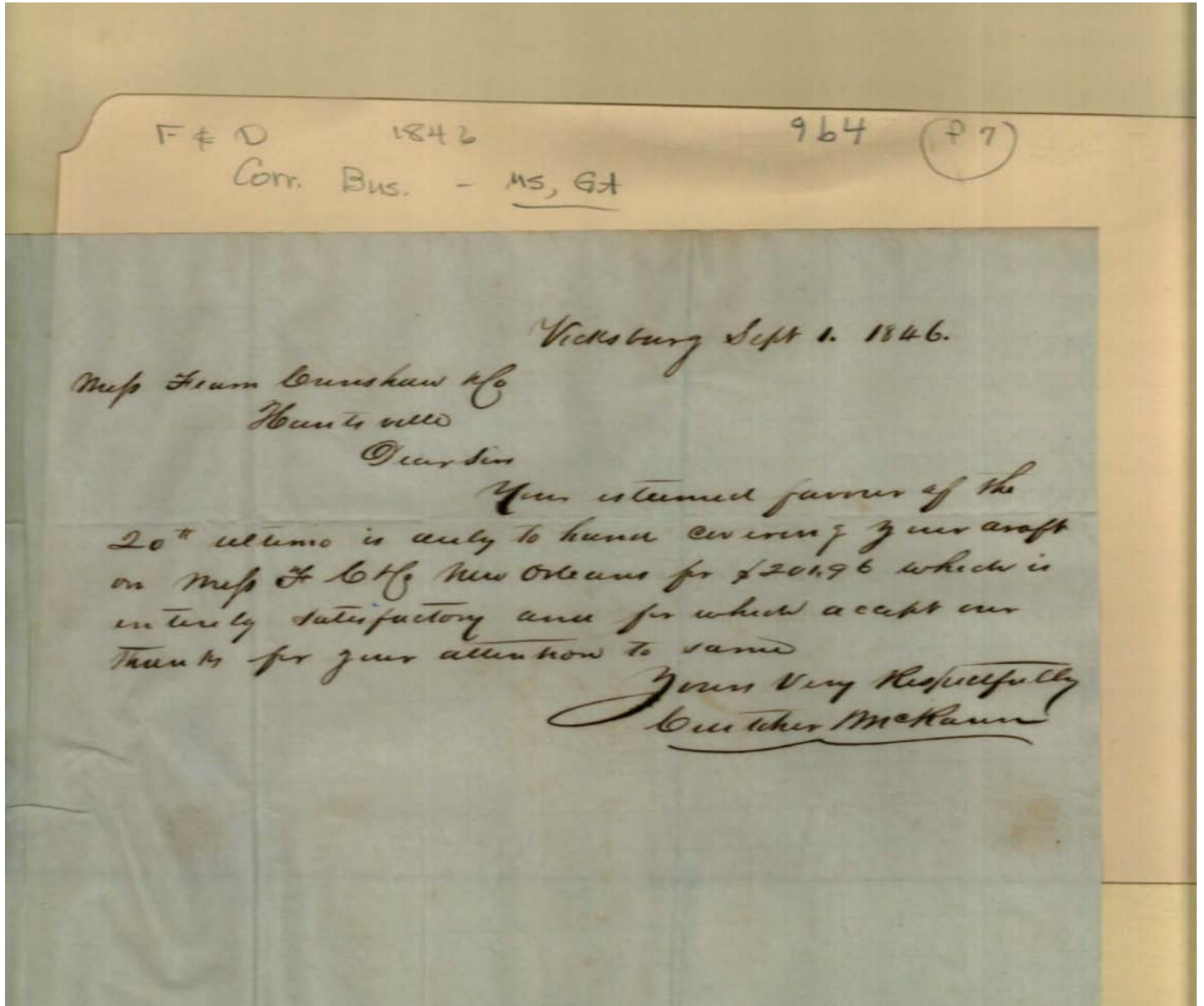

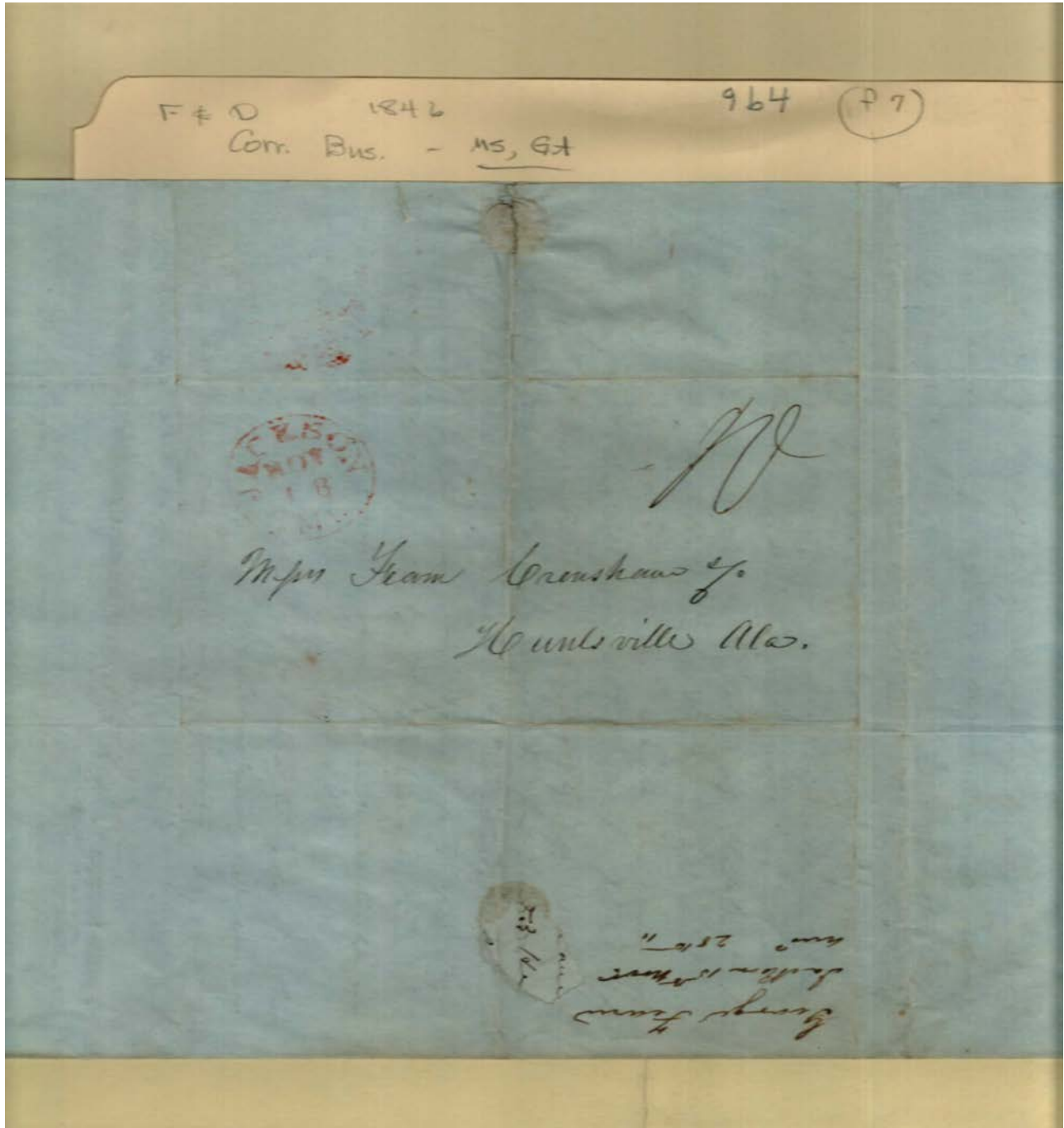

Jackson Miss 15th Nov 1846

My dear Genl Crenshaw & Co.

My particular friend Col S. S. Irvin, near this place, & with
whom I think somewhat acquainted, wishes
to make some arrangement with you here
to give him in a negotiation for the purchase
of a plantation in Louisiana, part of Melville's
Bonds. If I recollect rightly he is to give fifteen
thousand dollars for the place, stock & all ready
for profitable cultivation - eight thousand
dollars to be secured to some of the Banks
on long term - thirty five hundred in one crop
two bills payable three months & some
out in half twelve months thereafter.
The bold will work about twenty hands, & would
as he fully expects be able to pay the bills out of
the first crop after cost becomes due - would rather
if desired by you, to raise the money out of the
growing crop. He stands as I conceive decidedly
right as a most honorable, consistent & responsible
gentleman, I have known him almost since
my arrival in this Country - He has always sus-
tained the character I now give him. I should be
much pleased should you conclude to give
him the benefit of your name, & feel assured you
might do so with entire safety - I know no man
in the country who stands higher as an honorable

 you without delay, so be aware to clear the negotiation
 soon.

Genl Jas W Wily of Madison County wishes
 an advance of eight or nine hundred dollars,
 by the first of January, upon his crop of 1847
 for which he will allow 8 per cent interest +
 2 1/2 per cent for the advance - says he wishes
 about 120 Bales - wishes Richardson & Fearn
 to ascertain whether you will accommodate
 him - Mr Hunt told letter of the Genl: had
 a small transaction with him, which I men-
 tioned to have shot in which he came up
 fully to his engagement - Mr Robt Shot-
 well, represents him as nothing all reliance.
 What shall we say to the Genl? He
 has friends & influence as I understand, & might
 be useful to you - would visit you Mr
 D. take our part of the country in his
 way down? When does he expect to be in
 N. O.?

I have thought it best to address this
 to Huntsville, as the circumstances of course
 would make no engagements beyond
 the present season.

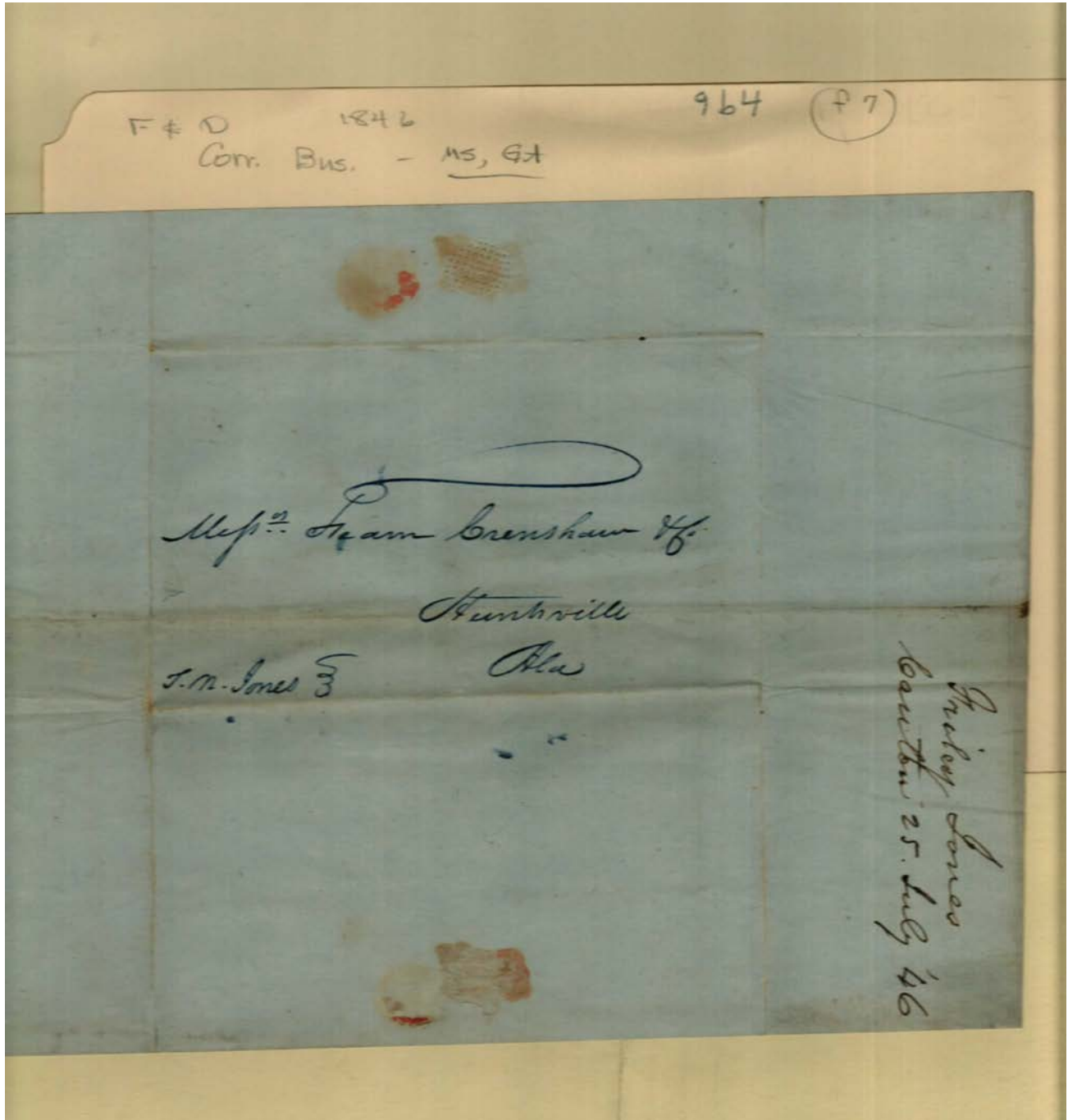

Canton Ms 25th July 1846
Messrs Fearn Crenshaw & Co
Gentlemen

I am in arrears to your house
some 12 or 13 hundred Dollars over drawn on produce sent to
you. I want to pay you and have got no money, and
my growing out is drawn on to meet my Banks debt
Please say the best you can do for me in the adjustment
of this claim. I have Land Negroes, Stocks &c. any portion
of it shall be sold to pay you now if you say so or
at a future day. I am going to try my fortune
in a Commission House in New Orleans and before I
quit my old friends its necessary to pay them up which
I am determined to do to their entire satisfaction at any
sacrifice. I have written to Mr. A. H. Ford our agent at
Brentsville and requested him to know of you the best
way I could pay you, you can communicate to him or
write to me or both. I have Old Negro Man Luke
in your neighbourhood yet who has your Nelly for a wife I
would like to put them together, and would be willing for you
or any of the factory concern to have him at valuation and
that value fixed by any disinterested man

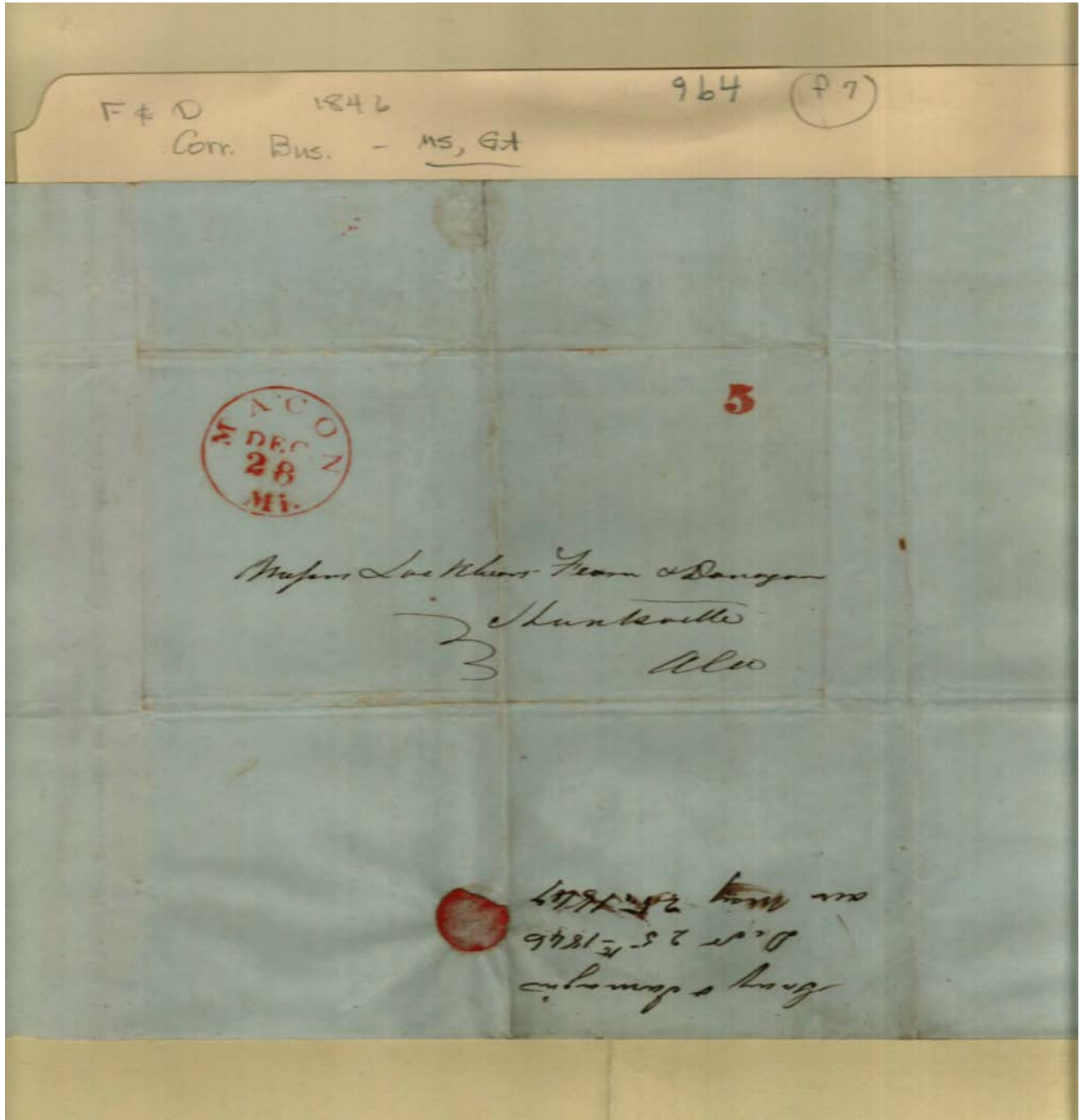

You will recollect that
the Execution in your favor vs Dent & Woodstreet
was hindered upon four negroes in the keeping of
Mr Longstreet and that W B Lucas interposed
his claim as Adm of Longstreet's estate. The
case has been hanging up in our court
for some time. We got a Judgment at the present
term of the court condemning the negroes to be
sold to satisfy your debt. Lucas has taken
an appeal to the High Court of Errors & Appeals -
but will see that the case is well attended to
wherever they may take it.
