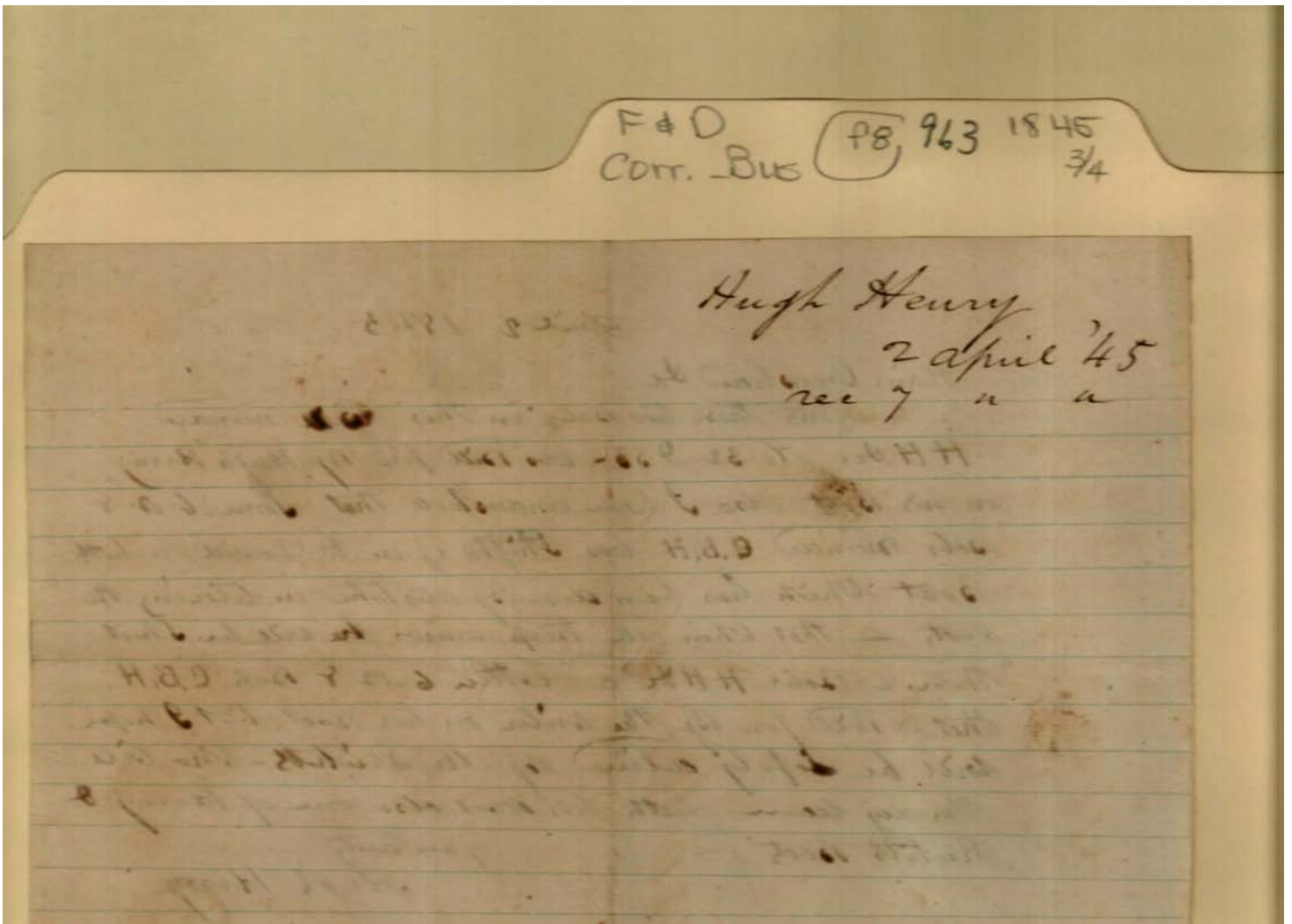

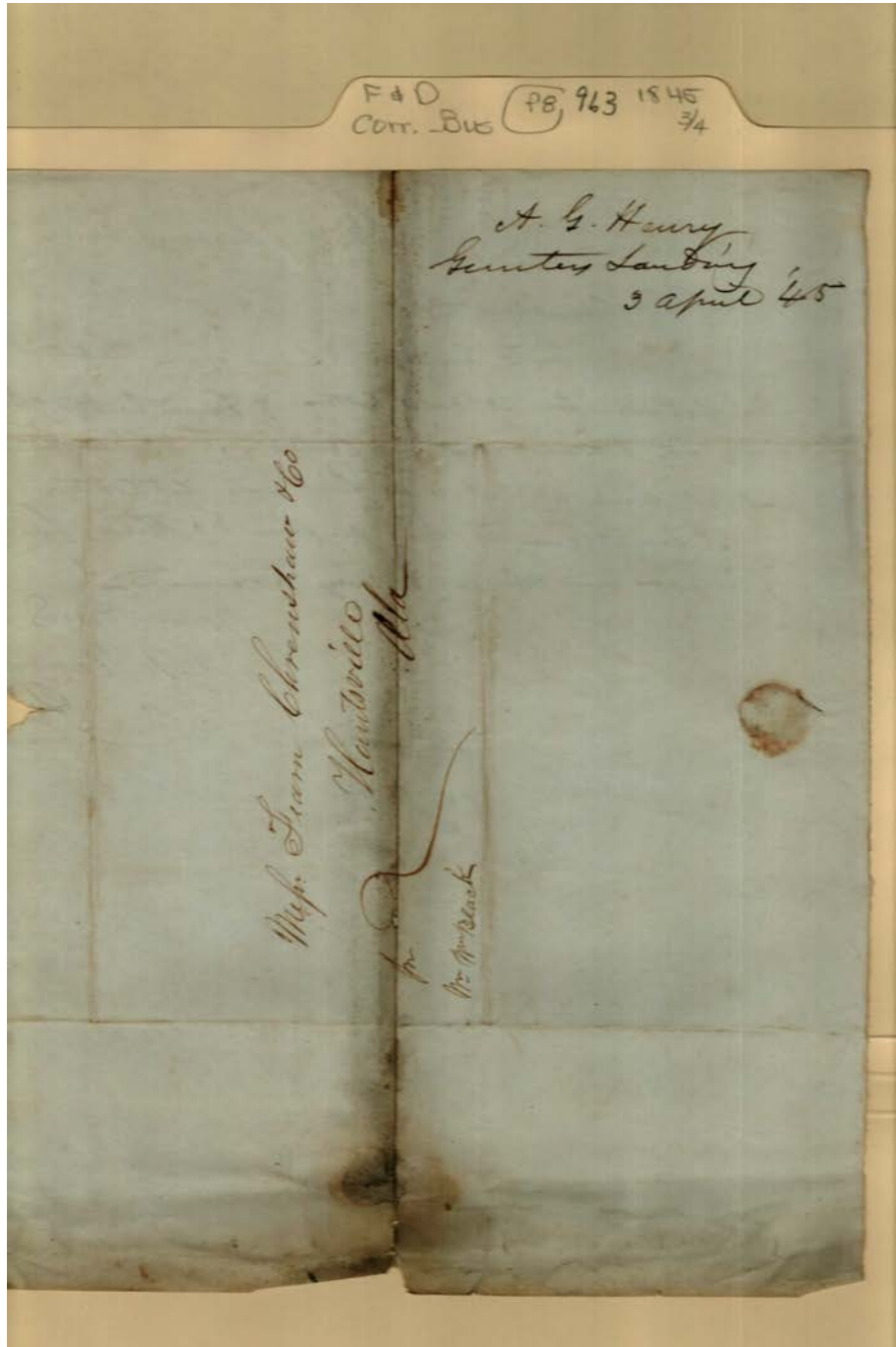

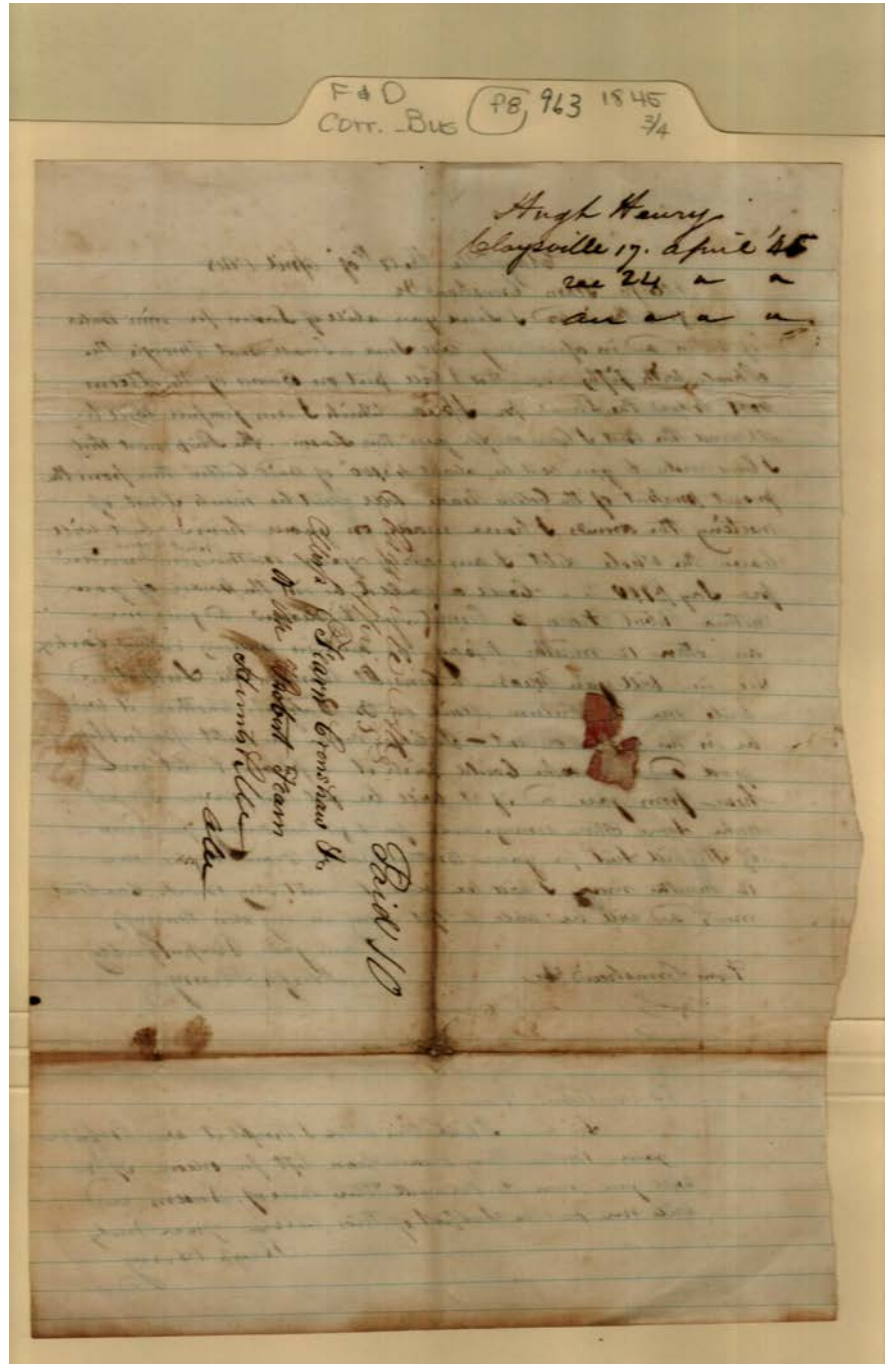

be in his power or not - I can make the debt sensibly
good and I suppose he could wish it - please to let me
hear from you and if it will be out his power I must
make some other arrangement for to get his money for him
if it will suit for your Brother Robert Fearn to give me
12 months more I will be able to meet my debts & current
matters and will be able to get along in my own business

I fear the emotion of my family will not permit me to come to town for a few days. if you can let me have it by this day week should I not be here on that day please hand it over to James Robertson Esq. or \$50. dollars of it there is a judgement against me for it and he is the lawyer who has the collection. I am not absent on execution to insure. and it will certainly unless the money is paid by this day week I have shipped about 38 thousand pounds of cotton I shall rely on you for the money and hope you will arrange it for me. I let you have \$55 in gold a week or two ago to be received. I came to town this day purposely on this account and for the cotton need. I did not get the need as I did not want five bushels. you must arrange this thing for me
