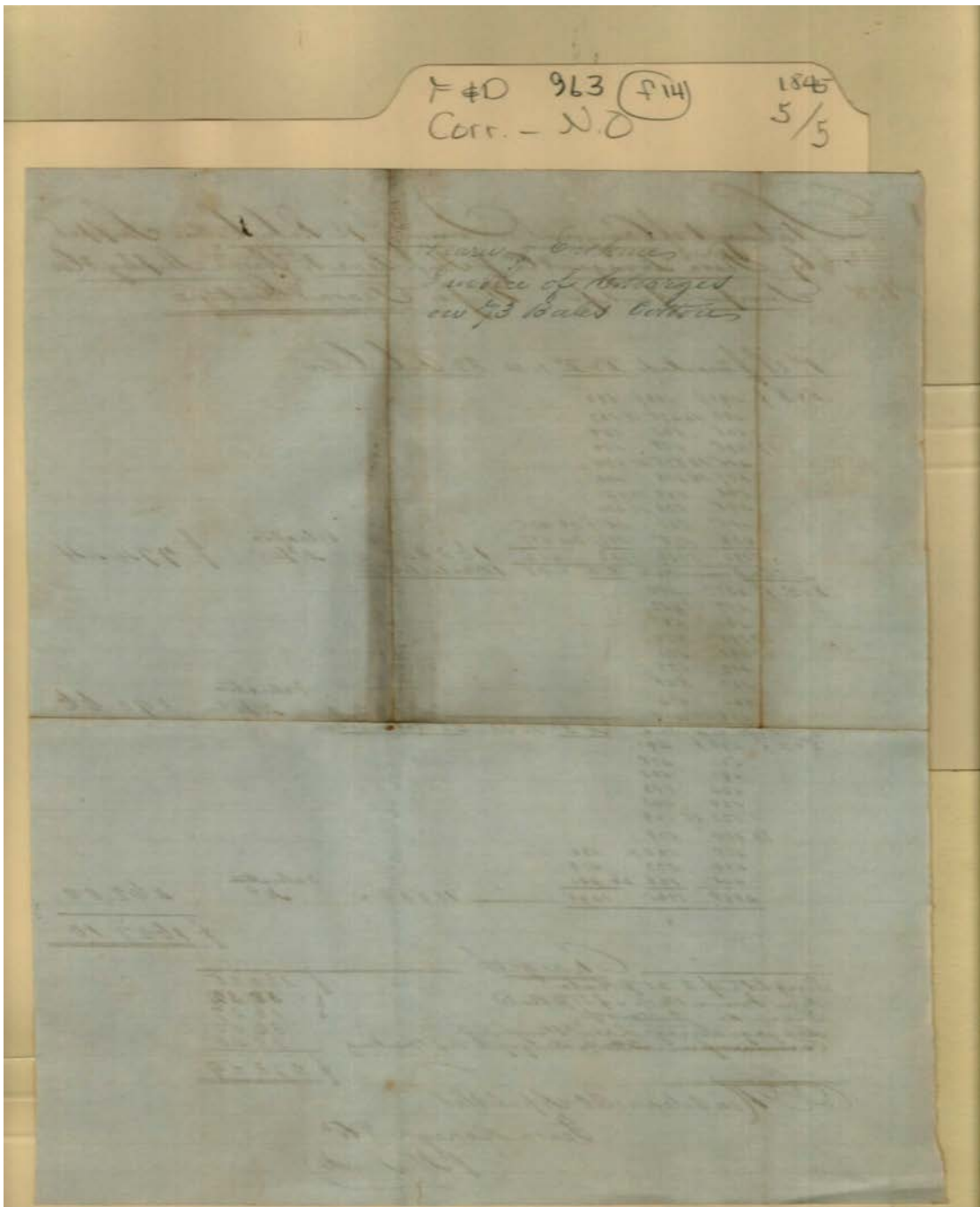

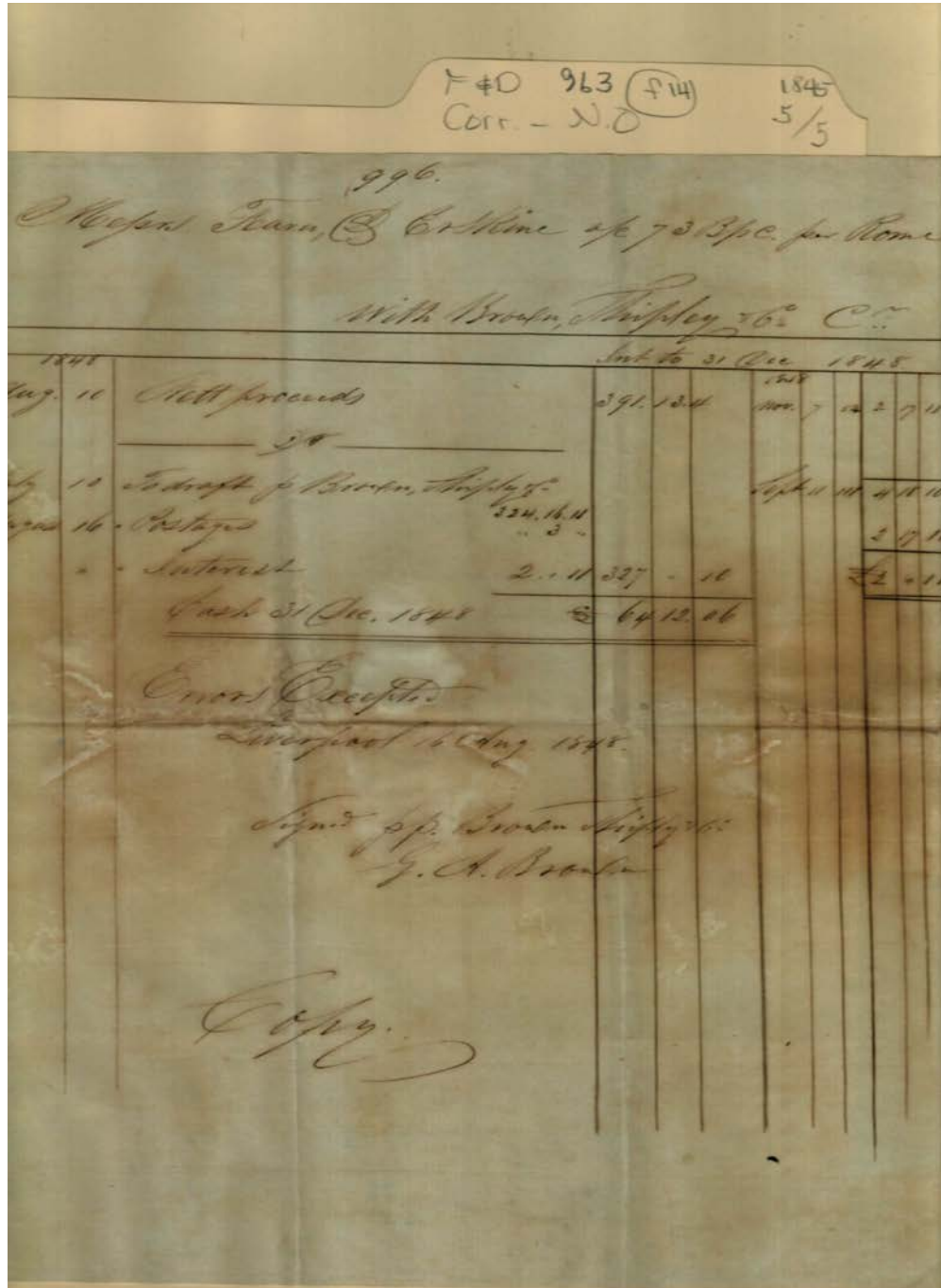

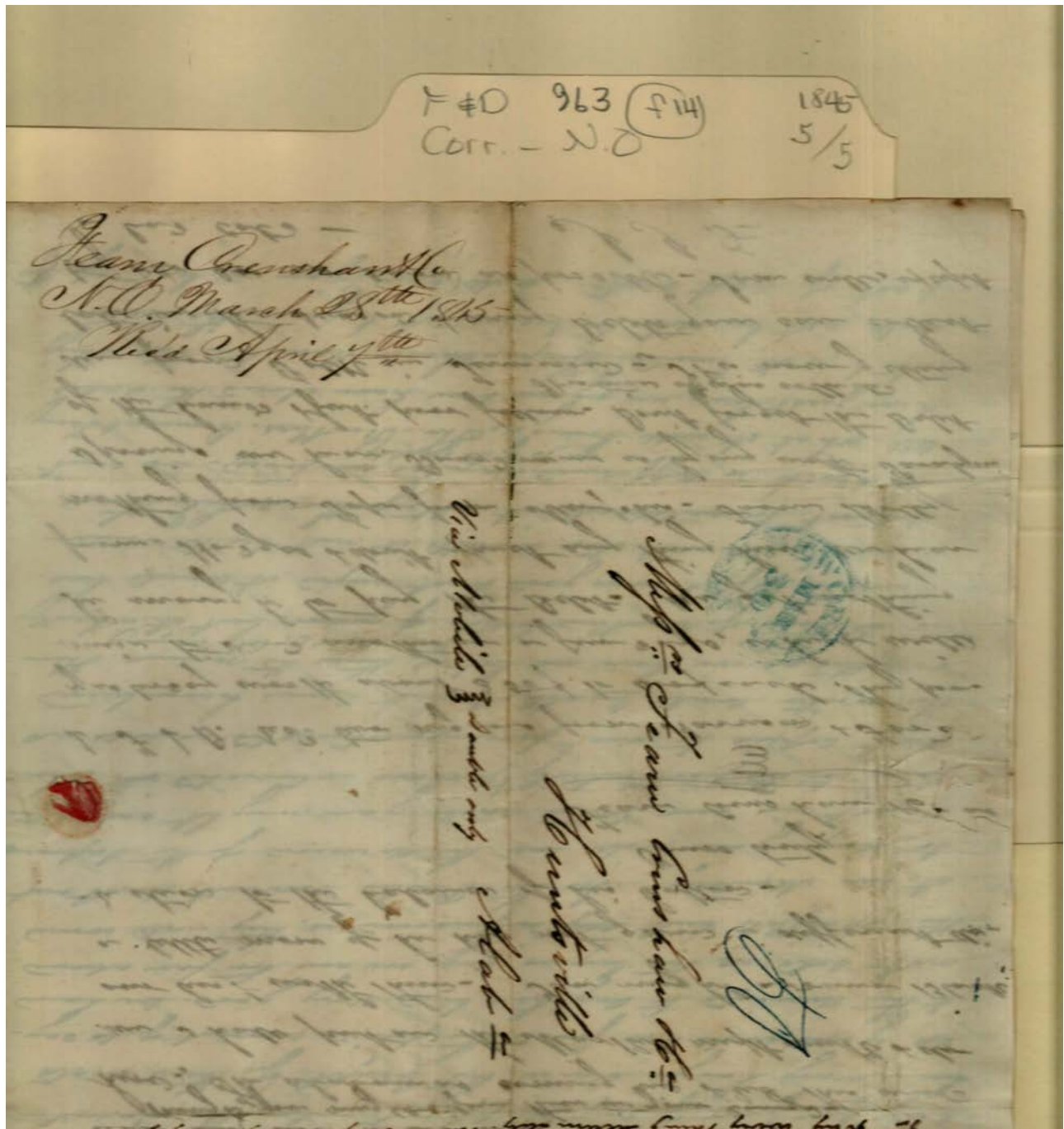

We had this pleasure on the 26th Inst. since the news of your favour to write. Four of Garrett Ewing & Co's Bales had arrived & are discharging their cargo, not yet sampled nor weighed. We had statements of receipts since our last, our main & few business is pretty well there.

On Thursday we see the "Cambridge" accounts for the "Cambridge" which of course you have seen and examined before now. The abolition of the duty on Cotton looks very one by surprise here. Although I looked for as probable in the course of time, it was not expected so soon. It had of course to do with the amount that has been a fortunate movement for large holders. We began having sold in the early part of the week, but the price was so full and we were unwilling this movement we did not feel at liberty to refuse. We omitted to mention it was 5 3/4 cts. Yesterday we sold 52 Bales out of 101 of Robert Brahan's & Co's. It was fine Cotton. we have more a bit and the Table was half Alabama & one half districts Mississippi 2000 Bales for which we are asking 6 3/4 cts in tendency to talk the price when offered - which we feel confident of getting - This will be a very satisfactory result

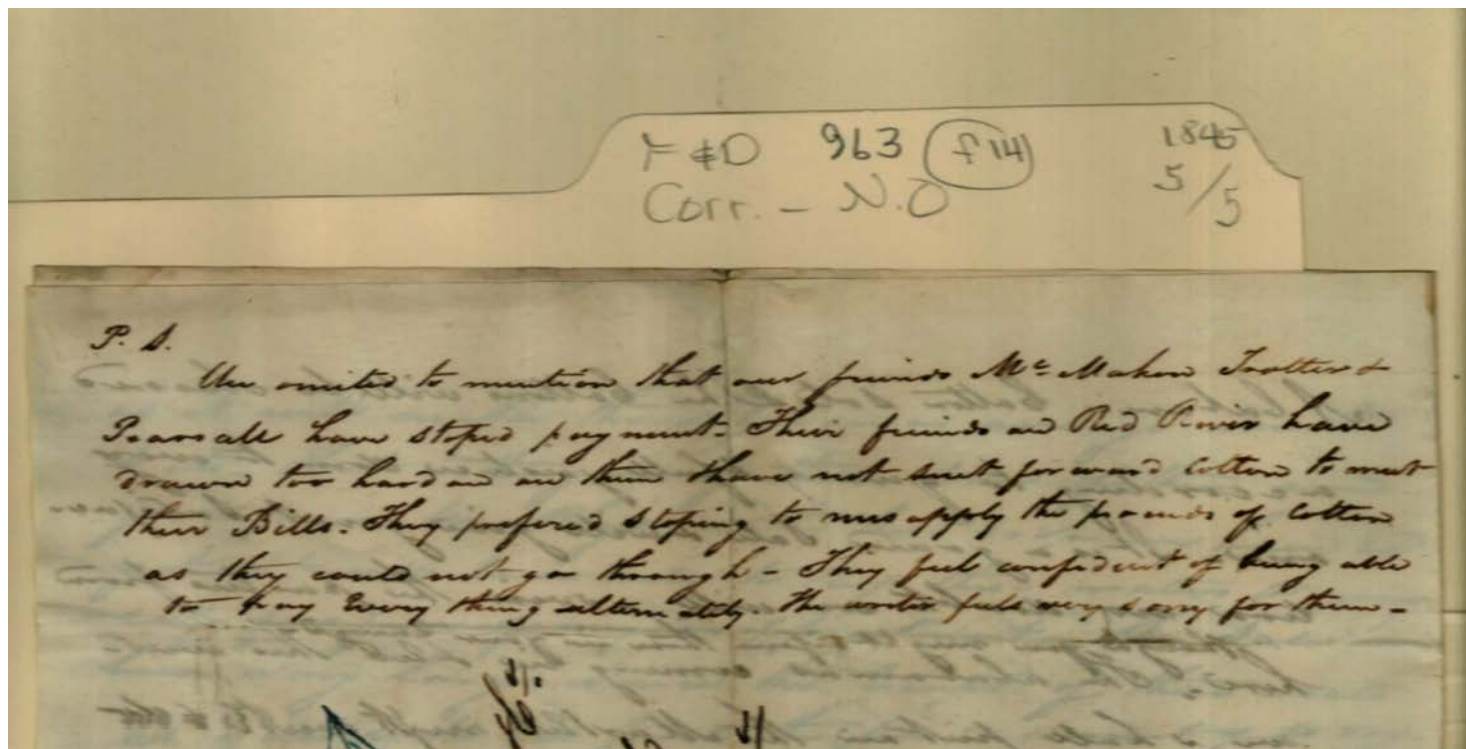

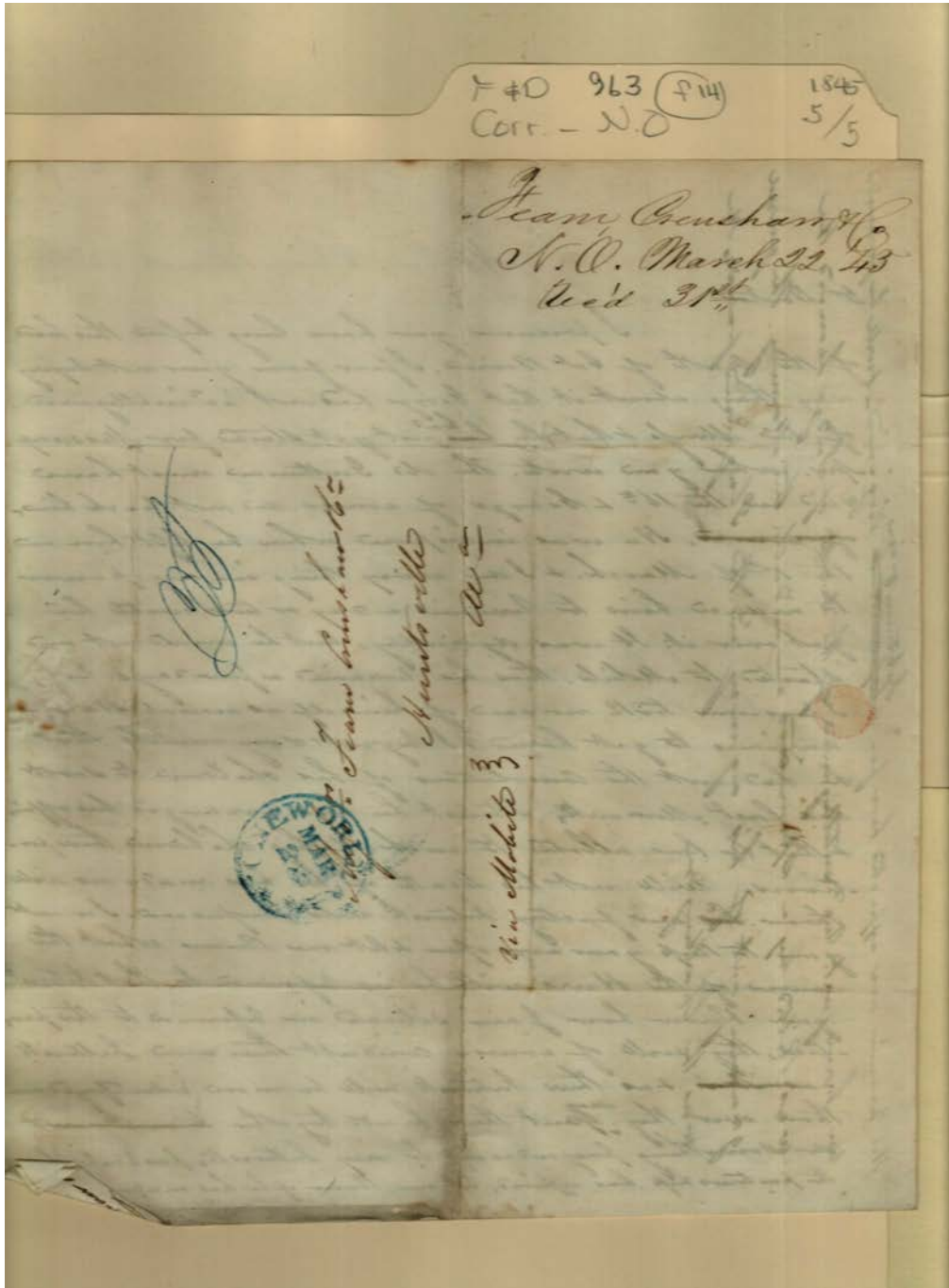

My dear Fearn Crenshaw & Co

We had the pleasure on the 19th Inst. to receive three years of the 10th 12 & 14th are to hand com. trusts notes & the entire amount all made as directed, & said notes had been entered here as your ^{own} advised. None of the flat boats are yet - Surge Hopkins is here & the Laris. They have no money say for mobile. we paid Surge Hopkins \$150 - for ship notes used. & your state are 1st day life the last \$50 & the 1st. The judge did not understand that your state was payable in Alabama. Money said if you so understood it, you then would settle the difference when you meet - so we paid him the amount as he seemed to expect it in N.O. funds, your letter of the 14th only came to hand this morning & we have not seen Mr Bitt. Since. Is there no entry made of the money draft purchased for Mr Bitt. The writer does not now recollect particulars but presume it was entered this acct. should compare with that. but presume he will understand it.

The amount for cotton this week has been limited, owing to the high prices demanded by holders & the decline in prices in New York. Owing to the day it has ^{been} more in demand & it is said at a decline of 1/2 we last week paid, we have sold nothing as we are not disposed to submit to a decline. we think we shall have a good demand next week & hope to be able to sell fairly at from 10 prices. thinking they will be as good in anticipation as after the 4th March accounts arrived. 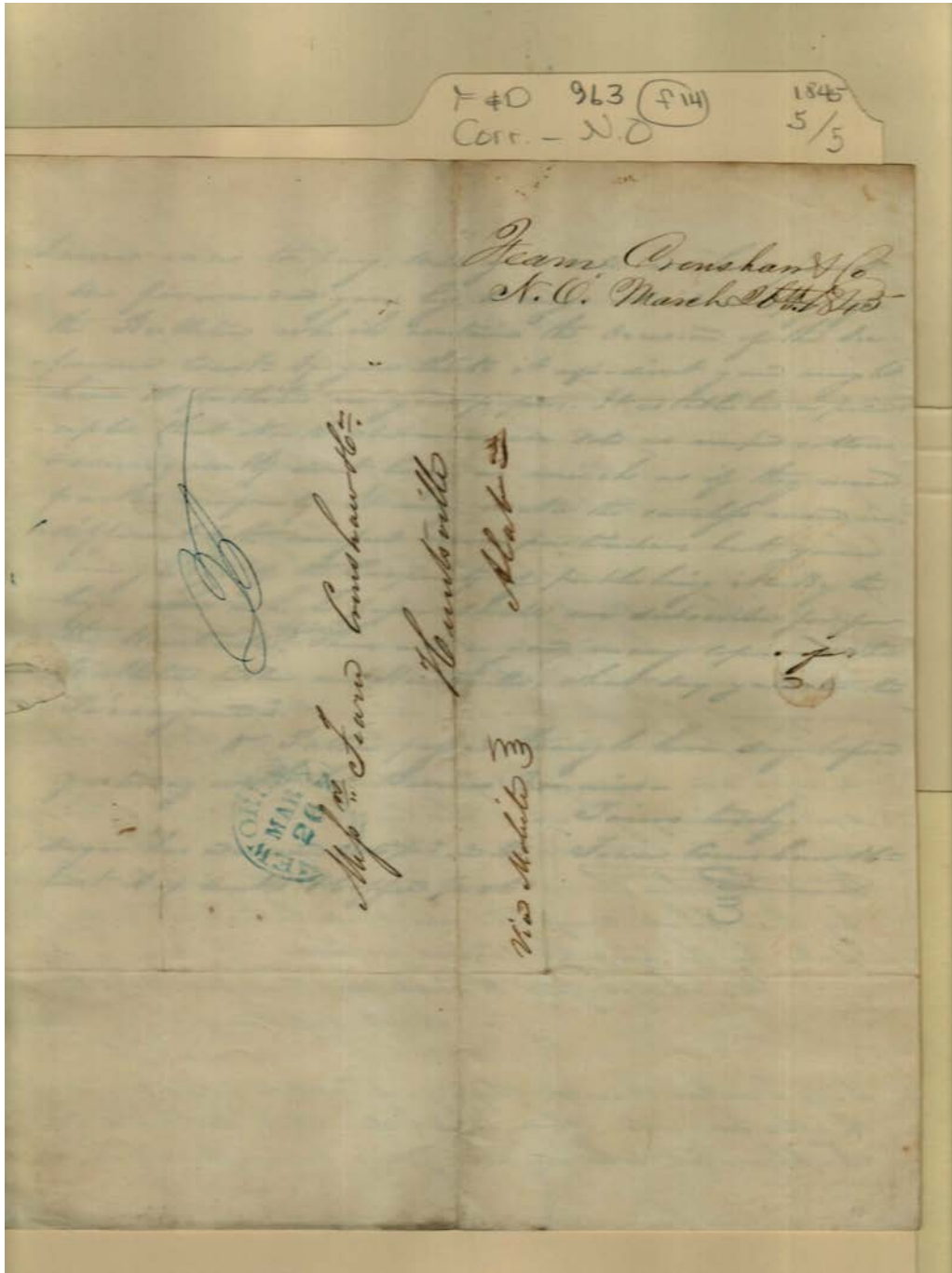

We had the pleasure on the 22^d Inst. to receive the sum of your favour to hand - as we anticipated the demand for cotton became quite augmented on Monday & sales to the extent of 10,000 Bales were effected, and that day yesterday the sales and 5,000 Bales & prices fully as high as the previous period with before last, we sold about 15,000 Bales this week at full price. We shall continue to sell whenever we have full offers and the next steamer comes as it is not improbable that the next news from Egypt may not be quite as good, owing to our large receipts which followed the low estimate of the crop. The receipts are running up fast & unless they stop very suddenly may go up to the high level estimate of the crop they are now 18,500,000 Bales at all the Ports. The other Boat of Herby & Lewis is in view & matters the first & before by these boats complete we shall have them ready for sale by the time the steamer arrives.

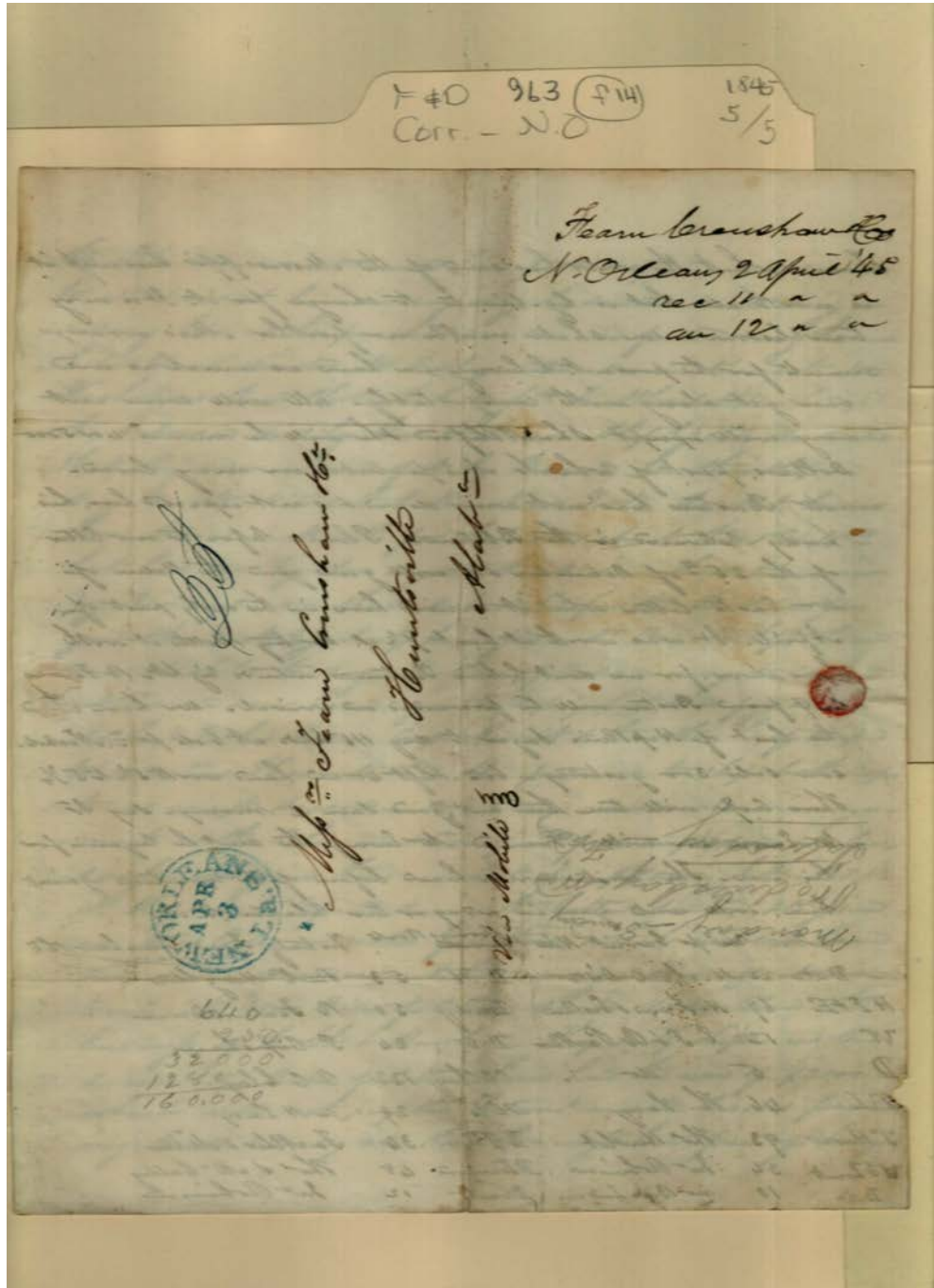

Dear Sir

In the 29th letter we had the pleasure to send you yours of the 21st & 24th with full details of the funds & the amounts as advised passed to you on the 21st. I present any misunderstanding relative to our bill of exchange of S. Jordan's business, with Mr Fennell & the balance of his acct. due us is to be deducted out of the sales of his cotton. It will make no difference if you do not wish it. It came forward over but we wish that we may be governed accordingly.

There is quite a calm in the Cotton Market though the sales are more than reported. There were 3000 Bales sold last evening after the accounts were given up. It is very true there is more enquiry & the independent dealers are not disposed to give way in price. We have done nothing this week except to sell your Bales of St. Louis Cotton at 12 1/2 cts per lb. per instance it is not another large lot to increase & have it sold for the most part. We have a list of cottons by Garrett Ewing & Co. of which you are advised when you see them in Lewis. We have had a Bill of Lading for 100 Bales of his cotton. The cotton has not arrived, but will come next trip of the steamer. Mr. E. M. Swooper has arrived to day. He brought us about 450 Bales of cotton. Mr. Ward has returned in.
