I beg permission to call your attention once more to a matter which I have heretofore asked you to give some consideration to. It is a debt which was passed over when we were all together, without a complaint with my signature was assigned for the purpose. It relates to the payment of a debt which Patton assigned to I think in justice are bound to. It has fallen on me, & perhaps any statement of the case to Mr. Beirne while here, as I did not wish to introduce the subject to him in the absence of Mr. Patton, I desire to present a fair statement of the case for the purpose of putting Mr. Beirne in possession of all the facts. If I state any incorrectly I will be corrected & request that you will inform me, that I may have it in my power to explain or acknowledge the error. This I am sure you will grant as a matter of justice.

The facts of the case are as follows. In March 1835 Patton & Donegan Co. became security for Wm. A. Patton a bond for \$2000. - signed to Gen. R. B. Eldridge Governor of the State of Arkansas & the understanding that William's interest or legacy should be credited on the bond. It appeared to be 1200 or 1300. (The Eldridge afterwards denied to the full extent. I desired to see Mr. Patton pay the whole amount, but I succeeded for my him to allow the amount or every man if I supplied correct.

at the time that the security was only for the balance that he would
 save after deducting his legacy. I signed the name of Patton Donegan
 & Co. to the bond with a seal. I did so from a conviction that I was
 exercising a privilege & discretion, which I had full authority to do
 now, which had been the in former practice of both Mr Patton & myself
 for 8 years previous by signing our partnerships. If I had not believed
 so, certainly I would not have exercised it, when I had no personal
 interest to promote, then I saw that I never had the most honest
 & individual transactions with Bass. Mr Patton never I was in the
 habit of doing so. He knew that our customers were in the habit
 of giving such favours. He granted them & then I did so too.
 Now I ask if he saw me exercising an authority not allowed
 by our partnerships, was it not his duty to have arrested me in
 it or was it fair in him to look out, see me using it for his
 interest as well as my own & saying nothing. I'll take all
 the benefit and advantage ^{gaining out of these accommodations} but you must bear all the losses
 yourself. Mr Patton must remember that we were in the
 habit of endorsing & giving security for many of our customers &
 that we did so without consulting each other. He will recollect
 that we insured for Richard Ford, Wm. Blake, Henry Jordan
 John Jordan, Isaac Jordan, Edw. T. Parker, Mastin &
 another. Ewing & McDowell, Patton & Bass & any others, some
 of these were insured, for we had to ask such favours occasionally
 ourselves, others of them never did & there was ^{nothing so} no objection, but to promote
 the welfare of our business, for I never had an individual trans-
 action with one of them - Mr Patton knows all this frequently
 used the name of the firm in endorsing for them, But if

I have written to you several times in writing of
 the case of the late Beirne & Co. I will relate what occurred in regard
 to the case of the late Beirne & Co. security Mr Patton was coming
 out of the case & something had been done the store was out, I told him
 that I had want these security what happened the amount would
 be for hundred dollars to an extent of 10000. He said in
 his judgment that he did not think he would go his security
 in the case he said that he did not think he was good. I told
 him he was mistaken, he was very good but I did not think he
 was, that the amount was small but he was, that there
 was but little left, that he had been a good customer & that
 I was not at all sure of a great deal more out of him & that
 I ought to refuse him. This was all that passed & I said that
 Mr Patton then in any other occasion, hinted to me directly
 or indirectly that my using the name of the firm, did not meet
 his approval, if he had, I would have cut off my right arm
 I would have done so again.
 The impression made on my mind from the com-
 munication of the case has been that as I had signed the names
 of the firm to a deal, that they were not bound, unless I could show
 a written power of attorney ^{authorizing me to sign} that it was not for this error, I should be
 held responsible, I said I would have shown the authority I
 had for using it by Mr Patton's note my note, and his knowledge
 of them. I have went more into detail than I first intended, but
 I am sending to you that Mr Beirne should be in full posses-
 sion of the facts & I hope to him for such consideration of the
 case as will satisfy me. Mr Patton has denied me the only
 proof of a mode of settlement resorted to by the partners, when differences
 arose between them, I offered to submit it to two disinterested gentlemen
 of which I have no record, but he refused, now I do it is the first, after
 a long time of 17 years. In conclusion I have only to say that under
 the present of the pecuniary consideration, I feel that Mr Patton's view of the
 case imparts an improper use of the name of the firm & I should be
 held responsible for it.

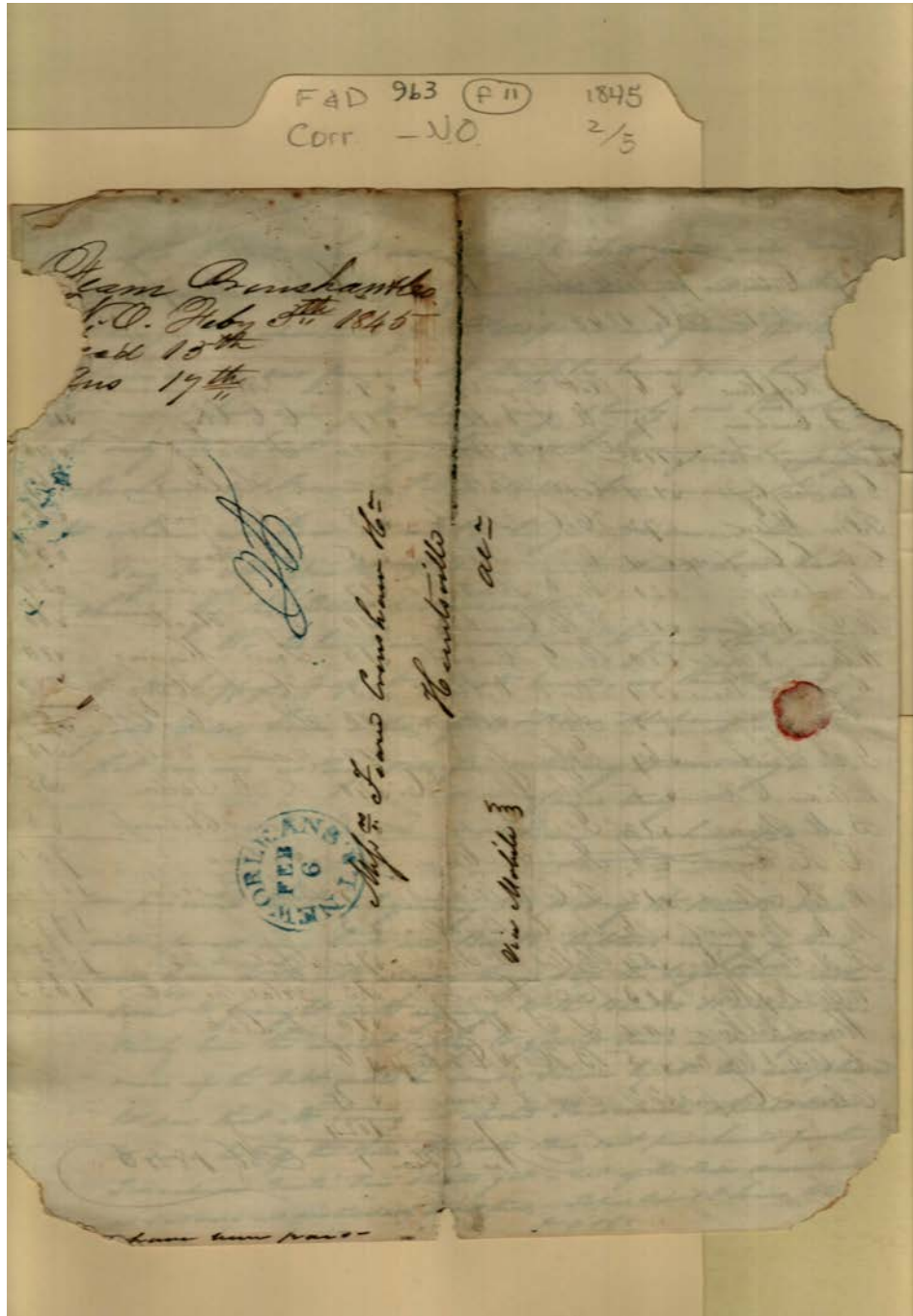

We wrote you on the 1st inst since then have yours of the 27th ult. we haven't a word from Bucke Davis, our friend Swoope stuck to us, not a word from Carroll or Cockerill. While the writer was in the steam Mr. Crenshaw forwarded Carroll out to Boston & they wanted him to have it settled if he was not shipping to us. we have rec^d from Boston & Bro 142 Bales cotton there no doubt he will ship us enough to pay his acct. we think Gov. Clay takes the right course, he will be much better off with a good life out of them in debt. Some-thing Merchants are so much the heart of Planters, that they all want to throw their debts on them & it should be discontinued as much as possible. We have advised Gov. Simmons that Messrs. Caruthers & Rising sent us his note has told him for his instructions. He makes a business case the dearest would not be able to pay much.

We have suspended notes to the 6th Jan'y. They are very encouraging for Texas & this week still with the large stocks of supplies we don't think prices will go up much. our prices are above there now judging from the sales of cotton rec^d from B. I. 16th although 4.50 etc were done we have to pay about 54 for Bales reclamations. say \$2500. They made a miserable out of it. will forward the acct in a few days. your business will be forwarded in a day or two by the Bile of Miss now in post. I am afraid you have a list

We the 17th Inst we had the pleasure, since then none of your favours to hand. The writer rec^d yours of the 14th Inst for last mail contents noted. we have but little to advise since our last. The Cotton Market continues dull & prices firm to 1/4th in favour of the buyer. we have not offered any during the period. Yesterday we rec^d Liverpool dates to the 12th Ult. Imports of Cotton very large. Demand good & prices sustained. This news brought buyers ^{out} to day & there has been a better demand & sales 5 to 6000 Bales at about previous quotations. we shall look for the 2 times a week or a day or two more if there should be an improvement it will have a good effect on prices here. Some persons here insist that the crop will go to 24,000,000 Bales. If it does there may be danger of holding Cotton too long, as it will have an effect on prices. They have 37 months supply in Great Britain & a supply equal to the consumption going forward this year. So that we can't look for much improvement.
