We wrote you 5th inst. and have not since
heard of you with stated inclosure.

The strangest move has occur'd in this market ever not-
with-stand- ing the advice placard in a character more
alarmsing than any we ever had seen in the whole course of our
mercantile experience, and actually made both this write and
our Mr. Donegan shiver with apprehension - yet after heavy sales
for two days thereafter at a decline of $\frac{1}{4}$ (and we discover that
a similar one occur'd in all the Southern & Northern Markets)
the market opened this week with a better spirit and the buying
went on fairly for the two first days at rather stiff prices
until the day before yesterday when they were as high as previous
to the war - and yesterday there was a perfect wreck, 10,000 bales
having changed hands at $\frac{1}{8}$ c. $\frac{1}{2}$ compromise. One Purchaser for
one of Plaines took yesterday 2,000 bales - in all he has taken
fall 20,000 within the last two weeks. His operations have doubt-
less had some effect on the feeling of others, but this week the rates
have greatly fallen off and the impulsion is taking that the crop
will be likely to fall much short of former estimates. The
speculating agents having sold on Friday last but really
were felt more strongly convinced in some doing our duty and
for the best - are particularly regret having parted with Dr. Watkins
bale - but it cannot be expected of any one that they shall always
take the most advantageous course - and this season has
been had with more diffi- than enough.

Whether the Crop is to fall materially short of former expectations we are not prepared to say - we never have counted it over 2 1/4 millions to 2,300,000 bushels - 2 1/4 millions will be about the Consumption of America this year - and if it is to fall 100 or 150 m short of that price will undoubtedly be higher than for the last six or eight weeks - but a mist has been cast the subject from the commencement of the season arising from the very abundant yield promised in the month of July which was followed by a long continued drought the injury from which was estimated variously by different people some contending the dry weather was beneficial rather than prejudicial. One thing is quite certain, prices cannot advance much for some time unless speculators in this country take hold, the stock in hand being so large, the shipments thus far very large, and they must leave of the abroad interests of the Crop before orders are to be expected at higher prices than were current at the last market. The stock on hand we shall not offer for sale until we can see a little better before us.

We enclose statement of reclamations Brown Shipley & Co. against A. J. de la Cour & Co. for 1000 bushels of wheat, which please give the necessary attention.
